## STAY INFORMED

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RAY REPORT-The Rays continue their final homestand before the All-Star break against the Yankees (2-1) and Guardians (1-0, 2 to play, today at Tropicana Field....despite with the Mets for third best in the majors, trailing the Astros (17-4/810) and Red Sox club history and two shy of the full-season club record set in 2017 (22)...have not been more than five games below or three games above .500 ...are in fourth place in the AL East for the 24th consecutive day, but their 10.0-game deficit in the division marks their smallest since entering play on May 24 ( 9.5 GB )...in order to enter the All-Star break with a winning record for a franchise-record seventh consecutive season (excl. 2020), Tampa Bay must sweep this series..since 2008, the club has held a winning record at the break
in 13 of 15 seasons $(2016,2014)$..the Rays have the hardest remaining schedule in the majors with a combined opponent winning pct. of .531 (Elias)

The Rays collected their fourth shutout in last night's $2-0$ win and second in their last inve home games (also June 30 vs. WSH)...it ties the third-fewest shutouts in the All-Star break since 2017 (3)...Tampa Bay had nine shutouts by last season's break. RHP Taj Bradiey (W, 7.0IP, 5H, OR, 2BB, 8SO) turned in the longest scoreless start seven starts since June 8, outpacing PIT Paul Skenes (1.14)
Tampa Bay's rotation has turned in a 2.93 ERA (92.OIP, 30ER) since June 23, third lowest in the majors behind Kansas City (2.82) and New York-NL (2.89)...Rays starters have allowed two runs or fewer in 13 of 17 games during that timeframe. The Rays were held to 1 -for- 16 (.063) with RISP last night and are an MLB-worst -for-61(.131) with RISP in their last six games since July 5...that stretch includes a
pair of 0 -for-10 performances (July 5 at TEX \& July 10 vs. NYY).
Tampa Bay has pitched to a 2.00 ERA (36.OIP, 8ER) in its last four contests since yielding a season-high 13 runs on July 7 at Texas...it marks the club's best ERA over a four-game span since May 4-7 (1.95).
The Rays are $8-3$ in their last home games on the heels of a $5-14$ stretch.
Evan Longoria, the Rays all-time leader in games played (1,435), RBI (892), extra-
base hits(618), runs (780), walks(569), total bases ( 2,630 ) and OPS $(824)$, is scheduled to throw today's ceremonial first pitch.
SERIES-LY SPEAKING-With a win today or tomorrow, Tampa Bay can claim its seventh series win in its last eight tries...it would also mark the club's fifth straight series win at home, its longest single-season streak since a six-series run from Aug. 11-Sept. 10, 2023.1 the Rays have won 12 of 13 series in which they claimed the opener, including 11 straight
since the lone loss from April 29-May 1 at Milwaukee...they are 4-11-2 when dropping the series-opening contest.

The Rays have never won seven of their final eight series heading into the AllStar break...they came closest in 2013, when they won six of eight (Elias).
SEE THE FUTURE-Two Rays prospects will participate in today's MLB Futures Game at 4:10 p.m. ET in Arlington, Texas: INF Xavier Isaac (Rays No. 3/MLB No. 31 prospect current Rays who have represented Tampa Bay in the Futures Game include Tai Bradley (2022) and Shane Baz (2021)...Manuel Rodríguez (CHC, 2021), Isaac Paredes (DET, 2019), Randy Arozarena (STL, 2018), Amed Rosario (NYM, 2016-17) and Yandy Díaz (CLE, 2016) have all bean selected to Futures Games with different organizations.

INF Tre Morgan was named one of eight participants in the inaugural Futures Skills Showcase...the showcase features three rounds and will air on MLB Network on tape delay tomorrow morning at 10:00 a.m. ET.
BLAST OFF-Yandy Díaz's 154 hard-hit balls ( $95+\mathrm{mph}$ ) are tied for third most in the AL behind TOR Vladimir Guerrero Jr. (165) and KC Bobby Witt Jr. (156)...with 14 games remaining in July, it marks the most hard-hit balls before the calendar flips to August by a Ray in the Statcast era (since 2015), surpassing his own mark of 152 from last season...Diaz has combined for nine...he has accomplished this while notching a career-low 12.3 pct. whiff rate, third lowest in MLB behind CLE Steven Kwan (6.3\%) and SD Luis Arraez (8.4\%) After matching a six-game hitting streak....he also has a 10-game on-base streak.
WALK THE WALK-Isaac Paredes has walked in six of his last 12 PA and has drawn a free pass in four straight and nine of his last 12 games since June 29, tallying an MLB leading 14 walks in that span...no other player has more than 10...paredes is drawing walks at a 26.4 pct.clip during the 12 -game run, boosting his season-long walk rate from 9.6 pct. to a career-best 11.9 pct

