**THE TWINS:** Have gone 1-4 through five games on their seven-game, eight-day homestand, going 1-3 against the Tigers over the weekend, followed by a loss to the Athletics last night... tonight, the Twins will host the A's for the second of three and complete the series tomorrow afternoon...after tomorrow's game, the Twins will travel to Chicago to begin a three-game weekend series against the White Sox...after that, they will travel to Toronto to play the Blue Jays for three games from August 25-27.

**A's BRING OUT THE TABLES, LADDERS AND CHAIRS:** The Twins lost to the A's last night at Target Field by a score of 6-3...Joe Ryan (12-6) was the starter and was issued the loss, allowing five runs (2 earned) on six hits in 4.0 innings pitched...Pierson Ohi pitched 4.0 innings of relief, allowing one run on three hits...the offense recorded six hits, two from Ryan Jeffers, who also homered for the ninth time this season...Brooks Lee hit his 13th home run and extended his hitting streak to six games, including five-straight with an extra-base hit.

**A's FOR EFFORT:** The Twins and A's are playing the sixth of seven games this season...Twins have gone 3-2 this season, going 3-1 in Sacramento from June 2-5, followed by a loss last night at Target Field.

- ☞ Twins are 9-3 in their last 12 against the A's, 15-4 in their last 19 and 19-5 in their last 24, dating back to May of 2022.
- ☞ A win tonight would secure the season series over the A's for the fourth consecutive season...they went 6-1 in 2024, 5-1 in 2023 and 5-1 in 2022.
- ☞ Byron Buxton is hitting .308 (12-for-39) with three doubles, one triple, one home run, 13 RBI, a .513 slugging percentage and an .846 OPS in his last 11 games against the A's.
- ☞ Trevor Larnach is hitting .308 (16-for-52) with two doubles, two home runs, seven RBI, four walks and an .819 OPS in 14 career games against the Athletics.
- ☞ Royce Lewis has hit safely in 12 of 15 career games against the A's...in those 15, he is hitting .302 (16-for-53) with five doubles, four home runs, seven RBI and a .996 OPS.

**CALIFORNIA LOVE:** The Twins have gone 10-4 against California teams this season, going 3-0 vs. Los Angeles-AL (April 25-27), 3-0 vs. San Francisco (May 9-11), 3-1 against the Athletics (June 2-5), 1-2 at Los Angeles-NL (July 21-24) and 0-1 vs. the Athletics this series...later this season, the Twins will host the Padres (3 G, August 29-31), and play in Anaheim (3 G, September 8-10).

**STRICT-LEE BUSINESS:** Brooks Lee has hit safely in six-straight games, hitting .273 (6-for-22) with two doubles, one triple, two home runs, eight RBI, two walks, a .727 slugging percentage and a 1.061 OPS in that span...it is tied for second-longest of his career...his career-high is 19, done earlier this season, from May 28-June 20.

- ☞ Over his last 11 home games, he is hitting .300 (12-for-40) with four home runs, 15 RBI, a .700 slugging percentage and a 1.033 OPS.

**BUCK-TASTIC:** Byron Buxton enters today with 99 hits on the season, one short of reaching 100 for the second time in his career...he hit 117 in 2017, his single-season career-high...additionally, at 25 home runs, he is three short of his single-season career-high of 28, hit in 2022

☞ He enters today with 499 career runs scored, looking to become the 18th player in Twins history (since 1961) to reach 500 runs scored.

☞ One run scored and he will become the third player in Twins history to reach 500+ runs, 150+ home runs, 100+ stolen bases and 400+ RBI...the others being Kirby Puckett and Torii Hunter.

☞ Over his last 44 games, Buxton is hitting .298 (50-for-168) with nine doubles, one triple, 15 home runs, 23 RBI, 36 runs scored, 14 walks, a .357 on-base percentage, a .631 slugging percentage and a .988 OPS.

☞ Buck has a .945 OPS at home this season, eighth-highest in baseball, trailing Aaron Judge (1.119), Shohei Ohtani (1.025), Kyle Schwarber (.993), Zach McKinstry (.977), Will Smith (.968), Junior Caminerio (.965) and George Springer (.964).

**SERIES CONVERSATIONS:** Twins need wins tonight and tomorrow to win their 17th series of the season...Minnesota is 16-22-2 in series play, going 10-7-2 at home and 6-15-0 on the road.

☞ After winning their four-game series in Sacramento earlier this season, the Twins are seeking two series wins over the A's in the same season for the third consecutive year, going 5-1 in 2024 and 5-1 in 2023.

**JEFF YEA:** Over his last 31 games, Ryan Jeffers is hitting .339 (38-for-112) with seven doubles, three home runs, 13 RBI, eight walks, a .398 on-base percentage, a .482 slugging percentage and an .881 OPS.

☞ At 91 hits, he needs two to tie his single-season career-high of 93, done last season...at 22 doubles, he needs one to set a new single-season career-high.

**TREVOLUTION:** Tonight marks Trevor Larnach's 113th game played this season, setting a new single-season career-high (112 in 2024)...

☞ Larnach's home run on August 11 at New York-AL was his 16th of the season, setting a new single-season career-high, passing his previous high of 15 in 2024...also, he also recently set a new career-high in hits and has 96 on the season (92 in 2024)...additionally, he needs one more double to reach 18 and set a career-high (17 in 2024).

**THE PLAYERS HAVE CHANGED, BUT THE GAME IS THE SAME:** Over their last six games, since August 13, the Twins bullpen has posted a 1.88 ERA (28.2 IP, 6 ER) with no home runs allowed, nine walks, 23 strikeouts and a .170 opponent batting average...since that date, they rank fourth in baseball in ERA and opponent batting average.

**TWINS ON A STICK:** The Twins today announced details for their presence at the 2025 Minnesota State Fair, with interactive games, giveaways and special appearances all part of the team's daily lineup...the Minnesota Twins Experience is located on the south end of Cooper Street at Judson Avenue, next to the International Bazaar, and is open from 9:00 am-9:00 pm daily, rain or shine, throughout the State Fair's duration (Thursday, August 21 through Monday, September 1).

☞ National Baseball Hall of Famer Tony Oliva will be on hand at the Experience tomorrow from 10:15-11:00 am.

**ON THIS DAY IN TWINS HISTORY:** In 1997, the Twins traded outfielder Roberto Kelly to Seattle for a player to be named later...the deal was finished on October 9, sending Joe Mays to the Twins...Mays eventually became an All-Star in 2001, going 17-13 with a 3.16 ERA in 34 starts...in 1989, the Twins traded Frank Viola for pitchers Rick Aguilera, David West and Kevin Tapani (plus 2 minor leaguers)...in 2017, the Twins inducted outfielder Michael Cuddyer into the club's Hall of Fame.
