**METSCELLANEOUS:** The Mets earned an 8-0 win over the A's in California yesterday...The Mets have not lost back-to-back games this year...The Mets are in a stretch of 13 straight games...They are 2-1 in that span...New York has won nine of their last 12 games...The Mets are in the midst of their second road trip of the year, a six-game road trip (2-1) against the A's (2-1) and Twins (three games)...Following this series, the Mets head home for their second homestand of the season, a seven-game stand against the Cardinals (four games) and Phillies (three games).

**SERIES-LY SPEAKING:** The Mets earned their fourth straight series victory and their second on the road...After dropping their first series of the season, the Mets have won each of their last four series.

**THEY'RE OUT OF OUR LEAGUE:** This year marked the first time in franchise history that the Mets open their home and road schedule against an Interleague Opponent...The Mets are 6-3 in Interleague Play this season...The team went 24-22 in Interleague Play last year...Overall, New York owns a 284-279 record in Interleague play.

**ON THE ROAD AGAIN:** New York hits the road for the second time this season...The Mets are 5-4 on the road this year...The Mets have posted a 2.62 ERA on the road this year, the second-best mark in the majors and the best mark in the NL.

**SHUT UP:** The Mets recorded their third shutout of the season yesterday...They are one of four teams with three or more shutouts this year...Last year, the team did not record a shutout until their 92nd game (7/11 vs. Washington)...They didn't record their third shutout until their 107th game...The Mets recorded a total of nine shutouts last year.

**HERE'S THE PITCH:** The Mets lead the majors with a 2.30 ERA (34 ER/133.0 IP)...They have struck out 138 this season, which is tied for the ninth-most in the majors and is fourth-most in the NL.

**STARTING OFF:** The Mets starting staff has posted an MLB-best 2.55 ERA (22 ER/77.2 IP)...They have struck out 83, which is tied for the eighth-most in the majors and is fourth-most in the NL.

**THE PEN IS MIGHTIER:** Mets relievers have combined to post a 1.95 ERA (12 ER/55.1 IP) this season...That is the third-best mark in the majors...New York relievers have stranded 21 of 26 inherited runners (19.2 percent) the third-best mark in the majors and the best in the NL.

**MAX POWER:** Max Kranick owns a career-high scoreless inning streak of 15.0 IP (since: 5/7/22 at CIN with PIT), including 10.0 innings pitched this season...He has held opponents to a .063 on-base percentage (2-32, 0 BB) which is the best in the majors among relief pitchers (min. 20 BF)...He has not issued a walk to any of his 32 batters faced and is one of four pitchers in the majors this season to not issue a walk and face at least 30 batters.

**WE FOUND NIMMO:** Brandon Nimmo is 4-12 with three runs, one double, two home runs, two RBI, two walks and a 1.345 OPS over his last three games...Nimmo has collected 310 career extra-base hits...That puts him tied with Daniel Murphy for 10th-most on the Mets all-time list...He has drawn 479 career free passes...That is the sixth-most in Mets history...Wayne Garrett is fifth with 482 walks as a Met.

**TWINS-METS NOTES:** The Mets head to Minneapolis for the first time since September 8-10, 2023...The Mets are 6-2 all-time at Target Field.

**WE REMEMBER:** The New York Mets announced that the team will wear a tribute uniform patch all season long to honor Mets Hall of Famer Ed Kranepool...Kranepool passed away on September 8, 2024, at age 79...Kranepool played for the Mets from 1962-1979, spending his entire 18-year career with the Mets...He was a member of the 1969 Miracle Mets, a 1965 All-Star and the club's all-time leader in games played...Kranepool remains in the Mets all-time top 10 in many statistical categories including plate appearances, hits, at-bats, total bases, doubles, RBI, walks and runs scored...He was inducted into the Mets Hall of Fame in 1990.

**THIS DAY IN METS HISTORY:** On this day in 2023, Francisco Lindor tied his career-high as he drove home seven runs as the Mets defeated the A's, 17-6, in Oakland...On this day in 1999, John Franco recorded his 400th career save and struck out three as the Mets defeated the Marlins, 4-1 at Shea Stadium...On this day in 1968, Nolan Ryan recorded his first career win, striking out eight over 6.2 scoreless innings as the Mets defeated the Astros, 4-0 in Houston.

