RECENT REDBIRDS: The St. Louis Cardinals embark on a seven-game road trip this afternoon, beginning with the opener of a three-game weekend series with the division-rival Chicago Cubs at Wrigley Field ... The Cardinals are visiting two of the three oldest professional baseball stadiums in America on the road trip as they play at Wrigley Field (1914) this weekend and Birmingham, Alabama's Rickwood Field (1910) on Thursday ... St. Louis closed out a 4-3 win over the Pirates yesterday to complete a 4-3 homestand against Colorado (2-2) and Pittsburgh (2-1).

FLIGHT PATTERN: The Cardinals enter today in 2nd place in the National League Central, 6.5 games behind Milwaukee, and tied with the Giants for the final spot in NL Wild Card race ... Since Mother's Day (May 12), St. Louis is tied with the Phillies for MLB's 3rd-best winning pct. (.643, 18-10) ... A win today would bring the Redbirds back to .500 for the first time since May 29.

THE WIN-DY CITY: Today marks the latest in the regular season (excluding 2020) for the Redbirds to make their first trip to Wrigley Field since June 20-22, 2016 (3-game Cards sweep) ... St. Louis has won the most games here (477) of any visitor since the Cubs began playing at Wrigley Field in 1916, which includes 14 of the last 22 since July 10, 2021 (.636 win pct.).

FLAG DAY FACEOFFS: St. Louis is 33-32 all-time (12-16 on the road) on Flag Day since it become official on Aug. 3, 1949 ... The Cardinals are 3-0 vs. the Chicago Cubs on Mike Claiborne's favorite baseball mile-marker ... Three other previous Flag Day faceoffs between Cards and Cubbies took place over consecutive seasons from 1985-87:

- **1985 at Wrigley Field (W 11-10):** St. Louis scores all 11 runs over final 5.0 innings to hang on to win as Bob Forsch relieves Jeff Lahti with 2 outs in the 9th inn. and retires Keith Moreland for his first career save ... Willie McGee triples while Andy Van Slyke hits a three-run homer.
- **1986 at Wrigley Field (W 1-0):** 8.0 scoreless from starting pitcher Ray Burris and a Tom Herr homer off Scott Sanderson in the 2nd inning.
- **1987 at Busch Stadium II (W 3-2):** Every position player in the Cardinals lineup records a hit as Danny Cox allows two runs over 8.1 innings and Todd Worrell records his 16th save of the season.

WINNING: Since May 10, rookie shortstop Masyn Winn is hitting .336 (36-107), tied for the 6th-highest in MLB over that timespan (Aaron Judge leads at .392) ... Overall this season, Winn's .302 (62-205) batting average leads Major League rookies, ranks 10th in Major League Baseball, and is 3rd to Bobby Witt Jr. (.330) and Mookie Betts (.308) among shortstops.

- Winn (age 22-085) today becomes the youngest Cards starting SS at Wrigley since Garry Templeton (age 22-058 on May 21, 1978).

DONNY, YOU'RE OUT OF YOUR ELEMENT: Brendan Donovan has reached base safely in all 12 games at Wrigley Field (.340/.421/.400, 17-50), 4th-longest to begin a Cardinals career ... Todd Zeile (19 from 1989-92) holds the franchise record.

BACKSTOP BRILLIANCE: In 25 games since May 7 when Willson Contreras suffered a fractured left arm, Iván Herrera is 8th in the NL in batting (.312, 29-93) while ranking among MLB primary catchers in batting (4th), hits (29, T-6th), and OBP (.379, 4th) ... Over that timespan, he and Pedro Pages are hitting .275 (33-120), 3rd-highest from team backstops behind the Reds (.281) and Angels (.297).

CLOSE CALLS: Forty-eight of the Cardinals 67 games (71.6%) this season have been decided by three runs or fewer, tied with the Mets for 2nd-most in Major League Baseball behind the Cubs (49).

- The Cardinals sport MLB's 2nd-lowest average margin of victory (2.48) ahead of only Tampa Bay (2.30).
- RHP Ryan Helsley, who paces MLB in saves (22) and co-leads in games finished (28), has converted 22 consecutive save opportunities, MLB's longest active successful save streak and tied with Tom Henke (1995) for the 3rd-longest in franchise history.
- St. Louis 18-1 when the trio of JoJo Romero, Andrew Kittredge, and Helsley all pitch in the same game (lost May 4 vs. White Sox).

CHICAGO CUBS CONNECTIONS

Willson Contreras played parts of seven seasons with the Cubs (2016-22)...was a three-time All-Star and member of the 2016 World Series Champions...originally signed as an international free agent with Chicago (July 2, 2009).

Sonny Gray was originally selected by the Cubs in the 27th round of the 2008 MLB Draft, but did not sign to attend Vanderbilt University.

Matt Carpenter (June 4, 2011 at Busch III), **Tommy Edman** (June 8, 2019 at Wrigley), and **Stubby Clapp** (June 18, 2001 at Busch II) made MLB debuts vs. the Cubs.

