**THE TWINS:** Completed their six-game homestand with a record of 2-4, going 1-2 vs. the Blue Jays and 1-2 vs. the Rangers...tonight, the Twins will begin a six-game, seven-day roadtrip with the first of three in Houston at Daikin Park through the weekend...they will continue the trip next week with an off-day in Cincinnati on Monday, followed by three games against the Reds at Great American Ball Park from Tuesday-Thursday.  
🔞 Twins are 29-17 in their last 46 games since April 22, tied with New York-NL (29-17) for the second most wins in baseball since that date, and trailing only Detroit (31-16).

**RANGER DANGER:** The Twins lost to the Rangers yesterday afternoon at Target Field by a score of 16-3, allowing 16 runs for the second time in the series...it also marked the largest margin of defeat for the Twins in 2025...Bailey Ober (4-3) was the starter and was issued the loss, allowing seven runs on six hits with three strikeouts, while setting single game career-highs with six walks and four home runs...the offense recorded eight hits, two from Willi Castro, who singled and hit his 10th double of the season, while driving in one run.

**IF YOU'RE GONNA PLAY IN TEXAS:** Austin native Chris Paddack began the season going 0-1, 14.73 ERA (7.1 IP, 12 ER), with three home runs allowed, six walks, four strikeouts and a .394 (13-for-33) opponent batting average...in his last 11 starts, since April 12, he has gone 2-4, 2.25 ERA (64.0 IP, 16 ER) with six home runs allowed, 16 walks, 48 strikeouts and a .197(45-for-229) opponent batting average...below are his AL ranks since April 12:

**BLASTOFF:** The Twins and Astros are playing the fourth of six games in 2025...the Twins hosted the Astros to open Target Field from April 3-6, winning the middle of the three games.  
🔞 Minnesota won its last series here from May 31-June 2, 2024, winning two of three...they have won each of their last two series in this ballpark.  
🔞 After going 0-6 against the Astros in 2022, the Twins have gone 9-6 in regular season games vs. Houston since the start of 2023.  
🔞 Byron Buxton is hitting .375 (9-for-24) with two doubles, one home run, four RBI, a .423 on-base percentage, a .583 slugging percentage and a 1.006 OPS in his last six games against the Astros.  
🔞 In 379 career regular season games at Daikin Park, Carlos Correa is hitting .275 (377-for-1370) with 76 doubles, 64 home runs, 236 RBI, 204 runs scored and an .837 OPS...on this ballpark's all-time list, he ranks seventh in RBI, tied for seventh in runs scored, 10th in doubles, home runs and hits, and 11th in games...since leaving Houston, Correa is just 9-for-59 (.153) against his former team, with three extra-base hits (2 doubles, 1 home run), four walks and 16 strikeouts in 16 regular season games.  
🔞 Ty France is hitting .332 (86-for-259) with 12 doubles, nine home runs, 29 RBI, a .397 on-base percentage and an .879 OPS in 71 career games against the Astros...86 hits are his most against any opponent...71 games are also his most.  
🔞 Matt Wallner is hitting .438 (7-for-16) with a 1.125 OPS in five career regular season games against the Astros.

**FROM PARIS WITH LOVE:** Ty France has reached base safely in a career-high 23-straight games...it marks the longest for a lwin this season and longest since Edouard Julien reached in 23-straight from September 6, 2023-March 30, 2024...the last in a *single season* was Byron Buxton with 24, from April 25-May 24, 2023...France's streak is the fourth-longest active streak in baseball, trailing José Ramírez (37), Vinnie Pasquantino (27) and Ketel Marte (24)  
🔞 During the streak, France is hitting .322 (28-for-87) with three doubles, one home run, 15 RBI, seven HBP and a .385 on-base percentage.

**SEEING IS BE-LEE-VING:** Brooks Lee has hit safely in 12-straight games with an at-bat, extending his career-high...the streak is the longest by a Twin this season and tied with Vinnie Pasquantino for the longest active streak in baseball...Minnesota's last streak as long was from Kyle Farmer, who hit in 13-straight, from September 3-22, 2024.  
🔞 During the current streak, Lee is hitting .327 (16-for-49) with two doubles, one home run and seven RBI.

**THE BUCK TRUCK HITS THE ROAD:** Over his last 18 road games, since April 19, Byron Buxton is hitting .329 (25-for-76) with two doubles, one triple, three home runs, 16 RBI , a .500 slugging percentage and an .869 OPS...Buck's .329 road average since that date ranks 14th in the AL (minimum of 75 plate appearances).  
🔞 Over his last seven road games, since May 15, he has driven in 11 runs.

**YOU WIN SOME, YOU LEWIS SOME:** Royce Lewis has hit safely in six of his last eight games, since June 3...over that span, he is hitting .375 (9-for-24) with two doubles, five RBI, five walks, a .483 on-base percentage, a .458 slugging percentage and a .941 OPS...since that date, he has posted a 17.2 walk percentage, which ranks ninth in the AL among players with at least 20 plate appearances...among that same criteria, he has a BB/K ratio of 1.25, 13th-best in the AL.

**LEFT-HANDED COMPLIMENTS:** Tonight marks the 11th time the Twins have faced a left-handed starter this season...Minnesota is 5-5 against lefty starters, their five losses against Martín Pérez (3/31 at CWS), Cole Ragans (4/8 at KC), Chris Sale (4/19 at ATL), Kris Bubic (5/25 vs. KC) and Patrick Corbin (yesterday)...their five wins coming against Yusei Kikuchi (4/26 vs. LAA), Garrett Crochet (May 4 at BOS), Cade Povich (5/6 vs. BAL), Logan Allen (5/19 vs. CLE) and Noah Cameron (5/23 vs. KC).  
🔞 In their last 37 games, Twins are slashing .260/.342/.397 (.739 OPS) against lefties...prior to that stretch, they were .157/.222/.289 (.511 OPS) in their first 20 vs. lefties.  
🔞 Notable individuals in that 37-game stretch (since April 19) vs. LHP: Willi Castro is hitting .364 (12-for-33)...Byron Buxton is hitting .400 (10-for-25)...Carlos Correa is hitting .324 (11-for-34) with four home runs and 10 RBI.  
🔞 In 2025, Correa is hitting .317 (13-for-41) with three doubles, four home runs, a .683 slugging percentage and a 1.032 OPS vs. lefties...his OPS ranks seventh in the AL (minimum of 40 at-bats).

**THE WORLDWIDE LEADER:** ESPN yesterday announced that the Twins-Tigers game on June 29 at Comerica Park will be broadcast on ESPN Sunday Night Baseball with first pitch at 6 pm (CT)...Sunday Night Baseball Presented by Capital One is available live on ESPN, ESPN Radio, ESPN Deportes and the ESPN App. Baseball Tonight: Sunday Night Countdown precedes Sunday Night Baseball with a one-hour pregame show, starting at 6 pm on ESPN.  
🔞 Last time the Twins were on Sunday Night Baseball was September 20, 2020 at Wrigley Field, a 4-0 Twins win in a José Berrios vs Yu Darvish matchup.

**ON THIS DAY IN TWINS HISTORY:** In 2006, Jason Kubel hit a walk-off grand slam against the Red Sox as Johan Santana struck out 13 batters, including the 1,000th K of his career, fanning David Ortiz...in 2017, the Twins set a franchise record with 28 hits in a 20-7 victory over Seattle at Target Field.
