### Thirteen Straight

Atlanta today plays its 13th game in 13 days to open the season, before enjoying its first scheduled day off tomorrow. Last night's win guarantees that the Braves will exit this opening stretch of consecutive games with a winning record.

The Braves made a grand total of one roster move affecting the active club in this 13-day stretch, selecting LHP Martín Pérez to the club on March 30 after optioning RHP Didier Fuentes.

Braves' starting pitchers in this stretch have totaled 64.1 innings, third most by a starting staff in baseball. Atlanta's rotation has six "quality" starts, tied with Los Angeles for most in the National League.

Atlanta has just one longer stretch of consecutive games scheduled later this season. The club is set to play on 17 straight days from July 17 through August 2.

**TODAY'S GAME:** The Braves and Angels today conclude a three-game mid-week series in what are the only scheduled meetings between the clubs this season...Atlanta and Los Angeles last met last season, with a three-game series at Truist Park.

*A* Atlanta scored seven unanswered runs last night to win, 7-2, and even the series...The two clubs will play the rubber match this afternoon.

*A* The Braves lost two-of-three to the Angels last season, the first time they dropped a series to Los Angeles since 2017...Since MLB moved to a balanced schedule in 2023, meaning the two clubs now play every year, Atlanta is 6-5 (.546) vs. Los Angeles.

*A* Atlanta and Los Angeles have met just 29 times since the advent of interleague play in 1997, with the Braves going 15-14 (.517) against the Angels all-time...Neither club has ever swept the other in nine total three-game series between the clubs, a trend that will continue this week.

*A* Atlanta is playing just its fifth series all-time here in Anaheim, and its first since the 2024 season...The Braves are 7-7 (.500) in 14 games here in their history, but took two-of-three here in their last trip in 2024.

*A* RH Grant Holmes is set today to make the second start of his career against the Angels, after pitching 6.0 scoreless innings and fanning 10 against them last July...The 6-foot-0, 226-pound right-hander also went 6.0 scoreless in his most recent turn this year, last Friday at Arizona...Holmes' slider enters play today with a run value of two, the sixth-best value on the pitch in baseball (min. 50 sliders thrown).

*A* LH Reid Detmers has never allowed a run over 6.0 career innings versus Atlanta, spanning one start and one relief appearance...The 6-foot-2, 210-pound left-hander last faced the Braves in relief last July, and started against the club in 2022...Detmers tossed 6.2 scoreless frames last Friday vs. Seattle, fanning four.

**PITCHING:** Atlanta allowed a pair of unearned runs in last night's first inning and then blanked Los Angeles the rest of the way...The Braves currently lead Major League Baseball with a 2.04 ERA (24 ER/106.0 IP).

*A* The Braves have pitched three shutouts and allowed zero earned runs in two other games, meaning Atlanta's staff has allowed no earned runs in five of its 12 games this season (42%)...Atlanta has not allowed an earned run with Jonah Heim behind the plate this season.

*A* Atlanta's bullpen pitched 4.1 scoreless innings of relief last night, and also leads the majors with a 0.86 ERA (4 ER/41.2 IP)...The Braves have not allowed a run in relief this series, and has 12 consecutive innings without an earned run dating to their last series vs. the D-backs.

**VERSUS LEFTIES:** Atlanta is set today to face left-hander Reid Detmers from the Angels, after beating lefty Yusei Kikuchi last night...The Braves have seen four left-handed starting pitchers this season, and are a perfect 4-0 in these games.

*A* Dating to the start of the 2019 season, no team in baseball has a better winning percentage versus left-handed starters than Atlanta...The Braves have gone 170-99 (.632) against lefties in that span; the Astros' .624 (201-121) mark ranks second.

*A* Of the 105 active players with at least 750 career plate appearances against left-handers, Ozzie Albies' .326 batting average is the highest in the majors... He is a career .326/.351/.538 batter against lefties, including five hits & one homer in 16 at-bats this year.

**NINTH INNING:** Atlanta scored two insurance runs in last night's ninth inning, and has now scored in the ninth in three consecutive games and five of its last six.

*A* The Braves are hitting .511/.549/.889 in the ninth inning this season, all of which are best in the majors...Atlanta leads all of baseball in ninth-inning hits (23), homers (5), runs (17), extra-base hits (tied, 7) and total bases (40).

*A* Atlanta's 17 runs in the ninth inning are the most by **any** team in **any** single inning this season...Houston has scored 16 times in the fifth to rank second...Due to leads at home, the Braves have only batted in the ninth nine times this year.

