HERE'S THE STORY: Since May 15 vs. NL West, the D-backs' 16-6 (.727) record is the best among the NL, ahead of the Dodgers (13-6, .684) and Cubs (9-6, .600)...their last 7 NL West series: 2-1 @ Rockies, 3-0 vs. Giants, 3-1 vs. Rockies, 3-0 @ Giants, 2-2 vs. Dodgers, 2-1 vs. Giants, currently 1-1 vs. Padres.

- The D-backs' 17 wins vs. NL West opponents are second among NL teams, behind the Dodgers (21).
- Gabriel Moreno's** 27 straight starts reaching base safely is a franchise high by a D-back catcher, ahead of Chris Snyder (25 from April 7-May 16, 2008) and Miguel Montero (25 from Aug. 13-Sept. 14, 2011).
- Ketel Marte** has a 10-game on-base streak, batting .316 (12-for-38)/1.132 OPS with 2 doubles, 1 triple, 4 homers, 7 RBI and 4 walks (4 K)...since June 11, is batting .319 (30-for-94)/.997 OPS with 7 doubles, 1 triple, 6 homers, 14 RBI, 9 walks (8 K), 2 hit-by-pitches and 4 stolen bases.
- José Cabrera** is making his fourth career start and first against an NL West opponent.

LAST GAME: Lost 4-1 @ Padres.

- Zac Gallen** (L, 4 ER in 6.0 IP, 6 H, 3 BB, 5 K), after allowing 4 runs on 3 hits in the first inning, including a 3-run homer, went on to toss 5.0 scoreless innings with just 3 hits allowed.
- Ketel Marte** (1-for-3, 2B, BB) led off with an extra-base hit (double) for a second consecutive game and second time this season (also: HR on April 11 @ Phillies and HR on April 13 @ Orioles).
- Gabriel Moreno** (2-for-4) had his second consecutive multi-hit game.
- Kevin Ginkel** (1.0 IP) and **Jonathan Loaisiga** (1.0 IP) combined for 2.0 perfect innings.

ARENADO NEARING 2,000 HITS: **Nolan Arenado** (1,990) is 10 hits shy of 2,000 career to become the sixth active player to reach 2,000 hits, to join Manny Machado/BAL-LAD-SD (July 7, 2025), Paul Goldschmidt/AZ-STL-NYY (July 26, 2024), Jose Altuve/HOU (Aug. 20, 2023), Freddie Freeman/ATL-LAD (June 25, 2023) and Andrew McCutchen/PIT-SF-NYY-PHI-MIL-TEX (June 11, 2023).

- Would become the third D-back to record their 2,000th career hit while with the D-backs, joining Steve Finley (Sept. 13, 2002 vs. Brewers) and Luis Gonzalez (May 22, 2004 @ Marlins) [source: Elias Sports Bureau].

ARENADO IN SAN DIEGO: **Nolan Arenado's** 16 homers at Petco Park are the most by a visiting player, ahead of Charlie Blackmon/COL (13), Freddie Freeman/ATL-LAD (13) and Justin Upton/AZ-DET-LAA-SEA (13).

- Has reached base safely in 23 of his last 24 games @ Padres (since Sept. 1, 2018), batting .333 (30-for-90)/1.044 OPS with 6 doubles, 8 homers, 16 RBI and 6 walks.

MORENO'S 27 STRAIGHT STARTS ON BASE: **Gabriel Moreno's** franchise-best 27 straight starts (by a catcher) reaching base safely is the longest streak by any catcher this season and longest since Carlos Narváez/BOS (30 from May 4-June 17, 2025).

- Since June 2, is hitting .333 (32-for-96)/.913 OPS with 4 doubles, 3 homers, 10 RBI and 18 walks (10 K).

TRAVELING BATS: Since May 13, **Gabriel Moreno's** .392 road AVG ranks atop the Majors...has reached base in 19 of his last 21 road games, hitting .392 (29-for-74)/1.039 OPS with 4 doubles, 3 homers, 11 RBI and 12 walks (11 K).

- Ketel Marte** has hit safely in 11 of his last 12 road games, batting .313 (15-for-48)/1.002 OPS with 4 doubles, 1 triple, 3 homers, 4 RBI and 4 walks.
- Geraldo Perdomo** has reached base safely in 21 of his last 24 road games (25 H, 13 BB)/.811 OPS with 3 doubles, 4 homers, 7 RBI and 13 walks (13 K).

BULLPEN SPOTLIGHT: Since May 1, the D-backs bullpen's 64 walks and 160 hits allowed rank fewest in MLB, while their 71 earned runs rank second, behind the Yankees (67 ER).

- Since May 1, the D-backs bullpen's 29 scoreless games rank tied for the most in the Majors with the Dodgers (29), ahead of the Braves (26), Mariners (25) and Phillies (25).
- The D-backs bullpen's 27.7 (31 IS/112 IR) inherited runs allowed pct. ranks fourth in the NL, behind the Marlins (20.3, 24/118), Reds (25.0, 36/144) and Braves (27.6, 24/87).

GINKEL BACK HOME IN THE 619: **Kevin Ginkel**, Lakeside native and El Capitan High School and Southwestern College alumnus, is scoreless in 11 of his last 12 appearances @ Padres, going 2-0 with a 0.68 ERA (1 ER in 13.1 IP), opponent .119 AVG (5-for-42), 0.53 WHIP, 2 walks and 11 strikeouts.

ALL-STAR FACTS: **Eduardo Rodriguez** (first career appearance in 11th MLB season) is 1 of 8 MLB players since 2022 to be named a first-time All-Star in their 10th season or later, joining Raisel Iglesias/ATL ('26, 12th), Matthew Boyd/CHC ('25, 11th), Jurickson Profar/SD ('24, 11th), Alex Cobb/SF ('23, 12th), Jorge Soler/MIA ('23, 10th), Martín Pérez/TEX ('22, 10th) and Travis d'Arnaud/ATL ('22, 10th) [source: Elias Sports Bureau].

- Corbin Carroll** (second straight appearance, third career) is 1 of 7 players who have debuted since 2017 with 3+ All-Star selections at age 25 or younger, along with Ronald Acuna Jr./ATL (4 in 2019, 2021-23), Vladimir Guerrero Jr./TOR (4 in 2021-24), Juan Soto/WSH-SD-NYY (4 in 2021-24), Riley Greene/DET (3 in 2024-26), Julio Rodriguez/SEA (3 in 2022-23, 2025) and Paul Skenes/PIT (3 in 2024-26).

VS. PADRES: The D-backs split their first series vs. Padres in the Mexico City Series from April 25-26 (1-1).

The D-backs have won or split 5 of their last 6 series @ Padres.
