FLIGHT PATTERN: The St. Louis Cardinals and Los Angeles Angels play the second game of a three-game Interleague series tonight at Angel Stadium as the Redbirds continue their seven game road trip through Milwaukee (1-3) and Orange County (1-0) ... The Cardinals open today tied with Pittsburgh (17-24) for 4th place in the National League Central, 7.0 games behind first place Milwaukee and 3.5 games back in the NL Wild Card race

COMEBACK CARDS: St. Louis has erased a three-run and four-run deficit in its last two wins ... The last time the Cardinals came back from 3+ runs in consecutive wins was 2019 at Cincinnati's Great American Ball Park, overcoming three-run deficit on July 18 (7-4 win) and then erasing a seven-run hole on July 19 (12-11 win) ... 52.9% (9 of 17) of the Cardinals wins this season have been the comeback variety, 5th highest in the majors ... The Rockies are first in percentage (84.6%) of comeback wins, while the Tigers lead MLB in total comeback wins (13). - *Elias*

THE MOUSE HOUSE: The Cardinals are playing their 8th game ever at Angel Stadium (2013-24), the fewest regular season games played here by any Major League team since the stadium opened in 1966 (chart left) ... Among active Major League stadiums, St. Louis has played fewer games at Yankee Stadium (3), Globe Life Field (3), and Target Field (6).

CALIFORNIA DREAMIN': St. Louis is visiting all five California-based organizations during the season for the 2nd time in franchise history (also 2013): March 28-31 at Los Angeles Dodgers (1-3); April 1-3 at San Diego (2-1); April 15-17 at Oakland (2-1); May 13-15 at Los Angeles Angels (1-0); and Sept. 27-29 at San Francisco.

DOUBLE TROUBLE: The Cardinals posted their first double-digit run total last night in their 41st game of the season, 3rd-longest streak to begin a season in franchise history behind 48 games in 1966 and 57 games in 1972 ... The White Sox are now the only MLB team this season without a double-digit run total ... The Cardinals offense has recorded 10+ hits in three straight games (May 11-present) for the first time this season ... The last time the Redbirds enjoyed double-digit hit totals over a longer streak was the first five games of the 2023 season (March 30-April 4) - *Elias*

WINNING TIME: Someone other than **Matt Carpenter** will lead off a Cardinals game at Angel Stadium for the first time tonight as rookie shortstop **Masyn Winn** leads off for the first time in his MLB career ... At age 22-054, Winn becomes the youngest to lead off for St. Louis since rookie shortstop **Luis Ordaz** (age 22-039) on Sept. 20, 1997 at Pittsburgh ... Winn currently sports MLB's highest line drive percentage (38.2%) and co-leads all MLB shortstops in defensive runs saved (8) with **Bobby Witt Jr.** - *Sports Info Sol*

THE LATE SHOW: The Cardinals are 149-151 all-time in night road games in the Pacific Time Zone since divisional play began in 1994, including a 6-1 mark this season (1-1 at LA Dodgers, 2-0 at Padres; 2-0 at Athletics; & 1-0 at LA Angels).

INTERLEAGUE ENFORCER RETURNS HOME: San Clemente native **Nolan Arenado** is batting .368/.444/.605, (14-38) in 10 Interleague games this season, and ranks among the all-time Interleague leaders in homers (51, T-11th), RBI (183, T-5th), doubles (66, 5th), and extra-base hits (121, 7th) ... The El Toro High School graduate's 328th career home run last night tied himself with former Angel **Mo Vaughn** and one of Areando's childhood favorites, **Shawn Green**, for 118th all-time in MLB History.

CARDS CITY CONNECT: As the Angels wear their Nike City Connect uniforms for the first time this season, St. Louis recently announced that it will unveil their Nike City Connect Series uniforms on Monday, May 20 ... The on-field debut of the Cardinals City Connect uniforms is scheduled for Saturday, May 25 at Busch Stadium vs. the division-rival Chicago Cubs.

