ALL EYES NORTH: The Twins have gone 1-4 through five games on their current six-game roadtrip, getting swept in three games at Cleveland over the weekend, followed by a split of the first two games in D.C....today, they will play the roadtrip finale with an afternoon game at Nationals Park...after the game, the Twins will travel back to the Twin Cities for an off-day tomorrow, then begin a seven-game homestand with three against the Rangers this weekend, followed by four against the Royals from Monday-Thursday.

TWO WORDS: STREAK SNAPPED (ALSO, NAZ REID): The Twins beat the Nationals last night in D.C. by a score of 10-0, snapping their season-long seven-game losing streak...the win marked Rocco Baldelli's 400th career managerial victory...Joe Ryan (3-3) was the starter and winner, pitching 7.0 shutout innings, with three hits allowed, two walks and six strikeouts...the offense recorded 10 hits, four being home runs by Jose Miranda (4), Byron Buxton (2, 3) and Willi Castro (4)...for Buxton it marked his 11th career multi-homer game...the win was Minnesota's largest margin of victory in a shutout since a 12-0 win at Cleveland on May 21, 2021.

INTER-CONFERENCE PLAY: The Twins are 3-4 in Interleague Play this season...their only three series this season were a two-game series in Milwaukee from April 2-3 (1-1), a three-game series at Target Field against Los Angeles (1-2) and this current one (1-1)...after this series, their next IL opponent will be the Pirates at PNC Park for a three-game weekend series from June 7-9. **☞** Trevor Larnach has three doubles, one triple, five home runs, 19 RBI, a .640 slugging percentage and a .936 OPS in 16 games against the NL since the start of last season...his OPS in that span ranks 15th among AL players with at least 50 plate appearances.

RAISED BY WOLVES: Nats starter Jake Irvin grew up in Bloomington, Minnesota and went to Bloomington-Jefferson High School — approximately 12 miles south of downtown Minneapolis...he was originally selected by the Twins in the 37th round of the 2015 First-Year Player Draft but elected to attend the University of Oklahoma and was eventually drafted by the Nationals in the fourth round in 2018...he was a Twins fan growing up with his favorite players being Nick Punto and Michael Cuddyer (he was probably also a Timberwolves fan - unconfirmed).

DUNKIN' DEUTSCHMAN: Max Kepler has played in 152 Interleague games in his career, slashing .258/.340/.469...below are his all-time Twins ranks in IL Play:

EASTBAY FUNK DUNK: The Twins are 52-61 all-time against NL East opponents, their fewest wins against any division in baseball...the Twins are 11-12 all-time against the Montreal/Washington franchise, including 8-12 since the franchise moved to D.C....the Twins have gone just 3-10 in their last 13 vs. the Nats, dating back to 2013...the Twins are just 2-6 all-time at Nationals Park, going 1-2 in 2013, 0-3 in 2016 and 1-1 this season. **☞** Last night's win marked Minnesota's first victory here since June 8, 2013, a 4-3, 11-inning victory.

RUN WITH THE WOLVES: Twins scored 10 runs last night, their most since scoring 11 on May 9 vs. Seattle...they entered last night having scored 12 runs over their previous seven games combined...despite the recent scoring drought, the Twins still rank first in the AL in runs scored (150) since April 22 and second in baseball (Philadelphia - 165).

THREE POINTERS: Twins pitchers have struck out 451 batters this season, the most in the AL and second-most in baseball, trailing only Philadelphia (458)...starters have struck out 266, sixth-most in baseball...relievers have struck out 185, eighth-most in baseball.

BIG AL JEFFERS-ON: Ryan Jeffers is hitting .298 (28-for-94) with five doubles, nine home runs, 17 RBI, a .421 on-base percentage, a .638 slugging percentage and a 1.059 OPS vs. NL opponents since the start of 2023...Jeffers' IL OPS ranks fourth in baseball since the start of last season...additionally, he has homered four times in his last nine games vs. the NL.

KARLOS ANTHONY TOWNS: Carlos Correa has hit safely in seven of his last eight games and in 10 of his last 12...in that span, he has posted an .889 OPS with a .535 slugging percentage, including six extra-base hits (3 doubles, 1 triple and 2 home runs) and five walks. **☞** He has reached safely in 10 straight road games, posting a .405 on-base percentage in that span...in his last 35 road games, dating back to August 7, 2023, he is hitting .299 (35-for-117) with a .415 on-base percentage and a .911 OPS.

ANTHONY EDOUARDS: Edouard Julien ranks in the 100th percentile in baseball in chase percentage at 15.0%...additionally, he ranks in the 88th percentile in walk percentage at 12.7%...among all AL players, his walk rate trails just six players: Kyle Tucker (18.6%), Aaron Judge (17.9%), Juan Soto (14.5%), Riley Greene (14.1%), Tyler O'Neill (13.3%) and Mark Canha (12.9%).

