THE TWINS: After completing their three-game series/homestand with the Yankees by getting swept in three games, the Twins began their six-game roadtrip with a loss in Cleveland last night...tonight, Minnesota will play the second of three at Progressive Field and complete the series tomorrow afternoon...after tomorrow's game, they will travel to D.C. and begin a three-game series with the Nationals from Monday-Wednesday.

☑ Twins have won 17 of their last 24 games...since April 22, the Twins are tied with the Dodgers (17-6) for the second-most wins in baseball, trailing Philadelphia (18-6).
☑ Twins are looking to avoid losing five consecutive games, which would tie their long for 2024, previously done from April 14-19.

TWINS DROP CLOSE ONE IN CLEVELAND: The Twins lost to the Guardians last night by a score of 3-2 at Progressive Field...Simeon Woods Richardson was the starter but did not factor into the decision, allowing one run on four hits in 5.1 innings pitched, with no walks and two strikeouts...Jhoan Duran (0-1) was dealt the loss, allowing a solo home run to José Ramírez, which broke a 2-2 tie in the bottom of the eighth inning...the offense recorded just four hits and walked five times...Alex Kirilloff homered for the third time this season...Max Kepler doubled, giving him 10 for the season and 194 in his career, passing César Tovar and moving into sole possession of 13th on the Twins all-time list.

RETURN OF THE MACK: The Twins have returned outfielder Byron Buxton from his rehab assignment and reinstated him the 10-day Injured List...Buxton, who missed the club's last 14 games with right knee inflammation, played in two games on rehab assignment this week with Triple-A St. Paul, going 0-for-6 with one RBI...prior to landing on the IL, Buxton played in 28 games for Minnesota, hitting .250 (23-for-92) with eight doubles, one triple, one home run, 11 RBI and 12 runs scored...to make room for Buxton on the 26-man roster, the Twins have optioned utility player Austin Martin to St. Paul...during his most recent stint with the Twins, Martin hit .214 (3-for-14) with one double, one walk and two stolen bases in eight games.

I WANT TO SPEAK WITH YOUR MANAGER: Rocco Baldelli enters today with 399 career managerial wins...since becoming the Twins manager in 2019, only two AL managers have won more than Rocco: Kevin Cash (445-309) and Aaron Boone (440-314)...14 active managers have reached the 400 wins mark (Bruce Bochy, Bob Melvin, Bud Black, A.J. Hinch, Dave Roberts, Cash, Craig Counsell, Ron Washington, Brian Snitker, Scott Servais, Boone, Torey Lovullo, Alex Cora and Dave Martinez)...below are the Twins' all-time managerial wins leaders (left) and Baldelli's milestone victories (right):

TWINS AND GUARDS: The Twins are playing the Guardians for the fourth of 13 times in 2024...the Twins have gone 0-3 against Cleveland this season, going 0-2 at Target Field from April 4-6, followed by a loss last night.

☑ Since the start of last season, 13 of the 16 games between these two teams have been decided by three runs and six have been decided by one run.

☑ Carlos Correa is hitting .300 (33-for-110) with seven home runs, 14 RBI, a .379 on-base percentage, a .509 slugging percentage and an .888 OPS in 29 games against the Guardians since the start of 2022.

☑ Christian Vázquez is hitting .306 (33-for-108) with eight doubles, 11 walks and an .805 OPS in 34 career games vs. the Guardians.

☑ In his last eight games at Progressive Field, Willi Castro is hitting .364 (8-for-22) with a .969 OPS.

SANTANA PLAYING THE HITS: In his last 21 games (roughly since he and Glen Perkins shook hands pregame in the Anaheim visiting clubhouse), Carlos Santana has posted an .876 OPS with three doubles, seven home runs, 18 RBI, a .571 slugging percentage and a 15.9% strikeout rate...in his previous 20 games, he posted a .407 OPS with two doubles, no home runs, three RBI and a 22.5% strikeout rate.

☑ Santana has hit .247 (589-for-2389) with 122 doubles, seven triples, 111 home runs, 335 RBI and an .806 OPS in 680 career games at Progressive Field...however, he has five hits in 49 at-bats at Progressive Field as an opponent in Cleveland.

THE LEFTORIUM: Twins hitters are slashing .274/.321/.433 with a .754 OPS vs. left-handed pitching compared to .219/.300/.384 with a .684 OPS vs. right-handed pitching.

☑ Since April 24 (17 games), the Twins are slashing .320/.354/.500 (.854 OPS) vs. lefties—the highest batting average in baseball since that date.

☑ Ryan Jeffers is hitting .318 (7-for-22) with a .966 OPS in his last 12 games vs. lefties.

