The Brewers are a Major League-best 31-13 (.705) since April 26.

#### That 70s Show

The Brewers are a franchise-best 44-26 (.629) through their first 70 games....the team's previous best record was 42-28 (.600) in 2018.

#### They're Out of Our League

The Brewers are 122-69 (.639) since 2022 during Interleague Play, trailing only the Dodgers (117-66, .639) by percentage points for the best record in the majors....the team is 20-11 (.645) against AL opponents in 2026.

#### Everyone Loves a Winner

Aaron Ashby was credited with the win last night to improve to 10-0 on the season....his 10 wins without a loss are the most in franchise history to start a season, breaking the record of CC Sabathia (9-0 in 2008)....he is just the fourth pitcher in franchise history with 10+ consecutive winning decisions in a season, joining:

#### That's a Fact, Jack!

In his last 16 games, Jackson Chourio is batting .377 (26-for-69) with 8 HR and 21 RBI....during this stretch, he has a .429 OBP/.783 SLG/1.211 OPS.

#### Don't Pitch to Mitch

In his last 23 games, Garrett Mitchell is batting .333 (26-for-78) with 4 HR and 12 RBI....during this stretch, he has a .388 OBP/.615 SLG/1.004 OPS.

#### It's Trevor Time!

Trevor Megill, who had a 14.40 ERA, over his first 6 appearances of the season (5ip, 8er), has a 1.71 ERA in his last 21 outings (21ip, 4er) while holding opponents to a .173 batting average (13-for-75, 4bb, 31k).

**TONIGHT'S GAME:** Is the fifth game (3-1) of a 6-game, 7-day homestand against Philadelphia (2-1) and Cleveland (1-0)....after this homestand, the team takes a 6-game trip to Atlanta (3g) and Cincinnati (3g)....the Brewers return to American Family Field for a 7-game homestand against Chicago-NL (3g) and Cincinnati (4g) from 6/26-7/2.

**IN THE TRAINER'S ROOM:** RHP Coleman Crow (right forearm), LHP Brian Fitzpatrick (left elbow), LHP DL Hall (left pectoral), RHP Logan Henderson (back), LHP Jared Koenig (left elbow), OF Brandon Lockridge (right knee), RHP Quinn Priester (right thoracic outlet), RHP Carlos Rodriguez (right shoulder), RHP Brandon Woodruff (right shoulder), LHP Rob Zastryzny (left trapezius) and LHP Angel Zerpa (left forearm) are on the injured list....Fitzpatrick, Priester and Zerpa are on the 60-day IL.

**MANAGER:** Pat Murphy (394g, 234-160, .594) is in his third season as Brewers manager....he was voted NL Manager of the Year in 2024 and 2025....he is one of four managers ever to win Manager of the Year in consecutive seasons, joining the Braves' Bobby Cox (2004-05), Rays' Kevin Cash (2020-21) and Guardians' Stephen Vogt (2024-25)....Murphy was named the 20th manager in franchise history on 11/15/23, replacing Craig Counsell....he signed a multi-year contract extension on 2/20/26.

**COACHES:** Returning from the 2025 staff is offense & strategy coordinator Jason Lane (11th season/1st in current role), pitching coordinator Jim Henderson (5th season/1st in current role), field coordinator Néstor Corredor (4th season/3rd in current role), pitching coach Chris Hook (8th season), bullpen coach Charlie Greene (3rd season), lead hitting coach Eric Theisen (2nd season/1st in current role) and third base coach Matt Erickson (3rd season/1st in current role)....assistant pitching coach Juan Sandoval, hitting coach Guillermo Martinez, hitting coach Daniel Vogelbach and first base coach Spencer Allen are all in their first seasons on the coaching staff.

**IN THE STANDINGS (83 days):** The team has spent the following number of days alone or tied at each spot in the NL Central standings: **FIRST:** 45, **SECOND:** 10, **THIRD:** 8, **FOURTH:** 13, **FIFTH:** 7....the Brewers are currently in first place, leading the second-place Cardinals by 4.5 games.

