**RECENT REDBIRDS:** The St. Louis Cardinals play the third of a three-game series against the Miami Marlins tonight at Busch Stadium wrapping up a seven-game homestand. The home team was shutout 5-0 last night by former Cardinal **Sandy Alcántara** and three more Marlins pitchers holding St. Louis to four hits. Following tonight's game, the Cardinals will fly to California to begin a six-game road trip with the San Diego Padres (Aug. 1-3) and Los Angeles Dodgers (Aug. 4-6).

**TRADE SHOW:** Tonight is the Cardinals final game in the month of July with an open day tomorrow in San Diego coinciding with the Major League Baseball Trade Deadline. All trades must be finalized by 5:00 p.m. Central Time.

**BIRD WATCHING:** St. Louis enters today in 4th place in the National League Central, 10.0 games behind first place Milwaukee. The 10.0 games back is the furthest the Cardinals have been out of first place this season and since the final day of the 2024 season, also 10.0 games behind first place Milwaukee with the Cardinals in 2nd place.

**SWIMMING WITH THE FISH:** A win tonight would give the Cardinals a fifth straight season winning the home series against Miami. Dating back to 2019, the Cardinals sport a 13-5 (.722) record over the Marlins in St. Louis. Miami last won a series at Busch Stadium in 2018 and split a four-game series in St. Louis in 2019. St. Louis will play three games in Miami on Aug. 18-20 to complete their season series.

**KING PLACED ON INJURED LIST; GRACEFFO RECALLED:** Prior to tonight's game, left-handed pitcher **John King** was placed on the 15-day Injured List with a left oblique strain. Right-handed pitcher **Gordon Graceffo** was recalled from Memphis (AAA) and will be active for tonight's game. Graceffo last pitched for the Cardinals on July 19 in Arizona. In 13 appearances with St. Louis, Graceffo is 3-0 with a 5.11 ERA and one save over 24.2 innings. King led the Cardinals with 43 appearances and was tied for the MLB lead post All-Star Break with seven.

**GORMAN BEGINS REHAB ASSIGNMENT:** Infielder **Nolan Gorman** (back tightness) was 0-for-4 with two strikeouts as the designated hitter for Springfield (AA) last night. Gorman was placed on the 10-day Injured List on July 19.

**NOOTBAAR REPORTS FOR REHAB ASSIGNMENT:** Outfielder **Lars Nootbaar** (left costochondral sprain) begins his injury rehabilitation assignment at Springfield (AA) tonight and will start in the outfield for the Cardinals. Nootbaar was placed on the 10-day Injured List on July 13.

**MAGIC MIKOLAS:** Tonight's starting pitcher for the Cardinals **Miles Mikolas** is a South Florida native, playing high school baseball at Jupiter High School and college ball at Nova Southeastern. Mikolas is 3-0 with a 1.42 ERA in three career starts vs. the Marlins at Busch Stadium. He enters tonight's game on a 10.2 inning scoreless streak at his home ballpark.

**HORTON HEARS A "HAPPY BIRTHDAY":** The Cardinals would like to wish radio broadcaster and former Cardinals pitcher **Ricky Horton** a Happy Birthday. Horton's broadcast partner **John Rooney** is also celebrating a half-birthday today, as his birthday lands on January 30th with the Major League schedule yet to begin at that time. Horton and Rooney are also connected by both making their Chicago White Sox debuts on the same day, April 4, 1988. Horton pitched the White Sox vs. the Baltimore Orioles and Rooney on his first call with the South Siders.

**DOUBLE JEOPARDY:** Cardinals first baseman **Willson Contreras** has hit a career-best 28 doubles this season, ranking tied for 2nd in the National League with **Pete Crow-Armstrong** (CHI) and trailing only **Jackson Chourio** (MIL) with 29. The 28 doubles through 109 games is the most by a Cardinal since **Paul Goldschmidt** hit 30 through the same amount of games in 2022.

**STOP, THIEF!:** Last night, **Victor Scott II** stole two bases to bring his season total to 29, tied with **Pete Crow-Armstrong** (CHI) and **Elly De La Cruz** (CIN) for the 2nd-most in the National League behind only **Oneil Cruz** (PIT) with 34. It marked his 3rd multiple stolen base game of the season, the most by a Cardinals player since **Tommy Edman** had four multiple stolen base games in 2023. **Delino DeShields** leads the Cardinals since the Wild Card Era (1995) with 10 in 1997. Hall of Famer **Lou Brock** holds the club record with 29 multi-steal games in 1974.

**Miles Mikolas** was born in nearby Jupiter, Fla... graduated from Jupiter (Fla.) HS and Nova Southeastern University...made MLB debut vs. the Marlins on May 5, 2012 at Petco Park (as a Padre).

**Miles Mikolas** (Jupiter), **Jordan Walker** (Jupiter), **Masyn Winn** (Jupiter) and **Nolan Gorman** (Pompano Beach) reside in the South Florida area.

**Brant Brown** served as the Marlins hitting coach in 2023.

**Jon Jay** was born in and resides in Miami...attended Christopher Columbus High School and the University of Miami...served as the First Base/Outfield Coach for Miami for two seasons (2023-24).

**Garrett Hampson** played in 98 games for the Marlins in 2023.

**Pedro Pagés** resides in Doral, Fla...graduated from Gulliver Prep High School in Miami...played college baseball at Florida Atlantic Univ...made MLB debut vs. Marlins (April 7, 2024 at Busch).

