**YESTERDAY'S NEWS:** The Orioles defeated the Tigers, 4-2, setting up today's rubber match...**Corbin Burnes** completed his first scoreless start and 21<sup>st</sup> quality start of the season after throwing 7.0 innings on two hits and a walk with seven strikeouts; the 21 quality outings tie a career high (2022 w/MIL) and are tied for the second most in the AL this year...**Gunnar Henderson** blasted a two-run homer in the seventh inning to make it 4-0, his 37<sup>th</sup> of the season; also doubled, becoming the first Oriole to reach 150 career extra-base hits prior to turning 24 since **Manny Machado** in 2017...**Cedric Mullins** opened the scoring in the third with an RBI single and tallied two hits, his fifth multi-hit effort in 11 games since September 2.

**WHAT'S TRENDING:** The O's have lost six of the last nine games since September 4...The team is 84-65 (.564) and 2.0 games behind the Yankees (.577, 86-63) in the AL East...Baltimore is 26-27 (.491) since the All-Star break and 31-34 (.477) since July 1...Since the start of 2023, Baltimore is 185-126 (.595), the second-best winning percentage in MLB behind the Dodgers (.603, 187-123) during that time.  
O's An AL East winner has not finished the season with a record under .600 since 2015-17; Boston won the division in 2017 and 2018, as did Toronto in 2015, with a .93-69 (.574) record.

**HOMER HAPPY:** The Orioles are second in MLB with 217 home runs behind the Yankees (218)...The Dodgers rank third with 205...The O's have hit 200 home runs in a season for the 13<sup>th</sup> time in team history and the 216 are the most by the club since 2017 (232)...Baltimore is averaging 1.46 homers per game this season, which would be the third-best mark in team history behind 1996 (1.58) and 2016 (1.56).

O's Baltimore has an MLB-best nine players with at least 10 home runs: **Anthony Santander** (41), **Gunnar Henderson** (37), **Colton Cowser** (20), **Adley Rutschman** and **Jordan Westburg** (18), **Cedric Mullins** (15), **Ryan Mountcastle** and **Ryan O'Hearn** (13), and **Ramon Urias** (10); the team record is 10 players, done in 2019, 2000, and 1998.

O's Henderson and Santander are one of two duos with at least 35 home runs, along with New York-AL's Aaron Judge (52) and Juan Soto (39); Baltimore did not have a player reach 35 homers last season, and this year marks the first time since 2016 that the team has had multiple players with 35+ home runs (Trumbo, 47; Davis, 38; Machado, 37).

O's The Birds have hit 13 leadoff homers, the most by the club in a single season and second in MLB this year behind the Phillies (14); Henderson has 10 of those, second most in one season by an Oriole behind **Brady Anderson**, who hit all 12 in 1996; Cowser (2) and Westburg (1) have the other three for the O's in 2024.

**TOP GUNN:** **Gunnar Henderson** was named the AL Player of the Week on Monday...The award marked the second of his career, joining June 11, 2023...He slashed .417/.464/.833 (10-for-24) with one double, three homers, six runs scored, five RBI, three walks, and two stolen bases in six games while ranking among AL leaders during the period in slugging percentage (1<sup>st</sup>), home runs (T-1<sup>st</sup>), total bases (T-1<sup>st</sup>, 20), OPS (2<sup>nd</sup>, 1.297), batting average (T-2<sup>nd</sup>), and hits (T-2<sup>nd</sup>).

O's He's three homers shy of becoming the fourth shortstop (11<sup>th</sup> occurrence) in MLB history to hit 40 home runs; Alex Rodriguez (6x, 1998-2003), Rico Petrocelli (1969), and Ernie Banks (4x, 1957-60) are the only MLB shortstops to accomplish the feat.

O's His 37 home runs are the most by a shortstop in team history, surpassing the record of 34 held by **Cal Ripken, Jr.** (1991) and **Miguel Tejada** (2004).

O's Henderson's 113 runs scored rank third in the AL and fourth in MLB, and are the most by an Oriole since **Roberto Alomar**, who set the club record with 132 in 1996; Henderson is the sixth player in O's history (since 1954) to score 100 runs in back-to-back seasons after scoring exactly 100 times last year, joining with **Manny Machado** (2, 2015-16), **Adam Jones** (2, 2012-13), **Brian Roberts** (3, 2007-09), Anderson (2, 1995-96), and Ripken, Jr. (3, 1983-85).

O's He's on pace to score 123 times; Alomar (132 in 1996), **Frank Robinson** (122 in 1966), and Ripken, Jr. (121 in 1983) are the only players in Orioles history (since 1954) to score at least 120 runs in a season.

O's He ranks third in MLB with 7.8 fWAR; that is the best mark by an Oriole since Ripken, Jr. set the club record with 10.6 in 1991; eight Orioles (13 occurrences) have finished a season with at least 7.0 fWAR in a season; he's also among AL leaders in walks (3<sup>rd</sup>, 73), total bases (3<sup>rd</sup>, 318), home runs (4<sup>th</sup>, 37), extra-base hits (4<sup>th</sup>, 72), hits (6<sup>th</sup>, 165), slugging percentage (6<sup>th</sup>, .545), on-base percentage (7<sup>th</sup>, .368), and OPS (7<sup>th</sup>, .913).