**AT HOME:** The Brewers are 24-14 at home, going 8-3-1 in series play....the team has a pair of season-high 5-game winning streaks coming from 4/30-5/12 and 5/25-6/2.

**ON THE ROAD:** The Brewers are 20-12 on the road, going 7-3-1 in series play....the team is 12-4 in its last 16 road games and had a season-high 5-game winning streak from 5/31-6/8.

**LET'S GO TO THE VIDEO TAPE:** The Brewers have made 22 replay challenges this season, going 16-6....their last challenge (lost) came on 6/8 at Athletics as an out call at first base involving Brice Turang was confirmed.

**BREWING SUCCESS:** The Brewers have qualified for the postseason seven times in the last eight seasons and three seasons in a row....the team was just two games away from making the postseason in nine straight seasons (2017-25), missing out in both 2017 and 2022 by a single game....Milwaukee has won the NL Central in four of the last five seasons and three seasons in a row.

**BREWING CONSISTENCY:** The Brewers, Astros and Dodgers are the only Major League teams with 86+ wins in each of the last eight full seasons (2017-25)....this does not include the shortened 2020 season....the Brewers have 807 wins since 2017, which ranks fourth in the majors behind the Dodgers (900), Astros (840) and Yankees (832).

**TONIGHT'S STARTER: #23 - RHP BRANDON SPROAT (13g, 11gs, 1-4, 5.70)**

**2026 Arsenal: Sinker (27.4%) - Cutter (26.6%) - 4-Seam Fastball (19.7%) - Curveball (11.4%) - Sweeper (8.2%) - Changeup (6.7%)**

**SPROAT AT A GLANCE:** Brandon Sproat, 25, will be making his 14th appearance and 12th start of the season....Sproat last pitched last Wednesday in a start in Las Vegas against the Athletics and had no decision in the Brewers' 4-3 loss (6ip, 4h, 1r, 1er, 1bb, 3k, 1hr, 68 pitches)....he left the game with a 3-1 lead....the team is 6-5 in his starts....he has 2 quality starts....opponents are batting .263 (59-for-224, 12hr)....he was acquired from the Mets with INF/OF Jett Williams on January 21 for RHP Freddy Peralta and RHP Tobias Myers....he entered 2026 as the fifth-best prospect in the Brewers organization according to *Baseball America*....Sproat was selected by the Mets in the second round of the 2023 First-Year Player Draft out of the University of Florida.

**LAST SEASON:** Sproat entered the 2025 season as the second-best prospect in the Mets organization according to *Baseball America* with his changeup rated best in the system....he went 8-6 with a 4.24 ERA in 26 games/25 starts at Triple-A Syracuse....he was named International League Pitcher of the Month for July (5gs, 2-0, 0.67era)....Sproat was selected by the Mets on September 7 and went 0-2 with a 4.79 ERA in 4 starts....he made his Major League debut on 9/7 at Cincinnati and carried a no-hitter into the sixth inning but took a 3-2 loss (6ip, 3h, 3r, 3er, 4bb, 7k).

**CAREER:** Is 1-6 with a 5.47 ERA in 17 games/15 starts (80.2ip, 77h, 49r, 49er, 37bb, 74k, 12hr)....has pitched for New York-NL (2025) and Milwaukee (2026).

**CAREER AT AMERICAN FAMILY FIELD:** Is 1-2 with a 6.33 ERA in 6 games/5 starts, all coming this season (27ip, 19er).

**CAREER ON THE ROAD:** Is 0-4 with a 5.36 ERA in 9 games/8 starts (43.2ip, 26er)....is 0-2 with a 5.18 ERA in 7 games/6 starts this season (33ip, 19er).

**CAREER vs. GUARDIANS:** Sproat has not faced Cleveland.

**ODDS & ENDS:** Sproat graduated from Pace (FL) High School, where he played football (quarterback) during his freshman and sophomore years in addition to four years of baseball....he enjoys golf, hunting, fishing and the outdoors.