**THE WRIGHT WAY:** On this day in 2012, David Wright went 3-5 with two runs, one home run and an RBI as the Mets defeated the Phillies, 5-0 at Citizens Bank Park...On July 19, the New York Mets will retire No. 5 and induct David Wright into the Mets Hall of Fame...Wright will become the eighth player in franchise history to have his number retired by the Mets, joining Tom Seaver (#41), Mike Piazza (#31), Jerry Koosman (#36), Keith Hernandez (#17), Willie Mays (#24), Dwight Gooden (#16) and Darryl Strawberry (#18).

**10 K CLAY:** In his last start, April 8 vs. Miami, Holmes made his Mets Citi Field debut...The right-hander allowed four runs over 5.1 innings, issued three walks and struck out a career-high 10 batters...Holmes became the fifth Met all-time to record 10 or more strikeouts in their home pitching debut joining Dennis Ribant (10 K on 8/17/1964 vs. PIT), Dick Selma (13 K on 9/12/65 vs. HOU), Aaron Harang (10 K on 9/12/13 vs. WAS) and Max Scherzer (10K on 4/19/22-G2 vs. SF)...Courtesy of *Elias*...Holmes struck out five straight batters starting at his final batter of the third inning until the first batter he faced in the fifth...His 5.1 innings were the second-most he has ever thrown in an outing behind his 6.0 innings pitched in his second career big league start on July 14, 2018 with Pittsburgh.

**ROAD IMPROVEMENT:** In 154 career road outings, Holmes has pitched to a 4.37 ERA (83 ER/171.0 IP)...In 98 road games since 2022, Holmes has posted a 2.71 ERA (31 ER/103.0 IP), a 4.17 earned run average improvement from his first 56 career road games...Since 2022, Holmes ranks seventh in the majors in road ERA (min. 100.0 IP).

**NEW ROLE WHO DIS:** Holmes started for the Mets on Opening Day (3/27 at HOU) in just his fifth career major league start...The first four starts of Holmes' career came in his first big league season, 2018 with Pittsburgh...Holmes is 2-3 with a 6.07 ERA (20 ER/29.2 IP) in his career as a starter...He is just the 10th pitcher in the Expansion Era (since 1961) to start Opening Day having made four or fewer career starts prior, joining Marty Pattin (4, 1969), Tom Hall, (4, 1969), Fernando Valenzuela (1981, 0), Al Holland (1982, 3), Dave Nied (1993, 2), Tanner Scheppers, (2014, 0), Dustin May (2020, 4), Garrett Crochet (2024, 0) and Sean Burke (2025, 3)...Courtesy of Sarah Langs.

**STAYING GROUNDED:** Since 2019, Holmes' 66.6% groundball rate is the second-highest mark in the majors during that span behind Aaron Bummer's 67.4% clip (min. 1000 BF)...In each of the last four seasons, Holmes' groundball rate has ranked in the top five in the majors, including a league-leading 77.0% mark in 2022 (min. 250 BF each season)...Additionally, Holmes has only allowed 18 home runs since 2019, the third fewest in the majors during that span behind only Emmanuel Clase (14) and Bummer (15) (min. 1000 BF).

**CLAYMATION:** Holmes became the seventh Mets pitcher to make their team debut as the club's Opening Day starter...The others are Roger Craig (4/11/62 at STL), Don Cardwell (4/11/67 vs. PIT), Mike Hampton (3/29/00 vs. CHC), Tom Glavine (3/31/03 vs. CHC), Pedro Martínez (4/4/05 at CIN) and Johan Santana (3/31/08 at FLA)...Courtesy of *Elias*...Additionally, Holmes celebrated his 32nd birthday on Opening Day...He became the seventh pitcher in major league history to start Opening Day on their birthday joining Vic Willis (4/12/1906 PIT at STL), Marty Pattin (4/6/1971 MIL at MIN), Bert Blyleven (4/6/73 MIN at OAK and 4/6/79 PIT vs. MTL), Catfish Hunter (4/8/76 NYY at MIL), Jon Lieber (4/2/01 CHC vs. MTL) and Ryan Drese (4/5/05 TEX at LAA)...Courtesy of *Elias*.

