Complete Games

RH Spencer Schwellenbach tossed the first complete game of his professional career in his last start, June 11 at Milwaukee, while RH David Peterson tossed a six-hit shutout for the Mets in his last turn, June 11 vs. Washington.

Over the last 10 seasons, tonight features just the second pitching matchup across baseball in which the two opposing starters are each coming off of 9.0-inning complete games. The last such game was June 4, 2016, when the Angels' Jhoulys Chacin squared off against the Pirates' Jeff Locke.

No Braves-Mets game has started two pitchers coming off of complete games since May 13, 1994, when Hall-of-Famer Tom Glavine beat Bobby Jones and the Mets, 7-2.

PLAYER OF THE WEEK: OF Ronald Acuña Jr. was named yesterday as the National League Player of the Week presented by Chevrolet, the fifth such honor of his career...His award spanned May 9 through May 15.

Acuña Jr. hit .619 (13-for-21) with three homers, six RBI, a double, five walks, eight runs scored, a stolen base, a 1.095 slugging percentage and a .692 on-base percentage for the week...He led the majors in batting average, on-base percentage, slugging, OPS (1.787) and hits, ranked second in total bases (23) and tied for third in runs scored.

The 2023 National League MVP hit safely in all six contests, marking his longest hitting streak since hitting in six straight games from April 12th-17th last season...He matched a career-best by reaching base safely at least three times in five consecutive games to begin the week, marking the longest streak in the majors this season and the longest by a Brave since he also reached safely at least three times in five consecutive games from April 9-14, 2023.

Acuña Jr. hit home runs on Monday and Wednesday at Milwaukee, and Saturday against Colorado... His seven homers since being activated from the injured list on May 23rd are tied for seventh-most in the majors during that stretch...Since returning to Atlanta's lineup, he leads the Majors in on-base percentage (.478) and ranks second in OPS (1.179), trailing only Aaron Judge (1.225).

The award was the fifth of Acuna Jr.'s career - August 20, 2018; April 14, 2019; April 19, 2021; and July 3, 2023...His five awards are tied for second-most in Braves' history with Freddie Freeman and Dale Murphy, trailing only Hall-of-Famer Greg Maddux, who won six of his eight career awards with Atlanta.

LOTTA STRIKEOUTS: RH Spencer Strider fanned 13 batters in the start for Atlanta Saturday afternoon and RH Grant Holmes followed with a career-best 15 strikeouts on Sunday, and their 28 strikeouts are the most by the club's starters over any two-game span in franchise history...Braves' starters have 413 strikeouts on the season, trailing just the Phillies (436) and Astros (430) in the majors.

Dating to at least the 1974 season, Atlanta has never had its starting pitcher record double-digit strikeouts in three straight team games.

Atlanta's pitching staff as a whole combined for 35 strikeouts over the final two games of its series versus Colorado, its most over any two-game span of 9.0-inning games in franchise history...The 35 Ks surpassed the previous high of 32 from September 4-5, 2024, also vs. Colorado.

OLSON ON BASE: Matt Olson went 1-for-4 on Sunday afternoon to extend his on-base streak to 17 games...Only the Mets' Jeff McNeil, with an 18-game run, has a longer active streak in baseball.

Olson's run dates to May 29, and he has batted .290/.400/.500 during the streak, compiling a 149 wRC+.

His streak of of seven consecutive games with at least 6.0 innings pitched is tied for the third longest active streak in baseball and tied for the fifth longest this year..

His 89.2 innings pitched on the year are tied for the eight most in baseball this season and third most in the National League.
- 🔥

Pitching to a 1.00 WHIP this year, the fourth-best mark in the NL.

- 🔥

Pitching to a 2.29 ERA in six starts at Truist Park this season.
- 🔥

Recording strikes on 68.7% of pitches thrown, the highest rate in the National League and second-highest in the majors among qualified pitchers.
- 🔥

Producing a 33.7% chase rate on all of his pitches, tied for the fourth highest percentage in baseball and third highest in the National League among qualifiers... Trails teammate Chris Sale (33.9%) and Matthew Liberatore (34.4%) in the NL.

Since the 2024 All-Star Break, Schwellenbach has pitched to a 2.93 ERA in 27 starts, fifth lowest in the National League (min. 25 starts).

Made his first Opening Day roster with Atlanta in his third professional season.
- 🔥

Had a scoreless streak of 16.0 innings to open the season, which covered his first two starts of the season (14.0) and first 2.0 innings of his start against the Phillies...In the Atlanta-era (since 1966), it's tied for the fifth-longest scoreless streak by a Braves hurler to begin a season, along with Jim Britton (1968) and Terrell Wade (1996).

