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PITTSBURGH PIRATES (14-27) vs. NEW YORK METS (26-15)

May 12, 2025 - Citi Field - Queens, NY - 7:10 EDT - Game #42/Road #20

RHP Paul Skenes (3-4, 2.77 ERA) vs. LHP David Peterson (2-2, 3.05 ERA)

THE PIRATES: walked off the Braves, 4-3, yesterday afternoon to secure a series victory over Atlanta...Promoted Don Kelly from bench coach to manager on Thursday after relieving Derek Shelton of his duties (Radley Haddad, the team's game planning and strategy coach, was also relieved of his duties)...Have scored four runs or fewer in 17 consecutive games (since April 23 at Los Angeles-AL), tied for the longest-such streak in club history since at least 1901 (also August 12-29, 1908)...Are in the 16th game of a stretch of 34 straight games against National League opponents (April 25-June 1)...Are also in the fourth game of a stretch of nine consecutive games against the National League East (are 6-5 against the division in 2025).

WALK IT OFF: Joey Bart reached on a fielder's choice that scored Adam Frazier and gave Pittsburgh a walkoff victory over Atlanta on Sunday...It was Bart's second career walkoff, both of which have come this season (also April 9 vs. St. Louis, 13th-inning single)...It was also Pittsburgh's third walkoff of the season (Tommy Pham, who played in 79 games for the Mets in 2023, had a walkoff single in the 11th inning on April 6 vs. the Yankees).

JOEY BARRELS: Over his last two games, Joey Bart is 6-for-9 with three RBI...He's the first Pirates catcher with six-plus hits in a two-game span since Elias Díaz (May 18-19, 2019) and the first with six-plus hits and three-plus RBI in a two-game span since Ryan Doumit (September 20-21, 2008)...Bart singled in his first at-bat on Sunday, giving him hits in five consecutive at-bats following his career-high, four-hit game on Saturday...The last Pittsburgh batter to hit safely in six-plus consecutive at-bats within a single season was Ke'Bryan Hayes, who did so in eight straight at-bats from September 25-27, 2020.

EMPIRE STATE OF MIND: Henry Davis, the No. 1 overall selection in the 2021 First-Year Player Draft, was a four-year letterwinner at Fox Lane High School in Bedford, New York (located approximately 45 minutes north of Citi Field)...In five games when catching Paul Skenes (No. 1 overall pick in 2023) this season, Davis has a 2.40 catcher's ERA (30.0ip/8er).

LOCK IN, KE': Ke'Bryan Hayes went 2-for-5 on Sunday vs. Atlanta...He's hit safely in 17 of his last 20 games (since April 19 vs. Cleveland), going 24-for-79 (.304) in that stretch...His .304 average in that span is tied with Colorado's Jordan Beck for eighth-best in the National League (min. 75ab)...The Mets' Francisco Lindor is fourth (.333, 29-for-87).

CARMEN'S ELECTRIC: Carmen Mlodzinski allowed four hits and one walk over 5.2 scoreless innings on Sunday vs. Atlanta...It was the longest scoreless start of his professional career (pitched 5.0 scoreless innings once with Double-A Altoona in 2022 and twice with High-A Greensboro in 2021)...Over his last three starts (since April 30 vs. Chicago-NL), Mlodzinski has a 2.51 ERA (14.1ip/4er).

DENNIS THE MENACE: Dennis Santana, who made nine appearances for the Mets in 2023, struck out a batter while tossing a perfect ninth inning on Sunday vs. Atlanta...In his last 13 outings (since April 6 vs. New York-AL), Santana has a 1.38 ERA (13.0ip/2er), the seventh-lowest mark among National League relievers (minimum 13.0 innings pitched) in that span (the Mets' Reed Garrett, 1.32, ranks sixth)...Santana has not allowed a homer in 43.2 consecutive innings (since last August 3), tied with Detroit's Sean Guenther for the sixth-longest active streak among all Major League pitchers (the Mets' Kodai Senga, 37.2, ranks tied for 10th on that list).

SETTING THE TONE: Over their last six games (since May 5 at St. Louis), Pirates starting pitchers have posted a 2.36 ERA (34.1ip/9er), the fifth-lowest mark in Major League Baseball (the Mets rank seventh with a 2.41 ERA)...Pittsburgh starters have pitched 5.2-plus innings in five consecutive games, the longest-such streak since also doing that in five straight games from May 1-6, 2024.

BUCS ON THE BASES: The Pirates have stolen 45 bases in 2025, tied with Boston for fifth-most in all of MLB...Sunday marked Pittsburgh's fourth game this season with three-plus stolen bases (last on May 2 vs. San Diego)...The Pirates have nine different players with multiple steals, tied with Milwaukee for third-most in all of MLB...Only Seattle (11) and Tampa Bay (10) have more.

