



# Los Angeles Angels (26-42) at San Francisco Giants (34-35)

**TODAY'S GAME:** SF welcomes the Angels to town, which kicks off its third straight series, and fourth in its last five series, against American League teams...the Giants are 6-9 in Interleague games, yet are 4-2 in their last six such games.

- ▶ Despite a recent season-high six-game losing streak from May 29-June 4, the Giants have won 15 of their last 25 games dating to May 15 (a .600 winning percentage).
- ▶ The .600 win % in that time is tied for second-best in that span in the NL behind Philadelphia (16-9, .640).
- ▶ Since that aforementioned six-game slide, the Giants have won five of their last seven games with the only losses coming on Tuesday to Houston and Sunday at Texas.

**GIANTS ROSTER MOVES:** The Giants made the following moves prior to today's game.

- ▶ **IF Nick Ahmed** (#16) returned from his rehab assignment and was reinstated from the 10-day Injured List.
- ▶ **IF Casey Schmitt** was optioned to Triple-A Sacramento yesterday.
- ▶ **IF Marco Luciano** returned from his rehab assignment, was reinstated from the 10-day Injured List and was optioned to Triple-A Sacramento yesterday.

**BEAT LA...A:** The Giants are 26-16 all-time in the regular season vs. the Angels, outscoring them 209-163 (+46)...at Oracle Park, SF is 14-7 vs. LAA, outscoring them 93-74 (+19).

- ▶ SF's 14-7 (.667) mark at home against LAA is tied with Cleveland for its second-best home record vs. any active MLB franchise, behind only its record vs. Texas (20-8, .714) per *Stats, LLC*.
- ▶ Dating back to the 2015 season, SF has gone 4-1-2 in seven series vs. LAA, and has won seven of its last 10 games.

**ON YOUR LEFT:** The Giants are 8-12 in games against left-handed starting pitchers this year but have won each their last three games against a LHSP after losing five in a row from late May to early June.

- ▶ **IF Matt Chapman** has a .304 average versus lefty starters this year while his .925 OPS against them is 12th-best in MLB (min. 70 PA).
- ▶ A key bat in SF's lineup against lefties, **OF Austin Slater**, is 6-for-13 (.462) overall with four runs, three RBI (one being for a walk-off), a walk and a stolen base in his first four games since returning from the 7-day concussion IL.

**NO HOME RUNS AT HOME:** The Giants have an MLB-low 22 home runs at home this season...their 22 home runs through their first 34 games at home are their fewest since 2017, when they hit 19 over 34 home games.

- ▶ In SF's previous four instances of fewer than 22 homers in its first 34 home games, two of those SF teams made the Postseason, with the 2012 squad winning the World Series.
- ▶ Even with the low homer output, SF is 6-2-0 in its last eight home series since April 22, losing only to LAD and NYY.

**ON THE BRINK: IF Wilmer Flores** logged a pinch-hit single on Monday for his 999th career hit...when Flores reaches the 1,000-hit mark, he'll be the 17th Venezuelan-born player to record at least 1,000 career hits and 150 career homers.

- ▶ His .421 (16x38) career average against LAA is second-best among active MLB players (min. 30 at-bats), trailing only MIN's Kyle Farmer (.424) according to *Stats, LLC*.

**EL BORI: OF Heliot Ramos** has been a bright spot for SF since his call-up on May 8, reaching base safely in 28 of his 32 games with a .305/.385/.500 slash line (.885 OPS), five doubles, six homers and 24 RBI.

- ▶ In 11 games this June, he's 15-for-43 (.349) with five extra-base hits (one double, four homers), 11 RBI, six runs, six walks and a 1.083 OPS.
- ▶ In the 31 games Ramos has started, the Giants are averaging 5.0 runs per game and hitting .253, compared to 3.6 runs per game and a .237 average when he doesn't (*SIS*).
- ▶ The Giants are 18-13 in Ramos' 31 starts this year.
- ▶ Defensively, he has +7 DRS in the outfield in 271.2 innings... the +7 DRS are tied for fifth-best among MLB outfielders.

**COMMUTER TRAFFIC:** SF is one of MLB's top offenses at getting the leadoff runner on-base as shown in the chart below...SF's .340 on-base percentage to lead off an inning would be the franchise's third-best over the past 50 seasons behind 2020 (.361) and 1999 (.345) per *Stats, LLC*.