**Iván Herrera** caught his first MLB shutout against the Marlins, June 27, 2022 at Busch Stadium from **Adam Wainwright** (7 IP), **James Naile** (1 IP) and **Jake Woodford** (1 IP) in a 9-0 win.

**Nolan Gorman** won the 2017 High School Home Run Derby at Marlins Park during All-Star Week.

**Sandy Alcántara** pitched in eight games for St. Louis in 2017...Originally signed with the Cardinals as an International free agent on July 2, 2013 (signed by **Moises Rodriguez**)...traded to Miami with **Daniel Castano**, **Zac Gallen**, and **Magneuris Sierra** for **Marcell Ozuna** (Dec. 14, 2017).

Cardinals Communications Game Day Associates Supervisor **Jacob Mayer** was a 2016 Communications Intern for the Marlins.

Marlins Minor League Operations Assistant **Lizzy Millner** previous served as a Cardinals Baseball Operations Fellow in 2023.

Since 2003, the Cardinals and Marlins have shared the Roger Dean Chevrolet Stadium Complex in Jupiter, Fla. as their Spring Training site... RDGS is also the home to the Palm Beach Cardinals and Jupiter Hammerheads of the Single-A Florida State League.

Miami and St. Louis played the first regular season game at then Marlins Park (April 4, 2012), a 4-1 Cardinals win.

TONIGHT'S GAME:

- South Florida native out of Jupiter, Fla. will be making his 21st start of the season, 203rd career. 193 of his starts with the Cardinals, 10 with the Rangers in 2014.
- Marks his 6th season with 20 or more starts all with the Cardinals.
- Needs 2.0 innings pitched for 1,200 career.
- Trails **Dizzy Dean** (1930-37) by three starts for 12th place all-time in Cardinals history.
- Mikolas is one of just 3 MLB pitchers to have made as many as 190 starts exclusively with one team since he joined the Cardinals in 2018; also **Aaron Nola**, PHI & **Kyle Freeland**, COL
- Receiving an average of 3.44 run support per game, 6th-lowest in MLB.
- Opened the season with 29.0 homerless IP (March 31-April 30); averaged 2.10 HR/9 IP since May 1, highest in MLB.
- At age 36 (turns 37 on August 28), Miles is the oldest player on the team's active roster.
- Has entered his 8th season (was injured for all of 2020) with the Cardinals in 2025; Leads active Cardinals pitchers in wins (66), innings pitched (1,106.2), strikeouts (803) and games started (192).
- The Cardinals are 105-87 in his 192 career starts with St. Louis and Miles holds a 66-65 mark as a Cardinal.
- Since joining St. Louis in 2018, Mikolas leads MLB in first strike percentage (68.1) and lowest walk percentage (4.3%).

**LAST TIME OUT:** Pitched 5.0 scoreless innings scattering seven hits with no walks and one strikeout. Was his 3rd scoreless start of the season and ran his home scoreless streak to 10.2 innings.

2025 NOTES:

- St. Louis is 10-10 in his starts this season. The Cardinals lost each of his first 5 starts to begin the season, then won 7-straight from April 30-June 5.
- Pitched his 3rd scoreless start of the season (22nd career since joining STL in 2018) vs. SD (7/25). Has two scoreless starts this month (7/10 vs. WSH).
- Surrendered a franchise record six home runs vs. CHI (7/4) at Wrigley Field en route to a franchise record eight total home runs (King - 2) allowed by the Cardinals.
- Five of the six home runs allowed were solo home runs. Of pitchers who have allowed six home runs in MLB history, pitched the longest outing (6.0) since Tommy Thomas of the St. Louis Browns (6/27/1936) vs. NYY.
- Has hurled season-best 6.0 innings in 6 of his 20 starts (5 were quality starts).
- Allowed a two-run 1st inning HR (1st HR allowed in 2025) to the Pittsburgh's' Bryan Reynolds on May 5 and took a no-decision in the Cardinals 6-3 win over the Pirates. Walked 3+ batters for only the 10th time in his 179 career starts as a Cardinal. The game was the anniversary date of his May 5, 2012 MLB debut.
- Blanked the Reds over 5.1 IP (77 pitches) on April 30 in Game 1 of double header at Great American Ball Park. Was credited with his 1st win of the season as he and three relievers combined on the 6-0 shutout win. The Cardinals got back/back/back HR's from Scott II, Nootbaar and Winn to break the game open in the 9th inning.
- Fanned a season-high 7 batters in his 6/15 start at MIL over 6.0 IP.
- Started Game 2 of 4/6 doubleheader at BOS on ESPN Sunday Night Baseball; Lasted just 2.2 IP in the 18-7 loss, his shortest start since going 2.0 IP on 9/8/24 in 10-4 loss to Seattle.

MIKOLAS vs. MIAMI:

- Jupiter, Fla., native is making his 9th career start and 11th appearance vs. the Marlins. Is 4-1 with a 3.33 ERA.
- His .800 winning pct. is his 2nd-highest against teams with five or more decisions (San Francisco 5-1).
- Is 3-0 with a 1.42 ERA in three career starts vs. the Marlins at Busch Stadium with all three starts lasting 6.0 innings or more.
- Last win at Busch Stadium was July 17, 2023 in a 6-4 win tossing 6.0 innings and allowing three runs.
- Has two relief appearances vs. Miami, both as a member of the Padres in 2012.
- Made three career starts vs. Miami in Spring Training with all three scoreless of 3.0 innings or less.
