**TODAY, WE ALL WEAR #42:** Tonight, the legacy of Jackie Robinson will be honored and celebrated league-wide...as is tradition, players, managers and coaches will wear Robinson's iconic number, with all teams using Dodger blue "42" jersey numbers (regardless of their primary team colors).

- The D-backs will proudly host their annual Jackie Robinson Day on April 22 at Chase Field and welcome special guests and community groups who embody Jackie's spirit of resilience, courage, and leadership to uplift Black voices and stories.
- Pregame recognitions will include the Boys and Girls Club Youth of the Year and JR42 Jr. RBI Outreach Clinic, the National Anthem and Lift Every Voice and Sing performed by The Pilgrim Rest Baptist Church, a ceremonial first pitch from Gizette Knight of Shining Light Foundation and NASCAR Track President, Latasha Causey will serve as the team's Honorary Captain for the day.

**LAST GAME:** The D-backs won 5-2 vs. Brewers on Sunday afternoon in comeback fashion after plating 5 unanswered runs from the fifth to the eighth inning to secure their second straight series win and third in their last 4.

- Josh Naylor** delivered the go-ahead RBI base hit in the seventh before **Alek Thomas** extended the lead with a 2-run, 2-out single in the eighth.
- Zac Gallen** (ND; 2 ER in 6.0 IP, 5 K) tossed his second quality start in his last 3 bids.
- Corbin Carroll** (2-for-4, 2B, BB) logged his second straight multi-hit performance.

**FACING THE FISH:** Since 2022, the D-backs are 7-2 @ Marlins (11-7 overall)...they have won 4 consecutive matchups in Miami (April 16, 2023 and Aug. 19-21, 2024).

- Jupiter, Florida native **Pavin Smith**, in his last 9 games vs. Marlins, is hitting .316 (6-for-19)/.440 OBP with 1 double, 4 RBI and 5 walks.
- Alek Thomas**, in his last 7 games vs. Marlins, is hitting .316 (6-for-19) with 1 double, 1 homer and 5 RBI.

**ANSWERBACKS:** The D-backs' 4 comeback wins this season after trailing by 2+ runs in the fifth inning or later are the most in the Majors, ahead of the Giants (3).

- April 13 vs. Brewers: trailed 2-0 into the fifth
- April 12 vs. Brewers: trailed 4-0 into the ninth
- April 1 @ Yankees: trailed 4-0 into the eighth
- March 30 vs. Cubs: trailed 3-0 into the sixth

**LATE RUN SUPPORT:** The D-backs' 38 runs scored in the seventh inning or later are the most in the Majors, ahead of the Cubs (33), Cardinals (30) and Phillies (27).

### LONGEST ACTIVE CONSECUTIVE PA WITHOUT A STRIKEOUT:

**Geraldo Perdomo/AZ ..... 43 PA (since 4/3)**

Luis Matos/SF .....23 PA (since 9/11/24)

Jacob Young/WSH.....23 PA (since 3/31)

**SNAKES AMONG MLB LEADERS: Corbin Carroll** ranks among MLB leaders in SLG (2nd, .698) extra-base hits (T-2nd, 12), total bases (T-3rd, 44), OPS (4th, 1.123) and home runs (T-9th, 5).

- Geraldo Perdomo** ranks in walks (T-5th, 13) and OBP (7th, .448).
- Alek Thomas** ranks in triples (T-1st, 2).

**PERDOMO WALKS THE WALK: Geraldo Perdomo's** 5-game walk streak is the second longest active streak, behind Carson Kelly/CHC (7), while his 5-game streak of reaching base 2+ times is the second longest active streak, behind Aaron Judge/NYY (7).

- With 10 walks in his last 5 games, Perdomo looks to become the fourth D-back all-time with 11+ walks in a 6-game span to join Paul Goldschmidt (8x, last 2016), Adam Dunn (2008) and Luis Gonzalez (2002).

**CARROLL'S ON-BASE STREAK: Corbin Carroll's** 16-game on-base streak to start the season is the longest by a D-back since David Peralta (16 G from 3/29-4/20/2018)...only 3 D-backs have recorded on-base streaks of 17+ games: Gerardo Parra (17 G from 5/13-6/1/2009), Orlando Hudson (33 G from 4/2-5/6/2007) and Luis Gonzalez (franchise record 35 G from 4/5-5/18, 1999).

