End of the Road

The Braves this afternoon are set to play their final road game of the 2025 season. Atlanta enters play this afternoon with a 36-44 (.450) record away from Truist Park this year.

Atlanta tied its modern-era franchise record by losing each of its first eight road games this year, including the entirety of its sevengame trip to open the season. Since the date of their first road win, April 12 at Tampa Bay, the Braves have gone an even 36--36(.500) on the road.

Regardless of today's outcome, Atlanta's winning percentage on the road this season will be its lowest since going 35-46 (.432) in such games in 2017.

TODAY'S GAME: The Braves and Tigers today conclude a three-game weekend series with the only scheduled matchups between the teams this season... The two clubs are set to meet during the first month of the 2026 season next year, with a three-game set at Truist Park in Atlanta from April 28-30.

- The Braves used a ninth-inning rally to win yesterday afternoon, and have won each of the first two games of this series...Atlanta will play for the sweep this afternoon.
- Atlanta swept three games between the clubs last season, and has now won the series in each of the last five seasons these two clubs have met...The Braves won the series, two-games-to-one, in 2023, 2019 and 2016, and have not lost a series to the Tigers since getting swept in 2013.
- The Braves and Tigers have met 32 times since the advent of interleague play in 1997, and Atlanta's win last night moved the club to two games over .500 at 17-15 (.531) against Detroit all-time...Atlanta has won seven of the 11 total series between the clubs.
- The Braves are playing just their fourth series ever here at Comerica Park, and their first since 2023... Atlanta is just 5-6 in 11 total games here, but has won four straight and captured its only series win in this building (2-1) on its last visit.
- A RH Spencer Strider has made one prior start against Detroit in his career, pitching here at Comerica Park on June 14, 2023...The righthander allowed five runs over 5.0 innings in that start, but earned the win in Atlanta's victory, 10-7...Strider pitched 7.0 one-run innings in his last start, Monday night in Washington, and owns a 2.52 ERA (7 ER/25.0 IP) over his last four turns.
- A RH Casey Mize has also made one prior start against Atlanta in his career, allowing five hits and two runs over 4.0 innings in a loss last June at Truist Park...The former Auburn Tiger is 5-1 over his last eight starts, pitching to a 4.85 ERA.

STREAKING: Atlanta's win yesterday afternoon was its season-best seventh consecutive victory, the longest active winning streak in the National League...Only Cleveland, which has won 10 straight games, has a longer active winning run.

- The Braves last won seven straight games in 2023, when they had four streaks of at least as many games...Its last longer run was a nine-game streak from June 24 to July 3 of that year.
- Six of Atlanta's seven victories in the streak have come by multiple runs, and the Braves have a run differential of +36 (55-19) over the seven games.
- The 55 total runs for Atlanta over the run are its most in any seven-game stretch this season, three more than any other such span of games...The Braves scored 52 times over seven games from August 13-19.

NACHO ALVAREZ JR: Connected on the first two home runs of his career yesterday afternoon, and plated the game-tying run in the top of the ninth with a two-out single to right...It marked the first three-RBI game of his career.

- He drove a 2-2 pitch in yesterday's third inning out down the left-field line for his first home run, and later connected on a 1-1 pitch out to left-center in the eighth...Per Elias, Alvarez Jr. became the first Brave to have the first home runs of his career come in a multi-homer game since Derek Lilliquist on May 1, 1990 vs. the Mets.
- Through 18 games in September, he has batted .288/.315/.481 with a .796 OPS, four doubles and seven total RBI.
- His run-scoring single was the first game-tying RBI with two outs in the ninth inning or later for Atlanta this season, and the first since Sean Murphy homered in such a situation in Arizona on July 8, 2024.

DRAKE BALDWIN: Drove a 2-2 pitch with two outs in the third inning out to right-center yesterday for his second homer in as many games and his 18th on the season...The two-run drive gave him 75 RBI for the

- Dating to the 1947 season, when the first national Rookie of the Year award was presented by the BBWAA, Baldwin became just the eighth rookie to reach 18 homers and 75 RBI while playing over half his games behind the plate, and the first to do so since J.P. Arencibia in 2011.
- Of the first seven such catchers to reach Baldwin's counting stats in their rookie seasons, four were named Rookie of the Year - Earl Williams in 1971, Benito Santiago in 1987, Mike Piazza in 1993 and Geovany Soto in 2008.

