CINCINNATI REDS (9-24) vs. PITTSBURGH PIRATES (13-19)

May 14, 2022 at PNC Park, Pittsburgh, PA -- GAME #33/HOME #18

RHP LUIS CASTILLO (0-0, 5.79 ERA) vs. RHP ZACH THOMPSON (1-3, 7.08 ERA)

THE PIRATES...have dropped back-to-back games after winning two of their previous three games against the Dodgers...Have gone 4-5 in their last nine games after dropping six-of-seven...Posted a 5-4 record in their first nine games; have gone 8-15 in 23 games since...Have won two games in a row on three occasions (last time coming on April 21-22)...Were 13-19 after 32 games last year (14-19 after 33).

BIG ZACH: Right-handed pitcher **Zach Thompson** is making his sixth start (seventh appearance) of the season tonight. ...He held the Reds to two hits while pitching 5.0 scoreless innings last Sunday afternoon in Cincinnati...The 6'7" Thompson was one of three players acquired by the Pirates along with outfielder **Connor Scott** and right-handed pitcher **Kyle Nicolas** this past offseason in exchange for catcher Jacob Stallings...Tonight marks his third appearance at PNC Park this season; he gave up two runs in 4.0ip against the Cubs on 4/13 and suffered a loss to the Padres on 4/29 (4.1ip/4er).

NIGHT VISION: **Ke'Bryan Hayes** has produced a .375 (21-for-56) batting average in his 16 games played at night, the third-highest average among National League players under the lights this season behind San Diego's Manny Machado (.410) and Eric Hosmer (.392).

LEADING THINGS OFF: **Ben Gamel** connected for the first leadoff home run of his career and the second by a Pirates player this year (also **Daniel Vogelbach** on April 14 vs. the Nationals)...The Gamel blast was also the 186th leadoff home run in the team's 136 seasons of play in the National League...The Pirates have now matched their leadoff home run total from last year; they hit three in the 2020 season and eight in 2019.

DOWN ON THE FARM: **Cal Mitchell** connected for two home runs last night and tied his season high with four RBI in Indianapolis' 7-5 win against Columbus...Mitchell is hitting .324 (11-for-34) with two doubles, two home runs and seven RBI in his first eight games of this month.

SUITING UP: On Thursday, **Roldolfo Castro** became the 39th different player to appear in a game for the Pirates this season (19th different position player)...The Pirates had a club-record 64 different players appear in a game last season.

ON A SERIES NOTES: Dating back to September of 2017, the Pirates have gone 8-2-1 in the last 11 series played against the Reds at PNC Park...The Bucs have posted a 25-11 record against the Reds in last 36 meetings at PNC Park.

LEADING THE WAY: As a group, Pittsburgh's leadoff batters have combined to hit .316 (42-for-133) this season - the highest average among all National League teams and the second-best mark in the Majors behind the White Sox (.328)... In his 11 games from the top spot, **Ben Gamel** has gone 16-for-41 (.390) with five extra-base hits and eight RBI.

GET A WHIFF OF THIS: **David Bednar** has struck out at least one batter in each of his first 13 appearances, whiffing a total of 24 in 15.2 innings of work (13.79 K/per 9.0ip)...His 24 strikeouts this year are tied for the fourth-most among all big league relief pitchers and tied with New York's Edwin Diaz for the second-most among all National League relievers... Dating back to 8/3/21, Bednar has whiffed at least one batter in 29 consecutive games.

DAN THE DH: **Daniel Vogelbach** connected for his fifth home run of the season on Wednesday; a solo shot in the seventh inning that broke a 3-3 tie with the Dodgers...Vogelbach has hit five home runs this season as a designated hitter; a single-season high for a Pirates player...Among all National League players this season, Vogelbach is tied with Pete Alonso for the second-most home runs hit as a DH...Bryce Harper leads all players with seven.

SEEING RED: This series with the Reds is the first of three scheduled this season at PNC Park (also August 19-21 and September 26-28)...The Pirates went 5-4 at home against Cincinnati last season, including wins in each of the final two series from September 14-16 and October 1-3.

BIG BEN: **Ben Gamel** enters today's action with most hits in the National League (18) and the second-most in MLB during the month of May...Batimore's Cedric Mullins leads all players in 19 hits this month...Gamel is hitting .419 (18-for-43) with four doubles, a triple, two homers and eight RBI in his first 11 games this month while lifting his season batting average from .224 to .307.

PROVIDING RELIEF: **Anthony Banda** stranded each of his two inherited runners while going on to work 1.1 scoreless innings against the Reds Friday night...Banda has now been scored upon once in his last seven appearances (4.2ip).

THIS AND THAT: **Ke'Bryan Hayes** has gone 27-for-74 (.365) with four doubles, a triple and two home runs in 20 career games against the Reds...**Bryan Reynolds** has gone 17-for-54 (.315) with five doubles, three home runs, seven RBI and a .464 on-base percentage in 18 career games against the Reds at PNC Park.

BOMBS AWAY: The Pirates homered three times Wednesday and have now gone deep 12 times in their last seven games after hitting a total of three long balls in their previous 11 games...Pittsburgh's 14 home runs this month are tied for sixth among all National League teams and tied for ninth-most in all of MLB this month (the Brewers lead all teams with 20).

ON THIS DATE IN PIRATES HISTORY

May 14, 1982: The Pirates trailed 5-0 after the first inning, but came away with an 8-7 win over the Reds at Three Rivers Stadium. Don Robinson retired just two batters and was charged with five runs before giving way to Manny Sarmiento. The Bucs scored three times apiece in the seventh and eighth innings to pull out the win. With the tying run at second base, Kent Tekulve induced Hall-of-Fame catcher Johnny Bench to pop out in foul territory to end the game.

JOSÉ QUINTANA: The 33-year-old lefthander will be making his seventh start of the season tomorrow afternoon...His last start was a 5-1 win over the Dodgers at PNC Park on Monday (6.0ip/2h/0r/4bb/5so). ...Has given up two runs or less in five of his first six starts...Made his Pirates debut in the Home Opener on 4/12 and suffered a 2-1 loss to the Cubs (5.1ip/1er)...Has not received any run support when he has been in the game in three of his first six starts...The Pirates have been victorious in each of his last two starts and in four of his last five.

vs. CINCINNATI: 4-4 with a 3.88 ERA (51.0ip/24r/22er) in 10 career games (nine starts)...Made his last appearance in relief on 8/30/20 and gave up one run in 3.0ip while pitching with the Cubs at Great American Ball Park...Tossed 6.0 scoreless innings in his last start on 6/29/19 at Great American Ball Park in a 6-0 Cubs victory.
