THE TWINS: Have gone 1-4 through five games on their seven-game, eight-day homestand,
going 1-3 against the Tigers over the weekend, followed by a loss to the Athletics last night
tonight, the Twins will host the A's for the second of three and complete the series tomorrow
afternoonafter tomorrow's game, the Twins will travel to Chicago to begin a three-game weekend series against the White Soxafter that, they will travel to Toronto to play the Blue
weekend series against the White Soxafter that, they will travel to Toronto to play the Blue
Jays for three games from August 25-27.

A's BRING OUT THE TABLES, LADDERS AND CHAIRS: The Twins lost to the A's last night at Target Field by a score of 6-3...Joe Ryan (12-6) was the starter and was issued the loss, allowing five runs (2 earned) on six hits in 4.0 innings pitched...Pierson Ohl pitched 4.0 innings of relief, allowing one run on three hits...the offense recorded six hits, two from Ryan Jeffers, who also homered for the ninth time this season...Brooks Lee hit his 13th home run and extended his hitting streak to six games, including five-straight with an extra-base hit.

A's FOR EFFORT: The Twins and A's are playing the sixth of seven games this season...Twins have gone 3-2 this season, going 3-1 in Sacramento from June 2-5, followed by a loss last night at Target Field.

♣ Twins are 9-3 in their last 12 against the A's, 15-4 in their last 19 and 19-5 in their last 24, dating back to May of 2022.

♣ A win tonight would secure the season series over the A's for the fourth consecutive season... they went 6-1 in 2024, 5-1 in 2023 and 5-1 in 2022.

♣ Byron Buxton is hitting 308 (12-for-39) with three doubles, one triple, one home run, 13 RBI, a .513 slugging percentage and an .846 OPS in his last 11 games against the A's.

♣ Trevor Larnach is hitting .308 (16-for-52) with two doubles, two home runs, seven RBI, four walks and an .819 OPS in 14 career games against the Athletics.

♣ Royce Lewis has hit safely in 12 of 15 career games against the A's...in those 15 he is hitting .302 (16-for-53) with five doubles, four home runs, seven RBI and a .996 OPS.

CALIFORNIA LOVE: The Twins have gone 10-4 against California teams this season, going 3-0 vs. Los Angeles-AL (April 25-27), 3-0 vs. San Francisco (May 9-11), 3-1 against the Athletics (June 2-5), 1-2 at Los Angeles-NL (July 21-24) and 0-1 vs. the Athletics this series...later this season, the Twins will host the Padres (3 G, August 29-31), and play in Anaheim (3 G, September 8-10).

STRICT-LEE BUSINESS: Brooks Lee has hit safely in six-straight games, hitting .273 (6-for-22) with two doubles, one triple, two home runs, eight RBI, two walks, a .727 slugging percentage and a 1.061 OPS in that span...it is tied for second-longest of his career...his career-high is 19, done earlier this season, from May 28-June 20.

◆ Over his last 11 home games, he is hitting .300 (12-for-40) with four home runs, 15 RBI, a .700 slugging percentage and a 1.033 OPS.

SERIES CONVERSATIONS: Twins need wins tonight and tomorrow to win their 17th series of the season...Minnesota is 16-22-2 in series play, going 10-7-2 at home and 6-15-0 on the road.

◆ After winning their four-game series in Sacramento earlier this season, the Twins are seeking two series wins over the A's in the same season for the third consecutive year, going 5-1 in 2024 and 5-1 in 2023.

JEFF YEA: Over his last 31 games, Ryan Jeffers is hitting .339 (38-for-112) with seven doubles, three home runs, 13 RBI, eight walks, a .398 on-base percentage, a .482 slugging percentage and an .881 OPS.

◆ At 91 hits, he needs two to tie his single-season career-high of 93, done last season...at 22 doubles, he needs one to set a new single-season career-high.

TREVOLUTION: Tonight marks Trevor Larnach's 113th game played this season, setting a new single-season career-high (112 in 2024)...
◆ Larnach's home run on August 11 at New York-AL was his 16th of the season, setting a new single-season career-high, passing his previous high of 15 in 2024...also, he also recently set a new career-high in hits and has 96 on the season (92 in 2024)...additionally, he needs one more double to reach 18 and set a career-high (17 in 2024).

THE PLAYERS HAVE CHANGED, BUT THE GAME IS THE SAME: Over their last six games, since August 13, the Twins bullpen has posted a 1.88 ERA (28.2 IP, 6 ER) with no home runs allowed, nine walks, 23 strikeouts and a .170 opponent batting average...since that date, they rank fourth in baseball in ERA and opponent batting average.

TWINS ON A STICK: The Twins today announced details for their presence at the 2025 Minnesota State Fair, with interactive games, giveaways and special appearances all part of the team's daily lineup...the Minnesota Twins Experience is located on the south end of Cooper Street at Judson Avenue, next to the International Bazaar, and is open from 9:00 am-9:00 pm daily, rain or shine, throughout the State Fair's duration (Thursday, August 21 through Monday, September 1).