**RUBBER GAMES:** Atlanta and Los Angeles have split the first two games of this series, and are set to play the deciding rubber game this afternoon...The Braves have won their only series-deciding game this year, beating the A's, 5-1, on April 1.

*A* The Braves went just 8-14 (.363) in series-deciding games last season, including losses in both of their last two opportunities.

*A* Atlanta has yet to lose a series this year...The Braves won both of their three-game sets in their opening homestand, and just split four games with the D-backs on this road trip.

**OZZIE ALBIES:** Reached base twice last night, driving a solo home run out to right field in the eighth inning and working a walk in the ninth...The homer was his third of the year, tied with Brandon Lowe for the most by a second baseman in baseball this year.

*A* Albies' eighth-inning drive was the 160th homer of his career, tying him with David Justice for 15th place in franchise annals, and 11th since the team moved to Atlanta in 1966.

*A* Since debuting in 2017, Albies 160 homers are by far the most by any second baseman in the National League, and trail just Jose Altuve (179) at the position in all of baseball.

*A* Dating to last year's All-Star break, Albies has 12 homers and has slugged .444 in 74 total games... That pace would equal 26 homers over 162 games.

#### Today's Game

- A* Makes his third start of the season and 31st career start in his third major league campaign...It is his second career road start of 2026 and his first career appearance at Angel Stadium.
- A* Struck out a season-high 10 batters in his only career outing against the Angels, tossing 6.0 scoreless innings on three hits with three walks in 2025...Is 0-0 with a 0.00 ERA (0 ER/6.0 IP) in one career start against Los Angeles (AL).
- A* Carried a no-hit bid through 5.1 innings in his last outing on April 3 at Arizona, allowing just one hit over 6.0 scoreless frames with three strikeouts and no walks in 85 pitches...The Braves won, 2-0, though both runs scored in the ninth inning after Holmes had exited.
- A* Has received zero run support through his first two starts this season (11.0 IP)...Both games in which he started have been won by Atlanta after he left the game.
- A* Took the loss in his season debut on March 29 against Kansas City, allowing three earned runs on five hits over 5.0 innings with four strikeouts and two walks...Surrendered a solo homer to Carter Jensen in the fourth inning.
- A* Reached 200 career strikeouts on April 3 at Chase Field in Arizona, entering the game with 197 and fanning three.
- A* His 30 career starts for the Braves are the most in Atlanta-franchise history by a South Carolina-born player.
- A* Made his second career Opening Day roster with Atlanta this season after also making the club's roster to open 2025.
- A* Went 1-0 with a 1.02 ERA in five spring appearances (four starts), striking out 20 over 17.2 innings with just one walk...Did not allow a run in his first four outings before surrendering two earned runs over 5.1 innings in his final spring start on March 24 against Tampa Bay.
- A* Missed the final 57 games of the 2025 season after being placed on the 60-day injured list on July 27 with right elbow inflammation.
- A* Is 3-7 with a 3.09 ERA (36 ER/105.0 IP) in 27 career appearances at home and 3-4 with a 4.53 ERA (45 ER/89.1 IP) in 23 outings on the road.

#### 2025

- A* Was placed on the 60-day injured list on July 27, 2025 with right elbow inflammation and missed the final 57 games of the season.
- A* In his second major league season, went 4-9 with a 3.99 ERA (51 ER/115.0 IP) in 22 games, 21 starts, for Atlanta.
- A* Became the fourth pitcher, sixth instance, in franchise history to record 15 or more strikeouts within a single game, joining Hall-of-Famer Warren Spahn, twice, Hall-of-Famer John Smoltz, twice, and teammate Spencer Strider.
  - A* Was the first National League pitcher to fan 15 in a losing decision since Cliff Lee with Philadelphia, May 6, 2011 against Atlanta.
  - A* Generated 25 swings and misses during the outing, tied for the fifth most in a single game in the majors at that time.
- A* Was 2-8 in 10 decisions over 16 starts from May 2 through the end of the season, with a 3.86 ERA over 86.1 innings in that span.
- A* Made 21 starts for Atlanta, third most on the club behind Bryce Elder (28) and Spencer Strider (23).
- A* In his debut season in 2024, went 2-1 with a 3.27 ERA (11 ER/30.1 IP) in 26 relief appearances and one start...Was recalled by Atlanta from Triple-A Gwinnett on August 8, 2024.

