THE TWINS: After completing their nine-game, 10-day roadtrip with a record of 6-3 (2-1 in Oakland, 2-1 in Arizona and 2-1 in Seattle), the Twins began their six-game homestand with a three-game series win over the Tigers this week, taking the bookend games...tonight, they will continue the homestand with the first of a three-game weekend series against the Astros. The Twins have gone 25-17 at home this season, including a record of 23-11 after starting the season 2-6 here in the first eight. With the win yesterday, the Twins improved to 11 games over .500, matching their high-water mark for 2024...a win tonight will be their highest since finishing the 2023 season 12 games over (.87-75).

TWINS SPOIL THE RETURN OF THE KING: The Twins beat the Tigers and old friend Kenta Maeda yesterday afternoon at Target Field by a score of 12-3 in a rain-shortened seven-inning game... Bailey Ober (8-4) was the starter and winner, allowing three runs (1 earned) on seven hits in 6.0 innings pitched, with no walks and eight strikeouts...the offense recorded 14 hits and were led by Jose Miranda, who went 5-for-5 with three doubles and two singles...it marked the second time this season for a Twin to record five hits (Correa - 6/12 vs. COL) and 60th time in club history with five-plus...the game was called in the bottom of the seventh inning due to rainy conditions after Ryan Jeffers was hit in the helmet by an erratic pitch from Shelby Miller.

READY FOR LIFTOFF: The Twins are Astros last played a three-game series at Minute Maid Park from May 31-June 2 as the Twins won the series, taking games 1 and 3. Houston's last trip to Minneapolis was during the 2023 ALDS for Games 3 and 4, as the Astros won both games by scores of 9-1 and 3-2, eliminating the Twins from the Postseason. After going 0-6 against the Astros in 2022, the Twins have gone 6-3 in regular season games vs. Houston since the start of 2023...in that span, they have outscored the 'Stros 41-34. The Twins are 41-45 all-time against the Astros in the regular season, including a record of 30-36 since Houston joined the American League in 2013. Notable numbers from the three-game series in Houston: Carlos Santana went 3-for-8 (.375) with a home run, Jose Miranda went 3-for-10 (.300) with a home run and three RBI... Trevor Larnach hit two home runs in eight at-bats...twins pitchers posted a 3.12 ERA (26.0 IP, 9 ER); relievers pitched 9.2 scoreless innings with five hits allowed (.152 BAA).

MINNESOTA: Minnesota has gone 42-25 in its last 67 games since April 22, the second-most wins in baseball since that date, trailing Philadelphia (43-22)...below are the Twins' offensive numbers through April 21 (first 20 games), compared to numbers since April 22 (67 games) and MLB ranks in parenthesis:

WINE 'EM AND DINE 'EM: The Twins have recalled right-handed pitcher Josh Winder (pronounced WINE-der) from Triple-A St. Paul...Winder, 27, has appeared in 15 games for the Saints this season, going 2-0, 4.78 ERA (26.1 IP, 14 ER), eight walks and 28 strikeouts...in his last six appearances for St. Paul, since June 12, he posted a 3.48 ERA (10.1 IP, 4 ER) with two walks and 11 strikeouts...to make room for Winder on the 26-man roster, the Twins have optioned right-handed pitcher David Festa to St. Paul...Festa, who made his major league debut in Arizona on June 27, made two starts for the Twins, going 1-1, 10.80 ERA (10.0 IP, 12 ER), one walk and eight strikeouts.

C4 EXP-'LOS-IVE: Carlos Correa enters today with a .311 batting average, fifth-best in the AL, trailing Steven Kwan (.367), Bobby Witt Jr. (.319), Luis Rengifo (.315) and Aaron Judge (.314)...through games of June 5, he was hitting .247, raising his average 64 points over the last 25 games since June 6...since that date, he is hitting .412 (40-for-97) with five doubles, six home runs, 19 RBI, a .477 on-base percentage, a .649 slugging percentage, a 1.127 OPS and 12 multi-hit games...additionally, he enters today with a seven-game hitting streak, his season-long is nine, from June 9-18.

MIRANDA WATCH!: Jose Miranda recorded five hits yesterday, becoming one of eight players in baseball with a five-hit game in 2024 (Carlos Correa, Mookie Betts, Jake Cronenworth, Logan O'Hoppe, Bryan Reynolds, Adley Rutschman and Christian Yelich)...Miranda is hitting .349 (44-for-126) with 12 doubles, one triple, four home runs, 28 RBI, a .393 on-base percentage, a .556 slugging percentage and a .948 OPS in his last 36 games, since May 24...since that date, he ranks fifth in baseball in batting average and tied for ninth in RBI with the 16th-lowest strikeout percentage (12.9%).

LEE, LEE, LEE, LEE, LEE, WE'RE TALKIN' LEE: Twins number two prospect Brooks Lee made his major league debut on Wednesday night and has gone 3-for-6 with one walk and two RBI in two games to begin his major league career...the last Twin to begin their career by hitting in each of their first three was Royce Lewis from May 6-8, 2023...the club record for a hitting streak to start a career is 13 by Glenn Williams, from June 7-28, 2005.

In 22 games between Triple-A St. Paul and Minnesota, Lee has hit .341 (31-for-91) with five doubles, seven home runs, 23 RBI, 20 runs scored, 10 walks, a .402 on-base percentage, a .626 slugging percentage and a 1.028 OPS.

