THE TWINS: Have gone 3-3 through six games on their nine-game homestand, going 2-1 vs. Miami last week, followed by a 1-2 series loss to Milwaukee over the weekend...today, Minnesota will continue the homestand with the first of three against the Astros...they will wrap the series and homestand on Wednesday afternoon.

☞ Twins have gone 5-3 over their last eight games...since May 3, they have gone 8-8 after going 3-13 in a 16-game stretch from April 15-May 2.

OBER, THE BIG CHEESE: The Twins beat the Brewers yesterday afternoon at Target Field by a score of 5-4, avoiding the three-game sweep...Bailey Ober (5-2) was the starter and winner, allowing three runs on six hits in 5.0 innings pitched, with two walks and one strikeout...two of his three home runs allowed came on solo home runs from Christian Yelich and Garrett Mitchell...the number three, four and five hitters in the lineup (Jeffers, Clemens and Keaschall) had all six of the Twins hits, combining to go 6-for-10 with three RBI...Jeffers reached three times, going 2-for-3 with a walk, two runs scored and one RBI.

☞ The attendance for the finale was announced at 25,375, giving the Twins 82,799 over the weekend series...marked the highest attended series at Target Field this season.

SPACEBALLS: The Twins and Astros are playing the first of six games in 2026...Minnesota will travel to Houston for a three-game series from June 29-July 1.

☞ Twins went 1-5 against Houston last season, going 1-2 at Target Field from April 3-6 and 0-3 at Daikin Park from June 13-15.

☞ Twins have lost four-straight to the Astros, it marks their longest losing streak to Houston since dropping six-straight during the 2022 season.

☞ Brooks Lee is hitting .458 (11-for-24) with one double, three home runs, seven RBI and a 1.333 OPS in six career games vs. Houston...he has hit safely in all six.

☞ Byron Buxton is hitting .333 (10-for-30) with two doubles, one home run, four RBI, a .394 on-base percentage, a .500 slugging percentage and an .894 OPS in his last eight games against the Astros...he has reached base safely in all eight.

☞ Victor Caratini played two seasons with Houston from 2024-25, playing in 201 games...he set a single-season career-high in home runs last season with 12.

PITCH PERFECT: Over their last nine games, since May 8, the Twins staff has posted a 2.52 ERA (82.0 IP, 23 ER) with a .207 opponent batting average...since that date, they rank sixth in baseball in both ERA and opponent batting average.

☞ Over their last nine games, Twins starters have gone 3-3, 2.44 ERA (48.0 IP, 13 ER) with 15 walks, 40 strikeouts and a .186 opponent batting average.

☞ Over their last seven games, Twins relievers have gone 2-1, 2.32 ERA (31.0 IP, 8 ER) with 19 walks, 26 strikeouts and a .227 opponent batting average.

E-LUKE-TRIC FEEL: Luke Keaschall went 2-for-3 with a walk yesterday vs. Milwaukee and now has 38 hits on the season, good for third-most on the team, trailing Buxton (44) and Lee (39)...he has reached safely in 12 of 14 games this month, posting a .429 on-base percentage in those games...below are his March/April (31 games) and May (14 games) comparisons:

A-MARVELOUS: Austin Martin is leading off for the fifth-straight game tonight (typically Buxton)...Martin is hitting .313 (36-for-115) with a .437 on-base percentage on the season...among players with a minimum of 130 plate appearances, Martin's on-base percentage leads baseball, while his batting average ranks 11th.

☞ He has posted a BB/K ratio of 1.10 (23 BB/21 K), eighth-best in the AL and 11th-best in baseball.

☞ His 14.8 strikeout percentage leads the team and is the 14th-lowest in the AL.

THE ROCKET MISSILE: Kody Clemens went 2-for-4 with two doubles and two RBI yesterday vs. Milwaukee...the two doubles gave him 10 on the season, marking the second-straight season he has reached double-digit double totals (career-high 12 in 2025).

☞ He enters tonight with a six-game hitting streak, hitting .478 (11-for-23) with six doubles, one home run, three RBI, a .500 on-base percentage, an .870 slugging percentage and a 1.370 OPS in that span.

☞ His career-high for a hitting streak is eight, done May 16-27, 2025.

