ROAD TRIPPING REDBIRDS: The St. Louis Cardinals conclude their three-game weekend series with the division-rival Milwaukee Brewers this afternoon at American Family Field ... The Redbirds are 5-4 on their 10-game, three-city NL Central road trip through Pittsburgh (2-2), Cincinnati (2-1), and Milwaukee (1-1) ... The Cardinals enter today in 3rd place in the National League Central, 12.5 games behind first place Milwaukee and 2.5 games behind Cincinnati for the 2nd Wild Card spot.

ON DECK: The Cardinals return home to St. Louis on Labor Day for a seven-game homestand with the Los Angeles Dodgers and division-rival Cincinnati Reds, two teams St. Louis is chasing in the Wild Card race.

ROAD WARRIORS: St. Louis is 13-5 in its last 18 road games (since July 25) after beginning the season 21-30 in their first 51.

BOTTOMS UP: After today's series finale, St. Louis and Milwaukee face off in seven of the final 14 games ... Since the Cardinals and Brewers began regular season play in 1997, the Cardinals own the Majors' best win pct. (112-80, .583) of any team to visit Milwaukee, while their .588 win pct. (100-70) at American Family Field (since 2001) is tops among all teams who annually play in Milwaukee ... This season, St. Louis has topped the 100-win threshold at American Family Field and at PNC Park (105-74, .587).

BEER BASHERS: The Cardinals have gone yard 214 times at American Family Field since it opened in 2001 (most among all opponents), with **Yadier Molina's** 19 blasts tied with **Albert Pujols** for 3rd-most all-time by a visiting player and his most for any career road venue ... Among Major Leaguers with at least 98 career PA at American Family Field, **Nolan Arenado** ranks 1st all-time in MLB history in average (.382), slugging (.798), and OPS (1.237) and 5th in OBP (.439), while **Paul Goldschmidt** is 3rd in OBP (.441) and slugging (.698), and 4th in OPS (1.139).

FROM NOLAN TO ROLEN: **Nolan Arenado's** next blast will be his 30th of the season as he looks to become only the 4th Cardinals primary third baseman with a 30-homer season and first since **Scott Rolen** (34 in 2004) ... Arenado also seeks to become the first Major Leaguer with six 30-homer seasons since 2015, achieving the feat faster than **Nelson Cruz** (26 HR) and **Manny Machado** (23 HR), who also have five seasons of 30+ homers from 2015-19.

HOT BURNES: In 16 lifetime plate appearances against **Corbin Burnes**, **Paul Goldschmidt** is hitting .467/.500/.733 (7-15) with a double and home run, while his seven hits off Burnes are the most by any batter ... In 11 plate appearances, **Tommy Edman** is 4-for-11 (.364/.500/.545) with a triple and three walks ... **Matt Carpenter** is batting 308/.400/.846 (4-13) with 2 HR in 15 plate appearances.

EARLY BIRD SPECIAL: St. Louis has homered in the first inning five times during the current road trip (Arenado 2, Goldschmidt 2, Edman) ... Among NL HR leaders in the 1st inn., **Paul Goldschmidt** ranks 3rd (8) and **Nolan Arenado** is T4th (7).

MOLINA MILESTONES: **Yadier Molina** made his 100th appearance of the season at catcher yesterday, recording his 16th campaign of catching 100 or more games in his career (2005-19, '21), surpassing **Bob Boone** (15) and trailing only **Iván Rodríguez** (17) in MLB history ... Molina needs three RBI to tie **Ernie Lombardi** (990) for 13th all-time among primary catchers in MLB history.

SOUTHPAW STARTERS: **Jon Lester's** start today is the 41st by a Cardinals left-hander this season, most by a St. Louis rotation since the 1999 Redbirds made 63 starts (**Darren Oliver**, **Kent Mercker**, **Donovan Osborne**, **Rick Ankiel**, **Lance Painter**) ... This season, Toronto leads MLB with 83 starts by southpaws, while the Cubs are 30th with four starts.

GETTING DEFENSIVE: St. Louis leads MLB in team defensive runs saved (67) according to *Fangraphs* and shares the MLB lead with Colorado (62) according to *Baseball Info Solutions* ... In *Statcast's* Outs above Average, St. Louis is tied with San Francisco for 2nd in MLB with 25, trailing Houston (40).