WELCOME BACK, JIMMY BALLGAME: Cardinals broadcaster and Hall of Famer **Jim Edmonds** has hit the most home runs as a Cardinal (241) of any player acquired via trade by St. Louis in its franchise history (1892-present), with **Paul Goldschmidt** (134 since 2019) ranking 5th and **Nolan Arenado** (92 since 2021) ranking 10th ... Edmonds joined St. Louis before the 2000 season from the Angels organization in exchange for RHP **Kent Bottenfield** and INF **Adam Kennedy** (March 23, 2000). - *Orf*

Miles Mikolas (May 20, 2012) and **John King** (Sept. 9, 2020) earned their first MLB wins against the Angels.

Hall of Famer **Ozzie Smith** graduated from Locke High School in Los Angeles...played college baseball at Cal Poly, San Luis Obispo.

Guillermo Zuñiga pitched in two games for St. Louis in 2023...made MLB Debut with the Cardinals versus the Angels (May 2, 2023 at Busch III)...traded to Angels for cash considerations (Feb. 7, 2024).

Ron "Pop" Warner was born in Alhambra, Calif...graduated from Redlands High School.

Michael Siani and Angels broadcaster **Mark Gubicza** are both graduates from William Penn Charter in Philadelphia...Siani is first player to make it to MLB who received scholarship established by Gubicza in his father's name for a student from Roxborough neighborhood.

Brandon Crawford played three seasons at UCLA (2006-08).

Luis Garcia pitched for St. Louis in 2021 (34 G).

Reid Detmers was born in Nokomis, Ill...graduated from Glenwood III. High School...grew up a Cardinals fan...father **Kris Detmers** pitched parts of six seasons in the Cardinals minor league organization (1994-99), where he was teammates with **Stubby Clapp** and **Pop Warner**.

Cardinals broadcaster **Bengie Molina** played in eight seasons with the Angels (1998-2004) & won 2002 World Series...originally signed by the Angels as an non-drafted free agent (May 23, 1993).

Hall of Famer **Tony La Russa** served as an executive with the Angels (2019-20).

Cardinals AGM/Scouting **Randy Flores** was born in Bellflower...graduated from El Rancho High School in Pico Rivera...pitched at the University of Southern California (1994-97).

Jim Edmonds was born in Diamond Bar, Calif...drafted by the Angels in the 7th round in 1988 ...played seven seasons with the Angels (1993-99), winning two Gold Gloves (1997-98) and was a 1995 AL All-Star...became a Cardinal via trade with the Angels (March 23, 2000), exchanged for **Kent Bottenfield** and **Adam Kennedy**.

Cardinals Hall of Famer **Mark McGwire** is a Pomona, CA native...graduated from Damien High School in La Verne, CA and played college baseball at USC...resides in Southern California.

Recently passed Hall of Famer **Whitey Herzog** was California Angels interim manager in 1974...later served as Angels General Manager (1993-94).

Former Cardinals personnel now with the Angels include **Phil Plantier**, **Joey Prebyski**, **Tony Ferreira**, **Joe Kruzel**, **Chris Carpenter**, **Jobel Jimenez**, **Mike Gallego**, and **Matt Swanson**.

St. Louis Post-Dispatch reporter **Daniel Guerrero** is an Anaheim, Calif native and grew up an Angels fan...earned associates degree in journalism at Fullerton College.

Bally Sports West reporter **Erica Weston** worked for Bally Sports Midwest from 2018-21.

