▼McCusker, 27, has played in 87 games for the Saints this season, hitting .245 (78-for-319) with 19 doubles, 19 home runs, 61 RBI, 46 runs scored, 30 walks, a .316 on-base percentage, a .483 slugging percentage and a .799 OPS...this will mark McCusker's second stint with the Twins after making his major league debut on May 18 at Milwaukee...in five games for the Twins from May 18-28, he went 1-for-6.

GAME OF THRONES: The Twins are playing the ninth of 13 games against the Royals this season...Minnesota is 4-4 against the Royals, going 1-3 at Kauffman and 3-1 at Target Field.

♣ Twins are 21-4 in their last 25 home games against the Royals.

♣ Twins are 32-19 in their last 51 overall against the Royals, dating back to April of 2022.

♣ Rocco Baldelli has a career managerial record of 60-41 vs. Kansas City...60 wins are his most against any opponent.

♣ Bailey Ober has allowed two earned runs over his last three starts (19.2 IP) vs. the Royals, including two walks, 14 strikeouts and no home runs allowed.

CHAPTER ONE: Twins have won three-straight and four of their last five, outscoring their opponents 32-21 over the last five...they have scored nine-plus runs in consecutive games for the first time since scoring 10 in back-to-back games June 2-3 at the Athletics.

◆ Over their last five games, the Twins are hitting .277 (48-for-173) with 10 home runs, 32 runs scored (6.4 runs-per-game), a .352 on-base percentage, a .520 slugging percentage and an .873 OPS.

◆ They have struck out just nine times in their last three games.

◆ They have scored in 13 of 26 innings over their last three games.

**KEA TO OUR HEARTS:** Since returning from the Injured List, Luke Keaschall has gone 6-for-13... he has reached base 20 times in 39 plate appearances to start his career, the only Twins to reach as many times were Miguel Sanó (21 times in 2015) and Kirby Puckett (20 times in 1984)...he has now hit safely in each of his first 10 games with an at-bat to start his career... also has reached base safely in all 11...below are Twins (since 1961) best on-base streaks to begin their career (above) and best hitting streaks to begin their career (below):

HITTING STREAK PLAYER DATES Glenn Williams June 7-28 2005 April 18-present mber 16-23, 2000 Luke Keaschall Luis Rivas 8 September 16-23, 2000 ALSO...: Keaschall has a .500+ OBP, 10+ RBI and five+ stolen bases...in the last 20 seasons, the only rookie with numbers like that over *any* 10-game span is Mike Trout in 2012.

AMERICA'S NEXT TOP JEFF: Ryan Jeffers has hit safely in a season-high 10-straight games... his career-high is 14, done July 15-August 9, 2023...he is the second Twin with a double-digit hitting streak this season...the high for a Twin in 2025 was Brooks Lee's 19 (May 28-June 20). 

◆ Over his last 22 games, Jeffers is hitting .375 (30-for-80) with seven doubles, two home runs, 10 RBI, four walks, a .419 on-base percentage, a .538 slugging percentage and a .956 OPS.

SERIES DISCUSSIONS: With a win tonight or tomorrow, the Twins will earn their 16th series victory this season and their second in-a-row...Minnesota is 15-20-2 in series play, going 9-7-2 at home and 6-13-0 on the road.

◆Minnesota is seeking its second consecutive series win over Kansas City after taking two of three from them here from May 23-25.

**THE MISSILE:** Kody Clemens went 2-for-5 last night and continues to extend his single-season career-highs in hits (48), runs (29), home runs (13) and RBI (35)...since playing his first game with Minnesota on April 28, he has posted an .812 OPS, tied with Wallner for second-best on the team since that date, trailing Byron Buxton (.958)...his .505 slugging percentage in that span ranks second, trailing Buxton (.585).

**LEFT TURNS:** Tonight marks the 22nd time the Twins have faced a left-handed starter this season...Minnesota is 8-13 against lefty starters...they won their last game vs. a left-handed starter, a 5-4 win on August 3 at Cleveland over Joey Cantillo. 
₱ Twins as a team have an OPS of .809 over their last 19 games against left-handed pitching. 
₱ Ryan Jeffers is hitting .364 (12-for-33) with a .963 OPS in his last 20 games vs. lefties. 
₱ Brooks Lee is hitting .354 (17-for-48) with an .892 OPS in his last 27 games vs. lefties. 
₱ Royce Lewis is hitting .306 (11-for-36) with two home runs, a .556 slugging percentage and an .889 OPS in his last 20 games vs. lefties.

**HEART & HUSTLE**: Byron Buxton is being given his 2025 Heart and Hustle Award in a special pregame ceremony today...the Major League Baseball Players Alumni Association (MLBPAA) recently announced the 30 preliminary winners of the award...this esteemed award honors active players who demonstrate a passion for the game of baseball and best embody the values, spirit and traditions of the game...the Heart and Hustle Award is also the only award in Major League Baseball that is voted on by former players...the Twins winner/nominee is Byron Buxton...the 2025 All-Star and clubhouse leader has played in 85 games this season, slashing .282/.343/.561 (.905 OPS) with 23 home runs, 59 RBI, 68 runs scored and 17 stolen bases (0 caught stealing)...he is currently on the 10-day IL with left ribcage inflammation but is with the club in Detroit...this marks the second time for Buck to win the award, also having done so in 2017 and 2019.

♥ Making 19th start of the season and 107th career start...13th career start against Kansas City. ♥ Made his return to the majors on August 2 at Cleveland after being placed on the 15-day Injured List on July 2 (retroactive to June 29)...did not factor into the decision of Minnesota's 4-5 defeat... allowed four runs on six hits (2 HR), with one walk and four strikeouts in 5.0 innings of work. 