TRAILING LATE: The Braves rallied with a pair of runs in the top of yesterday's ninth inning, and earned their second win this season when trailing after eight innings (May 6 vs. Cincinnati).

Atlanta now has 16 wins this season when it trails in the seventh inning or later, fewer than just Seattle and Philadelphia, with 19, and Toronto, with 18, in all of baseball.

INTERLEAGUE: Atlanta today also concludes its final series of the season against an American League opponent, and enters play 21-26 (.447) in interleague play...The Braves had lost two straight series against AL opponents, last earning a series win by taking two-ofthree against the White Sox from August 18-20.

the balanced schedule in 2023, in which all teams across the league play at least one series per year, Atlanta's 78-61 (.561) record in interleague play ranks eighth in the majors...This year will mark the Braves' first losing record under the current format.

Today's Game

- Making his 22nd start of the season and second of his career against Detroit.
 - ★ Earned the win in his lone previous matchup against Tigers, allowing seven hits and five runs over 5.0 frames in the first game of a doubleader.
- Has picked off a runner in four consecutive games and is now tied for the sixth most pickoffs in the National League.
 - Recorded his first pickoff on August 25 and his four since then are the most in basehall
- Scattered four hits while fanning six Washington hitters over 7.0 innings of one-run ball in his last start.
- A Snapped a five-game losing skid with a win against Washington in his last outing.
 - ★ Strider's five-game losing streak began on August 6 against Milwaukee...During that stretch he is pitching to a 7.89 ERA while allowing eight home runs and 12 walks with 22 strikeouts.
- ∠ His shortest outing of the season came on August 18 against Chicago (AL), going 3.0 innings with 68 pitches thrown.
- Has utilitzed his slider on 35.6% of pitches thrown this year...Averaged the slider at a rate of 31.4% between the 2021-'24 seasons.
 - Between 2021-'24, Strider threw his four-seam fastball on 62.1% of pitches... This year he is utilizing the heater at a rate of 52.5%.
- Started the year 0-5 with a 5.40 ERA...Snapped his losing streak on June 14, winning three games in a row.
- ★ Thus far this season, Strider is averaging 95.6 MPH on his fastball.
 - ★ The average velocity on his heater was 97.6 MPH between 2021-'24.
- ★ The Braves are 47-26 in Strider's starts throughout his career.

- Recorded the 600th strikeout of his career on August 25 against Miami...Became the fastest primary starter in history (by innings pitched) to reach the milestone.
 - ✓ Marked the first time in Strider's career he went at least 7.0 frames without recording more than three strikeouts in the game.
- In his last start before the All-Star break, Strider struck out 11 Athletics hitters while allowing five hits and three runs with a homer in his first no-decision of the year.
 - ∠ His streak of 10 consecutive games to start the season with a decision was tied
 with Arizona's Brandon Pfaadt for the longest in baseball this season.
 - ★ The streak was also tied for the 10th longest in Atlanta-franchise history to begin a season.
- Struck out a season most 13 hitters on June 19, holding Colorado to three hits over 6.0 scoreless innings with just one walk issued.
 - The 13 punchouts were the most since he fanned 13 against Arizona on July 20, 2023.
- Was placed on the 15-day IL on April 21 (backdated to April 18) with a strained right hamstring...Activated on May 19.
- - ∠ Became just the ninth pitcher in the modern era to reach 500 strikeouts in 68 appearances or less; and first to do so since Shane Bieber in 2021.
 - ⚠ The other pitchers were José Fernández, Yu Darvish, Mark Prior, Kerry Wood, Hideo Nomo, Dwight Gooden, and Herb Score.
 - ⚠ Of those pitchers, Strider is the only one to have more than three relief appearances in that span of games with 13.
- ✓ Made his season debut agaist Toronto on April 16, allowing two runs and five hits over 5.0 innings pitched...It was his first start since undergoing season-ending surgery on his right elbow last year... Strider went 376 days between starts.
 - Prior to his season debut, Strider made his last start on April 5, 2024 against Arizona, allowing seven hits, five runs, three walks and a home run with four strikeouts.
 - He was placed on the 15-day injured list on April 7, 2024 with a right elbow sprain...Dr. Keith Meister performed the surgery on April 12.