His five games with at least 10 strikeouts through a player's first 33 games are the second most in Braves franchise history, trailing only teammate Spencer Strider.
- 🔥

Through 33 career games, Schwellenbach's 198 strikeouts were the most by any pitcher in major league history through as many outings with 35 walks or less issued (1901).
- 🔥

Schwellenbach has not walked a batter in any of his five career double-digit strikeout performances...His five outings with 10-or-more strikeouts and zero walks are the most by any pitcher through their first 33 career appearances in MLB history, surpassing the previous high of four, held by former New York (NL) teammates, Matt Harvey (2013) and Noah Syndergaard (2014-15).

Became just the 16th in pitcher in major league history (dating to 1901) to make consecutive starts with at least 11 strikeouts and zero walks issued... Clayton Kershaw and Chris Archer are tied for the most with three.
- 🔥

With his start against Boston on May 31, he became the 16th pitcher in MLB history and first Brave with as many as 11 strikeouts on their birthday.
- 🔥

His fifth-inning strikeout of Boston's Wilyer Abreu came on a 100.2 mph four-seam fastball; the fastest pitch of his MLB career...Registered 14 pitches 98.9 mph-or-faster (10 four-seamers, four cutters); accounting for the top-14 fastest pitches of his career before May 31, 2025 (2,985 total pitches).

On June 6, Schwellenbach struck out San Francisco's Wilmer Flores in the bottom of the second inning for his 200th career punchout.
- 🔥

Joined Brandon Beachy and Spencer Strider as the only pitchers in Braves franchise history to eclipse the milestone in 34 career games or less...Strider did so in 21 starts and 13 relief appearances.
- 🔥

Became just the third player in baseball history to record 200 strikeouts and less than 40 walks in their first 34 career games, first since Noah Syndergaard with New York (NL).

In his first year with Atlanta and second professional season, Schwellenbach went 8-7 with a 3.35 ERA (46 ER/123.2 IP) over 21 starts...Made his debut on May 29 against Washington, allowing five hits and three runs while fanning five hitters.
- 🔥

His 122 strikeouts through his first 20 career games were the most by a Braves player through as many games to begin their career in franchise history.
- 🔥

Became the first pitcher in the live ball era to have at least 77 strikeouts and issue 12 walks or less through a player's first 12 career games.
- 🔥

Became the first player in Braves franchise history to strike out at least 10 hitters without allowing a run in one of his first 10 career games.

Aaron Bummer • LHP • 6-3 • 215 • 31 yrs • #49

- Saves/Opp:** 0/0 **Holds:** 1 **1st Batter/Retired:** 25/18 **Inherited Runners/Scored:** 22/11
- Has pitched to a 1.59 ERA (3 ER/17.0 IP) in his last 15 appearances, dating to May 3...It's his best 15-game stretch since joining the Braves organization.
 - In his June 1 outing versus Boston, set a new career high with five strikeouts.
 - Per Baseball Savant, his xERA is 2.41, which is the 11th-best in the National League (95th percentile)...Also ranks highly in barrel percentage (99th percentile, 1.3%).
 - His home ERA is 0.57 (1 ER/15.2 IP) but his road ERA is 6.00 (8 ER/12.0 IP)...Among pitchers with at least 15.2 innings pitched in their home venue, his ERA is sixth-best in MLB.
 - Among pitchers that have faced at least 300 batters since the start of 2024, Bummer's three barrels allowed are the fewest in Major League Baseball...Every other qualifying pitcher has allowed at least six in that span.
 - Has induced a ground ball rate of 58.7%, which ranks in the 95th percentile league-wide...The league-average ground ball rate is 43%...That ground ball rate ranks fifth in the National League (min. 25 IP).

Enyel De Los Santos • RHP • 6-3 • 235 • 29 yrs • #61

- Saves/Opp:** 0/1 **Holds:** 1 **1st Batter/Retired:** 29/22 **Inherited Runners/Scored:** 17/5
- Has thrown his slider 200 times, and has surrendered just eight hits on it...Among pitchers that have thrown at least that many, those eight hits are tied for the fourth fewest in Major League Baseball.
 - In at-bats that end with a changeup, opposing hitters are batting .063 (1-for-16).
 - In at-bats that last three pitches-or-fewer, opponents are batting .239...Fourth pitch-and-on, they're batting .177.
 - On April 8, struck out the side (9th inning) for the 13th time in his MLB career and for the first time this season...He last did it as a member of the San Diego Padres on July 28, 2024, at Baltimore.
 - Last year, allowed 26% of his earned runs (10) in just five games with the Yankees.
 - Tossed an "immaculate inning" on September 27, 2022 vs. the Rays in the seventh inning...Signified the 110th immaculate inning in MLB history, and the fourth in Cleveland's franchise history.

