## Colorado Rockies (65-90) at San Francisco Giants (77-78) RHP Ryan Feltner (3-8, 5.91) vs. LHP Carlos Rodón (13-8, 2.98)

**TONIGHT'S GAME:** The Giants are in the midst of their final homestand of the season... SF will play game three of this three-game set against the Rockies tonight followed by a three game series against the Diamondbacks this Friday-Sunday...the Giants enter today having won eight of their last nine games and seven of their last 11 here at home.

**EVEN STEVEN:** With just seven games remaining on the Giants' schedule, they'll need to go 4-3 to finish the season at .500...a win tonight and the Giants would climb back to the .500 mark for the first time since August 23 at Detroit (61-61).

**MILLER TIME:** RHP **Shelby Miller** tossed 2.0-scoreless innings with five strikeouts last night...in just two appearances for SF this season, he's thrown 4-2-scoreless innings with 12 strikeouts...according to *Stats, LLC*, Miller is the only MLB pitcher in the modern era to have back-to-back outings with five-plus strikeouts in less than 3.0 innings with no walks or runs allowed.

**GIVE ME FIVE:** The Giants have controlled the season series against the Rockies after starting the year on a five-game winning streak and winning each of their last seven contests heading into tonight's game...the two such streaks are tied for most in MLB against a single opponent this year (*Stats, LLC*)...dating back to last season, the Giants have posted a 28-9 (.757) record against Colorado, including a 14-4 (.778) record on the Shores of McCovey Cove.

**CARLOS' K'S:** **Rodón** is battling with MIL's Corbin Burnes for the NL strikeout title this season...Burnes is the current leader with 231 strikeouts while Rodón ranks second in the NL with 227 punchouts...if Rodón were to earn the strikeout title this year he'd become the sixth Giant in the modern era to top the NL and the second SF Giant.

**FAMILIAR FACES:** Each of the Giants' final seven games will come vs. NL West opponents, facing both Colorado, Arizona and San Diego...within the division, the Giants have gone 29-40 (.420) with a -22 run differential...however, San Francisco has won eight of its past nine games within the division.

**SEPTEMBER TO REMEMBER:** With last night's win, the Giants improved to 16-10 in September and clinched their first winning month since April (14-7)...since 2020, the Giants' have dominated in the month of September, ranking near the top of the Majors in numerous categories including ERA (3.48, 2nd), on-base percentage (.343, 2nd), batting average (.264, 4th), slugging percentage (.453, 4th) and runs per game (5.13, 7th)...SF's .636 winning percentage (49-28) in September since 2020 is the second-best in MLB, trailing only the Dodgers (53-23, .697).

**SO YOU'RE SAYING THERE'S A CHANCE:** The Giants are still mathematically in the playoff race, entering play today 6.0 games back of the Phillies and Brewers for the third and final Wild Card spot with seven games remaining on their schedule.

**CAN HE DO IT AGAIN?:** **OF Joc Pederson** will try and become the first Giants player to triple in three-straight games since **Willie Mays** in May 1956 (*Sports Info Solutions*)...Mays by the way was here at Oracle Park last night, the first time he'd been to the yard since 2019.

**LIMITING THE LONGBALL:** Despite allowing a homer last night, the Giants' pitching staff is still on pace to lead the National League in fewest homers per 9.0 innings (0.85) in back-to-back seasons for the first time since doing so three times in a row from 2000 to 2002 (*Sports Info Solutions*).

**NO FREE PASSES HERE:** The Giants currently rank third in the NL in fewest walks allowed (423), and could finish in the top three in consecutive years for the first time since 1988 and 1989 (finished second both seasons) (*Sports Info Solutions*).

**LAST TIME OUT:** Did not factor into the decision in his last start on Sept. 23 at Arizona...tossed 4.1 innings, allowing four earned runs on four hits with three walks and seven strikeouts in the Giants 6-5 victory over Arizona...has struggled against the Diamondbacks this year, going 0-2 with a 5.91 ERA (14er, 21.1ip) in four starts.

**LOTS OF DOUBLE DIGITS:** He's 2-2 with a 3.11 ERA (13er, 37.2ip) over his last seven starts...four of those seven outings have been double digit strikeout games where he's struck out 59 batters over 37.2 innings of work (14.10 K/9.0).

**VS. COLORADO:** Is scheduled to face the Rockies for the third time this year (fourth time in his career)...he's 1-1 with a 5.87 ERA (10er, 15.1ip) and 21 strikeouts over his first three starts...he's faced the Rockies twice at Oracle Park this season, going 1-0 with a 3.60 ERA (4er, 10.0ip) and 17 strikeouts.

**SWING AND WHIFF:** Rodon's fastball has missed a lot of bats this season and puts him third in the NL with a 158.3 Fastball Whiff+...Whiff+ is a proprietary Stats Perform metric that measures how well a pitch generates swings and misses (MLB average = 100)...Whiff+ accounts for the ability of each of a pitcher's offerings to get a swing and miss relative to other pitches of its type (STATS, LLC).

**PUNCHOUTS:** Has struck out 227 batters in 172.0 innings of work, the third-most strikeouts in the Majors behind NYY's Gerrit Cole (248) and MIL's Corbin Burnes (231)...Rodón's 11.88 strikeouts per 9.0 inning ratio is the best figure in the Majors...his 227 strikeouts are the fifth-most by a Giants left-handed pitch in a single season since 1883 (see chart).

**THERE'S NOTHING LIKE YOUR OWN PILLOW:** Has posted a 7-2 record with a 2.08 ERA (18er, 78.0ip), 111 strikeouts, .208 opponents average and 1.09 WHIP over 14 starts at Oracle Park this year...nine of his 14 starts at Oracle Park have been quality outings...his 2.08 ERA on the Shores of McCovey Cove ranks as the fifth-lowest home figure in the Majors...in comparison, he has a 6-6 record with a 3.73 ERA (39er, 94.0ip) and 116 strikeouts in 16 starts on the road.

**OPPONENT BATTING AVG:** Opposing hitters are batting just .205 off him, which ranks as the fifth-lowest figure in the National League...it's the second-lowest opponent average he's posted in a single season in his career after last season's .189 average...over his last six starts hes posted a .185 opponents average.

**DAYS OF REST:** When Rodón has four days of rest between starts, he's posted a 6-2 record with a 1.45 ERA (12er, 74.1ip) and 109 strikeouts in 12 outings...in comparison, when he has five days of rest between games, he's 7-5 with a 3.84 ERA (33er, 77.1ip) and 89 strikeouts in 14 starts.

**LIMITING LEFTIES:** Left-handed hitters are just 22-for-123 (.179) off him with 49 strikeouts and six extra-base hits...lefties are just 2-for-their-last-23 (.087) off him.

**KEEP IT IN THE PARK:** Has allowed eight homers over his last 12 starts...prior to that he had gone seven straight starts without allowing a homer...allowed his first home run on his slider this year at Chicago-NL on Sept. 9...each of his other 11 home runs allowed have come on his fastball.
