FLIGHT PATTERN: The St. Louis Cardinals and visiting Athletics open a three-game series today as both teams celebrate Labor Day at Busch Stadium ... The Cardinals enjoyed a short three-game weekend road trip in Cincinnati by taking two-of-three from the division-rival Reds at Great American Ball Park ... With 24 games remaining in the regular season, the Cardinals open play today in 4th place in the National League Central, 17.0 games behind first place Milwaukee and 5.5 games out of the final NL Wild Card position.

ROSTER EXPANSION: As Major League rosters expand to 28 players for September, the Cardinals activated OF Victor Scott II from the 10-Day Injured List and recalled RHP Chris Roycroft from Memphis (AAA) ... Scott II, who has missed 13 games due to a left ankle sprain, recently played three injury rehab games with Springfield (AA) over the weekend ... Today's recall marks Roycroft 4th stint with St. Louis season.

WINNING FORMULA: The Cardinals are needing a 14-10 run over their final 24 games to finish with a winning mark, above .500 ... The Cardinals have had winning marks in 25 of their past 31 seasons since joining

the NL Central Division in 1994 and in 23 of their 25 seasons played since 2000.

BACKSTOP BRILLIANCE: When rookie **Jimmy Crooks** went yard yesterday in Cincinnati, the 24-year-old became the first Cardinal to homer for his first MLB hit since OF **Lane Thomas** (April 19, 2019 vs. New York Mets) and just the 3rd catcher in franchise history to do so with **Bill Warwick** (Sept. 13, 1925 vs. Pittsburgh) and **Ray Stephens** (Sept. 20, 1990 vs. Philadelphia).

- Before Crooks, the last left-handed-hitting catcher to hit his first career homer with the St. Louis was Mike LaValliere (June 19, 1986 at Philadelphia).
- Four Redbirds backstops have now homered this season (Iván Herrera, Pedro Pagés, Yohel Pozo, & Crooks), most since 2010 when Yadier Molina, Steven Hill, Matt Pagnozzi, & Jason LaRue went yard.

INTERLEAGUE ACTION: St. Louis is 286-281 all-time in Interleague play, with a .504 win pct. that ranks 15th-best MLB ... The Cardinals are 20-22 in Interleague games this season, but just 8-13 at home after dropping their last seven (June 5-present).

LABORING: The Cardinals are 91-106-3 all-time on Labor Day since it became a national holiday in 1894, but are 52-31-2 in St. Louis (3-6 at Busch Stadium III).

The only time that St. Louis has faced an American League team on Labor Day was Sept. 1, 1997 against the Chicago White
Sox at Busch Memorial Stadium, when 23-year-old rookie outfielder Magglio Ordóñez hit a game-winning solo homer off
Tony Fossas in the 9th inning of a 5-4 loss to the ChiSox ... That afternoon marked the Pale Hose's first appearance at Busch
Memorial Stadium in history and first return to St. Louis since playing the Browns at Sportsman's Park on Sept. 27, 1953.

ENDING ON A HIGH NOTE: Since 2000, the Cardinals 406 combined regular season wins in September/October are 2nd-most in Major League Baseball behind only the Yankees (417) ... St. Louis ended last season by going 15-11 in Sept./Oct.

A CASE OF THE MONDAYS: The Cardinals (6-0) and Brewers (6-0) are the only two MLB teams to go undefeated on Monday since the All-Star Break ... Overall in 2025, St. Louis is 11-7 (.611) on Monday, T-3rd-most wins in MLB ... The 1991 Redbirds (15-5) sport the franchise's single-season most Monday wins, while the 2005 and 2019 Cardinals both were 14-2 (.875).

OAKLAND/SACRAMENTO/LAS VEGAS ATHLETICS CONNECTIONS

Sonny Gray was selected by Oakland in the 1st round (#18) of the 2011 MLB Draft...pitched parts of this first five seasons with the Athletics (2013-17) before traded to the Yankees with international bonus slot money for Dustin Fowler, James Kaprielian, and Jorge Mateo (July 31, 2017).

