CAREER

Tall right-hander from the University of Oklahoma developed into a reliable member of Washington's starting rotation and a leader in the clubhouse.

- After making 33 starts in 2024 and 2025, he joined **Max Scherzer** (2015-16) as the only two pitchers in Nationals history to start at least 33 games in back-to-back seasons.
- Had the "Best Control" in Washington's system, per *Baseball America*, entering the 2023 season.

LAST START

Irvin tossed 5.0 innings and allowed five earned runs on three hits and two walks with a strikeout...He took his fifth loss of the season in the 5-4 loss to the Atlanta Braves on July 30.

VS. PHILADELPHIA

Irvin is set to make his eighth career start against the Phillies...He holds a 0-5 record with a 6.42 ERA (29 ER/40.2 IP) with 28 strikeouts against Philadelphia.

REHAB APPEARANCES

Irvin allowed just two hits (2-for-38) with 12 strikeouts and one walk in 11.1 innings across three rehab outings with the FCL Nationals and Double-A Harrisburg Senators...In two outings with Harrisburg, he allowed one hit in 8.1 innings with nine strikeouts and one walk.

CURVIN' IRVIN

Opponents are batting .122 (6-for-49) against Irvin's curveball...He has given up one extra-base hit on his curveball this season.

2025

Was tied for second in Major League Baseball with 33 starts and ninth in the National League with 180.0 innings pitched.

- Matched a career high with 8.0 shutout innings against San Francisco on May 24...The game was completed in 1 hour, 52 minutes, tied for third fastest game in Nationals history (2005-pres.)...Irvin has pitched in two of the top six fastest games in Nationals history.
- Tossed 7.1 innings on April 25 vs. New York (NL)...Allowed one earned run on five hits with four strikeouts and one walk.
- Worked 7.0 innings or more in four starts this season...He went 3-0 in those games.
