THIS DATE IN GIANTS HISTORY

JULY 1, 1996

In San Francisco, **Barry Bonds** and **Mark Carreon** homered to lead the Giants to a 9-6 win over the Rockies. The win snapped a 10-game losing streak, the longest for the Giants since a 10-game skid in 1985 and a 13-game losing streak in 1944.

THE GIANTS: Are looking for a win tonight in game three against the Diamondbacks to avoid being swept for the seventh time overall this season and third time by Arizona (also: May 18-20 at ARI and May 25-27 at SF).

- ▶ With a win tonight, the Giants could avoid dropping nine straight to the D-backs, which would be the longest in MLB by one team vs. a single opponent to begin the season since the Yankees won their first nine games vs. the Red Sox in 2020.

ROSTER MOVES: SF made the following roster moves today.

- ▶ **IF Matt Chapman** placed on the 10-day IL (abdominal strain).
- ▶ **IF Christian Koss** (#50) recalled from Triple-A Sacramento.

BEAT THE HEAT: The Giants have now dropped each of their first eight games vs. AZ...this marks the first time they have dropped the first eight games in a single season vs. one opponent since the Giants also lost their first eight games against the Cubs in 1977 (June 9-August 22, 1977).

- ▶ SF is looking for a win tonight to avoid going 0-9 against a single opponent to start the season for the first time in franchise history.
- ▶ The eight straight wins by Arizona marks the longest winning streak by either team in the series since the Giants won nine games in a row from September 5, 2020-June 17, 2021.
- ▶ The last time the Giants lost eight-straight games against a team at any point in the season was 2022 when they dropped eight straight against the Dodgers from July 21-August 4.

DOMINANT DUO: LHP **Robbie Ray** and RHP **Logan Webb** combined for a 1.01 ERA (8er, 71.0ip) in 10 games in June, while the rest of the Giants pitchers (starters and relievers) combined for a 6.02 ERA (105er, 157.0ip) in June (SIS).

- ▶ According to SIS, Ray and Webb are the first pair of Giants pitchers to pitch 30.0 innings and have an ERA of 1.50 or lower in a calendar month since **Jonathan Sánchez** and **Madison Bumgarner** in September/October 2010...prior to that the only duo was **Bob Shaw** and **Juan Marichal** in July 1965.

ON THE MOUND: RHP **Trevor McDonald** will face Arizona for the second time this year...he last faced them on May 27 and threw 6.1 innings, allowing three runs (two earned) on six hits and two walks with six strikeouts in the Giants' 3-2 loss to the Diamondbacks.

- ▶ McDonald has gone 0-6 with a 6.47 ERA (23er, 32.0ip) in his last seven starts with the Giants winning only one of those games.

THE FUTURE STARTS HERE: MLB announced the 2026 All-Star Futures Game rosters earlier today...Giants prospects **IF Gavin Kilen** and **OF Dakota Jordan** were both named to the NL roster...the Futures Game will be played at 12:00 p.m. (ET) on Sunday, July 12th at Citizens Bank Park in Philadelphia and will air exclusively on NBC.

- ▶ **IF Gavin Kilen** leads the Eugene Emeralds with 60 RBI and is hitting .288 with 24 doubles and eight homers over 70 games.
- ▶ **OF Dakota Jordan** is hitting .271 with 52 RBI and a team-high 12 homers over 72 games with the Eugene Emeralds.

THE STARTING LINE: Giants starters finished the month of June with a 3.72 ERA, the seventh best figure in the Majors and their best figure in a month so far this year (4.40 ERA in March/April and a 5.21 ERA in May).

- ▶ Their best stretch was a 12-game span from June 14-June 28 where they posted a 2.03 ERA, which ranked as the second-best figure in MLB during that time behind only the Milwaukee Brewers (1.76 ERA).

PITCHER OF THE MONTH?: RHP **Logan Webb** posted a MLB-best 0.71 ERA in June...he limited opposing hitters to an MLB-best .370 OPS, tied for an MLB-best 0.61 WHIP and a fourth-ranked .148 opposing batting average.

- ▶ Webb's 0.71 ERA is the lowest in a calendar month (min. five games started and 35.0 innings pitched) by a Giants starter since **Noah Lowry** logged a 0.69 ERA in August of 2005...overall Webb's 0.71 ERA this month is sixth-lowest by a Giants starter since 1913...chart courtesy of *Elias* via *Sarah Langs*.