◆ Ober is 0-4 with a 5.37 ERA (57.0 IP, 34 ER), 10 home runs, eight walks and 52 strikeouts in 13

career starts against Kansas City...also has a 1.42 ERA (12.2 IP, 2 ER) in two starts this season.

TAIN'T OBER TIL IT'S OBER: Last pitched on August 2 against Cleveland in his return to the major leagues after being placed on the IL...did not factor into the decision of Minnesota's 4-5 defeat... allowed four runs on six hits (2 HR), with one walk and four strikeouts in 5.0 innings.

♣ Marked his seventh multi-homer game of the season; entered today tied for second-most in the league with Ryan Pepiot (23 starts), Seth Lugo (22 starts) and Zack Littell (22 starts)... most is eight Tyler Anderson (23 starts) and Jake Irvin (24 starts).

♣ Is one of 10 pitchers to have allowed a home run in seven-plus consecutive games this season, and one of three with an active streak (also, Austin Gomber, 7-straight and Brandon Walter, 8-straight).

♣ Has allowed four-plus runs in six-straight starts...had allowed four-plus runs in just five of his previous 32 starts.

REHABBING ACROSS THE RIVER: Made two rehab starts with Triple-A St. Paul...on July 18, faced the Louisville Bats, opposite Chase Petty, but did not factor into the decision of St. Paul's 3-1 victory... allowed four hits with three strikeouts in 4.0 scoreless innings...on July 25, faced the Worcester Red Sox, but did not factor into the decision of St. Paul's 3-5 defeat...allowed one run on two hits (1 HR), with one walk and six strikeouts in 5.0 innings.

© July 18 was his first appearance in Triple-A since September 9, 2023.

A ROYAL PAIN: Ober is 0-4 in 12 career starts against the Royals, posting a 5.37 ERA (57.0 IP, 34 ER) with eight walks and 52 strikeouts...Kansas City is one of two teams he has faced three-plus times and never recorded a win (also the Cincinnati Reds)...his first start against the Royals on June 6, 2021 marked the second game of his rookie season and first on the road.

♣ Last faced Kansas City on May 25 at Target Field, where he did not factor into Minnesota's 1-2 defeat...allowed one run on seven hits, with one walk and three strikeouts in 6.2 quality innings.

♣ Despite his career numbers vs. KC, over his last three starts against the Royals, he has posted a 0.92 ERA (19.2 IP, 2 ER) with two walks, no home runs and 14 strikeouts.

♣ His, 301 (71-for-236) opponent batting average is his highest among opponents he has faced at least three times, and his ERA is his third highest, behind the lexas Rangers (7.32) and Cincinnati Reds (6.23), both of which he has faced four times.

♣ Against the Royals, Ober has allowed career-high hits (71), runs (34) and triples (3), as well as the second highest number of home runs (10)...has allowed the highest batting average among American League opponents (.301).

HOME/ROAD SPLITS: Since 2021, Ober has gone 16-12 with a 4.11 ERA (282.1 IP, 129 ER), 9.05 K/9, 2.23 BB/9 and 1.72 HR/9 in 54 games (53 starts) at home compared to 13-16 with a 4.09 ERA (290.1 IP, 132 ER), 8.74 K/9, 1.74 BB/9 and 1.43 HR/9 in 54 road starts.

◆ Ober is 2-3, 4.89 ERA (49.2 IP, 27 ER) with 12 home runs, 12 walks, 42 strikeouts and a .267 (52-for-195) opponent batting average in nine home starts this season.

LEFT/RIGHT SPLITS: Through 18 starts in 2025, left-handed hitters have slashed .283/.316/.509 in 212 at-bats vs. Ober, while righties have slashed .295/.347/.541 in 183 at-bats...lefties have posted an average exit velocity of 86.8 mph and a whiff rate of 21.0 compared to righties' 92.3 mph and 27.1 percent.

© His hard hit percentage against left-handed batters is at its highest since 2021, 29.8 percent, while his hard hit percentage against right-handed batters is at an all-time high 55.2 percent.

JUNE GLOOM: Bailey allowed 14 home runs in the month of June: tied the most homers allowed by a pitcher in Twins history (1961-) (also 14, Bert Blyleven, May 1986)...Blyleven did so in six games and 43.2 innings, whereas Ober did so in five games and 30.0 innings...also the second most home runs allowed in a single month in American League/National League history, behind only Washington Senators pitcher Pedro Ramos, who allowed 17 in June 1957.

© Marked the first time a Twins pitcher has recorded five losses in a single month since Kevin Slowey went 0-5 in five starts in September 2011, part of an eight-game losing streak.

© Recorded the highest ERA in a single month by any MLB pitcher since Aaron Sele had a 9.30 ERA (0-6) in July 2005.

**THE ARSENAL:** Ober uses a six-pitch mix, per Baseball Savant...throws a 4-seamer 38.0% of the time, the lowest of his career...primarily uses his slider, sweeper and sinker against right-handed batters, while favoring his curveball and changeup against left-handed batters...here is a look at his pitch breakdown:

★ His 7.4 foot extension currently ranks in baseball's 98th percentile...he ranks in the bottom one percentile in breaking run value and bottom two percent in pitching run value.

★ Among pitchers who have thrown at least 200 sliders, Bailey has the third highest opponent batting average (.333) and slugging percentage (.640), ninth highest hard hit percentage (50.0) and 11th lowest strikeout percentage (13.5).