- Dating back to Sept. 23, 2024, Carroll has reached base in a career-high 22 straight games (surpassing his 21 from July 7-Aug. 4, 2024)...is the longest active streak in the span with Kyle Schwarber/PHI.
- Entering today, 4 players in the Majors have reached base in 16+ straight games to start their respective seasons: Kristian Campbell/BOS (17 G), **Corbin Carroll** (16 G), Fernando Tatis Jr./SD (16 G) and Kyle Schwarber/PHI (16 G).

**CARROLL WATCH CONTINUES:** Over his last 9 games, since April 4, **Corbin Carroll** has 9 extra-base hits (4 doubles, 1 triple, 4 homers)...in the span, is slashing .417 AVG/.488 OBP/.917 SLG/1.404 OPS...his 1.404 OPS and 33 total bases are the most in MLB in the span while his 9 extra-base hits are tied for the most with Jung Hoo Lee/SF.

**NOTHING SNEAKY ABOUT THIS POWER: Corbin Carroll's** 25 homers since July 7, 2024 rank tied for fifth in MLB with Brent Rooker/ATH, behind Aaron Judge/NYY (32), Shohei Ohtani/LAD (31), **Eugenio Suárez**/AZ (29) and Kyle Schwarber/PHI (27).

**STARTING PITCHER RHYTHM:** D-backs starting arms' 5 consecutive quality bids is the longest active streak of its kind in the Majors, ahead of the Phillies (4) and Reds (4): **Merrill Kelly** (W) on April 8 vs. Orioles, **Brandon Pfaadt** (W) on April 9 vs. Orioles, **Eduardo Rodriguez** (L) on April 11 vs. Brewers, **Corbin Burnes** (ND) on April 12 vs. Brewers and **Zac Gallen** (ND) on April 13 vs. Brewers.

- It is the first time the D-backs have accomplished the feat since July 3-12, 2018.
- Arizona's last string of 6+ consecutive quality starts was from Sept. 9-16, 2017 (8 straight).

### NEXT STARTER: RHP BRANDON PFAADT (2-1, 3.50)

- Will make his fourth start...made his last start on April 9 vs. Orioles (W; 0 ER in 6.0 IP, 4 H, 3 K).
- Will make his third career start vs. Miami...won his last start on Aug. 19, 2024 @ Marlins (W; 4 ER in 5.1 IP).

**AT A GLANCE:** Seventh season with the D-backs.  
 • Has posted 3 seasons of 12+ wins (2023, '22, '19).  
 • Entered the season ranked sixth on the D-backs' all-time wins list (53) and seventh in strikeouts (744).

**WHAT YOU NEED TO KNOW:** Fourth start of the season, second road start.  
 • Earned his 55th win as a D-back on April 8 vs. Orioles, tying Zack Greinke for fifth on the franchise's all-time wins list, behind Randy Johnson (118), Brandon Webb (87), Curt Schilling (58) and Patrick Corbin (56).  
 • In search of his first career win against the Marlins.

**LAST START:** On April 8 vs. Orioles, posted his first quality start of the season (W; 2 ER in 6.0 IP, 3 H, 4 K) to improve to 2-0 @ home.

**VS. MARLINS:** Fifth career start vs. Marlins.  
 • Made his last start vs. Marlins on May 10, 2024 (ND; 4 ER in 6.0 IP, 6 K)...made his lone start @ Marlins on July 29, 2019 (L; 7 ER in 6.0 IP).  
 • Has tossed 5.0+ innings and allowed 2 or fewer walks in each start.

**VS. NL EAST:** In his last 7 starts (4 quality), is 3-1 with a 3.98 ERA (19 ER in 43.0 IP), .184 opponent AVG, 17 walks and 48 strikeouts.  
 • Has tossed 6.0+ innings, allowed 3 or fewer runs and struck out 7+ batters in 5 of his last 7 starts.

**CLIMBING THE FRANCHISE LIST:** His 751 career strikeouts rank seventh on the club's all-time strikeouts list, behind Randy Johnson (2,077), Brandon Webb (1,065), Robbie Ray (998), Patrick Corbin (897), Curt Schilling (875) and Zac Gallen (866).  
 • Recorded his 750th strikeout on April 8 vs. Orioles (G. Henderson), becoming just the seventh D-back to reach 750+ strikeouts (also: Randy Johnson/2,077, Brandon Webb/1,065, Robbie Ray/998, Patrick Corbin/897, Curt Schilling/875 and Zac Gallen/866).