AMERICA'S NEXT TOP JEFF: Over his last 16 games, since April 23, Ryan Jeffers is hitting .309 (17-for-55) with four doubles, four home runs, 13 RBI, 12 runs scored, 11 walks, a .418 on-base percentage, a .600 slugging percentage and a 1.018 OPS...since that date, his OPS ranks seventh in the AL (min. 60 PA) and his slugging percentage ranks eighth.

OH JEEZ, SURE, YOU BET: Twins have scored 125 runs at home this season, fourth-most in baseball, trailing Pittsburgh (140), New York-AL (131) and Milwaukee (130).

☞ They have a +11 run differential at home (124-113).

☞ Through 26 games in 2025, the Twins had scored 115 runs at home.

GAMES BY JAMES: James Outman is hitting .296 (8-for-27) with a .321 on-base percentage, a .481 slugging percentage and an .803 OPS over his last 10 games with an at-bat...he began the season 0-for-his-first-18 through April 18...he has reached base safely five times over his last 13 plate appearances since Thursday.

BRAD AND BOJEE: Taj Bradley made his first rehab start last yesterday with Triple-A St. Paul, allowing one run on two hits in 1.2 innings pitched, with two walks and three strikeouts, throwing 42 pitches.

McD's, I'M LOVIN' IT: Low-A Fort Myers outfielder Quinn McDaniel has been named Florida State League Player of the Week...the 23-year-old played in six games for the Mighty Mussels, hitting .538 (14-for-26) with one double, two triples, two home runs, eight RBI, a .519 on-base percentage, a .962 slugging percentage and a 1.481 OPS...the Portsmouth, NH native was signed by the Twins as a free agent on May 11.

- ⚔ Kendry Rojas will make his first career MLB start (fourth appearance) in today's series opener against the Astros.
- ⚔ In his last appearance on May 14 vs. Miami, Rojas pitched 2.0 innings in relief of Zebby Matthews, allowing one run on one hit, with two walks and two strikeouts.
- ⚔ Rojas is currently ranked as the No. 10 prospect in the Twins organization according to MLB.com and the fourth-best pitching prospect; is ranked as the eighth-best prospect in Twins system according to *Baseball America*.

LAST TIME OUT: In his last outing, Kendry gave up one run on one hit, with two walks and three strikeouts in the eighth and ninth innings after relieving Zebby Matthews on May 14 vs. Miami...the one hit allowed was a MLB low for hits allowed in an outing for Rojas...the appearance was his first at Target Field, after making his two previous big-league appearances on the road at New York-NL on April 22 and in Cleveland on May 10.

TWO OUTINGS AGO: On May 10 in Cleveland, Rojas pitched 3.1 innings for the Twins as part of a bullpen game; allowed one run on five hits with three walks and five strikeouts while throwing a major league career-high 60 pitches, 34 of them for strikes (56.7%)...earned his first MLB win, exiting the game in the fifth inning with one out and a 5-2 Twins lead; Minnesota would go on to win 5-4 and secure their first series win over Cleveland since September 4-6, 2023.

⚔ **WITH THE WIN:** By securing the win, Kendry became the fourth Twins rookie to earn their first MLB victory this season, joining Garrett Acton (4/9 vs. Detroit), Connor Prielipp (4/27 vs. Seattle) and Andrew Morris (5/3 vs. Toronto).

1st CAREER MLB START: Kendry will make his first major league start tonight against the Astros...here are how some other Twins starters have fared in their first MLB starts:

GET TO KNOW KENDRY: Kendry Rojas was born in Ciego de Avila, Cuba on November 26, 2002...signed by Toronto as an international free agent on October 14, 2020...spent 2021-July 31, 2025 working his way up the Toronto farm system (FCL Blue Jays to Triple-A Buffalo)...in his Toronto minor league career, had a 10-14 record with a 3.32 ERA (252.2 IP, 93 ER), 83 walks and 298 strikeouts.

⚔ **CHANGE OF SCENERY:** Acquired by Minnesota via trade on July 31, 2025 along with outfielder Alan Roden, in exchange for infielder Ty France and right-handed pitcher Louis Varland...reported to Triple-A St. Paul and made eight starts in the Saints rotation to finish season; went 1-2 with a 6.59 ERA (27.1 IP, 20 ER), 23 walks, 28 strikeouts and a .314 (37-for-118) BAA in those eight games...was one of the 30 youngest pitchers to have appeared in a game in the International League in 2025 (22 years old in 2025 season).