O's Henderson has hit 31 of his home runs as the leadoff hitter, the second most in Orioles history, behind **Brady Anderson** (35) in 1996.

**MASHED TATERS:** **Anthony Santander** launched his 40<sup>th</sup> home run of the year on Monday, becoming the eighth Oriole (ninth occurrence) to do so and the first since **Mark Trumbo** in 2016 (see chart at right)...He's the eighth switch-hitter (12<sup>th</sup> occurrence) in MLB history to hit at least 40 homers in a season, along with New York-NL's Carlos Beltrán (2006), Houston's Lance Berkman (2: 2002, 06), Texas' Mark Teixeira (2005), Atlanta's Chipper Jones (1999), New York-NL's Todd Hundley (1996), San Diego's Ken Caminiti (1996), and New York-AL's Mickey Mantle (4: 1956, 58, 60-61)...Mantle is the only switch-hitter in MLB history to hit 50 homers, when he did so in 1956 (52) and 1961 (54).

O's He's five RBI shy of 100 for the season; no Oriole has reached that mark since **Jonathan Schoop** (105) in 2017; the last Baltimore switch-hitter to do so is **Bobby Bonilla** (116) in 1996.

O's Santander has hit 32 home runs since the start of June, tied with New York-AL's Aaron Judge, trailing Los Angeles-NL's Shohei Ohtani (33) for the most in MLB during that time; his 41 home runs rank third in MLB behind New York-AL's Aaron Judge (52) and Ohtani (47).

O's His 102 home runs since the start of 2022 are tied for sixth in MLB during that time and for second in the AL with Houston's Yordan Alvarez, behind only Judge (151).

O's He's the ninth player in O's history with multiple 30-homer seasons, joining **Manny Machado** (3, 2015-17), **Chris Davis** (4, 2012-13, 15-16), **Adam Jones** (2, 2012-13), **Rafael Palmeiro** (4, 1995-98), **Eddie Murray** (5, 1980, 82-83, 85, 87), **Boog Powell** (4, 1964, 66, 69-70), **Frank Robinson** (3, 1966-67, 69), and **Jim Gentile** (2, 1961-62).

**HOLY COWSER:** **Colton Cowser** leads AL rookies and is tied for second among MLB rookies with 20 home runs with Milwaukee's Jackson Chourio, trailing San Diego's Jackson Merrill (23)...He's the 10<sup>th</sup> rookie in team history (since 1954) to hit at least 20 homers and the first since **Gunnar Henderson** (28) last year...He also has 21 doubles, the ninth rookie in O's history to record 20 doubles and 20 home runs in a season and the first since Henderson (29-2B, 28 HR) in 2023...Among rookies, Cowser is second in the AL and fifth in MLB with 3.4 fWAR, trailing Milwaukee's Jackson Chourio (3.5), New York-AL's Austin Wells and PIT's Paul Skenes (3.6), and San Diego's Jackson Merrill (4.6)...He's among AL rookies in runs scored (1<sup>st</sup>, 70), extra-base hits (2<sup>nd</sup>, 44), total bases (2<sup>nd</sup>, 196), RBI (3<sup>rd</sup>, 62), doubles (T-3<sup>rd</sup>, 21), and OPS (5<sup>th</sup>, .752).

O's His 11 Outs Above Average are more than all other O's defenders combined, per Statcast; eight of those have come in left field, two behind Toronto's Daulton Varsho for the most among MLB left fielders; Detroit's Riley Greene is the next closest left fielder with four OAA.

**ON THE ROAD AGAIN:** Baltimore's penultimate road trip began in Boston on Monday...On Friday, the Orioles opened a three-game set in Detroit following a scheduled off day on Thursday...Despite losing 16 of the last 28 road games, the Orioles are 42-32 (.568) away from Oriole Park, the fourth-best road record in MLB this season, trailing the Brewers (.571, 44-33), Padres (.595, 44-30) and Yankees (.600, 45-30)...The Birds are 94-61 (.606) on the road since the start of 2023, the only MLB club with a road winning percentage above .600 in that time.

**AGAINST THE TIGERS:** The Orioles and Tigers conclude their first series of the year today at Comerica Park...The two teams face off for three games in Detroit over the weekend before meeting for three more in Baltimore next weekend...The O's won the season series against Detroit in 2023, going 6-1, including a three-game sweep in Baltimore from April 21-23...The 6-1 record last season marked Baltimore's first time winning more than five games in a single season against Detroit since the 2004 club swept the six-game season series...The Birds went 3-1 at Comerica Park in 2023 after going 5-12 in 17 games from 2017-2022...Baltimore currently holds the AL's top Wild Card spot while Detroit is 2.5 games back of the Twins for the final spot.

**THE SKIPPER:** Manager **Brandon Hyde** is in his sixth season in Baltimore...He is one win away from 400 for his career, all with Baltimore...Four previous managers have won 400 games at the helm of the Orioles: **Earl Weaver** (1,480), **Buck Showalter** (689), **Paul Richards** (517), and **Hank Bauer** (407).

