The Mariners and Rangers meet for the 4th of 13 matchups this season, with 6 set to be in Arlington and 7 at T-Mobile Park...the clubs last met for a 3-game series at Globe Life Field from April 23-25, with Seattle taking 2 of 3.

TONIGHT'S TILT...the Mariners continue their 7-game homestand with the first of 3 games against the Texas Rangers...Seattle opened the homestand with a 4-game series win against the Chicago White Sox (3-1)...following Sunday's series finale vs. Texas, Seattle will embark on a 10-day, 9-game odyssey to Cleveland (3 G, June 18-20), Miami (3 G, June 21-23) and Tampa Bay (3 G, June 24-26)...tonight's game will be televised live on **Apple TV+** with **Alex Faust** and **Ryan Spilborghs** in the booth and **Tricia Whitaker** reporting from the field...the game will also be broadcast live on **Seattle Sports (710 AM)** with **Dave Sims** and **Gary Hill Jr.**

ODDS AND ENDS...the Mariners fell to the White Sox by a 3-2 score in 10 innings last night, snapping a 4-game winning streak (June 9-12)...despite the loss Seattle is 9-4 over its last 13 games (5/31-c) and 13-5 over its last 18 games (5/26-c)...the Mariners are 31-5 when scoring 4+ runs in a game...Seattle is 31-3 when out-hitting its opponent.

- **Series-ly Sensational** - Seattle has a 12-4-1 series record over its last 17 series (4/15-c).
- **Get Game 1** - The Mariners have won a franchise record 10-consecutive home series openers dating back to April 15.
- **This Note is Fire** - The Mariners are 1-0 on fireworks nights this season, having beat the Angels, 5-4, in the first fireworks night of the season on May 31.
- **Well Connected** - The Mariners are 5-0 in their City Connect uniforms this season.
- **Programming Note** - Tonight's game will be televised exclusively on **Apple TV+** with **Alex Faust** and **Ryan Spilborghs** in the booth and **Tricia Whitaker** reporting from the field...Saturday's game will be televised on **FOX** with **Aaron Goldsmith** and **AJ Pierzynski** on the call.

FIRST-PLACE MARINERS...the Mariners (40-31) hold 1st place in the American League West Division by 5.5 games over the 2nd place Rangers (33-35) and 8.0 games over the 3rd place Astros (31-38)...the Mariners have held 1st place for 33 consecutive days (5/12-c).

TERRIFIC AT T-MOBILE...Seattle has won 8 consecutive home series dating back to April 15...Seattle's current streak of winning home series marks its longest within a single season since winning 10 consecutive home series from July 27-Oct. 7, 2001...during their current stretch, the Mariners are 20-6 (.769) at T-Mobile Park, 3rd-best home record in the Majors during that span and trailing only Philadelphia (.852/23-4) and Cleveland (.783/18-5)...overall this season, Seattle's 24-12 home record (.667) is 4th-best in MLB, trailing the Phillies (.730/27-10), Guardians (.724/21-8) and Yankees (.688/22-10).

TODAY'S ROSTER MOVES...today the Mariners recalled right-hander **Cody Bolton** from Triple-A Tacoma and optioned last night's starter, right-hander **Emerson Hancock** to Triple-A Tacoma...Hancock made a spot start for the Mariners last night, tossing a career-high 7.0 innings and allowing just 2 runs.

JOY DIVISION...the Mariners are 14-5 (.737) against the AL West Division this season, **2nd-best divisional record in the Majors** this season behind Baltimore (17-6, .739)...Seattle is 3-0 against the Angels, 4-2 against the Athletics, 5-2 against the Astros and 2-1 against the Rangers so far in 2024.

ROCKING THE WEST...tonight's start vs. Texas will be **Luis Castillo's** 5th start against AL West opponents this season...Castillo has not allowed more than 2 runs in any of his previous 4 starts this season vs. the division, with the Mariners winning all 4 games...overall, he is 3-0 with a 2.16 ERA (6 ER, 25.0 IP) with 6 walks and 26 strikeouts, recording a quality start in each of his 4 games against the division.

GOT IT ON LOCK...**Tyler Locklear** went 1-for-4 in last night's game, checking in with his first career home run...Locklear has hit safely in each of his first 4 career **starts**, batting .250 (4x16) with 2 runs, 1 double, 1 home run, 2 RBI and 1 hit-by-pitch, while reaching base at a .294 clip and slugging .500 (.794) OPS through 5 career games...he was selected from Triple-A Tacoma on June 9 and made his Major League debut later that night in Kansas City.

