## TONIGHT'S GAME:

- Is Game 3 (0-2) of a 4-game series vs **Luis Dorante's Marlins** and the third game (0-2) of a 7-game homestand before the All-Star break that includes a weekend series vs the **Rockies**.
- Following Sun's "first-half" finale vs **Col**, the Reds will enjoy 4-day break before lifting the lid on the season's "second half" at **NYM** (7/18-7/20) and **Wsh** (7/21-7/23).
- The Reds are coming off a 2-4 road trip at **Bos** (1-2) and **Phi** (1-2).

**ABBOTT AN ALL-STAR:** On Tue, **LHP Andrew Abbott** was named to the National League All-Star team as a replacement for **LAD's Yoshinobu Yamamoto**.  
It's his first career All-Star selection.

**ELLY DE LA ALL-STAR:** On Sun, **SS Elly De La Cruz** was named to the National League All-Star team for the second consecutive season.

- He's the first Reds player to be selected as an All-Star in back-to-back years since **Joey Votto** (2017-18).
- Is the sixth primary shortstop in Reds history to make consecutive All-Star teams, joining **Barry Larkin** (1988-91, '93-'97, '99-2000), **David Concepcion** (1975-82), **Leo Cardenas** (1964-66), **Roy McMillan** (1955-57), and **Eddie Miller** (1943-44, '46-'47).
- Is the seventh Red to earn multiple All-Star selections within his first 3 career seasons, the first since **Chris Sabo** (1988, '90).
- Joins **Johnny Bench** (4, 1968-71), **Frank Robinson** (3, 1956-59), and **Vada Pinson** (2, 1959-60) as the only Reds players named to multiple All-Star teams before turning 24.

**FRANCONA CLOSING IN ON 2000 WINS:** **Terry Francona** enters tonight's game 4 wins away from reaching 2,000 as a Major League manager.

- He'd become the 13th manager to reach the 2,000-win milestone.
- Would be the second active manager in the majors with 2,000 wins (**Tex** **Bruce Bochy** 2,216).
- Each big league skipper with 2,000 career wins, except for **Bochy** and **Dusty Baker**, are in the Hall of Fame.
- Baker** (2,183) and **Sparky Anderson** (2,194 wins) are the only 2,000-win skippers to manage the Reds.
- Leo Durocher** is the only 2,000-win manager to play for Cin (1930-33).
- Would be the fourth manager to earn his 2,000th win for a team he once played for (1987), joining **Bochy** (**SF**), **Bucky Harris** (**Det**), and **John McGraw** (**NYG**).

**SERIES NOTES:** The Reds are 135-106 all-time vs the **Marlins**, including 42-29 here at **Great American Ball Park**.

- The **Marlins** have clinched the 2025 season series vs **Cin**...it's **Mia's** first season series victory over the **Reds** since 2018 (5-2).
- Cin went 1-2 at **Mia** from 4/21-4/23 when the roof was open for all 3 games at **loanDepot park**...it marked the Reds' first series loss to the **Marlins** since 8/7-8/9, 2023 at **GABP** (1-2).
- The Reds have gone 24-15 over the last 7 seasons (6-1 in 2019, 0-0 in 2020, 5-2 in 2021, 4-3 in 2022, 3-3 in 2023, 5-2 in 2024, 1-4 in 2025) following 4 straight season series losses to the **Marlins**.

## 5 RUNS OVER 4 GAMES

After scoring 26 runs over a 4-game span from 6/30-7/4, the Reds have since managed just 5 runs over their last 4 games.

- This stretch marks the second time this season in which Cin plated 5 runs or fewer over a 4-game span (also: 4/1-4/4, 2 runs).
- Haven't scored 5 runs or fewer over a 5-game span since 9/22-9/28, 2024 when they dented the dish just 3 times in 5 games.

**HARD TO SWALLOW:** The Reds have lost 19 games this season in which they held a lead, including each of their last 4 games.

- Have scored 2 runs or fewer in 30 games this season, including each of their last 4 games.
- Have been held to 1 hit in a game 3 times this season, including Sun at **Phi** (**Zack Wheeler**, 1-hit CG).
- Are 2-37 this year when trailing after 7 innings.
- Are 1-40 when trailing after 8 innings, their lone victory in that scenario coming on 6/29 vs **SD** (trailed 2-1 entering the 9th inning, won 3-2).

**NO ROOM FOR THE BROOM:** The Reds have not been swept in any of their first 29 series this season, including the recently-completed 3-game set at **Phi** (1-2).

- Marks their longest streak of consecutive series without being swept to open a season since 1989, when they went 30 straight series before getting broomed in a 3-game set from 7/17-7/19 vs **Phi**.
- The Reds are the only Major League team that have yet to be swept this season.

**WREAKING HAVOC IN THE FIRST:** The Reds have scored at least 1 run in the 1st inning 28 times this season, including last night vs **Mia** (Matt McLain's solo HR)...from 6/29 to 7/7 didn't score a run in the first inning in 8 straight games, matching a season-high (also: 6/8-6/17).

- Cin has outscored opponents 64-41 in the first inning and are slashing .255/.338/.405 with 11 home runs.

**THE FUTURE IS HERE:** **C Alfredo Duno** and **INF Sal Stewart** will represent the Reds organization in the 26th edition of the **All-Star Futures Game** on 7/12 at **Truist Park** in Atlanta, GA.

**LAST TIME OUT:** Did not factor in the decision in the 9-6 win on Fri (7/5) at Phi (3.1ip, 9h, 4r/4er, 0bb, 2k, 1hr, 66TP).