☑ Willi Castro is hitting .424 (14-for-33) with a 1.094 OPS vs. left-handed pitching...in his last 13 games, he is 14-for-23 (.609) with a 1.522 OPS vs. lefties.

AMERICA'S NEXT TOP JEFF: Ryan Jeffers is hitting .297 (22-for-74) with eight doubles, seven home runs, 19 RBI, six walks, a .372 on-base percentage, a .689 slugging percentage and a 1.061 OPS in his last 21 games, since April 22.

☑ Among all AL qualifiers on the season, Jeffers ranks fourth in OPS (.951), trailing Kyle Tucker (1.015), Aaron Judge (.981) and Salvador Perez (.960)...additionally, he ranks second in the AL in slugging percentage (.595), third in OPS+ (170.9) and fifth in RC/27 (7.88).

MIRANDA WATCH!: Jose Miranda is hitting .321 (18-for-56) with six doubles, one home run, six RBI, a .367 on-base percentage, a .482 slugging percentage and an .849 OPS in his last 16 games...in that span, he is hitting .333 (9-for-27) with an .898 OPS vs. lefties.

ON THIS DAY IN TWINS HISTORY: In 1962, Bob Allison and Harmon Killebrew both hit grand slams in the first inning to lead the Twins to a 14-3 victory over Cleveland...in 1969, Rod Carew stole second base, third and home plate during the third inning of an 8-2 loss to Detroit...Carew pulled off the trifecta against the battery of Mickey Lolich and Bill Freehan and became the first player in 28 years to steal three bases in sequence in the same inning...in 2021, Bailey Ober made his major league debut at Target Field against the White Sox, allowing four runs on five hits in 4.0 innings pitched in a Twins 5-4 victory...Miguel Sanó hit three home runs in the game.

- ☞ Making ninth start of season and 66th of career...has allowed 10 earned runs in 35.1 innings (2.16 ERA) across seven starts since eight-run season debut March 31 in Kansas City.
- ☞ Last pitched on May 12 vs. Toronto, allowing zero runs on one hit in 6.1 innings, with one walk and a season-high 10 strikeouts...earned his fourth consecutive win in the Twins' 5-1 win.
- ☞ Made his major league debut three years ago today, on May 18, 2021 vs. Chicago-AL.
- ☞ Has made five career starts vs. Cleveland Guardians, going 1-1 with a 1.29 ERA (28.0 IP, 4 ER), two walks and 21 strikeouts.

LAST TIME OUT: Faced the Blue Jays on May 12 and tied a career-high streak with four consecutive wins in a 5-1 Twins win...allowed a season-low one hit, no runs and a career-high-tying 10 strikeouts in 6.1 innings...was perfect through 3.2 innings until Vladimir Guerrero recorded the only hit given up by Ober, on a single in the fourth inning...first start of his career where he went 6.0-plus innings allowing one-or-fewer hits and zero runs.

- ☞ Last 10 strikeout game was on September 27, 2022 vs. Chicago-AL...earned the victory, allowing two hits, no runs, one walk in a career-high 7.1 innings.
- ☞ Recorded 15 swings and misses in 67 strikes thrown (22.3%).
- ☞ His current win streak is tied with four others for the second-longest active streak in the AL.

TWO STARTS AGO: Faced Seattle on May 7 and did not factor into the decision of the Twins' 10-6 win...allowed two runs on three hits (1 HR) in 5.0 innings, with one walk and seven strikeouts...generated 13 whiffs in 46 swings (28.3%)...allowed both runs in the second, on Mitch Haniger's home run and Dylan Moore's RBI double...had a pair of strikeouts in the third and fourth innings before concluding with a 1-2-3 fifth inning...in his last six starts since eight-run season debut March 31 in Kansas City, has gone 3-0 with a 2.55 ERA (35.1 IP, 10 ER), seven walks and 34 strikeouts.

HITTING HIS STRIDE: Since April 8, Ober has gone 4-0, 2.16 ERA (41.2 IP, 10 ER) with seven walks and 44 strikeouts...since that date, he ranks among qualified AL pitchers in opponent batting average (.149, 1st), WHIP (0.67, 1st), base runners-per-9.0IP (6.26, 1st), fIP (2.12, 3rd) and ERA (2.16, 5th).

VS. CLEVELAND: Has made five career starts vs. Cleveland, going 1-1, 1.29 ERA (28.0 IP, 4 ER), two walks and 21 strikeouts...Cleveland hitters have hit .194 (19-for-98) with a .296 slugging percentage and a .527 OPS.