T-MAC: Was the Giants' 11th-round pick in 2019 out of George County High School in Lucedale, MS...originally committed to South Alabama for college ball before signing...made his debut with SF during the final game of the 2024 season and has made appearances at the Major League level in each season since.

LAST TIME OUT: Eclipsed the 5.0-inning threshold for the first time since June 7 with 5.1 innings of three-run ball against the Braves last Saturday at Oracle Park...unfortunately he was saddled with his sixth loss of the season in SF's 3-1 defeat but there were positive takeaways...it was his longest start since May 27 against Arizona (6.1 innings)...he also only walked one batter after four consecutive starts of three walks apiece and five straight overall with multiple walks.

A FEW BUMPS: After pitching extremely well in his first three outings while filling in for the injured **Logan Webb** (2-0 with a 2.37 ERA with SF' going 3-0 in those outings), McDonald has gone 0-6 with a 6.47 ERA (23er, 32.0ip) in his last seven starts with the Giants winning only one of those games...McDonald hasn't escaped the 4th inning in three of those seven outings.

DIGGING DEEPER: During this rough stretch, batters have slashed .307/.411/.387 (.798 OPS) off his sinker compared to .255/.300/.319 (.619 OPS) off the sinker in his first three outings...he also has a 12.1% walk rate during these last seven starts (3.9% walk rate in his first three starts).

VS. ARIZONA: Is facing the D-Backs for a second-time this year and for a third time overall in his brief MLB career...his last quality start came against the D-Backs back on May 27 at Oracle Park (6.1ip, 6h, 3r, 2er) in the Giants' 3-2 loss...he'll be making his second career appearance (first start) at Chase Field with his outing today...he worked 2.0 innings of relief on September 16 of last year in a 6-5 Giants loss.

EXTREME SPLITS: In his 10 starts at the MLB level this year, McDonald has limited right-handed hitters to a .189 average with a .495 OPS and just two extra-base hits allowed (both doubles)...lefties, however, have a .308 average with a .906 OPS off McDonald...lefties have eight doubles, a triple and four homers...in his last start against the Braves, their LHBs went 4-for-14 with a double while their RHBs went 3-for-8.

GROUNDING: Entering this start he owns a 56.8% groundball rate, which sits in the 95th percentile among Major Leaguers...his 56.8% groundball rate is fourth-best in the Majors if you lower the innings threshold to 50.0...he trails PHI's Cristopher Sánchez (58.3%), LAA's Jack Kochanowicz (57.2%) and WSH's Brad Lord (56.9%).

ORDER UP...: He's been most effective the first time through the order this year with hitters going a combined 15-for-81 (.185) with a .616 OPS...it goes upward from there with opposing hitters hitting .267 with a .715 OPS the second time through and .350 with an .892 OPS the third time through.

SUITCASE LIVING: Owns a 3.96 ERA (11er, 25.0ip) in five road starts compared to a 5.88 home ERA (17er, 26.0ip) in five starts...SF is 3-2 in his road outings compared to 1-4 in his starts at home.

MOVING THEIR FEET?: McDonald has hit nine batters in his 10 starts (51.0 innings) at the Major League level this season...the nine hit batters are tied for fifth-most in the Majors (tied for third-most in the National League)...the White Sox' Anthony Kay leads MLB with 15 hit batters.

IN TRIPLE-A IN 2026: Went 1-1 with a 5.40 ERA (9er, 15.0ip), 12 strikeouts and a 1.53 WHIP in five Triple-A games (four starts) for Sacramento...was much better at home (1-0 with a 2.79 ERA in three games) than on the road (0-1 with a 10.13 ERA in two games).

- ▶ Since returning from the IL (right knee bursitis) on May 29, he has a 0.85 ERA (4er, 42.1ip) with 34 strikeouts, a .153 BAA and 0.69 WHIP in six starts...he lowered his ERA from 5.06 prior to his IL stint to a current 3.09 mark.
- ▶ Will face the Rockies for the 21st time in his career...has posted a 11-3 record with a 2.94 ERA (38er, 116.1ip) and a 1.16 WHIP over his 20 starts.
- ▶ Is 4-2 with a 4.21 ERA (29er, 62.0ip) in 11 games at Coors.
