THE TWINS: After completing their three-game homestand with a 2-1 series victory against the Royals over the weekend, the Twins began their three-game roadtrip with a loss in the Bronx last night...tonight, they will play the second of three at Yankee Stadium...after tomorrow night's finale, Minnesota will travel home to play a seven-game, eight-day homestand with four against the Tigers (August 14-17) and three against the Athletics (August 19-21).
♣ Twins have gone 13-9 against the AL East this season, going 0-1 vs. New York, 6-0 vs. Baltimore, 3-3 vs. Boston, 3-3 vs. Tampa Bay and 1-2 vs. Toronto...it is one of two divisions the Twins have a winning record against (5-4 vs. NL West).

BRONX BUMMMER: The Twins lost to the Yankees last night in New York by a score of 6-2... Zebby Matthews (3-4) was the starter and was issued the loss, allowing three runs (all on solo home runs) on six hits in 5.2 innings pitched, with one walk and a career-high-tying nine strikeouts...the offense recorded just three hits and did not draw a walk...two of the hits were solo home runs from Byron Buxton (24) and Trevor Larnach (16)...the other hit was a Royce Lewis single in the third inning.

RETURN OF THE MATT: The Twins have reinstated outfielder Matt Wallner from the Paternity List...Matt's wife, Sydnie, gave birth to the couple's first child on Saturday morning, a girl named Elliotte Bryn...Wallner has played in 74 games for the Twins this season, hitting .218 (51-for-234) with 11 doubles, three triples, 16 home runs, 27 RBI, 34 runs scored, 34 walks, a .325 on-base percentage, a .496 slugging percentage and an .821 OPS.

To make room for Wallner on the 26-man roster, the Twins have optioned catcher Jhonny Pereda to Triple-A St. Paul...Pereda, who was recalled on Friday, did not appear with the Twins during his stint.

START SPREADING THE NEWS: The Twins and Yankees are playing the second of six games in 2025...Minnesota will host the Yankees for three games from September 15-17...Minnesota has lost eight straight against the Yankees, seeking their first win over New York since a 6-2 victory on April 25, 2023 at Target Field...prior to this stretch, they had gone 5-2 vs. the Yankees from September of 2022-April of 2023.

*Minnesota is 0-6 at Yankee Stadium dating back to April of 2023, their last win here coming on April 14, 2023, a 4-3 victory...prior to this slide, they won three-straight in the Bronx.

*Royce Lewis has hit in all three career games played at Yankee Stadium, going 3-for-8 (.375) with two home runs and two walks (.500 OBP).

LUUUUUUUUUUKE!!!: Luke Keaschall went 0-for-3 last night, snapping his on-base streak to start his career at 12 and his hitting streak to start his career at 11 — both second-best in Twins history...the AL Player of the Week has hit .400 (10-for-25) with three doubles, two home runs, 10 RBI, a .760 slugging percentage and a 1.160 OPS in six games since returning from the Injured List.

♣ In 51 major league plate appearances, Keaschall has struck out just four times...the four strikeouts were April 19 at Atlanta vs. Chris Sale and Raisel Iglesias, Sunday vs. Ryan Bergert and last night vs. Will Warren.

GOOD WOOD: Over the last five games, Twins batters have combined to strike out 39 times in 190 plate appearances...in those five games, since August 6, the 39 strikeouts are fifth-fewest in the AL and 10th-fewest in baseball.

RAKIN' JEFFERS: Ryan Jeffers went 0-for-4 last night, snapping his hitting streak at 12 games, second-longest for a Twin this season (Brooks Lee - 19, May 28-June 20).

◆ Over his last 25 games. Jeffers is hitting .366 (34-for-93) with seven doubles, two home runs, 11 RBI, four walks, a .404 on-base percentage, a .505 slugging percentage and a .909 OPS.

SERIES DISCUSSIONS: Twins are looking to avoid losing their first series since August 1-3 at Cleveland...they need to win tonight and tomorrow night to win the their third-straight series...Minnesota is 16-20-2 in series play, going 10-7-2 at home and 6-13-0 on the road.
₱ Twins would be seeking their first series win over the Yankees since taking two of three from April 24-26, 2023 at Target Field...their last series win at Yankee Stadium was April 13-15, 2023, taking two of three.

FOUR-POINT BUCK: Byron Buxton hit his 24th home run last night and is now four short of his single-season career-high of 28, hit in 2022...he is on pace to finish with 32 home runs.

\$\Phi\$ Since June 17, he has homered nine times in 15 road games, tied for fifth-most in baseball during that span...since that date, he has homered in five different road series': four at Cilicinnati (June 17-19), two at Detroit (June 27-29), none at Miami (July 1-3), one at Colorado (July 18-21), one at Los Angeles-NL (July 21-23) and one last night at New York-AL.

\$\Phi\$ He has a 13.75 at-bat-per-home run ratio, fourth-best in the AL and seventh-best in baseball, trailing Cal Raleigh (9.71), Kyle Schwarber (10.40), Aaron Judge (10.70), Shohei Ohtani (10.90), Eugenio Suárez (11.49) and Junior Caminero (13.52).