**ROSTER MOVES:** The O's reinstated **OF Heston Kjerstad** from the 10-day Injured List (concussion) and **RHP Jacob Webb** from the 15-day Injured List (right elbow inflammation) today...To make room on the active roster, **LHP Cole Irvin** and **INF Nick Maton** were designated for assignment...The Orioles' 40-man roster currently has 38 players.

**QUICK HITS:** Scheduled to make his 14<sup>th</sup> career start this afternoon against the Tigers...Recalled from Triple-A Norfolk on August 20 before appearing in a game after Zach Eflin landed on the 15-day IL; marks his third stint with the Orioles this season; also served as the 27<sup>th</sup> man for the doubleheader against Toronto on July 29...Became the first Oriole pitcher to make his Major League debut this season and fourth Oriole overall, joining INF Jackson Holliday, C David Bañuelos, and INF/OF Connor Norby...Became the first Oriole to throw at least 100 pitches in his MLB debut since Wei-Yin Chen on April 10, 2012 vs. New York-AL; is the third MLB player to do so since the start of 2019, joining Chicago-AL's Dylan Cease on July 3, 2019 (G1) vs. Detroit (101) and Cincinnati's Andrew Abbott on June 5, 2023 vs. Milwaukee (105)...On June 12 vs. Atlanta, he became the 11<sup>th</sup> Oriole in team history to throw at least 6.0 scoreless innings in his first career MLB home start and first since Mike Wright Jr. on May 17, 2015 vs. Los Angeles-AL (7.1 IP); at 24 years, 61 days old, became the youngest O's left-hander to toss 6.0+ shutout frames since Zack Britton (23y, 249d) on August 28, 2011 (G1) vs. New York-AL (7.0 IP)...On September 3 vs. Chicago-AL, he became the second-youngest Oriole (24y, 144d) with 10 strikeouts and no walks in a game behind Dennis Martínez (24y, 81d) on August 3, 1978 vs. Milwaukee and the youngest to do so in a nine-inning game...Acquired by the Orioles along with RHP Yennier Cano, LHP Juan Rojas, and RHP Juan Nuñez from the Minnesota Twins in exchange for RHP Jorge López and cash considerations on August 2, 2022...Originally selected by the Minnesota Twins in the third round (No. 98 overall) of the 2021 First-Year Player Draft out of the University of Nebraska.

**LAST TIME OUT:** Was dealt the loss on September 9 at Boston after allowing four runs on five hits (2 HR) and two walks with five strikeouts in 4.2 innings; left with a runner on, who was stranded...The two home runs tie a career high...Has failed to complete 5.0 innings in two of his last three starts...Threw 76 pitches, 46 strikes.

**AGAINST THE TIGERS AND THE AL CENTRAL:** Slated to make his first career start against Detroit...Has gone 1-1 with a 2.08 ERA (3 ER/13.0 IP) in two career starts against the AL Central...Last faced an AL Central foe on September 3 vs. Chicago-AL, tossing 7.1 scoreless innings on five hits with 10 strikeouts...Marked his second career win and third career quality start.

**ON THE ROAD AGAIN:** Is 0-4 with a 11.37 ERA (24 ER/19.0 IP) with five homers in five road starts compared to 2-4 with a 3.60 ERA (18 ER/45.0 IP) and six home runs allowed in eight starts at Oriole Park.

**STEP INTO THE DAYLIGHT:** Making his fourth career day start...Has gone 0-3 with a 14.34 ERA (17 ER/10.2 IP) in three afternoon starts compared to 2-5 with a 4.22 ERA (25 ER/53.1 IP) in his 10 night outings.

**HIGH TIDE:** Has gone 6-1 with a 3.48 ERA (30 ER/77.2 IP), a 1.11 WHIP, and 89 strikeouts against 27 walks across 15 outings (14 GS) for the Tides this year...When Povich was first promoted, he ranked among International League leaders in strikeouts (2<sup>nd</sup>), opponent average (3<sup>rd</sup>, .203), ERA (4<sup>th</sup>), WHIP (4<sup>th</sup>, 1.11), and wins (T-4<sup>th</sup>); only trailed teammate RHP Chayce McDermott (82) in strikeouts...At the time, his 75 strikeouts were tied for fifth among all minor league pitchers.

**FOREVER YOUNG:** At 24 years, 156 days old, he is currently the youngest pitcher on the O's and the fourth-youngest player overall behind Gunnar Henderson (23y, 78d), Coby Mayo (22y, 280d), and Jackson Holliday (20y, 286d).

**FLOWERS, NOT SHOWERS:** Named the International League Pitcher of the Month for April after going 2-1 with a 1.03 ERA (3 ER/26.1 IP) and a league-best 40 strikeouts in five starts...Also named the Orioles Minor League Pitcher of the Month after leading O's minor leaguers (min. 20 IP) in ERA, WHIP, and strikeouts...Named International League Pitcher of the Week for April 1-7 after going 1-0 with a 0.82 ERA (1 ER/11.0 IP), three hits, three walks, and 14 strikeouts in two starts at Charlotte during the week.
