Christian Yelich, who played for the Marlins from 2013-17 prior to being traded to the Brewers, is a career .315 hitter (28-for-89) with 5 HR and 19 RBI in 24 games against his former team, including .314 (16-for-51) with 2 HR and 12 RBI in 13 games in Miami.

A Life of Crime

Brice Turang has been successful in his last 35 stolen base attempts, the longest active streak in the majors and longest streak in team history.

Everyday People

Willy Adames and William Contreras have both started each of the team's first 48 games....this is the longest streak to start a season by Brewers teammates since Ryan Braun and Prince Fielder in 2011 (56 games).

ON THE ROAD: The Brewers are 16-11 on the road, going 4-3-1 in series play.....the team has lost its last three road series (1-2 at CHC/1-2 at KC/1-2 at HOU) after going 4-0-1 in its first five

MANAGER: Pat Murphy was named the 20th manager in franchise history on 11/15/23. replacing Craig Counsell.....he is signed to a 3-year contract through 2026.....Murphy spent the previous eight seasons (2016-23) as bench coach.....his only Major League managerial experience previously came in 2015 as interim manager of the San Diego Padres (42-54), replacing Bud Black in June of that season.....Murphy enjoyed a 25-year college head coaching career spent primarily at the University of Notre Dame (1988-94) and Arizona State University (1995-2009).

COACHES: First base coach Quintin Berry (4th season), field coordinator Néstor Corredor (2nd season/1st in current role), hitting coach Connor Dawson (3rd season), assistant pitching coach Jim Henderson (3rd season/1st in current role), pitching coach Chris Hook (6th season), third base coach Jason Lane (9th season/4th in current role), run prevention coordinator Walker McKinven (5th season/1st in current role) and hitting coach Ozzie Timmons (3rd season) all returned from the 2023 staff..... Rickie Weeks (associate manager), Daniel de Mondesert (assistant coach) and Charlie Greene (bulloen coach) are in their first seasons on the coaching staff, all Major League coaches for the first time.

LET'S GO TO THE VIDEO TAPE: The Brewers have made 10 replay challenges this season, going 6-4.....their last challenge came on 5/19 at Houston as an out call at first base involving Sal Frelick was overturned.

TONIGHT'S STARTER: #51 - RHP FREDDY PERALTA (9gs, 3-2, 4.17)

PERALTA AT A GLANCE: Freddy Peralta, 27, is making his 10th start of the season.....Peralta last started last Friday at Houston in a 5-4 loss (5ip, 8h, 5r, 5er, 1bb, 6k, 2hr, 97 pitches).....the team is 7-2 in his starts.....he has 4 quality starts.....opponents are batting .217 (39-for-180, 6hr).....he is the third pitcher in franchise history born in the Dominican Republic to start on Opening Day, joining Rafael Roque (1999) and Wily Peralta (2016), who is of no relation.....Peralta was acquired from Seattle, along with RHP Carlos Herrera and RHP Daniel Missaki, in exchange for 1B Adam Lind on 12/9/15.....on 2/28/20, he signed a 5-year contract through the 2024 season with club options for 2025 and 2026

LAST SEASON: Peralta went 12-10 with a 3.86 ERA in a career-high 30 starts last season.....the team went 17-13 in his starts.....he made 16 quality starts.....opponents batted .212 [131-for-617, 26hr].....Peralta ranked among the 2023 National League leaders in K/9IP (3rd, 11.41), WHIP (5th, 1.12), H/9IP (5th, 7.12), strikeouts (T5th, 210) and K/BB (7th, 3.89).....he became the eighth pitcher (14x) in franchise history to produce 200+ strikeouts in a season.

CAREER: Is 45-29 with a 3.86 ERA and 1 save in 155 games/106 starts (630.1ip, 270er).....is in his seventh Major League season, all with the Brewers (2018-24).....has gone 37-27 with a 3.85 ERA as a starter (546.1ip, 234er) and 8-2 with a 3.86 ERA in relief (84ip, 36er).....was an All-Star in 2021.

CAREER AT AMERICAN FAMILY FIELD: Is 26-14 with a 3.41 ERA in 81 games/53 starts (329.2ip, 125er).....is 1-0 with a 4.24 ERA in 3 starts this season (17ip, 8er).

CAREER ON THE ROAD: Is 19-15 with a 4.34 ERA in 74 games/53 starts (300.2ip, 145er)....is 2-2 with a 4.13 ERA in 6 starts this season (32.2ip, 15er).

CAREER vs. MARLINS: Is 3-2 with a 4.94 ERA in 8 games/5 starts against Miami (27.1ip, 26h, 15r, 15er, 5bb, 38k, 5hr), including 1-1 with a 4.82 ERA in 2 starts last season (9.1ip, 11h, 5r, 5er, 0bb, 13k, 3hr).