ON THIS DATE IN PIRATES HISTORY

May 12, 2008: The Pirates split a doubleheader with the Braves at PNC Park, shutting out Atlanta, 5-0, in the first game and falling, 8-1, in the nightcap. In the first game, Zach Duke tossed 6.0 scoreless innings to earn the win, while Freddy Sanchez gave Pittsburgh the lead with a three-run double off Jair Jurrjens in the fifth inning. Adam LaRoche hit a two-run homer in the eighth.

HOW ACQUIRED: Selected in the first round (No. 1) of the 2023 Draft.

STARTING OFF: Skenes will make his ninth start of the season tonight...Took home BBWAA NL Rookie of the Year honors last season after making his MLB debut on May 11 against the Cubs... Was the first-overall selection by the Pirates in the 2023 First-Year Player Draft out of LSU.

LAST TIME OUT: Skenes allowed two runs in 6.0 innings (six strikeouts), but lost a 2-1 decision on May 6 at St. Louis...Pittsburgh held a 1-0 lead entering the bottom of the sixth inning, but Skenes surrendered the game-winning, two-run double to Alec Burleson that inning...The Cardinals have handed Skenes four of his seven career losses...He's lost consecutive decisions for the second time in his career (also, last July 23 vs. St. Louis and August 10 at Los Angeles-NL).

AGAINST THE METS: Skenes will make his second career start against the Mets...He won a 14-2 decision against Luis Severino last July 5 at PNC Park, allowing two runs on four hits, two walks and a hit batter (eight strikeouts) over 7.0 innings...He is 3-0 in five career starts vs. the NL East.

LIMITING THE HITS: Skenes has allowed six hits or fewer in each of his first 31 starts to begin his Major League career...Per OptaStats, that's tied with Shohei Ohtani for the longest-such streak (excluding openers) to begin a career...Ohtani did it in 31 consecutive starts from 2018-21.

ON THE ROAD AGAIN: Skenes will make his second straight start on the road tonight...He is 7-3 with a 1.36 ERA (86.0ip/13er) through his first 15 starts away from PNC Park...That's the lowest ERA all-time for a pitcher through 15 road starts (first officially tracked in both leagues in 1913).

HOW LOW CAN YOU GO: Skenes' 2.18 ERA (181.2ip/44er) is the lowest of any Major League starter (minimum 20 starts, excluding openers) in the Live-Ball Era...His 2.18 ERA since making his MLB debut on May 11, 2024 is also the lowest among all qualified Major League starters.

OUR ACE: Through the first 25 starts of his Major League career, Skenes had a 1.92 ERA (145.1ip/31er) with 183 strikeouts...Per the Elias Sports Bureau, he's the only Major League pitcher since earned runs became an official stat (1912 in the National League/1913 in the American League) to post a sub-2.00 ERA with 175-plus strikeouts in his first 25 MLB games.

OPENING DAY HONORS: Skenes allowed two runs in 5.1 innings but had a no-decision on Opening Day (March 27) in Miami against the Marlins...At 22 years and 302 days old, Skenes was the youngest Opening Day starter in club history dating back to 1893 (Frank Killen, 22 years and 148 days)...He was also the youngest Major League pitcher to make an Opening Day start since José Fernández, who did so in Miami for the Marlins on March 31, 2014, when he was 21 years and 243 days old...Skenes, who was the top pick in the 2023 First-Year Player Draft, also became the fastest No. 1 overall selection to make an Opening Day start...According to Major League Baseball, the previous quickest to do so were Mike Moore (top pick in 1981 and Opening Day starter in 1984) and Stephen Strasburg (top pick in 2009 and Opening Day starter in 2012).

ROOKIE OF THE YEAR HONORS: Last year, Skenes became the second player in Pirates history to take home BBWAA Rookie of the Year honors, along with Jason Bay in 2004...He became the first rookie pitcher to make at least 23 starts and post a sub-2.00 ERA in a single season since Scott Perry with the Philadelphia Athletics in 1918...He also became the 24th pitcher to win the N.L. Rookie of the Year Award and the first to do so since Devin Williams with Milwaukee in 2020.

IN A LEAGUE OF HIS OWN: Skenes recorded a 1.96 earned run average in 23 starts during his rookie season in 2024...His 1.96 ERA from the time of his big-league debut on May 11 through the end of the season was the lowest in all of MLB...His .198 batting average against was also the lowest by a Pirates starting pitcher in team history (minimum 16 starts)...His 1.96 ERA was the lowest by a Major League rookie pitcher (minimum 18 starts) in the Live-Ball era (since 1920).

ALL-STAR HONORS: Skenes entered the 2024 All-Star break with a 6-0 record, 1.90 ERA, 0.92 WHIP, 89 strikeouts and 13 walks in 11 starts...The strikeout total was the fifth-most in Major League history (since 1901) through 11 starts...When he started for the National League on July 16 in Arlington, he became one of five rookie pitchers to start the All-Star Game, joining Hideo Nomo (1995), Fernando Valenzuela (1981), Mark Fidrych (1976) and Dave Stenhouse (1962).
