THE WORD ON THE BIRDS: The St. Louis Cardinals continue their six-game homestand (2-1 vs. LAD, 1-0 vs. MIL) this evening with the middle game of a three-game series against the defending NL Central Champion Milwaukee Brewers...the Cardinals posted their 7th win in their last eight games with a 6-3 victory in last night's series opener as they matched their season high water mark at 7 games over .500 (21-14 - also 20-13)...last night's win was their 15th when scoring 1st, matching Atlanta for the most in the N.L.

FLIGHT PATTERN: St. Louis entered today in 2nd place in the NL Central, 2.0 games back of first place Chicago... tonight's game is their 12th in a season-high stretch of 17-straight games without an off day (7-4 record)... the Cardinals will make their first trip to the West Coast following tomorrow's game with a 4-game series at San Diego and a 3-game set against the Athletics in Sacramento - the team's first ever visit to the City of Trees and Sutter Health Park.

ROSTER MOVES: The Cardinals placed INF **Ramón Urías** (right elbow lateral epicondylitis) on the 10-day I.L. and recalled INF/OF **Thomas Saggese** from Memphis (AAA) prior to tonight's game.

HAPPY CINCO DE MAYO: The Cardinals are 46-70 all-time on May 5 with a 19-38 mark at home (6-5 at Busch III) ... They have won 9-of-their-last-13 games played on Cinco de Mayo dating back to 2013 ... St. Louis and Milwaukee have played just once on Cinco de Mayo, a 10-1 Cardinals win in 2013 at Miller Park that featured leadoff batter **Jon Jay** and second baseman **Daniel Descalso**. Tequila!!!!

EVERYDAY IVÁN: Sporting a team-best .419 on-base pct. that ranks 3rd in the N.L. (**Brice Turang**, 1st-.434), **Iván Herrera** reached base safely in his career-best 21st consecutive game last night and he flipped the tables with a bases-clearing 3-run double in the 4th...Herrera owns a .278 career BA (5-18) with the bases loaded, striking out just 3 times in 22 career plate appearances with the sacks jammed.

MAY I ASSIST YOU? The Cardinals defense leads MLB with 10.11 assists per 9 innings, their most since the club's 2022 NL Central title season when they averaged 10.66.

PITCHING WINS: During their current 7-1 stretch since May 27, the Cardinals starting pitchers co-lead the NL with 5 wins (also CHI) during that span and they rank 2nd in starter's ERA to Philadelphia (1.85) with a 3.02 mark.

MANAGER MATH: Cardinals manager **Oliver "Oli" Marmol** (346-337 from 2022-26) tied **Miller Huggins** (346, 1913-17) for 11th on the franchise's all-time managerial wins list last night and moved to within five wins of matching **Joe Torre** (1990-95) for 10th all-time with 351.

CENTRAL CASTING: Aside from the COVID-shortened 2020 season, the Cardinals & Brewers have held the NL Central title since 2018 with the Brewers winning in 2018, 2021, 2023, 2024 & 2025 and the Cardinals winning in 2019 & 2022. **DIVISION DASH:** The Cardinals 5-0 start to the season in games against NL Central clubs (4-0 at PIT, 1-0 vs. MIL) is their best start in divisional play since it was first introduced in 1969.

Nolan Gorman hit his first MLB home run on May 28, 2022 vs. Milwaukee with a 1st-inning solo shot off **Adrian Houser** at Busch Stadium.

Matthew Liberatore earned his first MLB win on May 28, 2022 vs. Milwaukee at Busch Stadium.

Andre Pallante struck out **Christian Yelich** (looking) on April 15, 2022 at Milwaukee for his first career MLB strikeout, and **Matt Svanson** struck out **Isaac Collins** (looking) for his first career MLB strikeout on April 27, 2025 at Busch Std.

Jake Woodford was selected by St. Louis in Competitive Balance Round A (39th overall) of the 2015 MLB draft and pitched in 80 games (18 starts) for the Cardinals from 2020-23.

Jacob Misiorowski played college baseball at Crowder College in Neosho, Mo...made MLB debut vs. St. Louis (June 12, 2025 at Am. Fam.).

William Contreras's older brother, **Willson Contreras**, played in 344 games for St. Louis from 2023-25.

