AROUND THE HORN

TIKTOK SENSATION 'COOKING WITH DARRYL' BRINGS CHICAGO FLAVOR TO CHASE FIELD: Today thru Wednesday, TikTok sensation Darryl Postelnick, better known as “Cooking With Darryl,” brings his signature flavors to the ballpark...fans can experience two dishes inspired by Darryl's Chicago roots at Taste of Chase, located at Section 130, for a limited time while supplies last: Chicago Style Wings (Crispy whole wings, sweet and mild sauce, white bread and crispy fries) and Chicago Beef Empanadas (Shaved Italian beef, giardiniera, Italian cheese blend, flaky empanada dough and au jus).

HERE'S THE STORY: The D-backs have won 3 of their last 4 games.

- The D-backs have won 8 of their 12 series post-All-Star break (also: split 1, lost 3).
- The D-backs have won 6 of their last 7 series openers and are 13-8 overall in home series openers.
- **Corbin Carroll** has multiple hits in a career-high-tying 3 straight games (5x, last: Aug. 12-15) and has reached base safely in 12 straight games, batting .381 (16-for-42)/1.276 OPS with 5 doubles, 3 triples, 2 homers, 4 RBI, 8 walks (5 K) and 2 stolen bases.
- **Gabriel Moreno's** career-best 32-game home on-base streak is second longest single-season home streak in club history, surpassing Steve Finley's 31 in 2000, behind only Stephen Drew's 38 in 2009.
- **Merrill Kelly**, in 3 career home starts vs. Cubs, is 2-0 with a 2.95 ERA (6 ER in 18.1 IP), opponent .179 AVG (12-for-67)/.545 OPS, 6 walks and 12 strikeouts.

LAST GAME: The D-backs won 5-3 vs. Reds yesterday after coming back from a 3-0 deficit thru 5.0 innings, including a 4-run seventh inning...was their fourth comeback win when trailing 3+ runs thru 5.0 innings.

- **Ildemaro Vargas** (2-for-4, 2B, 3B, 2 RBI) hit the go-ahead, 1-out triple in the seventh, his second go-ahead triple of the year (also: April 5 vs. Braves) and fourth of his career...logged his fourth game with 2+ extra-base hits and 2+ RBI...his 5 triples are 3 more than his previous season high (2 in 2023).
- **Corbin Carroll** (2-for-3, 2B, 3B, RBI) and **Vargas** became the third pair of D-back teammates all-time to each have 2+ hits, 1+ doubles, 1+triples and 1+ RBI in the same game (also: Corbin Carroll/Randal Grichuk on June 11, 2024 vs. Angels and Steve Finley/Tony Womack on June 2, 1999 @ Expos).
- 6 D-back relievers - **Gerardo Carrillo** (1.2 IP), **Taylor Clarke** (1.1 IP), **Jonathan Loaisiga** (1.0 IP), **Juan Morillo** (1.0 IP), **Brandyn Garcia** (0.2 IP) and **Kevin Ginkel** (0.1 IP) - combined for 6.0 scoreless innings.

ROSTER MOVES: Yesterday, the D-backs reinstated RHP **Drey Jameson** from the 15-day injured list (right hip inflammation), recalled RHP **Gerardo Carrillo** from Triple-A Reno, placed RHP **Michael Soroka** on the 15-day injured list (right arm inflammation) and designated RHP **Zack Littell** for assignment.

WILD CARD RACE: The D-backs are fourth in the NL Wild Card race, 2.0 games behind the Padres (WC3, season tied 5-5), 4.0 games behind the Phillies (WC2, lead season 2-1) and 6.0 games behind the Cubs (WC1).

ANSWERBACKS: The D-backs' 39 comeback wins are second most in the Majors, behind the Cubs (40).

- It is the D-backs' ninth season in franchise history with 39+ comeback wins, joining 1999 (45), 2002 (41), '03 (41), '11 (franchise-high 48), '13 (42), '17 (44), '19 (41) and '23 (43).

WINS SINCE JULY 9: The D-backs' 24 wins (24-15) since July 9 are tied for third in the Majors with the Yankees, behind the Red Sox (29) and Padres (25).

GABI IN RARE CATCHER COMPANY: **Gabriel Moreno** (102 G, .306 AVG, 64 RBI, 10 CS, 2 E) is just 1 of 5 primary catchers since 2000 with a .300+ AVG, 60+ RBI, 10+ caught stealing and 2 or fewer errors within the first 110 games of a season, joining Ivan Rodriguez/TEX (2000 - .347 AVG, 83 RBI, 19 CS, 2 E), Jason Varitek/BOS ('04 - .307 AVG, 64 RBI, 20 CS, 2 E), Joe Mauer/MIN ('08 - .324 AVG, 60 RBI, 21 CS, 2 E) and Buster Posey/SF ('15 - .326 AVG, 78 RBI, 20 CS, 1 E).

TAWA'S TREND: **Tim Tawa** has multiple hits in a career-high 3 straight games...has reached base safely in a career-high 9 straight games, hitting .343 (12-for-35)/.966 OPS with 2 doubles, 2 homers, 6 RBI and 3 walks.

MORENO'S 17-GAME ON-BASE STREAK: **Gabriel Moreno** has reached base safely in 17 straight games since Aug. 5, batting .343 (23-for-67)/1.000 OPS with 9 doubles, 1 triple, 2 home runs, 17 RBI and 8 walks...it is the third longest on-base streak in his career, behind his 27-gamer from June 29-July 31 and 19-gamer from June 2-27.

WITH RISP: Since the All-Star break, **Gabriel Moreno's** 27 RBI with runners in scoring position ranks second in the Majors, behind Sal Stewart/CIN (28).

- Since Aug. 1 with runners in scoring position, **Ildemaro Vargas** is carrying a 1.115 OPS with 1 double, 2 triples, 1 homer, 12 RBI and 2 walks.

CORBIN THE FLASH: Since 2022, **Corbin Carroll's** 11.16 average home-to-third time is fastest in the Majors, ahead of Luisangel Acuña/NYM-CWS (11.21), Cam Cauley/TEX (11.24) and Chandler Simpson/TB (11.28).

WALDY'S WORLD: **Ryan Waldschmidt** has reached base safely in 12 of his last 14 games (19 times on base) with a .365 OBP, 2 doubles, 1 homer, 6 RBI and 8 walks.

- Among MLB rookies (min. 200 PA), his .277 AVG ranks seventh, behind Chase DeLauter/CLE (.288), Wade Meckler/LAA (.288), TJ Rumfield/COL (.287), Kevin McGonigle/DET (.283), Hao-Yu Lee/DET (.281) and Carson Benge/NYM (.278).

VS. CUBS: The D-backs have gone 6-4 in their last 10 home games vs. Cubs (since 2023).