Chris Roycroft was born in nearby Elmhurst, Ill... graduated from Willowbrook High School in Villa Park, Ill...played college baseball and basketball at Division III Aurora (Ill.) University from 2016-19... pitched for the Joliet Slammers of the independent Frontier League (2021-22).

Daniel Descalso played his final MLB season with the Cubs in 2019.

Nolan Gorman won the 2017 Under Armour High School All-America Game HR Derby at Wrigley Field.

As a compensation pick for the departure of **John Lackey** signing with Chicago in 2016, **Dylan Carlson** (No. 33) was selected by St. Louis in Compensation Round A of the first round of the 2016 MLB draft.

Dylan Carlson and **Nick Madrigal** were teammates at Elk Grove (Calif.) High School, coached by Dylan's father, Jeff.

Tommy Edman and **Nico Hoerner** were college teammates at Stanford University in 2016.

Cardinals broadcaster and Hall of Fame outfielder **Jim Edmonds** played part of 2008 with the Cubs.

Lars Nootbaar and **Shota Imanaga** were teammates on Gold Medal winning Team Japan in the 2023 World Baseball Classic.

Cardinals VP/General Manager **Michael Girsch** is a Chicago native...graduated from the University of Notre Dame and the University of Chicago.

Cubs Bullpen Coach **Darren Holmes** pitched in five games for the Cardinals in 2000.

Patrick Wisdom played in 32 games for St. Louis during 2018 debut season...originally selected by the Cardinals in the Supp. 1st round (No. 52) of the 2012 MLB Draft, as compensation for **Octavio Dotel** signing with Detroit...traded by St. Louis to Texas for **Drew Robinson** (Dec. 11, 2018).

Marquee Sports Network Analyst **Dexter Fowler** played four seasons in St. Louis (2017-20).

Chip Caray served as the Cubs play-by-play announcer for seven seasons (1998-2004) on WGN...his grandfather, **Harry Caray**, spent the final 16 years of his career broadcasting Cubs games (1982-97).

Cubs Scouting VP **Dan Kantrovitz** previously was Cardinals Scouting Director (2012-14)...2001 Cardinals 25th round draft pick from Brown Univ...took first job in MLB as the Cardinals Scouting Coord.

- Logged 6.0+ innings pitched in each of his first seven starts to begin the season (April 1-May 6), longest by a Cardinal to begin a season since 2017 (**Mike Leake** - 11 & **Michael Wacha** - 7). Streak was snapped in his 5/22 start vs. BAL (4.0 IP).
- Since 2013, leads active Major League Baseball pitchers in grounded into double plays (215). Has allowed 213 career home runs over that period for comparison.
- Posted career-highs for innings pitched (38.0) and strikeouts (29) in the month of April. Tied his most starts with six (also 2021 w/TEX). The 38.0 innings were the 3rd-most for Gibson in any calendar month, most recently tossing 39.1 with the Twins in 2018.
- St. Louis area resident and University of Missouri Baseball alum signed with the Cardinals as a free agent last November. Is one of three free-agent starters (**Sonny Gray** & **Lance Lynn**) that the Cardinals signed last off-season.
- Pitching for his fifth Major League team: Twins (2013-19), Rangers (2020-21), Phillies (2021-22), Orioles (2023) and Cardinals (2024).

LAST TIME OUT

- Recorded his second consecutive no decision following a win tossing 6.0 innings allowing three runs while matching his season-high eight hits with seven strikeouts. The Cardinals left him with a 4-3 lead but the bullpen allowed three runs and St. Louis fell 6-5.

CAREER

- Durable starting pitcher has made 29 or more starts in eight of the last 10 seasons, the most by any MLB pitcher.
- Has worked 150+ IP (minors/majors combined) in 10-straight (2013-23) professional seasons, excluding the COVID shortened 2020 season.
- Has posted a 3.24 ERA (25.0 IP) with **Willson Contreras** behind the plate, the 4th-lowest ERA of any of the 25 catchers he has pitched with in his career. **Pedro Pagés** on 5/28 was the 25th catcher of his career.
- Owns career marks of 108-102, one of 14 active pitchers with 100 or more wins. Ranks T-10th among active pitchers with 108 wins with **Wade Miley**, one behind **Carlos Carrasco** (109) for 9th.
- Has posted eight 10-win seasons since his MLB debut in 2013, tied for 4th-most among over that period trailing only **Max Scherzer** (10), **Gerrit Cole** (9) & **Clayton Kershaw** (9).
- Is one of four pitchers since 2014 to record 100 or more strikeouts in 9-of-10 seasons with **Jacob deGrom**, **Clayton Kershaw** and **Max Scherzer**.

2024

- Became the 9th active pitcher with 300 or more games started on April 30 [1] at Detroit. **Justin Verlander** leads the active list with 517.
- Pitched four straight quality starts (4/19-5/11), tied with **Sonny Gray** for the longest streak by a Cardinals pitcher since **Jordan Montgomery** ran off five straight (6/9-7/2/2023).
- Posted his career-highs for innings (38.0) and strikeouts (29) in the month of April. Tied his most starts with six (also 2021 w/TEX). The 38.0 innings were the 3rd-most for Gibson in any calendar month most recently tossing 39.1 with the Twins in 2018.