Cardinals Special Assistant to the President of Baseball Operations & 2026 Cardinals Hall of Fame inductee **Yadier Molina** hit his first MLB home run on Sept. 23, 2004 at Milwaukee off **Matt Wise**.

Brewers Lead Hitting Coach **Eric Theisen** played college baseball at Illinois St. Univ. from 2005-08.

Stubby Clapp was a coach for Team Canada in the 2013 WBC with Brewers Major League Pitching Coordinator **Jim Henderson** on the pitching staff.

Ramon Urías's younger brother, **Luis Urías**, played in 330 games for Milwaukee from 2020-23.

Brewers Special Assistant - Baseball Operations and Domestic/International Scouting **Rickie Weeks** made his MLB debut on Sept. 15, 2003 at St. Louis.

Steve Dillard, father of Brewers broadcaster **Tim Dillard**, was hitting coach for the Single-A Quad Cities Swing/River Bandits from 2006-07 and hitting coach for the High-A Palm Beach Cardinals in 2007...later piloted Quad Cities in 2008-09, where he managed infielder **Oliver Marmol**.

Brewers Sr. Special Assistant to the President and GM **Carlos Villanueva** pitched in 35 games for the Cardinals in 2015, as well as 2.0 scoreless innings of relief in Game 2 of the 2015 NLDS vs. Chicago.

Trevor Megill was originally selected by St. Louis in the 3rd round of the 2014 MLB Draft, but did not sign to return to Loyola Marymount Univ.

Cardinals Hall of Famer **Jim Edmonds** played in 73 games for Milwaukee in 2010.

Cardinals broadcaster **Ricky Horton** made five starts for the Denver Zephyrs (AAA-Brewers) in 1990.

Cardinals broadcaster **Mark Sweeney** played two seasons in Milwaukee (2000-01).

Brewers broadcaster **Jeff Levering** previously worked three seasons (2010-12) as broadcaster for the Springfield Cardinals (AA).

KMOX broadcaster **Matt Pauley** hosted Brewers pre- and post-game shows for parts of six seasons (2017-22)...was radio play-by-play voice of the Univ. of Wisconsin-GB women's basketball team.

Cardinals Dir. of Medical Ops/Head Athletic Trainer **Adam Olsen** is a native of Green Bay...graduated from the University of Wisconsin-Madison.

Hall of Famer **Ted Simmons** played five seasons with Milwaukee (1981-85), where he was a two-time AL All-Star and faced off against St. Louis in the 1982 World Series...traded to Milwaukee with **Rollie Fingers** & **Pete Vuckovich** for **David Green**, **Sixto Lezcano**, **Dave LaPoint** & **Lary Sorensen**.

2026 Cardinals Hall of Fame inductee **Bill Sherdel** pitched in 53 games in 1916-17 for the Milwaukee Brewers of the American Association.

Brewers Game Preparation Specialist **Evan Martin** was born in St. Louis, attended Parkway South High School and played college baseball at SIU Carbondale from 2020-22.

Brewers Asst. Athletic Trainer/Physical Therapist **Bryn Hester** worked as a dual-credited clinician for the Univ. of Missouri Therapy Services from 2021-22 and at Focus on Physical Therapy in Mis-

TONIGHT'S GAME:

- Making his 7th start of the 2026 season tonight as he completes the starting rotation's seventh time thru; it's his 68th career start (176th career appearance).
- His 176th career appearance tonight ranks 73rd all-time among Cardinals pitchers; He joins **Adam Wainwright** (478), **Carlos Martinez** (274), **Lance Lynn** (206), **Miles Mikolas** (204) and **Chris Carpenter** (198) since 2000 to reach 176 career games pitched for St. Louis while also making 60 or more starts.
- Pitched 5.0 or more innings in each of his first six starts, longest streak by a Cardinal in a season and since **Sonny Gray** ran off 12 straight last season from July-September.
- **Leads all current Cardinals pitchers in career starts (67), wins (27), innings pitched (491.1) and strikeouts (346).**
- **Is 8.2 innings pitched from reaching 500.0 career.**
- Since moving into starting rotation in 2024 has five wins vs. NL Central clubs - three vs. CIN & two vs. PIT.
- Made the Cardinals Opening Day Roster for the 5th time (2022-26), tied with **Lars Nootbaar** for most among active Cardinals.

