NOTABLE OFFSEASON TRANSACTIONS: 10/30, declined the mutual option on OF Ryan Braun.....11/4, named Ed Sedar advisor to the Major League coaching staff; named Quintin Berry first base coach.....11/19, promoted Matt Arnold to senior vice president and general manager.....12/2, acquired a player to be named (LHP Leo Crawford) from Los Angeles-NL for **RHP Corey Knebel**.....<u>1/21</u>, signed **INF/OF Daniel Robertson** to a 1-year contract.....2/5, signed 2B Kolten Wong to a 2-year contract with a club option for 2023.....<mark>2/22</mark>, re-signed **LHP Brett Anderson** to a 1-year contract.....**2/23**, signed **3B** Travis Shaw to a Minor League contract with an invitation to Major League camp.....3/8, signed OF Jackie Bradley Jr. to a 2-year contract with a player opt-out clause after 2021 and mutual option for 2023.

MANAGER: Craig Counsell is in his seventh season as Brewers manager (435-413) and sixth full season.....Counsell ranks third in franchise history in managerial wins, trailing Phil Garner (563-617) and Ned Yost (457-502).....under Counsell, the Brewers have made the postseason in three consecutive years for the first time in franchise history.....Counsell was named the 19th manager in franchise history on 5/4/15, replacing Ron Roenicke.....he is signed through 2023.

COACHES: Assistant hitting coach Jacob Cruz (2nd season), hitting coach Andy Haines (3rd season), pitching coach Chris Hook (3rd season), bullpen coach Steve Karsay (3rd season), third base coach Jason Lane (6th season, 1st as 3B coach), associate pitching, catching and strategy coach Walker McKinven (2nd season) and bench coach Pat Murphy (6th season) all returned from the 2020 coaching staff.....new to the staff is first base coach Quintin Berry.

2020 IN REVIEW: The Brewers went 29-31, finishing in fourth place in the NL Central, trailing the first-place Cubs by 5.0 games.....the team was the eighth seed in the National League postseason and fell to the top-seeded Dodgers, 2 games to none, in the Wild Card Series in Los Angeles.....the Brewers qualified for the postseason for the seventh time in franchise history and for a third straight season for the first time ever.

SPRING TRAINING: The Brewers went 15-11-3 this spring, winning each of their last 3 games.....the team played its home games at American Family Fields of Phoenix, the Spring Training home of the Brewers since 1998 (renovated in 2019).

HOUSER AT A GLANCE: Adrian Houser, 28, will be making his season debut today against the Twins.....Houser went 1-0 with a 5.60 ERA in 6 starts during Spring Training [17.2ip, 21h, 12r, 11er, 6bb, 16k, 2hr].....he last started on Monday at Globe Life Field in Texas and earned a 4-0 win (5.2ip, 2h, 1bb, 6k).....he was acquired from Houston, along with LHP Josh Hader, OF Brett Phillips and OF Domingo Santana, in exchange for OF Carlos Gómez, RHP Mike Fiers and International Signing Bonus Slot #76 on 7/30/15.

LAST SEASON: Houser went 1-6 with a 5.30 ERA in 12 games / 11 starts last season.....the team went 5-6 in his starts.....he made 1 quality start.....opponents batted .285.....he went 1-0 with a 0.75 ERA in his first 2 starts last season (12ip, 1er) and 0-6 with a 6.70 ERA in his last 9 starts (43ip, 32er).

CAREER: Is 7-13 with a 4.13 ERA in 56 games / 29 starts [183ip, 84er].....is in his fifth Major League season, all with the Brewers [2015, 2018-21].....is 3-13 with a 4.91 ERA as a starter [135.2ip, 74er] and 4-0 with a 1.90 ERA in relief [46.1ip, 10er].....underwent "Tommy John" surgery on his right elbow on 7/21/16.
