HERE'S THE STORY: The D-backs are 5-3 in their last 8 games vs. Reds and 10-7 in their last 17 games (since 2024).

- The D-backs' .667 win pct. (22-11) vs. opposing lefty starters ranks second in MLB, behind the Brewers (.684, 26-12).
- The D-backs have won 4 of their last 6 rubber games (vs. STL, vs. ATH, @ PIT, vs. LAD) and are 12-8 overall.
- **Corbin Carroll** has reached base safely in 11 straight games, batting .359 (14-for-39)/1.208 OPS with 4 doubles, 2 triples, 2 homers, 3 RBI, 8 walks (4 K) and 2 stolen bases.
- **Gabriel Moreno** has a career-best 15-game hitting streak, MLB's longest active streak, batting .359 (23-for-64)/1.022 OPS with 9 doubles, 1 triple, 2 home runs, 14 RBI and 4 walks.
- **Mitch Bratt** will face off vs. Reds for the first time in his career in his ninth career bid.
 - In his last 4 starts (@ CLE, vs. SD, vs. COL, @ BOS), is 1-1 with a 2.57 ERA (6 ER in 21.0 IP), opponent .171 AVG (12-for-70), 11 walks and 15 strikeouts.

- LAST GAME:** The D-backs lost 11-5 vs. Reds last night.
- **Nolan Arenado** (21) and **Tim Tawa** (8) homered in the fourth and sixth inning, respectively.
 - **Tim Tawa** (2-for-5, HR, 2 RBI) had his second consecutive multi-hit game.
 - **Lars Nootbaar** (2-for-5, 2B, RBI) and **Corbin Carroll** (2-for-5) each had 2 hits.
 - **Michael Soroka** took his fourth loss (6 ER in 3.1 IP, 3 BB, 3 K).

WILD CARD RACE: The D-backs are fourth in the NL Wild Card race, 2.0 games behind the Padres (WC3, season tied 5-5), 4.0 games behind the Phillies (WC2, lead season 2-1) and 6.0 games behind the Cubs (WC1).

WINS SINCE JULY 9: The D-backs' 23 wins (23-15) since July 9 are tied for third in the Majors with the Brewers and Yankees, behind the Red Sox (28) and Padres (24).

TAWA'S TREND: **Tim Tawa** has reached base safely in a career-high 8 straight games, hitting .323 (10-for-31)/.963 OPS with 2 doubles, 2 homers, 6 RBI and 3 walks.

MORENO'S HOME STREAK: **Gabriel Moreno's** career-best 31-game home on-base streak is tied for the second longest single-season home streak in club history with Steve Finley's 31 in 2000, behind Stephen Drew's 38 in 2009.

MORENO'S HITTING STREAK: **Gabriel Moreno's** 15-game hitting streak is the second longest by a D-backs catcher (primary position as catcher w/ plate appearances as designated hitter and pinch hitter):

HITTING LEFTIES: The D-backs offense vs. lefties ranks among all teams in August in doubles (1st, 19), AVG (1st, .301), OBP (2nd, .378), OPS (2nd, .865), times on base (2nd, 98), SLG (3rd, .487), P/PA (3rd, 4.21), hits (3rd, 68).

BATS VS. LHP: **Corbin Carroll**, in his last 9 games vs. lefties, is hitting .389 (7-for-18)/1.319 OPS with 2 doubles, 1 triple, 1 homer, 1 RBI and 5 walks (3 K).

- **Geraldo Perdomo**, in his last 8 games vs. lefties, is hitting .350 (7-for-20)/.909 OPS with 3 doubles, 1 RBI and 2 walks.
- **James McCann**, in his last 14 games vs. lefties, is hitting .438 (7-for-16)/1.026 OPS with 1 double, 2 RBI and 3 walks.
- **Ryan Waldschmidt**, in his last 23 games vs. lefties, is hitting .360 (9-for-25)/.928 OPS with 3 doubles, 2 RBI and 4 walks (3 K).

VS. STARTING PITCHERS: The D-backs offense vs. starting pitchers ranks among NL teams since Aug. 10 in OPS (1st, .856), AVG (2nd, .286), SLG (2nd, .508), fewest strikeouts (2nd, 39), OBP (3rd, .348), XBH (3rd, 24), runs (T-3rd, 32) and TB (4th, 94).

WALDY'S WORLD: **Ryan Waldschmidt** has hit safely in 4 straight games (8 times on base) and reached base safely in 11 of his last 13 games (19 times on base) with a .380 OBP, 2 doubles, 1 homer, 6 RBI and 8 walks.

- Among MLB rookies (min. 200 PA), his .279 AVG ranks fifth, behind TJ Rumfield/COL (.288), Wade Meckler/LAA (.288), Chase DeLauter/CLE (.284) and Kevin McGonigle/DET (.281).

DAY-GAME GABI: **Gabriel Moreno**, in 34 day games, is hitting .310 (35-for-113)/.971 OPS with 9 doubles, 7 homers, 23 RBI and 15 walks.

- Has reached base safely in 12 of his last 13 day games, hitting .327 (16-for-49)/1.029 OPS with 6 doubles, 3 homers, 15 RBI and 7 walks.

VS. REDS: The D-backs won 2 of 3 games @ Reds from June 12-14.