WILLI SZCZERBIAK: Since April 19, Willi Castro is hitting .328 (38-for-116) with 10 doubles, three triples, three home runs, 14 RBI, 17 runs scored and a .911 OPS in 31 games...since that date, he ranks fourth in the AL in batting average and 11th in OPS. **☞** Since April 24, Castro ranks tied for fifth in the AL in line drives hit with 24...his line drive percentage of 29.8 marks his highest since 2020 (30.9%).

BRING YA A☞: Friday night's start time vs. the Rangers has been shifted to 6:10 pm (CT), rather than 7:10 pm as previously scheduled...the Target Field gates will now open at 4:30 pm on Friday...moving first pitch time up by one hour was done to help accommodate ingress and egress to downtown Minneapolis throughout what is expected to be a busy evening, with Game 2 of the Western Conference Finals between the Minnesota Timberwolves and Dallas Mavericks scheduled for a 7:30 pm tip at Target Center.

LAST TIME OUT: Last pitched May 17 in Cleveland, opposite Triston McKenzie, and didn't factor into the decision of Minnesota's 3-2 loss...allowed one run on four hits in 5.1 innings with no walks and two strikeouts...all four hits were singles...was pulled with Andrés Giménez on third and one out in the sixth; Steven Okert entered and allowed a fielder's choice that retired Giménez, then a two-run home run to David Fry.

- ☞ Generated seven whiffs on 45 swings (15.6%)...his 18.4 percent whiff rate ranks in MLB's eighth percentile.
- ☞ Allowed six hard-hit balls (95.0+ mph)...Cleveland went 1-for-6 with three groundouts on those swings.
- ☞ First MLB appearance in which he didn't issue a walk.

TWO STARTS AGO: Started May 11 in Toronto, opposite Kevin Gausman, and didn't factor into the decision of Minnesota's 10-8 loss...allowed five runs on eight hits (2 HR) in 4.1 innings, with one walk and two strikeouts...allowed a solo home run to Bo Bichette in the second...gave up three straight hits and two runs to begin the third...Davis Schneider added a solo shot to lead off the fifth...Woods Richardson was pulled from that inning with a runner on first and one out; Cole Sands entered and allowed that inherited runner to score.

- ☞ Eight hits and two home runs allowed are both MLB career highs.
- ☞ Induced 10 whiffs on 48 swings (20.8%).
- ☞ Allowed eight hard-hit balls...Toronto went 6-for-8 with two doubles and a home run (Bichette, 105.3 mph) on those swings.

WOODS RICHARDSON VS. WASHINGTON: Made his second career MLB appearance vs. Washington on April 22, 2023 at Target Field, entering in relief of Pablo López...allowed five runs on seven hits (1 HR) in 4.2 innings, with a career-high three walks and five strikeouts.

- ☞ Five current Nationals faced Woods Richardson in that game, combining to go 4-for-11 with a home run (by CJ Abrams) and three strikeouts.
- ☞ Washington is the only National League opponent Woods Richardson has faced in his career.

ON THE ROAD AGAIN: Making fifth road start of the season...has gone 1-0 with a 3.72 ERA (19.1 IP, 8 ER), four walks and 11 strikeouts on the road, compared to 0-0 with a 1.64 ERA (11.0 IP, 2 ER), two walks and 14 strikeouts in two home starts...has allowed a .276 batting average (21-for-76), .297 BABIP (batting average on balls in play) and .725 OPS on the road, compared to .200 (8-for-40), .296 BABIP and .458 OPS at home.

REVERSE SPLITS: On May 17, Cleveland's left-handed hitters went 1-for-11 with two strikeouts vs. Woods Richardson, while its righties went 3-for-9...through six games vs. Woods Richardson this season, left-handed hitters have hit .196 (9-for-46) with a .492 OPS and 21.6 percent strikeout rate, while righties have hit .286 (20-for-70) with a .726 OPS and 18.9 percent strikeout rate.

- ☞ Washington has slugged .361 vs. right-handed pitching this season, the fifth-worst mark in baseball.

THE ARSENAL: Woods Richardson has used a four-pitch mix in his six MLB starts this season...here's his 2024 repertoire, per Baseball Savant:

- ☞ His slider has allowed a .227 slugging percentage, 25th lowest of 134 MLB pitchers (min. 25 PA)...ranks in MLB's 95th percentile with a breaking ball run value of 5.
- ☞ 4-seamer has allowed a 55.9 percent hard-hit rate, tied with Zac Gallen for sixth highest in baseball (min. 50 PA).

- ☞ Made two starts for St. Paul from April 9-15...was recalled by Minnesota on April 21 and made a relief appearance for Twins on April 22 vs. Washington, allowing five runs on seven hits in 4.2 innings pitched, with three walks and five strikeouts.
- ☞ Optioned back to St. Paul on April 23.
- ☞ Pitched a professional career-high 7.0 innings April 28 at Rochester, allowing two runs on three hits.