HOME/ROAD SPLITS (MAJORS): Of his three major league outings so far, Kendry has made one appearance at home, going 0-0 with a 4.50 ERA (2.0 IP, 1 ER), two walks and three strikeouts; in two road appearances is 1-0 with a 1.69 ERA (5.1 IP, 1 ER), six walks and five strikeouts.

⚔ **SPLITS IN THE MINORS:** Rojas has made two home appearances with St. Paul and three road appearances (one start) this season; at home is 0-0 with a 2.70 ERA (6.2 IP, 2 ER), three walks and five strikeouts and on the road is 1-0 with a 2.16 ERA (8.1 IP, 2 ER), two walks and 10 strikeouts.

LEFT-RIGHT SPLITS (MAJORS): Rojas has faced 34 total batters through his first three outings, with lefties slashing .222/.533/.222 (2-for-9) with zero extra-base hits, six walks and five strikeouts, while righties are slashing .353/.421/.471 (6-for-17) with two doubles, two walks and three strikeouts.

⚔ **SPLITS IN THE MINORS:** Through five appearances with St. Paul this season, lefties are slashing .000/.167/.000 (0-for-10) off Rojas with one walk and four strikeouts, while righties are slashing .304/.360/.391 (14-for-46) with one double, one homer, six RBI, four walks and 11 strikeouts...in his minor league career, lefties are slashing .215/.283/.312 (60-for-279) with 10 doubles, one triple, five home runs, 22 RBI, 18 walks and 82 strikeouts, while righties are slashing .246/.322/.373 (208-for-844) with 50 doubles, three triples, 17 home runs, 96 RBI, 92 walks and 261 strikeouts; if you combine both sides of the plate, Rojas has a career minor league BAA of .239 (268-for-1123).

THE ARSENAL: In his major league debut Rojas displayed a three-pitch arsenal...here are some details on that arsenal, per Baseball Savant:

⚔ **A NOTE ON THE HEATER:** Kendry's .222 (2-for-9) BAA on his 4-Seam Fastball currently ranks fifth on the Twins staff, while his .177 xBA on the heater ranks third, trailing Garrett Acton - .080 and Cody Laweryson - .150 (min. PA 10 and min. pitches 50)

⚔ **A NEW ADDITION TO THE ARSENAL (SINKER):** In his last two outings, Kendry has added a sinker to his arsenal after not throwing the pitch in his first MLB outing or any of his minor league outings this season...so far he has thrown the pitch in four plate appearances, with hitters going 0-for-2 on it with two strikeouts.

TOMORROW'S STARTER - ZEBBY MATTHEWS (2026: 1-0, 0.00 ERA // CAREER: 7-10, 5.59 ERA)

Zebby Matthews will start the middle game of the three game series against the Houston Astros tomorrow night...the start will be Zebby's second MLB start of the year and seventh overall of the 2026 season (six starts for Triple-A St. Paul); it will also be his first career start against the Astros...in his last start on May 14 vs. Miami, Matthews earned the win, pitching 7.0 scoreless innings, allowing four hits, while walking one and striking out five in a series-clinching 9-1 Twins win...the start marked the longest scoreless outing of Zebby's MLB career and the 7.0 innings pitched matched his career high (done twice before: May 30, 2025 at Seattle and September 23, 2025 at Texas).

CAREER NOTES

- In 2026, Rojas made his MLB debut on April 22 in relief against the New York Mets; he entered in the fifth inning and worked 2.0 scoreless innings, giving up two hits and walking three...relieved Connor Prielipp, who made his MLB debut that same night; was the first time the Twins had two pitchers debut on the same day since April 7, 1999 (three that day).
- Currently ranked as the 10th-best prospect in the Twins organization according to MLB.com and the fourth-best pitching prospect.
- Spent 2026 spring training with major league club, optioned to Triple-A St. Paul on March 9; on March 27, he was placed on 7-day injured list with a right hamstring strain...made one rehab start with Fort Myers on April 4 and was activated by St. Paul on April 11.
- Ranked eighth-best prospect in Twins minor league system by *Baseball America* entering 2026.