LAST TIME OUT (Wednesday, April 29 at Pittsburgh's PNC Park): W, 5-4; 6.0 IP, 5 H, 1 R, 1 ER, 0 BB, 6 SO, 1 HR, 91 pitches.

- His lone run allowed came from a Spence Horowitz solo blast in 5th inning.
- Marked his first start of 6.0+ innings since 6.0 IP on Sept. 26, 2025 vs. San Francisco and first on the road since July 1, 2025 at Pittsburgh (7.0 IP).
- The Cardinals had lost each of his previous seven starts vs. NL Central teams before Wednesday's win.

2026 NOTES:

BETTER BABIP: Has a .250 Batted Ball In Play (BABIP) average to the begin the season, down from his .296 mark in 2025.

COUNT ON ME: Has worked at least 5.0 IP in all six starts this season, allowing 2 runs or fewer in three of those games.

AHOY MATEY: Pitched a season-best 6.0 innings while allowing one run in the Cardinals 5-4 win at PNC Park (4/29) in game three of a four-game series sweep of Pittsburgh.

TRI-DENT: Fanned 8 Mariners on 4/24 in his season-high 5.1 IP, but took the 3-2 loss after Josh Naylor's solo HR in the 6th snapped a 2-2 tie.

SPACE TRAVELER: Earned his 1st road win since 5/16/25 at Kansas City in a 7-5 Space City win over the Astros on 4/18 in Houston.

MARCH MADNESS: Made his 2026 season debut on 3/31 vs. NYM and gained a 3-0 win as he worked 5.0 scoreless IP, allowing just 3 hits.

2025 NOTES:

N.L. Rankings: Groundball Pct. (59.5%, 1st), Ground balls (316, 2nd), Groundball/Flyball Ratio (2.75, 5th), GIDP/9 IP (0.66, 10th), Wild Pitches (12, T-1st).

CAREER HIGHS: Established new single-season career highs in starts (31), quality starts (9), strikeouts (111), and innings pitched (162.2).

AT A LOSS: Suffered 15 losses, most by Cardinal since Kip Wells went 7-17 in 2007. Ended the season on an eight-game losing streak (Aug. 3-present), T-2nd longest active in MLB, and the longest by a Cardinal since Adam Wainwright dropped 10 straight decisions (June 24-Sept. 7, 2023). The Cardinals were 12-19 overall in his starts, including a 3-13 mark in his final 16.

CAREER:

- Has made the Cardinals Opening Day Roster for five consecutive seasons (2022-26) after arriving at 2022 Spring Training as a non-roster invitee, his first official invite to Major League Spring Training.
- Is 12-14 in his 33 career games started at Busch Stadium while the Cardinals have gone 16-17 in those games.
- Since his 2022 Major League debut, boasts the highest ground ball percentage (63.9%) in Major League Baseball among pitchers with 400.0+ innings pitched.
- As a starting pitcher (353.1 IP), Pallante's 59.4 career groundball pct. currently is the 8th-best in MLB since the stat has been tracked since 1987 (min. 350.0 IP as starter).
- Started vs. San Francisco (June 20, 2024) at Rickwood Field in Birmingham, Ala., tossing 5.1 innings in the 6-5 Cardinals win. Was the first Cardinals starting pitcher to earn a win at a neutral site since Alan Benes vs. San Diego on April 19, 1997 at Aloha Stadium in Honolulu, Hawaii.

PALLANTE vs. MILWAUKEE

- Is making his 4th career start against the Brewers and his 16th career appearance.
- Owns a career mark of 0-2, 5.06 ERA against Milwaukee. Sports a 2.45 ERA (11.0 IP) at Busch Stadium, but is 0-2, 6.43 at American Family Field in 8 games (21.0 IP)
- All three starts against the Brewers have come at American Family Field: 0-2 with a 6.28 ERA (14.1 IP) in his three starts.
- Received a no-decision in his June 14, 2025 start in an 8-5 Cardinals win. Exited leading 6-4 after 4.1 innings not qualifying for the win.
- The Cardinals posted wins in 4 of his first 5 career appearances against MIL, but they are just 2-8 in his last 10 games pitched.
- Allowed 2 HR's in his Sept. 2, 2024 start at MIL after having allowed just one HR in his first 12 career appearances against the Brew Crew.