\$\Phi\$ Over his last 37 games, Byron Buxton is hitting .314 (44-for-140) with eight doubles, one triple, 14 home runs, 22 RBI, 32 runs scored, 12 walks, a .374 on-base percentage, a .686 slugging percentage and a 1.060 OPS.

MOON MOOSE SHOTS: Matt Wallner homered in his last game played on Saturday vs. Kansas City...it marked Wallner's 16th of the season, extending his single-season career-high — entered the year with 14 as his career-high in 2023...he now has five home runs in his last 11 games...since July 1, he has nine home runs, tied for 11th-most in the AL.

◆ Over his last 17 games, Wallner has reached base safely in 15 games, posting a .412 on-base percentage (14 hits, 13 walks), a .679 slugging percentage and a 1.091 OPS in that span.

I AM THE ONE WHO NACHS: Trevor Larnach has homered three times in his last five games, all on the road — two in Detroit on August 4 and 5 and one last night…over his last eight games overall, Larnach is hitting .308 (8-for-26) with three home runs, six RBI, two walks, a .379 on-base percentage, a .654 slugging percentage and a 1.033 OPS.

◆Larnach's home run last night was his 16th of the season, setting a new single-season career-high, passing his previous high of 15 in 2024…also, he sits at 92 hits (also last season), one more will set a new career-high.

LEFT TURNS: Tonight marks the 23rd time the Twins have faced a left-handed starter this season...Minnesota is 8-14 against lefty starters...they lost their last game vs. a left-handed starter, a 2-0 defeat on Saturday vs. Noah Cameron and the Royals...their last win against a lefty starter was a 5-4 victory on August 3 at Cleveland over Joey Cantillo. **©** Ryan Jeffers is hitting .389 (14-for-36) with a .991 OPS in his last 21 games vs. lefties. **©** Brooks Lee is hitting .346 (18-for-52) with an .863 OPS in his last 29 games vs. lefties. **©** Royce Lewis has posted an .826 OPS in his last 22 games vs. lefties. **©** Austin Martin is 4-for-8 at the major league level vs. lefties this season, including one home run.

ROYAL RUMBLE: Last appeared on August 8 vs. Kansas City as a relief pitcher, replacing starter Joe Ryan...did not factor into the decision of Minnesota's 9-4 victory...allowed a solo home run a Bobby Witt Jr. at the beginning of the sixth, then retired the next six batters before allowing a double to Kyle Isbel, walking Mike Yastrzemski, striking out Witt Jr. then permitting an RBI single to Vinnie Pasquantino in the eighth...was then replaced by reliever Cole Sands.

TIGER KING: Made his first major league start on August 4 at Detroit, opposite Casey Mize, but did not factor into the decision of Minnesota's 3-6 defeat...allowed two runs on four hits (1 HR) with no walks and seven strikeouts in 5.0 innings...faced the minimum amount of batters through four innings...both runs allowed came in the fifth inning on a Wenceel Pérez home run.

Fanned five consecutive batters in first and second innings, striking out the side in the second, and making him the second Twins pitcher all-time with five-straight strikeouts in his first MLB start (first Miles Trombley, 1992 at Detroit)

start (first, Mike Trombley, 1992 at Detroit).

Is the 14th pitcher in Twins history (1961-) to record seven-or-more strikeouts in their first career start...also first since Louis Varland did so on September 7, 2022.

Induced 16 total whiffs, T-11th most by a Twins pitcher so far this season...had a whiff rate

of 48.5 percent, the highest by any Twins starter this season (next highest, Joe Ryan, 46.4).

HOME/ROAD SPLITS: In two appearances on the road so far this season, Adams has gone 0-0, posting a 3.00 ERA (6.0 IP, 2 ER) with one home run, no walks, nine strikeouts and a .238 (5-for-21) opponent batting average; compared to 1-1 with a 8.56 ERA (13.2 IP, 13 ER), two home runs, four walks, nine strikeouts and a .345 (19-for-55) opponent batting average.

◆ In nine games (2 starts) at home in Triple-A this season, Adams is 2-2 with a 4.05 ERA (33.1 IP, 15 ER), two home runs, 16 walks and 34 strikeouts; compared to 1-0 with a 3.26 ERA (30.1 IP, 11 ER), one home run, four walks and 24 strikeouts in 10 road appearances (3 starts).

LEFT/RIGHT SPLITS: Through six major league appearances, left-handed hitters have slashed .432/.460/.727 in 44 at-bats vs. Adams, while righties have slashed .156/.189/.281 in 32 at-bats... lefties have posted an average exit velocity of 90.4 mph, a hard-hit percentage of 48.6 and a whiff rate of 26.8; compared to righties' 88.5 mph, 42,9 hard-hit percentage and 20.5 whiff rate.

◆ In 19 Triple-A appearances (5 starts) this season, left-handed batters have hit .290 (29-for-100) with a .357 on-base percentage, .410 slugging percentage and .767 OPS. right-handed batters have hit .209 (29-for-139), with a .268 on-base percentage, a .295 slugging percentage and a .620 OPS.

THE ARSENAL: Adams uses a six-pitch mix, per Baseball Savant...primarly uses his sinker against right-handed batters while favoring his fastball, changeup and curveball against left-handed batters...here is a look at his pitch breakdown:
