NATIONALS HISTORY
APRIL 10 (10-7)
2014 - For the second time in as many days, a **Jayson Werth** home run proved to be the difference between Washington and Miami. His two-run shot in the third inning off **Tom Koehler** propelled the Nationals to an eventual 7-1 victory over the Marlins. **Stephen Strasburg** fanned 12 batters in 6.2 innings of work.

ON THE ROAD AGAIN

The Washington Nationals open a three-game series against the Milwaukee Brewers on Friday night...Tonight's matchup marks the start of a seven-game road trip that opens against the Brewers this weekend before moving on to Pittsburgh to face the Pirates, Monday to Thursday.

- Tonight's game also begins a stretch of 17 games for the Nationals without a day off...Washington's next off day is April 27 in New York.

GOOD WOOD

James Wood is 7-for-15 (.467) with three homers, seven RBI, four walks, just two strikeouts, one stolen base and seven runs scored over his last four games...He homered in three consecutive games for the first time in his career from April 5-7...Seven of his 11 hits this year have gone for extra bases (3 2B, 4 HR).

- Wood laced a 116.0 MPH single on Wednesday, his hardest-hit ball of the season and the fifth-hardest hit ball in MLB this season.
- Thanks to this recent surge, he ranks among National League hitters in runs scored (T2nd, 11), home runs (T3rd, 4), extra-base hits (T5th, 7) and total bases (10th, 26).
- Since the start of last season, his 13 home runs against left-handed pitching ranks third among left-handed batters, trailing **Kyle Schwarber** (23) and **Shohei Ohtani** (15).

PRETTY OFFENSIVE

The Nationals have scored 71 runs, the second-most by any Nationals club in team history (2005-pres.), behind the 2019 Nationals who scored 77 runs through the first 12 contests.

- Washington has scored 13 runs in the first inning, the most in Major League Baseball.

A FOR ABRAMS

CJ Abrams has reached base safely in 10 of 11 games this season and hit safely in eight of his last nine...He is 11-for-35 (.314) with four homers, 12 RBI, six walks, four stolen bases and eight runs scored during the nine-game stretch.

- Abrams has improved his walk rate this season...He has a 12.2% BB (6 BB in 49 PA) in 2026, compared to a 5.8% BB (37 BB in 635 PA) in 2025.

DAYLEN'S DAYS

Daylen Lile's 14 hits are tied for 10th-most in the National League...He has hit safely in nine of the first 12 games and has reached safely in 10 of the 12.

- Since June 21, 2025, he ranks fourth among all hitters with a .315 batting average.
- The reigning National League Player and Rookie of the Month, Lile paced the National League in OPS (1.212), slugging percentage (.772), batting average (.391) and triples (7) during September 2025.

OUR HOUSE

Brady House leads the Nationals and is tied for fourth in the National League with five multi-hit games this season.

- House has hit safely in six of 10 starts, going 13-for-43 (.303) with three doubles, two homers, five RBI, four walks, seven runs scored, a .362 on-base percentage and a .512 slugging percentage in those 10 starts.
- He has four walks in 48 plate appearances (8.3% BB) through 12 games...He had eight walks in 274 plate appearances (2.9% BB) in 73 games in 2025.

HITTERISH

Joey Wiemer, who was acquired off waivers in the offseason after he was designated for assignment twice, is 11-for-25 (.440) with a triple, two homers, four RBI, five walks and eight runs through his first eight games of the season.

- Wiemer reached base in each of his first 10 plate appearances to start the season to match **Carlos Delgado** in 2002 for reaching in the most consecutive plate appearances to start a season since 1920, per *Elias Sports Bureau*...He fell just two plate appearances shy of the Nationals record for most consecutive plate appearances reaching base safely overall: 12 by **Juan Soto** from Sept. 21-24, 2021.

BLAKE BUTERA

Blake Butera was named Washington's eighth field manager on October 31, 2025 after spending the previous two seasons as the senior director of player development for the Tampa Bay Rays...He served as the Rays' Minor League field coordinator in 2023 following four seasons (2018-19, 2021-22) as a manager in their Minor League system.

- At Single-A Charleston, Butera was named Carolina League Manager of the Year in 2021 and 2022, won the Carolina League championship both seasons and the 2022 club was named Minor League Team of the Year by *Baseball America*.
- He began his coaching career with the Rays organization in 2017 as the bench coach for Single-A Hudson Valley and was promoted to manager in 2018, becoming the youngest manager in all of Minor League Baseball at the age of 25.

CAREER

Tall right-hander from the University of Oklahoma developed into a reliable member of Washington's starting rotation and a leader in the clubhouse.

- Ranks tied for second in Major League Baseball with 68 starts since the start of the 2024 season behind only San Francisco's **Logan Webb** (70 GS)...His 376.2 innings pitched since 2024 are seventh most.
- After making 33 starts in 2024 and 2025, he joined **Max Scherzer** (2015-16) as the only two pitchers in Nationals history to start at least 33 games in back-to-back seasons.
- Had the "Best Control" in Washington's system, per *Baseball America*, entering the 2023 season.

LAST START

Irvin allowed six earned runs on eight hits in 4.0 innings of work on April 4 vs. Los Angeles (NL).

VS. MILWAUKEE

Irvin is 0-5 with a 6.59 ERA (21 ER/28.2 IP) with 22 strikeouts in six career starts against the Brewers.

- He faced them twice in 2025, posting a 5.00 ERA (5 ER/9.0 IP) in those two starts.

2026 SPRING TRAINING

Made four Spring Training starts, going 2-0 with a 1.35 ERA (2 ER/13.1 IP) and a team-high 15 strikeouts...Three of his four outings were scoreless with both of his two runs scoring in his March 12 start at Houston.

2025

Was tied for second in Major League Baseball with 33 starts and ninth in the National League with 180.0 innings pitched.

- Matched a career high with 8.0 shutout innings against San Francisco on May 24...The game was completed in 1 hour, 52 minutes, tied for third fastest game in Nationals history (2005-pres.)...Irvin has pitched in two of the top six fastest games in Nationals history.
- Tossed 7.1 innings on April 25 vs. New York (NL)...Allowed one earned run on five hits with four strikeouts and one walk.
- Worked 7.0 innings or more in four starts this season...He went 3-0 in those games.
- Went 6-5 in games he completed 6.0 innings...Pitched to a 4.32 ERA in those 16 games.
- The Nationals 15 wins in his starts were the most for any Nationals starter.
- **2025 Pitch Mix:** Four-Seam (32.2%) Curve (29.6%) Sinker (21.9%) Change (7.7%) Slider (4.4%) Cutter (4.1%)

2024

In first full Major League season, his 33 starts were tied for the most in MLB...Led Washington and ranked fifth in the National League with 187.2 innings pitched.

- Also led the Nationals and ranked 10th in the National League with a 1.20 WHIP...Tied MacKenzie Gore for the team lead with 10 wins.
- Led Major League pitchers with six defensive runs saved, according to FanGraphs.com and Sports Info Solutions.
- Started strong, ranking fourth in the National League with a 2.80 ERA in 18 starts through July 4...Also ranked fourth in the National League in opponents' on-base percentage (.263) over this stretch.
- Led the National League and ranked second in MLB with a 1.65 ERA (9 ER/49.0 IP) and a .181 opponents' average from May 28-July 4.
- Capped that stretch with a career-high 8.0 innings of one-hit, shutout ball on July 4 vs. New York (NL).
- Tossed 7.1 strong innings on Sept. 16 at New York (NL)...Allowed one earned run on four hits with five strikeouts and one walk.
- Went 2-0 with a 1.16 ERA (3 ER/23.1 IP) in four starts against Atlanta...Did not allow an earned run in 16.0 consecutive innings spanning the first three starts against them...Allowed his first run in the fifth inning of the third contest, August 14 at Atlanta.
- Tossed at least 6.0 innings and allowed one walk or fewer in 14 starts, tied for third-most among National League pitchers.
- **2024 Pitch Mix:** Four-Seam (37.9%) Curveball (31.3%) Sinker (20.5%) Cutter (6.5%) Changeup (3.5%) Slider (0.3%)
