



# Colorado Rockies (15-30) vs. San Francisco Giants (22-25)

**TODAY'S GAME:** The Giants host the Colorado Rockies in the finale of this three-game series, looking to earn their first series sweep of the season.

- ▶ Yesterday's win clinched SF its third out of its last four series, and a winning homestand (currently 5-3).
- ▶ At Oracle Park, the Giants have gone 5-2-1 in their eight series this season.
- ▶ Yesterday's win gave SF its first three-game winning streak of the season...the Giants' last winning streak of more than three games was September 8-11 of last season (four).

**ROX ON:** Beginning with the 2021 season, the Giants have gone 42-14 (.750) against the Rockies, including a 22-5 (.815) record here at Oracle Park...SF has won each of its last seven games vs. Colorado here in the Bay and 10 of its last 11...SF has outscored COL by a 157-80 (+77) margin during this 27-game stretch of home games, dating to 2021.

- ▶ The Giants have a 15-4 series record against COL since 2021, the highest series winning percentage by SF against any opponent over that span (min. three series) per *Stats, LLC*.
- ▶ SF also has a chance for its ninth series sweep against Colorado since 2021, the most by any team against a single opponent over that span.

**TURNING THE TIDE?:** The Giants scored double digit runs in consecutive games for the first time since September 6-7, 2021 when they totaled 22 runs at Colorado.

- ▶ The 24 runs over a two-game span is the franchise's most since it scored 29 from September 1-2, 2020...SF's most runs scored over a three-game series last season was 31 at Chicago-AL from April 3-6.
- ▶ The Giants hit nine doubles yesterday, their most in a game since hitting 12 doubles on April 11, 1912 at Brooklyn.
- ▶ SF entered this series ranking 29th in MLB since April 24 with 3.20 runs/game...after the past two days of offensive onslaughts, the Giants rank 21st with 4.00 runs/game.
- ▶ The Giants are now 14-0 when scoring five or more runs...they are the only team in the Majors with an undefeated record when scoring five or more runs.

**MATOS MANIA:** One day after plating a career-high five runs in Friday's game, **OF Luis Matos** again set a new high mark, knocking in six runs in yesterday's win.

- ▶ He has 17 RBI in his first six games with a plate appearance this season...that's the most in Giants history through six games (with a PA) to start a season, and tied with Bal's Chris Davis (2013) for most in MLB history.
- ▶ The 17 RBI are also the most in a six game span by a Giant in any point of a season since **Hunter Pence** had 19 (Sept. 10-Sept. 15, 2013).
- ▶ According to *Sarah Langs*, Matos' 11 RBI the last two games are the most by a Giants player in a two-game span at age 22 or younger (since RBI became an official stat in 1920)...*Langs* also noted that Matos is the fourth Giants player with consecutive games of five or more RBI, joining **Jack Clark** (1982), **Don Mueller** (1951) and **Bill Terry** (1932).
- ▶ According to *Opta Stats*, Matos is the youngest in MLB history to have back-to-back five-RBI games (RBI became an official stat in 1920).

**WADE'S WORLD: IF/OF LaMonte Wade Jr.** extended his on-base streak to 18 straight games with a single in the 8th inning yesterday...the 18-game on-base streak is the third-longest active streak in MLB behind MIL's William Contreras (25 games) and SD's Luis Arraez (22 games).

- ▶ Wade's 18-game on-base streak is the second-longest of his career behind his 19-game streak (April 20-May 13, 2023).
- ▶ He has 16 walks this month, most in MLB...the last Giant with 16+ walks in a month was also Wade (17 in June, 2023).
- ▶ On the season, his .465 on-base percentage and 21.1% walk rate are both tops in MLB (min. 100 PA).

**EXTRA! EXTRA!:** The Giants have an extra-base hit in 17-straight games entering today (dates back to May 1), the longest active streak by an NL team...the streak is tied for the team's longest overall this season, also done from April 10-28.

**I'VE GOT 5 ON IT:** One major change in SF's offensive output over the last week is the production of the fifth spot in its lineup as shown in the table below.

**CHAPPY NEW YEAR: IF Matt Chapman** recorded his second career four-hit game in yesterday's win (other: with Oakland on July 7, 2018 at Cleveland).