WE'RE GOING STREAKING: Relievers **Luis García** (20.1-1st) and **T.J. McFarland** (16.1-3rd) own the two of the top three longest active scoreless innings streaks in Major League Baseball.

MILWAUKEE CONNECTIONS

Paul DeJong graduated from Antioch (Ill.) High School...resides in Hazelhurst, Wisc.

Yadier Molina hit his first Major League home run off Milwaukee's **Matt Wise** (Sept. 23, 2004).

Cardinals Director of Medical Operations/Head Athletic Trainer **Adam Olsen** is a native of Green Bay...earned his Master's in Physical Therapy from The University of Wisconsin-Madison.

Devin Williams was born in Florissant, Mo. and resides in Maryland Heights...was 1st Team Rawlings/Perfect Game Preseason High School All-American at Hazelwood West High School in 2013...committed to the Univ. of Missouri before drafted by Milwaukee in the 2nd round in 2013.

Kolten Wong played eight seasons (2013-20) with St. Louis and winner of two Gold Gloves (2019-20)...selected by the Cardinals in the 1st round (22nd overall) of the 2011 MLB Draft.

Mike Maddux served as Brewers Pitching Coach from 2003-08...oversaw Brewers staff that ranked 2nd in the NL with a 3.85 ERA in 2008, lowest by a Milwaukee club in 16 years, en-route to securing the Brewers' first postseason berth in 26 years.

Brewers broadcaster **Bob Uecker** played two seasons (1964-65) with St. Louis...won the 1964 World Series...originally traded by the Milwaukee Braves to St. Louis for **Jimmie Coker** and **Gary Kolb** (April 9, 1964).

TODAY'S GAME

- Making his 7th start as a member of the Cardinals, 446th career start and 447th career appearance. Currently ranks 25th all-time among left-handers in games started.
- The Cardinals have won each of his last four starts after dropping his first two starts since joining the club. Has not has a team he's pitched for win five straight since the Cubs won nine straight Lester starts (May 29-July 15, 2018).
- Made six starts in the month of August (2-1, 5.12 ERA) for the 6th time in his career (2008, 2012-14, 2019, 2021).
- Needs two wins for 200 career and 35 strikeouts for 2,500 career. Would become the 10th left-handed pitcher in MLB history to reach the 200 win/2,500 strikeout threshold.
- Ranks 30th all-time among left-handed pitchers at 198 wins. Former Cardinals south-paw Chuck Finley resides in 29th place with 200 career wins.
- Is 35 strikeouts shy of 2,500 for his career. Passed by Mark Langston (2,464) and Jim Kaat (2,461) into 12th place all-time among left-handers during his last start at Cincinnati (8/30).
- Has a career record of 4-3 with a 3.86 ERA in 13 career starts at Busch Stadium.
- Has faced and beaten 29 MLB teams in his career. Has never faced Boston.
- Holds 77-42 career record over the final three months of the regular season (Aug.-Oct.).

LAST TIME OUT

- Threw 6.0 innings allowing one run on a solo home run by Kyle Farmer, earning his second win as a member of the Cardinals (198th career). Has allowed only one hit to the Reds in his last two starts at GABP dating back to July 27, 2020 (w/CHI).

2021 SEASON

- Has pitched 5.0 or more innings in 15 of 22 starts this season (5 of 6 since joining STL).
- Earned his first win as a member of the Cardinals at KC (8/14) exiting with a 2-1 lead after 5.2 innings allowing just one run in a game St. Louis exploded late to win 9-4.
- Did not make his first start until April 30 due to COVID protocols.
- Has only made four starts of 6.0 innings or more after leading Major League Baseball with a 56-5 record when pitching 6.0 or more innings since the start of 2016, accomplishing the feat 85 times (Max Scherzer, 1st, 128; 75-23).
- Did not earn his first win of the season until his 10th start, that coming in the second game of a doubleheader vs. NYM (6/19). Previous career-high was six games into the 2017 season before his first win.
- Allowed a homer in seven straight starts (6/2-7/5), 2nd-longest streak of career (8 in 2018).

- Has pitched for five different Major League organizations; Red Sox (2006-14), Athletics (2014), Cubs (2016-20), Nationals (2021), and Cardinals (2021).