BULLY 'PEN...the Mariners bullpen has posted a 1.50 ERA (2 ER, 12.0 IP) during the current homestand (6/10-c), tallying 15 strikeouts with 5 walks, while limiting opponents to a .171 (7x41) batting average against...during the 'stand, 3 Mariners relievers have tossed multiple innings without allowing a run: **Trent Thornton** (2.2 IP, 0 ER), **Ryne Stanek** (2.0 IP, 0 ER) and **Austin Voth** (2.0 IP, 0 ER).

JULIO HEATING UP...**Julio Rodríguez** over his last 19 games (5/25-c) is batting .311 (23x74) with 15 runs, 1 double, 4 home runs, 12 RBI, 6 walks and 7 stolen bases with an .849 OPS...during that span, he has reached base safely in 18 of 19 games, including 16 games with at least 1 hit and 6 multi-hit games.

NOW THAT IS SOME HIGH-QUALITY STUFF...the Mariners **lead the Majors** with 43 quality starts this season...Seattle is one of 3 starting rotations in the Major Leagues to produce 4 pitchers who have tallied 6+ quality starts this season (also: Philadelphia and Toronto)...**Logan Gilbert** (11 QS), **Luis Castillo** (9), **Bryce Miller** (7) and **George Kirby** (7) have all gone 6.0+ innings while allowing 3-or-fewer earned runs 6+ times this year...the Mariners are also the only team to produce 6 pitchers with at least 4+ QS this season: Gilbert (10), Castillo (8), Miller (7), Kirby (7), **Bryan Woo** (4) and **Emerson Hancock** (4).

IT'S MORE THAN A TREND...the Mariners are 16-7 (.696) in 1-run games and 5-2 (.714) in extra innings this season...Seattle's 1-run record is 2nd-best in the Majors, trailing only Tampa Bay (13-5/.722)...since **Scott Servais** took over as Mariners manager (2016-c), Seattle owns the most 1-run wins (230) across the big leagues...Seattle also owns the best extra innings record (.611/77-49) in the Majors since 2016...Seattle's 63 walk-off wins since 2016 are tied for 3rd-most in the Majors during that span.

HOMESTAND HIGHLIGHTS...Seattle continues a 7-game homestand vs. the White Sox and Texas Rangers (June 14-16)...upcoming ballpark happenings include **'70s Fireworks Night** (6/14 vs. TEX), **African American Heritage Day: A Juneteenth Celebration** (6/15 vs. TEX), **Father's Day - Big Dumper Stadium Seat Cushion** (6/16 vs. TEX), **Youth Softball & Fastpitch Day - Julio Rodríguez Poster** (6/16 vs. TEX).

AS YOU KNOW...the Mariners hold a 2.58 ERA at T-Mobile Park this season, best home ERA in MLB by a wide margin, ranking ahead of the 2nd place Yankees (3.01), but...**DID YOU KNOW?**...over the last 2 calendar months (4/14-c), Mariners pitchers have been nearly unhittable in 27 games at home, posting a 2.16 ERA (59 ER, 246.0 IP) with 56 walks and 269 strikeouts, while holding opponents to a .186 average and a .538 OPS during that span...the Mariners have surrendered more than 4 runs at home only once during the 2-month stretch, while keeping opponents to 2 runs-or-less in 15 of 27 games (55.5%) and 1-run-or-less in 10 of 27 games (37.0%)...during the 2-month span, Seattle is 20-7 (.741) at home, 3rd-best home record in MLB, trailing only Philadelphia (23-5/.821) and Cleveland (19-5/.792).

ABOUT CASTILLO...

- The 31-year-old right-hander is set to make his 15th start of the year and 2nd against Texas...he is also making his 196th Major League start and 5th career start against the Rangers. Has been named an All-Star in 2019, 2022 and 2023. Originally signed as an international free agent by the San Francisco Giants on 12/23/11. Made MLB debut on 6/23/17 vs. Washington (w/ Cincinnati). Signed a 5-year contract extension with the Seattle Mariners on Sept. 24, 2022 after being acquired in a trade with Cincinnati on July 30, 2022.

LAST TIME OUT...L#7 on 6/8 at Kansas City...tossed 5.0 innings and allowed 5 runs on 6 hits (1 home run) with 1 walk and 4 strikeouts.

CRUISE CONTROL...since his start on April 20 at Colorado, the right-hander is 5-3 with a 2.48 ERA (17 ER, 61.2 IP) and a 0.99 WHIP...8 of the 10 starts in that span has been quality starts.