- ▶ With seven hits over his last two games, he (and **OF Luis Matos**) are the first Giants with three-plus hits in straight games since **OF Mitch Haniger** (May 26-27, 2023)...the last Giant with three-plus hits in three straight games was **IF Joe Panik** (Sept. 4-6, 2017).
- ▶ Since the homestand began May 10, Chapman is batting .355 (11x31) with 10 runs, five doubles, a home run, six RBI and a 1.042 OPS over eight games.

**This Date in Giants History**

May 19, 2001 - Three solo home runs was not out of the ordinary for **Barry Bonds** who passed Eddie Matthews and Ernie Banks for sole possession of 12th place on the all-time home run list...the Giants defeated the Braves 6-3.

**WELCOME TO SF:** Hicks signed with San Francisco as a free agent on January 18, 2024 on a four-year deal worth \$44 million...he was originally drafted by the Cardinals in the supplemental third round (105th overall) of the 2015 First-Year Player Draft and spent his whole career with St. Louis before being traded to Toronto in July last season for RHP Sem Robberse and RHP Adam Kloffenstein.

**PUSH TO START:** Is transitioning from a relief role into a traditional starting role...has made 17 career starts entering today, nine of which have come this season...Hicks worked almost exclusively out of the rotation in the minor leagues, but the Cardinals ended up moving him to the bullpen to accelerate his path to the Majors.

**THIRD TIME'S A CHARM:** So far this season, he's done well when pitching longer into the game with opponents going 7-for-32 (.219) the third time through the lineup.

**LAST OUTING:** Put the Giants behind early after allowing a lead-off home run by **Mookie Betts**...it was only the second home run he has allowed this season...he tied his season high with seven hits allowed over 5.0 innings.

**AMONG THE LEAGUE LEADERS:** Has posted a 2.44 ERA over his first nine outings, which currently ranks as the fourth-best ERA in the National League.

**VS. COLORADO:** Logged his fourth win of the season with an 8-6 victory at Coors field on May 8...he is slated to make his ninth career appearance and second career start against the Rockies...he's held Colorado hitters to a .260 (13-for-50) average over his career, however he's issued eight walks, compared to just 10 strikeouts over his eight outings.

**HOME IS WHERE THE HEAT IS:** Opponents are hitting .218 against Hicks at Oracle Park this season...his 1.86 ERA ranks ninth in the National League among starting pitchers at home (min. 20.0ip).

**LEFT, LEFT, LEFT, RIGHT, LEFT:** Right-handed hitters have gone 21-for-100 (.210) versus Hicks thus far in 2024...however, right-handers are 17-for-51 (.333) over his last four games...lefties are just 6-for-31 (.194) in his last four starts.

**GOTTA SPLIT:** Opponents are hitting just .079 (3-for-38) with 17 strike outs off his splitter and .133 (4-for-30) off his sweeper, compared to a .294 (30-for-102) off his sinker...over his last three starts, Hicks hasn't allowed a hit on his splitter.

**HIGH FIVE:** Hicks has pitched 5.0+ innings in eight of his nine starts this season.

**FEEL THE HEAT:** Since entering the Majors in 2018, Hicks has consistently been one of the hardest throwing pitchers in the league... he has thrown 4,894 pitches in his Major League career, with 1,661 (34%) clocked at over 100 mph...so far this year he hasn't thrown a pitch above 100 with his fastest pitch logging in at 99.5 mph on March 30 at San Diego.

**2023 SEASON:** Made 65 relief appearances between the Cardinals (40 games) and Blue Jays (25 games), posting a combined 3.29 ERA (24er, 65.2ip) with 12 saves...his 81 strikeouts, 11.1 K/9.0ip, and 28.4 strikeout percentage were all career bests...threw 470 pitches at 100+ MPH (42.2% off his total pitches) and 24 pitches at 103+ MPH, both second in MLB to Jhoan Duran.

**DIABETIC PHENOM:** Was diagnosed with Type 1 diabetes at age 17 while in high school...he calls himself the "diabetic phenom", which was the Xbox identity he chose for himself... Diabetic phenom evolved into his brand and he now sells merchandise...he wears cleats that say "Type 1" on them when he pitches.