RUNNIN' RAYS-Since July 1, the Rays are 12-for-14 (85.7\%) on stolen base attempts, the second-most thefts in the AL behind the Athletics (13)...they have recorded at least one SB apiece this month-Lowe has an AL-leading 6 SB in his last 14 games since June 23 on the season, Tampa Bay's 93 SB pace the AL, ahead of the Red Sox (88SB), and rank fifth in the majors...the club is looking to lead the AL in steals at the All-Star break for the second consecutive season (111SB in 2023).

Despite going 13 games since his last stolen base, tied for the longest drought of his career (also May 22-June 7, 2023), José Caballero still leads the AL with 24 SB, besting BOS David Hamilton (23SB)...Caballero could join Carl Crawford (2009, 2004) as the only Rays to lead the AL in steals at the All-Star break.

Rays catchers have collected an AL-most 4 CS this month, throwing out four of (10-for-84), tied with the Cardinals for the lowest mark in the majors. (10-for-84), tied with the Cardinals for the lowest mark in the majors.
HOMER (UN)HAPPY-The Rays have yielded the most home runs before the All-Star home run differential is second worst in the majors ahead of only the Blue Jays - 44 (12884), but they have out-homered opponents, 30-27 ( +3 ), over their last 23 games.

CLOSE SHAVES-The Rays own the majors' best record in games decided by two runs or fewer at 33-15(.088)...their 17-9 (.654) mark in one-run games ranks second behind the Red Sox (11-5/.688)...Tampa Bay is $14-4$ at home ingames decided by two runs or fewer, including
wins in six of seven and eight of their last 10 contests...they are 14-32 (.304) overall in games wins in six of seven and eight of their last 10 contests...they are 14-32.(304) overall in gam
with a margin of 3+ runs, better than only the White Sox (12-39/.235) among AL clubs.
EN GARDE!-The Rays and Guardians continue a seven-game season series today at Tropicana Field...Tampa Bay will visit Progressive Field from Sept. 12-15...the clubs split of which were walk-offs...Tampa Bay is 6-8 in the last 14 meetings on the heels of an 11game winning streak from May 19, 2019-July 24, 2021...the Rays are seeking their first season series win over the Guardians since winning three straight from 2018-21 (clubs did not meet in 2020), having gone 3-3 last year and 2-4 in 2022 .

Brandon Lowe is 11-for-32 (.344) with 3 XBH and 4 RBI in his last nine games
against Cleveland dating to July 30, 2022.
The Rays have won five of their last six games against AL Central opponents after
starting the season 4-9.

TODAY'S START-The right-hander will take the mound for his teamleading 19th start of the season and 10th at home...has worked 5.0+innings in all nine of his starts at Tropicana Field, posting a 3.57 ERA (53.0IP, 21ER)... has thrown 5.0+ IP in 15 of 18 starts...has a 7.29 ERA (21.0IP, 17ER) in his last five starts...is looking for his first home win since May 11 vs. NYY.
LAST TIME OUT-Suffered the loss on July 7 at Texas...tossed 4.0 innings, allowing a season-high seven runs on nine hits and one walk with five strikeouts...the 7 ER were the second most allowed of his career (8ER, May 30, 2019 at TB)...was tagged for a two-out RBI-double by Wyatt Langford in the opening frame...allowed the six other runs in the 4th, capped by a two-out, three-run homer by Corey Seager...joined Shawn Armstrong (June 29 vs. WSH) as the only Rays to allow six earned runs in an inning this season.