Yohel Pozo played two minor league seasons for Triple-A Las Vegas (2023-24) in the Athletics organization...made his MLB debut vs. Oakland while with Texas (Aug. 13, 2021) and singled off Cole Irvin for his first MLB hit.

Daniel Descalso was born in Redwood City, Calif...graduated from Saint Francis High School in Mountain View in 2004...played college baseball at University of California, Davis (2005-07)...resides in Danville, Calif.

Cardinals Hall of Famer Willie McGee played 29 games for the Athletics in 1990 and was a member of their AL Championship squad...traded by St. Louis to Oakland for Daryl Green, Félix José, and Stan Royer...was born in San Francisco...graduated from Harry Ells High School in Richmond...played college baseball at Diablo Valley College in Pleasant Hill...worked as an assistant coach for Contra Costa College in San Pablo...resides in Hercules.

Cardinals Video Coordinator **Chad Blair** previously served in a similar role with the Athletics from (1988-95)...is a native of nearby Santa Rosa, Calif.

Athletics Quality Control Coach **Marcus Jensen** played 16 games for St. Louis in 1999.

Cardinals Hall of Famer Matt Holliday played 93 games for the 2009 Athletics before traded St. Louis for Clayton Mortensen, Shane Peterson, and Brett Wallace (July 24, 2009).

Dean Kiekhefer pitched in four games for the Athletics during the 2018 season.

Former 1999 Athletics 2nd round draft pick **Ryan Ludwick** and **Jason Isringhausen**, who pitched for the Athletics (1999-2001), are both Cardinals Player Development Special Advisors.

Athletics Hitting Coach Mike Aldrete was the Cardinals assistant hitting coach (2008-11) and bench coach (2012-14)...member of the Cardinals 2011 World Championship team and 2013 National League pennant winner...his son, Michael Aldrete, was selected by St. Louis in the 39th round of the 2012 Draft.

Brandon Allen played in 44 games for the Athletics from 2011-12 & was the A's Opening Day First Baseman in 2012.

Hall of Famer **Dennis Eckersley** pitched nine seasons with Oakland (1987-95) and two with St. Louis (1996-97)...converted 386 of his 390 career saves between the Athletics (320) and Cardinals (66).

Cardinals Manager of Player Development & Performance **Emily Wiebe** grew up in nearby San Francisco, Calif...attended University High School.

Francisco, Calif...attended University High School. Cardinals Hall of Famer and broadcaster idwest analyst **AI Hrabosky** was born in Oakland, Calif. Athletics Head Athletic Trainer **Jeff Collins** is a SIU-Edwardsville graduate.

Hall of Fame Manager **Tony La Russa** was a manager of the Athletics (1986-95) and Cardinals (1996-2011)...is only manager to win multiple pennants in both leagues and one of two (Sparky Anderson) to win a World Series in both...His 70 postseason victories (50 with St. Louis, 19 with Oakland, & 1 with Chicago) rank 2nd to Joe Torre (84)...La Russa piloted the A's to four division titles, three AL pennants. and the 1989 World Championship...is A's franchise wins leader (798)...also played parts of four seasons in Oakland (1968-71).

Cardinals Hall of Famer Mark McGwire played parts of 12 seasons in Oakland (1986-97)...1987 AL Rookie of the Year...1989 World Series Champion & member of three AL pennant winners (1988-90)...eight-time AL All-Star (1987-92, '95-97)... won two Silver Sluggers (1992 & '96) and one Golove (1990)...selected by Oakland in the 1st round (#10) in the 1984 MLB Draft..traded to St. Louis for Eric Ludwick, T.J. Mathews and Blake Stein.

Cardinals broadcaster **Chip Caray**'s son, **Chris Caray**, is an Athletics broadcaster.

Cardinals broadcaster **Brad Thompson** was born in Las Vegas...graduated from Cimarron-Memorial High School in Las Vegas in 2000.

Athletic writer **Katie Woo** is a native of Vacaville, Calif...previously covered the Giants, 49ers, & Warriors for NBC Sports Bay Area & California.