**HOPE SPRINGS ETERNAL:** In five Grapefruit League starts, Holmes allowed two runs over 19.1 innings, pitched to a 0.78 WHIP and held opposing batters to a .109 (7-64) average...Four of Holmes' five Grapefruit League outings were scoreless starts, including his first three...Holmes started the Grapefruit League opener for the Mets on February 22 vs. Houston and threw 3.0 perfect innings...The right-hander registered a pair of eight-strikeout performances, March 9 vs. Washington (3.2 IP) and March 21 vs. St. Louis (5.1 IP)...His 23 strikeouts on the Spring were tied for sixth in the Grapefruit League and tied for 13th in the majors...Among pitchers with 15.0 or more innings, Holmes ranked third in the majors in ERA (0.93) and fourth in WHIP.

**LET'S TAKE A LOOK BACK AT LAST SEASON:** In 2024, Holmes made 67 relief appearances with the Yankees and pitched to a 3.14 ERA (22 ER/63.0 IP)...His career-high 30 saves ranked fourth in the American League and eighth in the majors...In his final outing of 2024, September 29 vs. Pittsburgh, Holmes locked up his 74th career save and moved into a tie with John Wetteland for seventh-most in Yankees history (since saves became an official stat in 1969)...Did not allow an earned run in his first 20 games of the season from March 28 - May 19, marking the second-longest season-opening streak in franchise history, trailing only Dellin Betances' season-opening 26-game streak in 2015 (since ER became an official stat in 1913)...His 20.0IP over that span were the most by any major league reliever who had not allowed an earned run during that stretch...Also did not allow an earned run in 23 games from September 25, 2023 - May 19, 2024, the second-longest streak of his career, trailing only a 29-game stretch from April 9 - June 18, 2022...Did not allow an earned run in 29 of his first 30 appearances of the season from March 28 - June 9, going 1-1 with 19 saves and a 1.23 ERA (4 ER/29.1 IP) over that stretch...His 19 saves were tied with Cleveland's Emmanuel Clase (19) for the second-most over that span, trailing only St. Louis' Ryan Helsley (21)...Allowed 14 runs (10 ER) in 14 games from June 13 - July 30...Was named to his second career All-Star team (also: 2022)...Over his final 22 appearances of the year, held opponents to a .188 (12-64) average and was unscored upon in 17 of those appearances...Appeared in 13 Postseason games and went 3-1 with a 2.25 ERA (3 ER/12.0 IP) and 12 strikeouts...Pitched in the Yankees first eight Postseason games...Became the fifth pitcher in major league history to appear in each of their club's first eight postseason games, joining Tyler Matzek (2021 with Atlanta), Greg Holland (2014 with Kansas City), Wade Davis (2014 with Kansas City) and Jesse Orosco (1996 with Baltimore)...Became the 11th relief pitcher in major league history with three or more wins in a single Postseason and the third Yankee to accomplish the feat (also: Sparky Lyle, 1977 and Mike Stanton, 2000).

**REELIN' IN THE YEARS:** Holmes was selected by Pittsburgh in the ninth round of the 2011 First-Year Player Draft out of Slocomb High School (AL)...He was signed by Pirates scout Darren Mazerowski, the son of Hall of Famer Bill Mazerowski...The 6-5, 245-pounder made his major league debut on April 6, 2018 with Pittsburgh vs. Cincinnati and appeared in 91 career games with the Pirates from 2018-2021...Was acquired by the Yankees on June 26, 2021, in exchange for INF Hoy Park and INF Diego Castillo...Established career highs in games (69), innings (70.0 IP), wins (8) and strikeouts (77) during the 2021 season...Became the Yankees closer in 2022 and recorded 74 saves from 2022-2024, the third-most in the AL and the 11th-most in the majors during that span...Earned a career-high 30 saves in 2024 and became the 11th pitcher in Yankees franchise history to record 30+ saves in a season...Is a two-time American League All-Star (2022, 2024) and was twice

named American League Relief Pitcher of the Month (May 2022, Sept./Oct. 2023)...Over 16 career Postseason appearances, is 3-1 with a 1.35 ERA (3 ER/20.0 IP), a 0.90 WHIP and a .172 (11-64) batting average.