**PICKOFF PROWESS:** Since 2022, his 9 pickoffs are fifth among NL starting pitchers, behind Taijuan Walker (15), Patrick Corbin (13), Charlie Morton (11) and David Peterson/NYM (10).

**BREAKING BALL RUN VALUE:** His breaking ball run value of 2 ranks in the 91st percentile in MLB.  
 • On his curve, is holding opponents to .000 AVG and 15.4% whiff (36 pitches) and, on his slider, a .143 AVG and 42.9% whiff (25 pitches).

**LIMITING LEADOFF:** Holding hitters leading off an inning to a .133 AVG (2-for-15)/.502 OPS with 2 walks and 3 strikeouts.

**1-2, GOT YOU:** Hitters 1-2 are batting .083 AVG (1-for-12)/.556 OPS with 6 strikeouts.  
 • His .083 AVG is tied with Erick Fedde/STL for ninth among starting pitchers and fourth among NL starting pitchers.

**2024 RECAP:** Went 5-1 with a 4.17 ERA (38 R-36 ER in 77.2 IP) and 65 strikeouts over 13 starts in his sixth season with the D-backs.  
 • Placed on the 15-day injured list (right shoulder strain) on April 23... transferred to the 60-day injured list on May 2...reinstated from the 60-day injured list (right shoulder strain) on Aug. 11.  
 • Since Aug. 11, his 13.86 strikes looking above average (SLAA) and his 111.5 pct. strikes looking rate vs. Average (SL+) were the highest among NL starters.  
 • For the first time in his career, threw 6 different pitches 10+ times each.  
 • Held opponents to 2 or fewer runs with runners in scoring position in 9 of his 13 starts (.217 AVG; 13-for-60).

**CONSECUTIVE 5.0+-INNING STREAK:** His 38 consecutive starts of 5.0+ innings from April 6, 2023-Sept. 5, 2024 marked the second longest streak in the Majors since 2022, behind only Mitch Keller (49 straight starts; April 5, 2023-July 8, 2024).

**POSTSEASON WARRIOR:** In Game 2 of the World Series @ Rangers on Oct. 28, 2023, became the fourth D-backs pitcher (5 times overall) to allow 1 run or fewer over 7.0+ innings in a World Series start (also: Randy Johnson, Curt Schilling [2x] and Miguel Batista...additionally, his 9 strikeouts tied Schilling for second-most strikeouts in a World Series game by a D-backs starter behind Johnson's 11 strikeouts.  
 • Also retired the first 11 batters, surpassing the record for most consecutive batters retired by a D-backs pitcher to start a World Series game (prev: 10 by Randy Johnson on Oct. 28, 2001 in Game 2 vs. Yankees) [Elias Sports Bureau].

**USA! USA!** Selected to pitch for Team USA in the 2023 World Baseball Classic, marking the first time participating with a national team at any level.  
 • Went 0-1 with an 8.31 ERA (4 ER in 4.1 IP) over 2 games.  
 • Started the fourth game vs. Colombia and championship vs. Japan.

*"Growing up I never played with any of the youth USA teams, so the fact that in this point in my career I got the opportunity is special. Being able to represent the country and be a part of that roster of guys is special. Seeing that USA jersey with my name on it's a little bigger than just the big leagues."*

**ARIZONA KID:** Grew up in Scottsdale, Ariz., and attended Desert Mountain High School, Yavapai College and Arizona State University... attended Arizona State University (2010) and helped the Sun Devils reach the College World Series in 2010...went to Yavapai College in Prescott, Ariz. (2008-09) and went 15-1 in 2 seasons.

**HOW HE STARTED:** Rays' eighth-round pick in the 2010 draft.  
 • Played 5 seasons in the Rays' system (2010-14).  
 • Played 4 seasons (2015-18) with the SK Wyverns in the Korean Baseball Organization (KBO).

- ◆ Struck out the side in the eighth inning during his season debut on March 28 vs. Cubs (0 ER in 2.0 IP, 3 K).
- ◆ In 2024, appeared in 51 games with the Tigers, going 6-8 with 2 saves, a 4.53 ERA (28 ER in 55.2 IP) and 49 strikeouts.