SO MUCH DRIP, WE MIGHT MAKE ANOTHER LAKE: Tonight and tomorrow, the Twins will be wearing their 2024 Nike MLB City Connect Series uniform, a look that embodies this majestic and "where the water reflects the sky" and celebrates the 10,000 lakes that shape and unite us...the Nike City Connect Series, which debuted in 2021, celebrates the deep-rooted history, culture and spirit of each city that continues to bring the MLB clubs and their communities together...Minnesota debuted these uniforms on June 14 and 15 vs. Oakland, winning both games...full list of tentative dates these will be worn after these games: July 20 vs. Milwaukee, August 2 vs. Chicago-AL, August 9 vs. Cleveland, August 23 vs. St. Louis, August 30 vs. Toronto, September 13 vs. Cincinnati and September 27 vs. Baltimore.

STRONG IN SEATTLE: Last pitched June 29 at Seattle, opposite Bryce Miller, and earned the win in Minnesota's 5-1 victory...allowed one run on four hits (1 HR) in 6.0 innings with one walk and nine strikeouts...stranded J.P. Crawford on third base in the first inning...only run came on Mitch Haniger's third-inning home run...retired the last 10 batters he faced, seven by strikeout.

- ☞ Induced 18 whiffs on 52 swings (34.6%)...ranks in MLB's 77th percentile with a 28.8 percent whiff rate this season.
- ☞ Allowed just three hard-hit balls (95.0+ mph); Seattle went 1-for-3 on those swings, the only hit being Haniger's 103.7 mph home run...ranks in MLB's 50th percentile with a 38.8 hard-hit percentage this season.
- ☞ Threw his two fastest pitches of the season, 96.9 mph and 96.7 mph 4-seamers to Julio Rodriguez and Mitch Garver.
- ☞ Has totaled 23 strikeouts in his last two starts, the most in a two-start span in his career and tied for the most by any pitcher this season...the last Twin with 23-or-more strikeouts in a two-start span was Francisco Liriano from July 13-18, 2012 (25 K).

TWO STARTS AGO: Started June 23 at Oakland, opposite Hogan Harris, and earned the win in Minnesota's 3-0 victory...allowed two hits and one walk in 8.0 scoreless innings with 14 strikeouts...was perfect through 5.2 innings until Lawrence Butler's single.

- ☞ 14 strikeouts matched a career high set September 10, 2023 vs. New York-NL.
- ☞ Completed 8.0-or-more innings for the fifth time in his career and first since September 10, 2023 vs. New York-NL (also 8.0).

HOUSTON, WE HAVE A PABLO: Has made three career starts (regular + Postseason) vs. Houston, all on the road; has gone 2-0 with a 1.47 ERA (18.1 IP, 3 ER), four walks and 18 strikeouts.

- ☞ Beat Houston in Game 2 of the 2023 ALDS, throwing 7.0 scoreless innings with six hits, one walk and seven strikeouts in Minnesota's 6-2 victory.
- ☞ Beat Houston on May 31, allowing one run on six hits (1 HR) in 7.0 innings with one walk and six strikeouts...Minnesota won that game 6-1.

HOME/ROAD SPLITS: Making ninth home start of 2024...has gone 3-3 with a 5.14 ERA (42.0 IP, 24 ER), 9.21 strikeouts-per-9.0 innings and 1.50 home-runs-per-9.0 innings at home, compared to 5-3 with a 4.67 ERA (52.0 IP, 27 ER), 11.60 K/9 and 1.73 HR/9 in nine road starts.

- ☞ Has a 1.29 WHIP and .795 opponent OPS at home, 1.04 WHIP and .662 OPS on the road.
- ☞ Has issued 1.29 walks-per-9.0 innings at home, 2.42 on the road.
- ☞ Batting average on balls in play vs. López: .339 at home, .256 on the road.

LEFT/RIGHT SPLITS: Through 17 games vs. López, left-handed hitters have hit .262 (49-for-187) with a .471 slugging percentage, .760 OPS, 27.3 percent strikeout rate and 5.1 percent home run rate, while righties have hit .224 (39-for-174) with a .402 SLG, .685 OPS, 29.3 percent strikeout rate and 3.7 percent home run rate.

- ☞ On June 29, Seattle's lefties went 3-for-11 with a walk and four strikeouts vs. López, while its righties went 1-for-10 with a home run and five strikeouts.
- ☞ Whiff rate vs. vs. López: 26.7 percent by lefties, 31.4 percent by righties.
- ☞ Hard-hit percentage vs. López: 37.0 percent by lefties, 41.2 percent by righties.

- ☞ On June 29, Seattle went 0-for-4 with three strikeouts – and eight whiffs on 18 swings – vs. López's sweeper...the pitch has a 32.2 percent whiff rate this season.
- ☞ Sweeper has allowed a .265 batting average but .194 expected batting average...has allowed a .518 slugging percentage but a .315 expected slugging.
- ☞ His 4-seamer ranks sixth in baseball (min. 100 PA) in batting average against (.175), fourth in strikeout rate (34.2%) and fifth in putaway rate (26.8%).
- ☞ Right-handed hitters have hit .127 (8-for-63) with a 37.1 percent strikeout rate vs. López's 4-seamer.
- ☞ In two-strike counts, opponents have hit .313 (10-for-32) with 12 strikeouts vs. López's changeup.

ON THIS DATE: One year ago today, on July 5, 2023, López threw the only complete-game shutout of his career to date...facing Kansas City at Target Field, he threw exactly 100 pitches, allowing four hits with zero walks and 12 strikeouts in Minnesota's 5-0 win.
