TODAY'S TRANSACTIONS The Reds today selected from AAA-Louisville RHP Zach McCambley (#62); recalled from Louisville RHP Luis Mey (#47); designated for assignment LHP Brandon Leibrandt and RHP Lyon Richardson.

- **McCambley** will make his Major League debut when he plays.
- Additionally, **RHP Rhett Lowder** (15-day IL, right shoulder pain) was placed on a rehabilitation assignment at Louisville.

TONIGHT'S GAME: Is Game 2 (0-1) of a 3-game series vs **Logan Jones' Royals** and the fifth game (1-3) of a 6-game homestand that includes a 1-2 weekend series loss to the **Braves**.

- Following tomorrow's game and Thu's off day, the Reds will resume their road schedule with a 6-game trip to **StL** (6/5-6/7) and **SD** (6/8-6/10).

BLEADY IN THE LIFE: In last night's 9-2 loss vs **KC**, **LF JJ Bleday** went 1-for-4 with a walk and a solo homer (#10).

- His 10 home runs through his first 31 games w/ Cin are T3rd-most by any Red in that span since 1900 (**Aristides Aquino** 14, 2018-19; **Walker Cooper** 11, 1949).
- Since being recalled from AAA-Louisville on 4/26, he's slashing .301/.398/.655 with 10 HR, 27 RBI, and a 1.053 OPS in 31 games.
- His 1.6 WAR ranks second on the team behind **Chase Burns** (3.0) and **Elly De La Cruz** (2.4).
- For the month of May, **Bleday** slashed .301/.387/.631 with 8 HR, 25 RBI, 8 2B, 1 3B, 65 TB, and a 1.018 OPS in 27 games (31-for-103).
- He led all National League players for the month in slugging pct and total bases while ranking among the leaders in RBI (T1st) and HR (T3rd).

CATTLE DRIVE: OF/INF Spencer Steer has reached safely in a career-high 20 consecutive games dating back to 5/9 vs **Hou**.

- **Steer's** current on-base run is the longest active streak in the majors.
- He's hit safely in 28 of his last 31 games (.316/.391/.447), since 4/28.
- Has at least 1 hit in 42 games this season, T6th-most in the NL.
- Hit safely in 24 games during the month of May, most in the majors.
- Since 4/18, **Steer** is slashing .309/.396/.453 in 39 games (43-for-149, 4hr, 16rbi, 12xbh, 63 times on base).
- Overall this year, **Steer** has appeared in 26g in LF, 24g at 1B, 16g in RF, 6g at 2B, and 2g at 3B...is 1 of 13 Major League players to appear at 5 or more different positions this season...only 3 have appeared at 6.
- Has 294 career starts in the infield and 173 career starts in the outfield...only **Pete Rose** and **Frank Robinson** have made 200 or more starts for the Reds in both the infield and outfield.

FIRST INNING HOMERS: Reds pitchers have allowed a 1st-inning homer in 4 of the last 5 games, including last night's grand slam by **KC's Lane Thomas**.

- The Reds have given up 10 home runs in the 1st inning this season, T8th-most in the majors...last year, they allowed 20.

ARROYO DEBUTS: Last night vs **KC**, **INF Edwin Arroyo** made his Major League debut and went 1-for-4 with a single and a run scored.

- Was the second Red this season to make his Major League debut (also: **RHP Jose Franco** on 3/30 vs **Pit**).
- **Arroyo** became the fourth-youngest Red (22 years, 280 days) to start at second base in his Major League debut since 1900...only **Jim Begly** in 1924, **Pete Rose** in 1963, and **Lew Fonseca** in 1921 were younger.

BULLPEN WORK: The Reds bullpen ranks second in the majors with 217 combined relief appearances...only the **Blue Jays** have more (227).

- Last year, Reds relievers combined for 550 appearances which ranked tied for sixth in the majors.
- The Reds have used a total of 26 different pitchers this season...only the **Orioles** have used more (27)...last year Cin used 28 pitchers.

SERIES NOTES:

- The Reds are 19-23 all-time vs **KC**, including 4-12 here at **Great American Ball Park** and 13-8 at **Kauffman Stadium**.
 - The Reds took 2 of 3 games last season (5/26-5/28) at **KC** and have won 8 of the last 14 games vs the **Royals**...their 3-2 loss on 5/28 snapped their 6-game winning streak at **Kauffman Stadium**, dating back to 2021.
 - Of the 16 completed **Reds/Royals** series, 9 have resulted in sweeps.
 - The first game of the **June 1999** series was postponed because of a power failure...the Reds swept the next day's doubleheader, 9-4 and 7-4 in 10 innings, before winning the series finale, 14-3...was the first doubleheader in interleague history.
- SAVE THE LAST DANCE FOR ME:** In Sun's 6-4 win vs **Atl**, **LHP Sam Moll** earned his second career save, his first since 6/27/23 for **Oak** vs **NYG**, a span of 1,069 days (2 years, 11 months, 4 days).
- **Moll** became the eighth different pitcher this season to earn a save for the Redlegs (also: **Antone**, **Ashcraft**, **Burke**, **Johnson**, **Pagán**, **Phillips**, **Santillan**)...the Reds, **Nationals** (8) and **Twins** (11) are the only teams in the majors to have saves from 8 different pitchers in 2026.