Dylan Dodd • LHP • 6-2 • 210 • 26 yrs • #46

- Saves/Opp:** 0/0 **Holds:** 0 **1st Batter/Retired:** 4/3 **Inherited Runners/Scored:** 7/2
- In 23 appearances since his first outing of the season (AAA/MLB), Dodd has pitched to a 2.53 ERA (6 ER/21.1 IP) with 28 strikeouts and two walks...Owns a 0.94 WHIP in that time...In his last 12 games with Gwinnett, owns a 1.64 ERA (2 ER/11.0 IP).
 - Allowed five earned runs in his first appearance of 2025...Has also allowed just six in 23 appearances since.
 - Has transitioned to the bullpen for the first time in his professional career...Across 19 appearances with Triple-A Gwinnett, the southpaw has gone 2-1 with a 5.40 ERA (11 ER/18.1 IP).
 - At the Triple-A level, has struck out 25 batters and walked just three...Owns a K/9 of 12.27.

Raisel Iglesias • RHP • 6-2 • 190 • 35 yrs • #26

- Saves/Opp:** 8/12 **Holds:** 1 **1st Batter/Retired:** 27/18 **Inherited Runners/Scored:** 4/3
- Has allowed 11 barrels this season, tied for fourth most in MLB among relievers...He allowed seven throughout all of 2024.
 - Has surrendered seven home runs this season, already surpassing his total from all of 2024 (4)...Pitched just 20.1 innings to allow those seven, contrasting the 69.1 innings he covered last season.
 - Has 232 career saves, fifth most among active pitchers.
 - Among pitchers with as many appearances since his Braves debut on August 5, 2022 (179 apps.), Iglesias' 2.59 ERA (51 ER/177.1 IP) is the seventh best in Major League Baseball.
 - Last season, was named August's Reliever of the Month for the third time in his career...Within the month, went 3-0 with a 0.00 ERA (0 ER/13.1 IP) and six saves in 11 total appearances...Allowed just two hits without issuing a walk.

Pierce Johnson • RHP • 6-2 • 202 • 34 yrs • #38

- Saves/Opp:** 1/3 **Holds:** 5 **1st Batter/Retired:** 27/22 **Inherited Runners/Scored:** 15/6
- From April 19 until May 10, retired 26 consecutive batters over nine appearances – the longest such streak of his eight-year MLB career...Since 2000, his 26-batter streak was tied for the second-longest streak by a Brave of not allowing a batter to reach via hit, walk or hit-by-pitch, trailing Raisel Iglesias (38, July 27-August 23, 2024) and tied with Chris Sale (26, April 26-May 1, 2024).
 - From April 19-May 15, posted 11 consecutive scoreless outings...Across 11.0 innings in that time, he struck out 10 and walked one.
 - Has thrown his curveball 69.1% of the time...Among pitchers with at least five appearances so far, he easily leads the field...The second-place pitcher is Toronto's Brendon Little, who has thrown his curve 47.3% of the time.

Dylan Lee • LHP • 6-3 • 214 • 30 yrs • #52

- Saves/Opp:** 1/4 **Holds:** 8 **1st Batter/Retired:** 32/28 **Inherited Runners/Scored:** 14/2
- Has thrown his slider 267 times, and has surrendered just five hits on it...**Among pitchers that have thrown as many, those five hits are the fewest in Major League Baseball...**Every other pitcher with at least 267 sliders has allowed at least eight hits on the offering.
 - Per Baseball Savant, throws the fifth-most-valuable slider in the game (tied), with a Run Value of eight.
 - Has pitched to a 2.76 ERA (5 ER/16.1 IP) at home and a 1.23 ERA (2 ER/14.2 IP) on the road.

Rafael Montero • RHP • 6-0 • 193 • 34 yrs • #48

- Saves/Opp:** 0/0 **Holds:** 4 **1st Batter/Retired:** 24/20 **Inherited Runners/Scored:** 6/0
- Right-handers are batting just .122 off Montero (6-for-49), but left-handers are batting .282 (11-for-39)...**Among all MLB relievers, Montero's .122 opponents' batting average against right-handers is fourth-best (min. 24 games)**...The only pitchers ahead of him are Robert Suarez (SD, .091), Emilio Pagán (CIN, .118) and Nick Mears (MIL, .122).
 - The Braves acquired Montero and cash considerations from the Houston Astros in exchange for a player to be named later...Minor-league right-hander Patrick Halligan was the PTBNL.
 - Prior to the trade, appeared in three games for Houston and posted a 4.50 ERA (2 ER/4.0 IP).