7.7.7...in 2024, Castillo has gone 7.0+ innings and allowed 0 runs on 3 occasions...this is tied for the most in the Majors (also: Ranger Suárez-PHI and Max Fried-ATL)...each of the 3 outings have come since April 20.

BARNSTORMING...since 9/25/22, he has thrown 5.0+ innings in 23 consecutive road starts...marks the T-2nd-longest active streak in the Majors, behind Mitch Keller-PIT (24) and Corbin Burnes-BAL/MIL (27).

WHIFF ARTIST...currently 9th in the AL in strikeouts this season with 85...he is also 3rd in MLB and the AL in swings-and-misses (192) this season...had 6+ strikeouts in 8 consecutive starts from 4/2-5/12.

MASTER OF THE STRIKEOUT...since he made his Mariners debut on 8/3/22, Castillo is tied for the Major League lead with 381 strikeouts (also: Dylan Cease-SD/CWS) and leads the Majors with 863 swings-and-misses.

FOR CLUB & COUNTRY...in MLB history, he ranks highly among Dominican-born pitchers in various categories...minimum 1100.0 innings pitched, he ranks 2nd in SO/9 (9.8), 3rd in SO/BB (3.24), 7th in ERA (3.53) and 17th in strikeouts (1241)...he is 2 strikeouts from tying Juan Guzman (1243) for 16th-most strikeouts and 9 strikeouts from tying Miguel Batista (1250) for 15th-most...among active Dominican-born pitchers, he is 2nd in games started (195), wins (67), innings pitched (1138.0), strikeouts (1241) and quality starts (108), trailing in all to Johnny Cueto (363 GS, 144 W, 2245.0 IP, 1851 SO and 206 QS)...Castillo was born in Bani, Dominican Republic.

CRITICAL MOMENTS...in 2024 is holding opposing hitters to a .200 (5x25) average when there are runners in scoring position with 2 outs...in 26 such plate appearances this season, he has allowed 2 doubles, 1 home run and 1 walk with 7 strikeouts...has gone 16 straight plate appearances without allowing a hit when there is a runner in scoring position with 2 outs.

OF QUALITY...in 7 starts from 4/14-5/18, he was 4-2 with a 2.01 ERA (10 ER, 44.2 IP), 48 strikeouts, 11 walks and a 0.90 WHIP...all 7 starts were quality starts, while opponents slashed .236/.281/.402...he is 1 of 4 pitchers in the Majors this season to have a 7+ streak of quality starts (also: Corbin Burnes-BAL (8), Ranger Suárez-PHI (7) and Luis Gil-NYY (7)).

CHASING A DREAM...entering tonight sits in the 81st percentile for Chase% in the Majors (Chase% measures the proportion of pitches outside of the strike zone that batters swing at) (per Baseball Savant)...has a Chase% of 31.8% so far in 2024, which is the 2nd-best in his career (2019, 32.2%).

60-GAME DASH...is making his 59th start since joining the Mariners in 2022...with 1 start before he reaches 60 career starts for Seattle, he already has the most strikeouts in franchise history through a starting pitchers' first 60 starts (385)...through 58 starts, he ranks 4th with a 3.31 ERA (127 ER, 345.2 IP), trailing James Paxton (3.18), Joel Piñeiro (3.25) and Erik Hanson (3.26).

THE POWER BATS...has held batters in the 3-5 spots in the lineup to a .245 (28x114) average with 7 doubles, 1 triple, 4 home runs and 29 strikeouts this season.

QUALITY AND QUALITY...during his start against the Chicago Cubs on 4/14, he earned his 100th quality start in his career...he is 1 of 30 active pitchers to have 100 or more quality starts in their career.

1,000 AND COUNTING...recorded his 1,000th career strikeout on 5/22/23 against Oakland...he currently has the 26th-most strikeouts among active pitchers with 1,241.

AWARD SEASON...finished 5th in 2023 American League Cy Young Award voting after ranking among the league leaders in fWAR (10th, 3.4), strikeouts (4th, 219), ERA (5th, 3.34), starts (T-1st, 33), SO/9 (4th, 10.01), Opp. AVG (.218/160x735, 3rd) and WHIP (1.096, 6th)...Gerrit Cole-NYY won the award.

CAREER YEAR...set career-best marks in several categories last season, including starts (33, also: 2021), innings pitched (197.0), walks-per-9-innings (2.6, also: 2018), strikeout-to-walk ratio (3.91).

HEY NOW, YOU'RE AN ALL-STAR...was named to his third All-Star team last season, his first with the Mariners (previously: 2019 and 2022)