POWER SURGE: The Reds have homered 51 times over their last 36 games (since 4/21 at **TB**), sixth-most in the majors during that time, behind the **WSox** (59), **Mariners** (55), **Yankees** (54), **Braves** (54), and **Nationals** (53).

- Are on pace to hit 200 homers this season, which would be the 10th time in franchise history they'd reach the 200-HR mark.
- Have hit 2 or more HRs in a game 20 times this season.
- Have hit 44 homers at **Great American Ball Park** in 2026, tying them for third-most by any Major League team at its home venue.
- Entered the 4/21 game at **TB** ranked T17th in the majors with 22 HR... enter today's game ranked eighth in the majors with 73 HR.
- 115 of their 258 runs scored this year have come via HR (44.6%, 5th).

NO ROOM FOR THE BROOM: The Reds have avoided being swept in 41 consecutive home series (min. 1g)...it's their longest such streak since 9/19/11-9/25/13 when the Reds eluded a series sweep at **Great American Ball Park** in a franchise-record 52 consecutive home series.

- The Reds avoided the sweep in all 26 of their series last year at **GABP**...only the Cin teams of 1940, 1943, 1944, 1994, and 2012 ran the home schedule without being broomed.

HAPPY BIRTHDAY! Yesterday celebrated his 27th birthday.

LAST TIME OUT: Suffered the 4-2 loss on Wed, 5/27 at NYM (6.0ip, 6h, 3r/3er, 1bb, 4k, 2hr, 101TP).

- Was his fourth quality start of the season, the 33rd of his career.
- Threw a season-high 101 pitches...the first time he eclipsed the 100-pitch mark since 9/10/25 vs SD (102).
- Produced a season-high 10 fly balls, the most since he allowed 11 on 8/6/25 at Chc.
- Generated 11 swings-and-misses (54 swings)...batters put 19 pitches in play.
- 7 hard-hit balls marked a season high.
- 7 of his 24 batters reached.

MAY 20 at PHI: Earned the 9-4 win on Wed, 5/20 at Phi (5.1ip, 3h, 2r/1er, 3bb, 3k, 1hr, 96TP).

- Reached max velocity of 94.5 mph, his highest since 9/21/2025 vs Chc (94.6).
- Produced a season-high 13 swings-and-misses, his most since 9/16/25 at StL (15).
- 2 of his first 3 pitches were strikes to 52.9% of the batters he faced (min. 3 pitches per PA).
- Was ahead in the count to 14 of his 22 batters.
- Allowed 6 of his 22 batters to reach.
- Threw 26 pitches in the 1st inning.
- Faced 2 batters in the 6th (Bryce Harper flyout, Alec Bohm HR) before turning it over to Brock Burke.

MAY 15 at CLE: Earned the 7-6 win on Fri, 5/15 at Cle (5.0ip, 4h, 1r/1er, 3bb, 2k, 1hr, 90TP).

- Extended his career-long scoreless streak to 21.2 innings before allowing a solo homer to Rhys Hoskins to lead off the 6th inning...Hoskins was the only batter he faced in the 6th...turned it over to Pierce Johnson after the homer.

HEATING UP: Over his last 6 starts, beginning 4/30 vs Col, has pitched to a 1.85 ERA (34.0ip, 8r/7er, 25h, 14bb, 23k, 5hr, .205/.285/.328).

IT'S GONNA BE MAY: Has posted a 1.79 ERA over 16 career starts in the month of May, the fourth-lowest mark by a Reds pitcher in any specific calendar month (min. 16gs) since 1913 (when earned runs became an official stat)...the only other Cin pitchers with a lower ERA in calendar month is Fred Toney (1.42era, August & 1.73era, September/October) and Jose Rijo (1.76era, September/October).

- His career 1.79 ERA in May is the fourth-lowest by any Major Leaguer with at least 16 starts in May since earned runs became an official stat in 1913 (Cristopher Sanchez 1.76, Eddie Cicotte 1.70, Cy Falkenberg 1.79).

SCORELESS STREAK: Posted a career-high 21.2 consecutive scoreless innings streak from 4/30-5/15.

ACCOLADES: Was recognized as a finalist for the 2025 All-MLB Team and received votes in 2025 for National League Cy Young Award and Rawlings Gold Glove Award.

HE EARNED IT: His 3.50 ERA through his first 87 career starts is the lowest by a Reds starting pitcher in that span since RHP Mario Soto (3.20, 1977-83).

PERSONAL: Graduated from Halifax County High School (South Boston, VA), the same school attended by All Elite Wrestling champion "Hangman" Adam Page and Major League pitcher Jeremy Jeffress...was named 2017 Gatorade Virginia Player of the Year...was a 4-year member of the Halifax swim team...at the University of Virginia became only the second pitcher in school history to record at least 300 strikeouts.