- A* Awards: Midwest League Midseason All-Star (2015); Texas League Pitcher of the Week (July 30, 2017).
- A* In 2022, pitched for three different minor league teams throughout the Oakland and Atlanta organizations...Separately, went 1-2 with Triple-A Las Vegas before joining the Braves system.
- A* Pitched the entire 2021 season for Triple-A Las Vegas and saw more relief appearances (29) than starts (7) for first time in career.
- A* Set career highs and led the team in games (50) and saves (13) in 2023 with Triple-A Gwinnett...Led all Stripers relievers in strikeouts (74).
- A* Named Gatorade Player of the Year in South Carolina following his senior year in 2014.
- A* Selected by the Los Angeles Dodgers in the first round (22nd overall) of the 2014 June draft (Conway High School, SC).
- A* On August 1, 2016, traded by the Dodgers to the Oakland Athletics along with RHP Frankie Montas and RHP Jharel Cotton for OF Josh Reddick and RHP Rich Hill.
- A* Pitched 10 seasons in the minors before making his MLB debut.
- A* Signed by the Atlanta Braves as a minor league free agent on August 13, 2022.

- Appeared in 42 games in his second season as a Brave in 2025, pitching to a 3-2 record and a 3.81 ERA (23 ER/54.1 IP) with 51 strikeouts and a 1.25 WHIP, his lowest since 2020...Was placed on the injured list on August 24 due to left shoulder inflammation and missed the remainder of the season.
- Ranked in the 99th percentile in baseball with a barrel rate of just 3.2% in 2025...His nine total barrels and 2.8% barrel rate allowed since joining the Braves in 2024 are both the best in the majors (min. 400 batters faced).
- Opponents hit ground balls off him 55.8% of the time last season (league average 42.4%)...Since his debut in 2017, Bummer's career ground ball rate of 64.0% is highest in the majors (min. 350 games).
- Tossed his curveball a career-high 35.1% of the time in 2025, the most of any major league pitcher with at least 900 total pitches last season...Utilized a curveball for the first time in 2024 at a 2.3% clip.

- Picked up the 41st multi-inning save of his career, his second as a Brave (also: 9/22/24 at MIA, 2.0 IP), on April 7 at Los Angeles-AL...Despite having just two since 2022, Iglesias' 41 saves of 1.1-plus innings are the most in MLB since he became a primary reliever in 2016.
- In his third full season with Atlanta, appeared in a career-high 70 games and went 29-for-34 in save opportunities...Pitched to a 3.21 ERA (24 ER/67.1 IP)...Ranked fourth in the NL and tied for ninth in the majors in saves.
- Has not allowed a run in 47 of his last 50 appearances since June 9 of last season...He leads major league relievers with at least 45.0 innings pitched in ERA (1.10, 6 ER/49.0 IP), WHIP (0.67) and batting average against (.139) and ranks second in fWAR (1.7) in that span...Is the first Braves pitcher to allow six runs or less across 50 appearances since Craig Kimbrel from June 8, 2013-April 12, 2014.
- Among active pitchers with as many appearances since his Braves debut on August 5, 2022 (227 apps.), Iglesias owns the best ERA (2.29, 57 ER/224.1 IP), WHIP (0.93) and strikeout-to-walk ratio (4.98, 244 K/49 BB).
- Ranks second among Braves pitchers in franchise history (min. 100 G) in WHIP and ERA+ (183), third in strikeout-to-walk ratio, fourth in hits-per-nine-innings (6.4) and fifth in ERA and saves (99).

- Pitched to a 5-0 record with a 0.72 ERA (2 ER/25.0 IP), a 0.68 WHIP and 22 strikeouts in 24 outings with Atlanta to conclude the 2025 season.
- Since his Braves debut on July 31, 2025, Kinley ranks among major league pitchers (min. 25.0 IP) in ERA (2nd, 0.61, 2 ER/29.2 IP), opponent's OPS (3rd, .354), WHIP (4th, 0.67) and batting average against (4th, .126).
- Is tied with Raisel Iglesias for the fewest runs allowed (2) in a pitcher's first 29 outings with Atlanta in the live-ball era...He and Craig Kimbrel hold the second-lowest ERA (0.61), only trailing Iglesias' mark of 0.34 when he arrived to the club in 2022.
- Allowed a run in his third appearance with the Braves, August 5, and then allowed one additional tally over his final 21 games...Strung together a career-high scoreless streak of 19.1 innings between runs.
- Among Braves pitchers with at least 24 appearances in a season, Kinley holds the second-best ERA, WHIP, hits-per-nine-innings (4.0) and ERA+ (583) marks in a single campaign.
- Ranked in the 100th percentile in baseball by allowing a hard-hit percentage of 29.6 percent.
