PITTSBURGH PIRATES (1-4) AT TAMPA BAY RAYS (3-1)

April 1, 2025 - George M. Steinbrenner Field - Tampa, FL - 7:05 EDT - Game #6/Road #6
RHP Thomas Harrington (Major League Debut) vs. RHP Shane Baz (4-3, 3.06 ERA in 2024)

THE PIRATES: fell for the third time in a row and fourth time in five games to open the season with their loss last night...Earned their first win of 2025 with a 4-3 victory Friday night...Opened the season on the road for the ninth straight year and the 10th time in 11 years...Finished 2024 with a 76-86 record (fifth place in the N.L. Central)...Won 15 games in their last at-bat last season (most since having 16 in 2021)...Played in 51 one-run games in 2024, their most since 2018 (also 51).

SHOW TIME: The Pirates today selected the contract of right-handed pitcher Thomas Harrington (#78), who will make his MLB debut tonight, to the 26-man active roster...Catcher Jason Delay was designated for assignment to make room for Harrington on the 40-man roster, while right-handed pitcher David Bednar was optioned to Triple-A Indianapolis to make room on the 26-man roster...Harrington, who enters today rated No. 73 among Baseball America's top-100 prospects (No. 78 by MLB Pipeline), ranked second among all Pirates minor leaguers in WHIP (0.96), fourth in ERA (2.61) and strikeouts (115) and fifth in batting average against (.220) in 2024 after pitching in 22 games (21 starts) between Low-A Bradenton (rehab), Double-A Altoona and Indianapolis.

LET'S GO REYNOLDS: The next game for Bryan Reynolds will be the 800th of his big-league career...Since making his Major League debut on April 20, 2019, Reynolds ranks sixth in all of Major League Baseball among switch hitters in home runs (122), fifth in RBI (413), fourth in batting average (.276) and OBP (.351), sixth in slugging (.468) and third in OPS (.819).

IKF: Isiah Kiner-Falefa is 5-for-13 (.385) while hitting safely in each of his last four games since going hitless on Opening Day (he has hit out of the ninth spot of the lineup in each of the first five games)...Since the beginning of last season, Kiner-Falefa is batting .341 (15-for-44) with a .420 on-base percentage in 16 games out of the ninth spot...Pittsburgh's .333 average out of the ninth spot is tied for the fourth-best in MLB (Tampa Bay is tied for the second-best average at .364).

TAKE A WALK: The Pirates have walked 25 times in their first five games of 2025 (third-most in MLB behind the Cubs with 33 and Dodgers with 27), but did not draw any free passes Monday at Tampa Bay...Oneil Cruz is tied for fourth in MLB with six walks (four came on Saturday in Miami).

SPEED AND DISCIPLINE: Oneil Cruz leads Major League Baseball with five steals and is pacing the Pirates with six walks through the first five games of 2025...He's one of four Major Leaguers since 1901 with five-plus stolen bases and six-plus walks through his team's first five games of a campaign, along with Rickey Henderson (1982), Joe Morgan (1976) and Davey Lopes (1975).

I'VE BEEN EVERYWHERE: When Andrew McCutchen appears in a game here at George M. Steinbrenner Field, it will be the 37th stadium he's played at least one game in since making his MLB debut in 2009, per the Elias Sports Bureau...Out of the 30 active stadiums, the only ones he hasn't played at besides Steinbrenner are Globe Life Field (Rangers) and Sutter Health Park (Athletics)...He's also played in games at eight stadiums not currently in use by a Major League team (Globe Life Park, Hubert H. Humphrey Metrodome, Oakland Coliseum, Sahlen Field, Sun Life Stadium, TD Ballpark, Tropicana Field and Turner Field)...McCutchen appeared in one game at Historic Bowman Field in Williamsport, PA, when Pittsburgh was in the 2017 Little League Classic.

CUTCH: Andrew McCutchen collected the 800th extra-base hit of his Major League career with his home run leading off the second inning Sunday at Miami...His 611 extra-base hits with Pittsburgh rank fifth in Pirates history, while his 800 Major League extra-base hits are third-most among all active players...McCutchen is also just three RBI shy of 1100 for his Major League career, and he ranks fifth among active players on that list (LAD's Freddie Freeman leads with 1236, while NYY's Giancarlo Stanton is six RBI ahead of McCutchen with 1103)...McCutchen is also tied with Arky Vaughan for 10th on the Pirates' all-time runs list (936)...Tommy Leach ranks ninth (1009).

