Ronald Acuña Jr., Ozzie Albies, Freddie Freeman, and Marcell Ozuna, the first four hitters in the Braves lineup, are a combined 3-for-44 (.068) with 14 strikeouts and five walks this season.

Last season, the first four spots in the Braves lineup batted a combined .300 (283-for-943) with 54 home runs and a .947 OPS.

Acuña Jr., Freeman and Ozuna all won a Silver Slugger award, while Travis d’Arnaud, who made the majority of the starts in the cleanup spot, also won a Silver Slugger.

Relievers

The Braves bullpen is 0-2 despite owning a 1.69 ERA (2 ER/10.2 IP) with 16 strikeouts and no home runs allowed.

The relievers’ERA of 1.69 is fourth best in baseball, trailing only the Yankees (0.48), the Phillies (0.69), and the Padres (1.25).

The Braves bullpen’s K/9 rate of 13.50 is the best in baseball.

The Phillies went 9-for-40 (.225) with seven singles and two doubles against the Braves bullpen.

TODAY’S GAME: The Braves and Nationals open a three-game set today with the first of 19 matchups between the clubs this season...The teams will play a straight doubleheader tomorrow that begins at 12:05 p.m...The Braves will return here, May 4-6, for another three-game set.

☞ The Braves lost, 2-1, on Sunday to the Phillies to drop to 0-3 this season...In 2019, the last time the Braves opened the season in Philadelphia, they were swept in that season-opening set, getting outscored, 23-11...They went 97-65 that season to win the National League East.

☞ Since moving to Atlanta in 1966, the Braves have started the season with at least three straight losses 10 times now...The last time they dropped four straight to open a season was 2012, when they began 0-4 before winning game five.

☞ The Braves dropped 10 straight to open the 1988 season to set the franchise record for losses to start a season.

THREE RUNS: The Braves have scored three total runs this season, and suffered through an 18.0-inning scoreless streak before Travis d’Arnaud hit a solo home run in the seventh inning Sunday...Pablo Sandoval hit a two-run, seventh-inning home run on Opening Day for the Braves’ only other runs this season...The Braves were held scoreless by Zack Wheeler and two other relievers on Saturday in a 4-0 loss.

☞ Last season, the Braves longest scoreless streak was a 13-inning stretch, August 8-August 9.

☞ The Braves scored two runs or less in a game 18 times last season.

☞ The Braves scored 348 runs last season, the second most in the major leagues...The Dodgers scored one more run (349)... Atlanta scored the most runs any modern-era (since 1900) Braves team has scored in the first 60 games of a season...The 1900 Boston Beaneaters set the old mark at 346, before the 2003 team matched them...The Braves’ 5.8 runs per game

STARTING PITCHING: The Braves first three starters (Max Fried, Charlie Morton, Ian Anderson) all went 5.0 innings in their games, with Morton being the only to suffer the loss...The starting pitchers have combined for a 3.60 ERA (6 ER/15.0 IP) with 20 strikeouts and six walks.

☞ Last season, the Braves’ longest streak of at least 5.0 innings by their starting pitchers was two games, done eight times and last on September 24 and 25.

☞ Braves starting pitchers threw 251.2 innings last season, the fewest in the National League...The next closest NL team was Miami, at 273.1 innings from starters.

☞ The starters also compiled a 5.51 ERA (154 ER/251.2 IP), also the worst in the NL.

AT NATIONALS PARK: The Braves went 3-1 here at Nationals Park last season, a year after going 6-3 in Washington.

☞ In the first nine years after Nationals Park opened in 2008, the Braves had two winning seasons here in Washington D.C. ...From 2015-2016, the Braves went 1-19 here.

☞ Since that 1-19 stretch, the Braves have gone 19-13 (.594) here in Washington...The only two NL teams that have been better here are Los Angeles (7-2, .778;) and St. Louis (6-4, .600).

☞ In those 32 games, the Braves have compiled a .807 OPS and hit 49 home runs.

☞ 1B Freddie Freeman hit .438 (7-for-16) with two home runs in four games here last season, and for his career, owns a .921 OPS in this ballpark.

NO LONG LOSING STREAKS: The Braves enter today’s game with a three-game losing streak...The club’s longest losing streak last season was four games, and they were one of two teams in 2020 to not have multiple three-game losing skids.

☞ The Dodgers longest losing streak was two games, done three times.

