OLDEST ACTIVE

**RECENT REDBIRDS:** The St. Louis Cardinals embark on a seven-game road trip this afternoon, beginning with the opener of a three-game weekend series with the division-rival Chicago Cubs at Wrigley Field ... The Cardinals are visiting two of the three oldest professional baseball stadiums in America on the road trip as they play at Wrigley Field (1914) this weekend and Birmingham, Alabama's Rickwood Field (1910) on Thursday ... St. Louis closed out a 4-3 win over the Pirates yesterday to complete a 4-3 homestand against Colorado (2-2) and Pittsburgh (2-1).

**FLIGHT PATTERN:** The Cardinals enter today in 2nd place in the National League Central, 6.5 games behind Milwaukee, and tied with the Giants for the final spot in NL Wild Card race ... Since Mother's Day (May 12), St. Louis is tied with the Phillies for MLB's 3rd-best winning pct. (.643, 18-10) ... A win today would bring the Redbirds back to .500 for the first time since May 29.

**THE WIN-DY CITY**: Today marks the latest in the regular season (excluding 2020) for the Redbirds to make their first trip to Wrigley Field since June 20-22, 2016 (3-game Cards sweep) ... St. Louis has won the most games here (477) of any visitor since the Cubs began playing at Wrigley Field in 1916, which includes 14 of the last 22 since July 10, 2021 (.636 win pct.).

**FLAG DAY FACEOFFS:** St. Louis is 33-32 all-time (12-16 on the road) on Flag Day since it become official on Aug. 3, 1949 ... The Cardinals are 3-0 vs. the Chicago Cubs on **Mike Claiborne**'s favorite baseball mile-marker ... Three three previous Flag Day faceoffs between Cards and Cubbies took place over consecutive seasons from 1985-87:

- **1985 at Wrigley Field (W 11-10):** St. Louis scores all 11 runs over final 5.0 innings to hang on to win as **Bob Forsch** relieves **Jeff Lahti** with 2 outs in the 9th inn. and retires **Keith Moreland** for his first career save ... **Willie McGee** triples while **Andy Van Slyke** hits a three-run homer.
- 1986 at Wrigley Field (W 1-0): 8.0 scoreless from starting pitcher Ray Burris and a Tom Herr homer off Scott Sanderson in the 2nd inning.
- **1987 at Busch Stadium II (W 3-2):** Every position player in the Cardinals lineup records a hit as **Danny Cox** allows two runs over 8.1 innings and **Todd Worrell** records his 16th save of the season.

**WINNING:** Since May 10, rookie shortstop **Masyn Winn** is hitting .336 (36-107), tied for the 6th-highest in MLB over that timespan (**Aaron Judge** leads at .392) ... Overall this season, Winn's .302 (62-205) batting average leads Major League rookies, ranks 10th in Major League Baseball, and is 3rd to **Bobby Witt Jr.** (.330) and **Mookie Betts** (.308) among shortstops.

• Winn (age 22-085) today becomes the youngest Cards starting SS at Wrigley since Garry Templeton (age 22-058 on May 21, 1978).

**DONNY, YOU'RE OUT OF YOUR ELEMENT: Brendan Donovan** has reached base safely in all 12 games at Wrigley Field (.340/.421/.400, 17-50), 4th-longest to begin a Cardinals career ... **Todd Zeile** (19 from 1989-92) holds the franchise record.

**BACKSTOP BRILLIANCE:** In 25 games since May 7 when **Willson Contreras** suffered a fractured left arm, **Iván Herrera** is 8th in the NL in batting (.312, 29-93) while ranking among MLB primary catchers in batting (4th), hits (29, T-6th), and OBP (.379, 4th) ... Over that timespan, he and **Pedro Pages** are hitting .275 (33-120), 3rd-highest from team backstops behind the Reds (.281) and Angels (.297).

**CLOSE CALLS:** Forty-eight of the Cardinals 67 games (71.6%) this season have been decided by three runs or fewer, tied with the Mets for 2nd-most in Major League Baseball behind the Cubs (49).

- The Cardinals sport MLB's 2nd-lowest average margin of victory (2.48) ahead of only Tampa Bay (2.30).
- RHP **Ryan Helsley**, who paces MLB in saves (22) and co-leads in games finished (28), has converted 22 consecutive save opportunities, MLB's longest active successful save streak and tied with **Tom Henke** (1995) for the 3rd-longest in franchise history.
- St. Louis 18-1 when the trio of JoJo Romero, Andrew Kittredge, and Helsley all pitch in the same game (lost May 4 vs. White Sox).

- Durable starting pitcher has made 29 or more starts in eight of the last 10 seasons, the most by any MLB pitcher.
- Has worked 150+ IP (minors/majors combined) in 10-straight (2013-23) professional seasons, excluding the COVID shortened 2020 season.

- Became the 9th active pitcher with 300 or more games started on April 30 [1] at Detroit. Justin Verlander leads the active list with 517.
- Pitched four straight quality starts (4/19-5/11), tied with **Sonny Gray** for the longest streak by a Cardinals pitcher since **Jordan Montgomery** ran off five straight (6/9-7/2/2023).