The National Baseball Hall of Famer Tony Oliva will be on hand at the Experience tomorrow from 10:15-11:00 am.

ON THIS DAY IN TWINS HISTORY: In **1997**, the Twins traded outfielder Roberto Kelly to Seattle for a player to be named later...the deal was finished on October 9, sending Joe Mays to the Twins...Mays eventually became an All-Star in 2001, going 17-13 with a 3.16 ERA in 34 starts...in **1989**, the Twins traded Frank Viola for pitchers Rick Aguilera, David West and Kevin Tapani (plus 2 minor leaguers)...in **2017**, the Twins inducted outfielder Michael Cuddyer into the club's Hall of Fame.

EYE OF THE TIGER: Last pitched on August 14 vs. Detroit, opposite Tarik Skubal; he did not factor into the decision of Minnesota's 3-4, 11-inning defeat...allowed three runs on four hits, with no walks and four strikeouts in 5.1 innings of work...was perfect through 3.2 innings, retiring 11-straight batters before allowing a two-out double to Kerry Carpenter, followed by a home run to Riley Greene.

© Generated 14 total swing and misses for a whiff rate of 30.4 percent, tied for his third most on the season (highest, 18 whiffs, 36.0 percent, May 3 at Boston).

© Became the only pitcher in baseball with 110-or-fewer innings pitched and 24 home runs allowed this season.

A ROYAL PAIN: Pitched on August 9 vs. Kansas City, opposite Noah Cameron...was dealt his seventh loss of the season in Minnesota's 0-2 shutout defeat...allowed one run on four hits, with one walk and four strikeouts in 6.0 quality innings...retired eight-straight batters to start the game before allowing a single to Kyle Isbel...Ober is now 0-5 all-time against Kansas City.

4 Marked his first game with no home runs allowed since May 25, snapping his seven-game streak.

Also marked his first quality start since May 25...was his first loss in a quality start this season, and fifth quality start loss in his career (first since July 10, 2024 at Chicago-AL).

STRAIGHT-A'S: Ober is 3-0 in three career starts against the Athletics...has posted a 1.33 ERA (20.1 IP, 3 ER) with two walks, 26 strikeouts and a .174 (12-for-69) opponent batting average...the Athletics are the only team Bailey has faced at least three times and remains undefeated.

© Last saw the A's at Target Field on June 16, 2024 where he earned the win, allowing one run on six hits (1 HR), with two walks and eight strikeouts...then faced the A's again just six days later on June 22 where he again earned the win, allowing two runs on four hits (2 HR), with no walks and 10 strikeouts in his first career complete game.

© Is his lowest ERA (1.33) against any opponent...also his second lowest opponent batting average (.174) among opponents he has faced at least thee times, behind the Toronto Blue Jays (.167).

HOME/ROAD SPLITS: Since 2021, Ober has gone 16-13 with a 4.08 ERA (293.2 IP, 133 ER), 8.95 K/9, 2.18 BB/9 and 1.69 HR/9 in 56 games (55 starts) at home compared to 13-16 with a 4.09 ERA (290.1 IP, 132 ER), 8.74 K/9, 1.74 BB/9 and 1.43 HR/9 in 54 road starts.

◆ Ober is 2-4, 4.57 ERA (61.0 IP, 31 ER) with 13 home runs, 13 walks, 50 strikeouts and a .254 (60-for-236) opponent batting average in 11 home starts this season.

◆ In two starts against the A's at Target Field, is 2-0 with a 0.79 ERA (11.1 IP, 1 ER), one home run allowed, two walks, 16 strikeouts and a .205 (8-for-39) opponent batting average.

LEFT/RIGHT SPLITS: Through 20 starts in 2025, left-handed hitters have slashed .283/.313/.509 in 230 at-bats vs. Ober, while righties have slashed .277/.327/.505 in 206 at-bats...lefties have posted an average exit velocity of 86.7 mph and a whiff rate of 20.9 compared to righties' 91.6 mph and 26.9 percent.

This hard hit percentage against left-handed batters is at its highest since 2021, 29.7 percent, while his hard hit percentage against right-handed batters is at an all-time high 53.5 percent.

JUNE GLOOM: Bailey allowed 14 home runs in the month of June; tied the most homers allowed by a pitcher in Twins history (1961-) (also 14, Bert Blyleven, May 1986)...Blyleven did so in six games and 43.2 innings, whereas Ober did so in five games and 30.0 innings...also the second most home runs allowed in a single month in American League/National League history, behind only Washington Senators pitcher Pedro Ramos, who allowed 17 in June 1957.

© Marked the first time a Twins pitcher has recorded five losses in a single month since Kevin Slowey went 0-5 in five starts in September 2011, part of an eight-game losing streak.

© Recorded the highest ERA in a single month by any MLB pitcher since Aaron Sele had a 9.30 ERA (0-6) in July 2005.

THE ARSENAL: Ober uses a six-pitch mix, per Baseball Savant...throws a 4-seamer 37.7% of the time, the lowest of his career...primarily uses his slider, sweeper and sinker against right-handed batters, while favoring his curveball and changeup against left-handed batters...here is a look at