ON THE BASES: With steals from Oneil Cruz and Isiah Kiner-Falefa on Monday at Tampa Bay, Pittsburgh has swiped 17 bases through its first five games of the season...The 17 steals are tied for the Pirates' most through five games in a season since at least 1900, per the Elias Sports Bureau, matching the 1907 club...The 17 steals are also tied for fourth-most by any MLB team through its first five games of a season since at least 1900, per Elias (1903 New York Giants & 1915 New York Yankees lead with 20 SB each).

ON THIS DATE IN PIRATES HISTORY

April 1, 2021: Ke'Bryan Hayes hit a two-run homer in the first inning that set the stage for Pittsburgh's 5-3 win over the Cubs at Wrigley Field on Opening Day. Hayes became the second Pirates rookie to homer in a season opener, the first since Johnny Ray in 1982. Pittsburgh's pitching staff limited Chicago to only two hits, tied with the 1903 club for its fewest allowed on Opening Day.

HOW ACQUIRED: Selected in Comp. Balance A round (No. 36) of the 2022 Draft.

STARTING OFF: The 23-year-old righty will make his Major League debut tonight, becoming the first Pirates pitcher to make his Major League debut as a starter since Paul Skenes on May 11, 2024...Harrington was selected 36th overall by the Pirates with their Competitive Balance A round selection in the 2022 First-Year Player Draft.

FEELING THE DRAFT: Harrington is the first member of Pittsburgh's 2022 draft class to reach Major League Baseball...The Pirates selected Termarr Johnson in the first round (No. 4 overall)...Pittsburgh also selected Hunter Barco, who is currently rated by MLB Pipeline as Pittsburgh's No. 7 prospect, in the second round...The club selected infielder Jack Brannigan in the third round of that draft...Brannigan enters 2025 rated by Baseball America as having the "Best Infield Arm" in Pittsburgh's minor league system.

ABOUT THIS SPRING: Harrington allowed six runs in 9.2 innings across four outings (two starts) this spring after attending as a non-roster invitee (reassigned to minor league camp on 3/24)...He last pitched on 3/24 in Fort Myers against Minnesota, allowing four runs and five hits while striking out two Twins batters over 3.0 innings.

2024 IN REVIEW: Harrington attended big-league camp for the first time in his career in 2024 as a non-roster invitee...He began the regular season on the injured list at Double-A Altoona with a rotator cuff strain...Harrington's final stop of 2024 came with Triple-A Indianapolis, when he was promoted there on August 4...He went 7-3 with a 2.61 ERA, 115 strikeouts, 19 walks and a 0.96 WHIP in 22 total games (21 starts)...From August 17 through the end of the season, his five wins were tied for most in all of Minor League Baseball, while his 2.52 ERA ranked fifth in the International League.

PROSPECT RANKINGS: Harrington entered the 2025 season rated as Pittsburgh's No. 3 prospect according to Baseball America, who also tabbed him as having the "Best Control" in the organization...Harrington was rated as Pittsburgh's sixth-best prospect in 2024 by Baseball America, and No. 10 by the outlet heading into the 2023 season.

A FIRST FROM CAMPBELL: Harrington became the first player the Pirates ever selected out of Campbell (NC) University...Other players from Campbell include Hall of Famers Gaylord Perry and Jim Perry, as well as current Orioles outfielder Cedric Mullins and Angels infielder Zach Neto...When he was drafted, Harrington became the second-highest pick in Campbell and Big South Conference history, trailing only Neto, his teammate who was selected No. 13 overall in that same draft...In 2022, he became the first player in school history to be named to the Golden Spikes Award watch list.

MEET THE MAN: Harrington grew up not far from Tobacco Road in Sanford, NC (southwest of Raleigh/Durham), and follows Duke men's basketball closely...He grew up a St. Louis Cardinals fan and listed his favorite player as Albert Pujols...He also admired Max Scherzer when he began pitching more seriously...He is a scratch golfer.