**X-SPENCE REPORT: RHP Spencer Howard** will make his second start for SF...he allowed one run across 4.2 innings last Saturday at Texas, one out shy of his first win of 2024.

- ▶ Howard has pitched at least 4.0 innings while allowing fewer than two runs and five hits in each of his first three games with the Giants organization.
- ▶ The only players since 1901 with a longer streak to start their career for the franchise are **RHP Jordan Hicks** (six earlier this year), **LHP Carlos Rodón** (five – 2022), **LHP Alex Wood** (five – 2021) and **RHP Matt Cain** (six – 2005) (*Stats, LLC*).
- ▶ In his only other appearance at Oracle Park this year, Howard blanked the Phillies over 4.0 relief innings with four strikeouts on May 28.

**June 14, 1979 - Willie McCovey** hit his 513th home run in a shot off Dennis Lamp, establishing him as the National League all-time left-handed home run leader. The Chicago Cubs ended up beating the Giants 8-6 at Candlestick Park.

# SPENCER HOWARD RHP #56

2024 RECORD: 0-0, 2.03 ERA

**WELCOME TO SF:** Howard is making his second start in his fourth game since having his contract purchased on May 28...He signed an MiLB contract with the Giants on September 22, 2023 and was an invite to Major League Spring Training this year.

**VS. LOS ANGELES-AL:** This will be Howard's third career game vs. the Angels, and first since 2022...he is 1-1 with a 3.68 ERA (3er, 7.1ip) with eight strikeouts and a 1.09 WHIP...Howard had one of the best outings of his MLB career against the Angels on July 28, 2022, earning the win with 5.0 shutout innings with five strikeouts and just three hits allowed.

**LAST OUTING:** Narrowly missed out on the win last Sunday against his former team, the Texas Rangers...struck out two while allowing one run on three hits and three walks across 4.2 innings, throwing 74 pitches (53 for strikes).

**OPPORTUNITY CALLS:** Howard was brought up to eat innings with injuries to starting pitchers **LHP Blake Snell** and **RHP Keaton Winn**...he has made the most of his latest Major League opportunity, posting a 2.03 ERA (3er, 13.1ip), nine strikeouts and a 1.13 WHIP in three games thus far.

**FAST TIMES:** Through three games, Howard has almost exclusively used three pitches: his four-seam fastball (54.2% usage), slider (23.2%) and changeup (17.9%)...below is a chart of where Los Angeles-AL ranks in MLB against those three pitches.

**LAST SEASON:** Spent a good portion of 2023 on separate trips to the IL with a right lat strain and a right shoulder strain...he pitched mostly in Triple-A with the Texas and New York-AL organizations, going 1-2 with a 6.86 ERA (16er, 21.0ip), 34 strikeouts and a 1.24 WHIP...he posted a 10.80 ERA (4er, 3.1ip) while striking out 2 in three MLB games with Texas...he was traded from Texas to New York-AL on August 1 in exchange for cash.

**TOP GUN:** Howard had an illustrious Minor League career, ranking as a top-50 prospect in both 2020 and 2021 according to Baseball America (No. 27 in both 2020 and 2021) and MLB.com (No. 34 in 2020 and No. 42 in 2021)...below is a list of Howard's Minor League awards.

**MUSTANG PRIDE:** Howard had a strong career at Cal Poly, San Luis Obispo, which he began as a walk-on...in his final season, 2017, Howard went 8-1 with a 1.95 ERA (19er, 87.2ip) and 97 strikeouts to earn Second-Team All-American and All-Big West nods as well as the University's **Mike Krukow** Outstanding Pitcher Award.

**BEFORE SF:** Howard was originally selected by Philadelphia out of Cal Poly, San Luis Obispo in the second round of the 2017 MLB draft... after making his debut with the Phillies on August 9, 2020, Howard would later be traded alongside RHP Josh Gessner and RHP Kevin Gowdy to Texas in exchange for RHP Ian Kennedy, RHP Hans Crouse and RHP Kyle Gibson on July 30, 2021...Howard was 3-11 with a 7.20 ERA, 109 strikeouts and a 1.67 WHIP over 115.0 innings across 38 MLB games (29 starts) from 2020-2023.