- ☞ In his last start against the Guardians on June 2, 2023, Ober allowed four hits, no walks and three strikeouts in 6.0 scoreless innings; Twins won, 1-0.
- ☞ Only win vs. Cleveland came on May 5, 2023 at Progressive Field...allowed three hits, one walk and six strikeouts in 7.0 scoreless innings.
- ☞ Has an active 18.0 scoreless innings against the Guardians dating back to his last three starts.

ON THE ROAD AGAIN: Making his sixth road start of the season today...in previous five, has gone 3-1 with a 4.67 ERA (27.0 IP, 14 ER), four walks, 25 strikeouts, a 0.96 WHIP and a .218 (22-for-101) opponent batting average...compared to three home starts, he is 1-0, 2.25 ERA (16.0 IP, 4 ER), four walks, 20 strikeouts, a 0.75 WHIP and a .151 (8-for-53) opponent batting average

- ☞ Has gone 9-9 with a 3.83 ERA (17.1 IP, 73 ER) in 33 career road starts, compared to 8-4 with a 3.45 ERA (164.1 IP, 63 ER) in 32 career home starts.
- ☞ After his outing at Kauffman Stadium, Ober is 3-0, 2.10 ERA (25.2 IP, 6 ER) in his last four road starts.
- ☞ Since 2022, Ober is tied for second with teammate Pablo López and former teammate Sonny Gray with eight road wins.

REVERSE SPLITS: On May 12, Toronto left-handed hitters went 0-for-5 with three strikeouts against Ober, while righties went 1-for-15 with seven strikeouts...through eight games this season, lefties have hit .177 (11-for-62) with a .563 OPS and a 27.4 percent strikeout rate, while righties have hit .207 (19-for-92) with a .660 OPS and a 30.4 percent strikeout rate.

- ☞ Lefties have a 25.9 percent whiff rate and 86.0 mph average exit velocity vs. Ober, while righties a 23.6 percent whiff rate and 89.8 mph average exit velocity.
- ☞ In five career starts, Cleveland left-handed hitters have hit .151 (8-for-53), with three extra-base hits two doubles and one home run with seven strikeouts and a .442 OPS, while righties have hit .244 (11-for-45) with three extra-base hits, two doubles, one home run, 14 strikeouts and an .626 OPS.

THE ARSENAL: Has used a five-pitch mix thus far in 2024, per Baseball Savant...uses 4-seamer and cutter against both left- and right-handed hitters...predominantly throws changeup and curveball to lefties, slider to righties. Here's his pitch usage through eight starts:

☞ In his last start Blue Jays hitters went 1-for-11 with six strikeouts against the 4-seam fastball.

CAREER-HIGH-TYING STREAK: With a win in his last start on May 12, he tied his career-high with four consecutive wins dating back to April 20 against Detroit...his last four-game win streak was from September 27, 2022-May 16, 2023...during the four-game win-streak he has beaten Detroit, Los Angeles-AL, Chicago-AL and Toronto.

NIGHT NIGHT: In three night games this season, he is 1-0, 2.60 ERA (17.1 IP, 5 ER), six walks, 22 strikeouts and an opponent batting average of .158 (9-for-57)...this compares to 3-1, 4.56 ERA (25.2 IP, 13 ER), two walks, 23 strikeouts and an opponent batting average of .216 (21-for-97) in five day game starts.

2023 RECAP:

- ☞ Was Triple-A St. Paul's Opening Day starter and pitched in four games for Saints to begin the season, posting a 2.55 ERA (17.2 IP, 5 ER) with six walks and 22 strikeouts.
- ☞ Named Twins minor league Pitcher of the Week on April 23 after throwing 5.0 scoreless innings.
- ☞ Recalled by Twins on April 23 and made season debut that day against Washington, allowing one run on three hits in 5.2 innings, earning the win.
- ☞ Posted a 1.82 ERA (24.2 IP, 5 ER) with four walks and 24 strikeouts over his next four starts with the Twins.
- ☞ Pitched 7.0 shutout innings twice: May 5 at Cleveland and July 1 at Baltimore.
- ☞ Allowed three earned runs-or-fewer in 15 of first 16 starts with Twins from April 23-July 23.
- ☞ Posted career-best four-start stretch (July 18-August 4) without issuing a walk.
- ☞ To limit innings, returned to Triple-A from August 28-September 15 and started once in that span.
- ☞ Set career highs in wins (8), innings pitched (144.1), starts (26) and strikeouts (146).
- ☞ Ranked fourth on Twins staff in starts, innings and strikeouts.
- ☞ Left off AL Wild Card Series roster vs. Toronto but added to ALDS roster vs. Houston.
- ☞ Made Postseason debut and started Game 1 at Houston, allowing three runs on four hits (2 HR)