TONIGHT'S GAME

- Makes his 7th start of the season and his 16th career start against the LA Angels tonight.
- Is pitching at Angel Stadium for the first time since 9/28/16. Each of his previous games/starts here came as a member of the Oakland A's.
- Had an 0.89 ERA through his first five starts with St. Louis, lowest by a Cardinal in his first five appearances as a starter with the organization since 1910.
- Both of this losses this season have come vs. MIL. Allowed a career-high 3 HR's and a season-high 6 runs on 7 hits in 7-1 loss at Milwaukee last Thu. (5/9).
- Surpassed 1,600 career innings in his 5/3 start vs. the White Sox, firing 7.0 scoreless innings of three -hit ball in a 3-0 win, his 7th career win vs. the Pale Hose, the opponent he has his 3rd-most wins against.
- Has MLB leading K% on Sweeper pitch, fanning 23 in 34 plate appearances (67.6).
- Opened the season with 17.0 scoreless innings, longest by a Cardinals starting pitcher this season and 4th-longest in MLB. The last time a Cardinals starting pitcher opened the season with 17.0+ scoreless innings was **Woody Williams** (24.2 IP) in 2003, who set the franchise record in the Divisional Era (1969-present). - *Elias*
- Struck out 12 batters vs. Milwaukee (April 21), his most since a career-high 13 vs. Houston (April 7, 2023); the 15th double-digit strikeout game of his career.
- Ranks 14th among active pitchers with 102 career wins. Is joined by teammates **Lance Lynn** (137, 6th) and **Kyle Gibson** (106, T-11th) in the top-20.
- Gray is one of three free-agent starters (**Lance Lynn & Kyle Gibson**) that the Cardinals signed this past off-season.
- Has joined his fifth Major League team: Athletics (2013-17), Yankees (2017-18), Reds (2019-21), Twins (2022-23) and Cardinals (2024).

LAST TIME OUT

- Dropped a 7-1 decision last Thu. (5/9) at MIL, allowing three HR's, matching his career high for just the 6th time. Allowed 6 runs for just the 3rd time in 74 starts dating back to July 25, 2021 (career high 8 vs. STL). Both of his losses as Cardinals have been vs. MIL.

CAREER

- Selected by the Oakland Athletics in the 1st round (18th overall) of the 2011 Major League Draft out of Vanderbilt University.
 - His 3.45 career ERA ranks 6th among active pitchers & 1,565 strikeouts rank 16th.
 - Has made seven career starts at Busch Stadium, with four of those being Quality Starts. He is 2-3, 2.90 ERA career at Busch (40.1 IP/13 ER). Five of his seven starts at Busch Stadium were with the Cincinnati Reds.
- ### 2024
- Has struck out 44 batters over his first six starts for the Cardinals, the most in franchise history, besting **Alan Benes'** 43 K's in his 1st six starts as a Cardinal (1995-96).
 - Struck out a season-high 12 batters over 6.2 innings in a 2-0 loss to MIL (4/21). Marked his 15th career double-digit strikeout game and first since a career-high 13 vs. HOU (4/7/23). Surrendered a two-out single to Owen Miller in the 7th as part of three consecutive hits before exiting.
 - Threw a season-high 7.0 scoreless innings in a 3-0 win over the White Sox on 5/3, lowering his ERA to 0.89, the lowest by a Cardinals pitcher in his first five starts with the club since 1910.
 - Made his Cardinals regular season debut on April 9 vs. Philadelphia. Joined **John Smoltz** (Aug. 23, 2009 at San Diego - 5 IP, 3 H, 0 R, 0 BB, 9 K) as the 2nd Cardinal since 1901 (37th MLB pitcher overall) to pitch 5.0+ scoreless innings with 5 hits or fewer, zero walks, and 5+ strikeouts in his first game with the franchise.
 - Struck out **Bryce Harper** (swinging) on April 9 for his first strikeout in a Cardinals uniform.
 - Began the season on the 15-day I.L. with right hamstring injury, suffered on March 4.
 - Had been named the team's Opening Day starter for 2024 before suffering injury. Was 0-0 with a 0.00 ERA (3.2 IP) in his two Grapefruit League starts in spring.
 - Worked in minor league training games at the Cardinals Jupiter complex and in a simu-
