## MIAMI MARLINS (44-49) vs. PITTSBURGH PIRATES (39-55)

JULY 23, 2022 at PNC Park, PITTSBURGH, PA -- GAME #95/HOME #45

RHP MAX MEYER (0-1, 8.44 ERA) vs. LHP JOSÉ QUINTANA (2-5, 3.99 ERA)

**THE PIRATES:**...opened their three-game homestand with an 8-1 loss against the Marlins last night...Are in the second game of a stretch that has the team playing 10 of the next 12 games at PNC Park.

**TODAY'S TRANSACTIONS:** The Pirates made the following roster moves prior to tonight's game:

- \*Traded catcher Michael Perez to the New York Mets for cash considerations
- \*Optioned right-handed pitcher Colin Holderman to Triple-A Indianapolis

**ON Q:** José Quintana will make his 19th start of the season tonight in game two of this three-game series... Quintana has gone 2-3 with a 3.02 ERA (50.2ip/17er) in 10 starts this year at PNC Park...Tonight will be he first time to pitch back at PNC Park since allowing one run in 5.0 innings while winning a 5-2 decision against the Yankees on July 5.

**55 BUCS:** When he makes his debut, outfielder Greg Allen will become the 56th player to appear in a game this season for the Pirates...The 55 players used by the Pirates this season leads the Majors...The next closest team are the Reds (53).

**HERE'S THE DEAL:** Prior to last night's game the Pirates acquired right-handed pitcher Colin Holderman from the New York Mets in exchange for designated hitter Daniel Vogelbach...Holderman went 4-0 with a 2.04 ERA (17.2ip/4er), 18 strikeouts, a 1.02 WHIP and .186 batting average against in 15 appearances this season with the Mets.

**YOUNG BUCS:** The Pirates have had a total of 268 games this season played by rookies, the third-highest total in baseball behind the Diamondbacks (360) and Royals (322), and well above the Major League average of 116 games.

Pirates rookies have also totaled 34 home runs this season, the second-highest total in baseball behind the Royals (35)...For context, the average Major League team has approximately nine home runs from rookies.

- Coming into today, the Pirates rookie home run total represents 12.4 percent of the league's rookie home run output (274 total).
- Dating back to the 1947 season, the highest home run total the Pirates have ever had from a rookie class was in 2017 (36).

**LET'S HEAR IT FOR HAYES:** Ke'Bryan Hayes enters today with a nine-game hitting streak, the longest by a Pirate this year and longest since Colin Moran also hit safely in nine straight last year from August 26 to September 4...During his current hitting streak, Hayes has gone 11-for-36 (.306) with a double, triple, home run and .375 on-base percentage.

**CATCH ME IF YOU CAN:** Bucco backstop connected for the first home run of his big league career last night (it was also his first since June 18, 2021, while playing for Indianapolis)...Since July 7, Delay has recorded 11 hits, which are tied for the second-most among National League backstops along with Colorado's Elias Diaz...The only National League catcher with more hits in that time is Arizona's Carson Kelly (12).

**DUANE DEALIN':** Duane Underwood Jr. has struck out at least one batter in each of his last 18 appearances, which is tied with Miami's Steven Okert for the fourth-longest streak among relief pitchers in MLB this year...The only three relievers in MLB to record a punchout in more consecutive games this year are A.J. Minter (21 games), Penn Murfee (20 games) and Devin Williams (19 games).

**THE BULLPEN:** Pittsburgh's bullpen enters today with the eighth-most strikeouts (362) in all of MLB...The only three National League teams to record more strikeouts from their bullpen are the Cubs (446), Braves (385) and Mets (372).
