Griffin tossed 7.0 innings of one-run ball on eight hits with two strikeouts...He earned his 11th win of the season in the 5-2 victory over the Athletics on July 19...He has not allowed more than one earned run in any of his last eight starts.

- The Nationals have won his last six starts and 10 of his last 11 starts since May 19.

vs. ARIZONA

Griffin is set to make his second career start against the Diamondbacks...He earned the win on June 5 at Arizona (5.0 IP, 2 H, ER, 4 SO).

1 IS THE LONLIEST NUMBER...UNLESS YOU'RE FOSTER GRIFFIN

Griffin has allowed one earned run or fewer in eight consecutive starts, tied for the longest streak in MLB this season with Milwaukee's **Jacob Misi- orowski** (8 GS, May 1 to June 12)...The eight-game streak is the longest streak in Nationals history (2005-pres.).

- During the eight-start streak, Griffin is 5-0 with a 1.25 ERA (7 ER/50.1 IP) with 46 strikeouts and just six walks...Left-handed batters are 5-for-44 (.113) with 17 strikeouts and zero walks.

RANKINGS

Griffin ranks among National League pitchers in WHIP (4th, 1.03), opponents' on-base percentage (4th, .271), winning percentage (T4th, .846), walks allowed per nine innings (5th, 2.07), innings pitched (5th, 117.1) opponents' average (7th, .215), strikeouts-to-walk ratio (7th, 4.11) and ERA (8th, 2.68).

TECHNICALLY, HE'S A ROOKIE

Although he spent three seasons in Japan, Griffin still qualifies as a rookie...Because of that, he leads qualified National League rookie pitchers in ERA (2.68), WHIP (1.03), wins (11), starts (20), innings pitched (117.1) and winning percentage (.846)...He ranks second in strikeouts (111) and opponents' average (.215).

- Griffin earned his 10th win of the season on July 8 against the Houston Astros, the most wins in a single-season by a Nationals rookie (2005-pres.).

LEFT ON LEFT CRIME

Griffin has held opposing left-handed batters to a .154 batting average (18-for-117) with 38 strikeouts and just six walks...He has surrendered just one extra-base hit to a left-handed batter over his last nine starts...They are 5-for-48 (.104) with one home run, 18 strikeouts and one walk against him since May 30.