TODAY'S GAME:

- The Cardinals Opening Day starter is set to make his 28th start of the season (336th career appearance/326th start). It's his 56th career start for St. Louis.
- Ranks 7th among active pitchers with 325 starts.
- Passed Barry Zito (1,885) for 110th in career strikeouts in his lst start with 1,892. Josh Beckett ranks next in 109th with 1,901.
- Is the first Cardinal with back-to-back 10-win seasons since Adam Wainwright (2021-22).
- Has a 8-4 record with a 3.57 ERA (10 HR) in 17 home starts, but 4-3 with a 5.24 ERA (10 HR) in 10 road starts.
- Boasts the 2nd-highest strikeout percentage on the Sweeper (49.5) trailing only **Garrett Crochet** (BOS, 50.7) of those with 150 or more batters faced.
- The Cardinals are 19-8 in Gray's 27 starts this season. Tied with Philadelphia's Cristopher Sanchez for 2nd and trailing San Francisco's Robbie Ray and Detroit's Tarik Skubal (20) for most team wins any pitcher.
- St. Louis is 13-4 in his 17 home starts this season, most wins by a home team record for any starting pitcher in MLB this season. Toronto's Chris Bassitt (12) is 2nd.
- Sonny's 17 wins at home since joining St. Louis (2024-25) are 3rd-most in the majors behind Tarik Skubal and Carlos Rodon (18).
- Leads the Cardinals staff in percentage of Swings That Miss (27.2%) 10th-best in the NL.
- Has 20 career double-digit strikeout games, including three since May 19. Since his career began in 2013, ranks T-28th among his peers in 10+K games.
- Issued one-or-fewer walks in MLB-leading 21-of-27 starts this season; St. Louis is 15-6 in those games.
- Has six scoreless starts of 6.0 innings or more, tied for 2nd-most in MLB behind Detroit's LHP Tarik Skubal (11)
- Is one of 11 pitchers in Busch Stadium III history with 200+ strikeouts (250 K). Kyle Lohse ranks 9th with 297 strikeouts.
- 20 of his 152 hits allowed in 2025 have been homers and 34 of his 77 runs (44.1%) allowed this season have come via home run.
- Over past two seasons since joining St. Louis (2024-25), ranks among MLB leaders in strikeouts (371, 6th) and wins (25, T-6th).
- St. Louis is 36-19 (.655) in his 55 starts with the club since joining in 2024; His record stands at 25-16 while wearing the Birds on the Bat.

LAST TIME OUT (Friday, August 27 vs. Pittsburgh Pirates): Pitched a solid 7.0 innings allowing just three hits accounting for two runs (1 ER) and matched his season-high with three walks. A Tommy Pham bases loaded two-RBI single accounted for both runs in the 6th inning.

2025:

- Has two starts holding the opposition to one hit this season (8/4 at LAD 7.0 IP & 6/27 at CLE 9.0 IP).
- Authored a one-hit complete-game shutout masterpiece at CLE (6/27) striking out a season-high 11 Guardians on only 89 pitches in the 5-0 Cardinals win. His only blemish was a two-out Nolan Jones single in the bottom of the 5th inning.
- Marked Gray's 5th career shutout and first since July 28, 2015 at Los Angeles Dodgers. It was the 11th time a Cardinal threw a one-hitter, one batter over the minimum since 1901, and first since **Jordan Montgomery** at Wrigley Field on Aug, 22, 2022.
- Since pitch counts were accurately kept in 1988, Gray joined David Cone's perfect game (July 18, 1999) as the only two pitchers to throw shutouts of one hit or fewer with 10+ strikeouts in 89 pitches or fewer.
- His 19 starts before the All-Star Break tied his single-season most (2014).

GRAY vs. ATHLETICS

- Pitched for the Athletics from 2013-17 making 112 starts (114 app.), his most with any MLB organization. Was 44-36 with a 3.42 ERA over that period while making two postseason starts in 2013.
- Is a career 2-1 with a 3.38 ERA over six starts against the Athletics. ade his first appearance in 2018 with the Yankees and most recently in 2024 with the Cardinals in their final visit to the Coliseum.
- Pitched 6.0 scoreless innings of four-hit ball en route to a 3-1 win on Jackie Robinson Day in 2024 as a member of the Cardinals.
- Facing the Athletics for the first time at Busch Stadium.