CLEVELAND ROCKS-Littell has made nine career appearances (1GS) opposite Cleveland, going 3-0 with a 2.20 ERA (16.1IP, 4ER)...his lone star came last season at Progressive Field on Sept. 2 (ND, 4.2IP, 9H, 4ER, 1SO)...is $7-4$ with a 3.75 ERA (86.1IP, 36ER) in 37 career appearances (9GS) against AL Central opponents, including a 4.63 ERA (46.2IP, 24ER) in the nine starts.

HOME COOKING-He has worked 5.0+ IP while allowing 3 ER or fewer in six straight home starts, including three quality starts, posting a 3.31 ERA (35.1IP, 13ER) during that stretch...it marks the longest streak by a Ray since Tyler Glasnow (6GS, June 25-Sept. 6, 2023)...the last to do so in seven consecutive starts was Zach Eflin (11GS) from April 1-July 21, 2023.

Over the same timeframe (since May 4), Littell is 1-2 with a 7.33 ERA (27.0IP, 22ER) across six road starts.

WELL-RESTED-Littell will be starting on five days' rest for the fifth time thanks to the Rays July 8 off day...according to STATS LLC, he is $3-3$ with a 2.51 ERA (57.1IP, 16ER) in 10 starts with 5+ days of rest...he has allowed three runs or fewer in each of those starts, recording five of his six quality starts...this, compared to his 0-3 record and 7.11 ERA (38.0IP, 30ER) across eight starts on 4 days' rest.

PINPOINT PRECISION-Littell's 4.1 pct. walk rate ranks fourth in the majors, trailing Zach Eflin (2.2\%), SEA George Kirby (2.5\%) and CHC Shota Imanaga (4.0\%) have lower walk rates...according to Elias, his free pass to NYY Anthony Rizzo on May 11 snapped a 123 BF streak without a walk, 4th longest in Rays history behind Zach Eflin (165BF, 2024), Corey Kluber (150BF, 2022) and David Price (124BF, 2013)...from April 17-May 4, Littel recorded 6+ SO without issuing a walk in a club-record 4 straight starts.

A LITTELL HELP?-He has received two runs of support or fewer in 14 of his 18 starts, including nine straight...his 2.96 run support average during the streak (since May 21) is fifth lowest in the AL (min. 40.0IP)...Littell has carried the load in Rays victories, pitching to a 2.81 ERA (48.0IP, 15ER) in wins and a 6.08 ERA (47.1IP, 32ER) in losses.

SLOW AND STEADY-Littell throws offspeed/breaking pitches 63.5 pct of the time...his 36.5 pct. fastball usage rate is fourth lowest in MLB (min. 1,000 pitches thrown), higher than only MIN Kenta Maeda (31.8\%), BOS Tanner Houck (32.2\%) and LAA Patrick Sandoval (33.4\%)...Littell's slider has been his most effective pitch - opponents are hitting 4-for-19 (.210) has been his most effective pitch-opponents are hitting 4
with a .263 slugging pct. against it over his two starts in July.

Left-handed hitters are batting . 211 (17-for-77) with 19 SO against
his slider...righties are 21-for-71(.296) with only 9 SO.
ROLEREVERSAL-In 2023, he went 0-1 with an 8.10 ERA (3.1IP, 3ER) in his first four relief appearances with the Rays after being claimed off waivers from the Red Sox on May 12...was on the 15-day IL from May 24-June 14 (right shoulder fatigue)...made two starts as an opener on June 29 at AZ and July 5 vs. PHI before transitioning to a full-time starting role on July 19 at TEX.

Over 14 starts, went $3-5$ with a 3.41 ERA (71.1IP, 27ER) and 1.05
WHIP...in 14 relief appearances, he posted an 0-1 mark with a 6.75 ERA (18.2IP, 14ER) and 1.66 WHIP.
He became the first pitcher to be claimed off waivers mid-season
and go on to make 10+ starts for a team that made the postseason since Doug Fister with the 2017 Red Sox (Elias).

## TOMDRROW'S PROBABLE STARTER: RHP RYAN PEPIOT [5-5, 4.20]

LAST START-Fell one out shy of a quality start en route to his fifth win on July 9 vs. NYY (W, 5.2IP, 4H, ER, 3BB, 7SO)...marked his first win since June 4 at MIA and first at home since April 18 vs. LAA...threw a career-high 101 pitches...has turned in a 2.95 ERA (18.1IP, 6 ER ) across his last four starts.