☞ The Braves lost four straight from August 10-August 14...They then lost consecutive games four other times.

☞ The Braves lost consecutive games to an opponent five total times last season.

☞ The club’s longest winning streak was a five-game run, July 29-August 2 and then again from August 30-September 4.

VS. THE NL EAST: The Braves are scheduled to play their first 13 games against the NL East this season, with this three-game trip to Washington following a three-game set in Philadelphia...The Braves will play host to the Phillies for three games next weekend, before a four-game series with the Marlins.

☞ The Braves went 24-16 (.600) against the NL East last season, after they finished 46-30 (.605) in intradivision games in 2019 and 49-27 (.645) in 2018.

☞ The club’s 119-73 (.620) record against the NL East over the previous three seasons ranks as the second best intradivision record in the NL...Only Los Angeles was better inside their division over this time frame at 123-70 (.637).

☞ Last season, the Braves went 7-3 against the Mets, 6-4 against the Marlins and Nationals, and 5-5 against the Phillies.

☞ The Braves will face an opponent outside the NL East for the first time this season on April 16, when they travel to Wrigley Field to match up with the Cubs...That game will start a string of 15 straight outside the division.

Today's Game

A Makes his first start of the season and the 112th of his career...Is his 189th career appearance.

A Is set for his Braves debut after the club signed him to a one-year contract worth \$11 million in November of 2020.

A seven-year major league veteran, Smyly is 35-35 with a 4.13 ERA (320 ER/710.2 IP) over 188 career games, including 111 starts.

A Was drafted by Detroit in 2010 and debuted with the Tigers in 2012...Has also pitched for Tampa Bay, Texas, Philadelphia and San Francisco.

A Pitched in seven games and made five starts for San Francisco in 2020, going 0-1 with a 3.42 ERA (10 ER/26.1 IP) and 42 strikeouts...Allowed opponents to bat just .198 (20-for-101) and struck out 38% of batters he faced.

Established career bests in opposing average (.198), OBP (.261), slugging (.297) OPS (.558), strikeouts-per-nine (14.35) and strikeout percentage (37.8)...His 1.10 WHIP was his lowest since the 2013 season with Detroit (1.04), while his 3.42 ERA was his best since 2015 with Tampa Bay (3.11).

A Led San Francisco in strikeouts per nine (14.35) and percentage of pitches put in play (12.4)...The Giants won four of his five starts

A Smyly struck out 42 batters over 26.1 innings...His 14.35 strikeouts-per-nine-inning average led the majors among pitchers with at least five starts.

A Has pitched in just two career games against Washington, making one start...Has a 2.25 ERA (2 ER/8.0 IP) without a decision.

A Last pitched against the Nationals in 2019 while with Philadelphia...Allowed just two runs and fanned 10 over 6.1 innings.

2021 Spring

A Made four starts this spring and went 1-1 with a 3.29 ERA...Allowed 16 hits and seven runs (five earned) over 13.2 innings.

2020 Recap

Left-handers managed just three hits in 36 at bats against him...His .083 opposing average vs. lefties was best in the majors among pitchers with at least five starts.

A Made his Giants debut with 1.0 inning of scoreless relief on 7/23 vs. the Dodgers fanning two.

A Made his first start just three days later, pitching 3.1 innings of one-run ball also against the Dodgers.

A Missed 35 games with a left index finger sprain...Was placed on the injured list August 2 and was reinstated on September 10.

A Did not allow more than three runs in any of his seven appearances on the season and allowed two runs or fewer in six of the seven games.

A Fanned 10 batters over 5.0 innings in his last appearance of the season, 9/27 vs. San Diego.

A Allowed three hits and two runs to take the loss, his only decision of the season

A Has compiled a 35-35 record and a 4.13 ERA (326 ER/710.2 IP) over 188 games and 111 starts in seven major league seasons...Has tallied three saves in relief.

A Was drafted by Detroit in 2010 and debuted with the Tigers in 2012...Has also pitched for Tampa Bay, Texas, Philadelphia and San Francisco.

A Has pitched in 10 postseason games, all in relief, and has gone 1-0 with a 2.57 ERA (2 ER/7.0 IP) in the playoffs...Pitched in two games of the 2012 World Series with the Tigers.

A Played three seasons at the University of Arkansas after graduating from Little Rock (AR) Central High School.

A Pitched on the Razorbacks staff with roommate and former Braves left-hander Dallas Keuchel in 2009.