- Was his shortest start of the season and his shortest start since 7/13/24 vs Mia (3.1ip).
- Faced 7 batters in the first inning and allowed 3 runs (3er) on 4 hits and 31 pitches (1hr).
- Hadn't thrown 31 or more pitches in an inning since 8/18/24 vs KC (32 pitches in the 3rd inning).

**JUNE 28:** Did not factor in the decision in the 6-4 loss on 6/28 vs SD (5.0ip, 7h, 1r/1er, 2bb, 4k, 1hr, 102TP).

- Was in line for the victory until the Padres plated 5 unanswered runs in innings 6-7.
- Was his 11th start this season in which he allowed fewer than 2 runs.
- Threw 52 pitches in his final 2 innings of work.
- Issued a free pass to Jose Iglesias in the 4th inning...had not walked any of his previous 73 consecutive right-handed batters dating back to 6/4 vs Mil.

**JUNE 22:** Earned the 4-1 win on 6/22 at StL (7.0ip, 3h, 1r/1er, 0bb, 3k, 100TP).

- Was his third app of the season in which he pitched at least 7.0 innings while allowing fewer than 2 runs.
- Marked his second consecutive start in which he didn't walk a batter.
- Was the third time this season he reached 100 pitches.
- Retired his final 18 batters.
- Became the first Reds starter to allow 1 run or fewer to StL in at least 3 straight starts since Luis Castillo did it in 4 consecutive starts against the Cards from 7/23/18-7/20/19.

**JUNE 17:** Did not factor in the decision in the 6-5 win vs Min on 6/17 (5.2ip, 8h, 5r/1er, 0bb, 5k, 2hr, 90TP).

- Was reached for 5 runs for the second time in 3 starts, but only 1 was earned.
- In the 4th inning induced groundouts to the first 2 batters he faced before Ty France reached on a throwing error by 3b Christian Encarnacion-Strand...the next 2 batters singled in 2 runs before Harrison Bader hit a 2-run homer...all 4 runs that inning were unearned.
- His 3rd inning strikeout of Bader was the 300th of his career... became the fifth-fastest Reds pitcher by appearances (58) to reach the 300K mark since 1893 (*courtesy Elias*).

**JUNE 10 (COMPLETE GAME SHUTOUT):** Threw his first career complete-game shutout in the 1-0 win at Cle on 6/10 (9ip, 3h, 1bb, 5k, 110TP).

- Was the first CG SHO by a Reds pitcher since Hunter Greene's on 6/6/22 vs AZ (7ip)...was the first 9-inning CG SHO by a Reds pitcher since Wade Miley's no-hitter at Progressive Field on 5/7/21.
- Had a runner in scoring position just twice, once in the 2nd inning and once in the 8th...4 of his 31 batters reached base.
- Was ahead in the count to just 38.7% of his batters (12 of 31), the fourth-lowest such percentage of his 11 starts.
- Threw first-pitch strikes to 20 of his 31 batters (64.5%).
- His 110 pitches were the second-most he's ever thrown in a game (113TP on 7/25/23 at Mil, 6.0ip).

**LAST TIME OUT:** Suffered the 5-1 loss on Sat (7/5) at Phi (6.0ip, 4h, 3r/3er, 2bb, 8k, 2hr, 85TP).

- Held Phi scoreless through 4.1 innings (2h, 55TP) until Edmundo Sosa's solo homer in the 5th.
- After Alec Bohm's 1-out, 2-run homer in the 6th, induced a Nick Casatellanos ground out and a J.T. Realmuto strikeout to conclude his outing
- Was his 10th quality start...is the first time in his career he's reached 10 quality starts in a season...is the first Reds' LHP to reach 10 QS in a season since Wade Miley in 2021.

**ALL-STAR:** On Tue was named to the National League All-Star team as a replacement for LAD's Yoshinobu Yamamota...it's Abbott's first career All-Star selection.

**Vs LEFTIES:** Over his last 2 outings, left-handed batters are 7-for-14 (1hr, 1bb, 3xbh)...over his first 13 outings held lefty swingers to a .178/.241/.329 slash line.

**HE EARNED IT:** His 3.37 ERA (331.0ip, 132r/124er) through his first 61 career starts is the lowest by a Reds starting pitcher in that span since RHP Mario Soto (3.27, 1977-82).

**EASY AS 1-2-3:** Is holding top of the order batters (1, 2, 3) to a .223/.271/.339 slash line (27-for-121, 4hr, 20 hard-hit pitches).

**IN HIS MAY ERA:** His 0.55 ERA in May was the lowest among qualified Major League pitchers...is his lowest ERA in a month since pitching to a 1.21 mark in June 2023 (5gs, 4qs, 29.2ip, 4er, 16h, 12bb, 30k, 3hr).

- Was the first Reds pitcher to post a 0.55 ERA over a 6-start, single-season span (min. 30ip) since RHP Hunter Greene's 0.48 ERA last year from 6/30-8/3.
- Was the first Reds starting pitcher to open a season with a 1.55 ERA or lower over his 9 starts since RHP Johnny Cueto pitched to a 1.25 ERA over his first 9 starts in 2014.

**PERSONAL:** Graduated from Halifax County High School (South Boston, VA), the same school attended by All Elite Wrestling champion “**Hangman**” **Adam Page** and Major League pitcher **Jeremy Jeffress**...was named 2017 Gatorade Virginia Player of the Year...was a 4-year member of the Halifax swim team...at the University of Virginia became only the second pitcher in school history to record at least 300 strikeouts.
