WORDS ON THE BIRDS: The Cardinals and Reds conclude their three-game Memorial Day weekend series at Great American Ball Park this afternoon after splitting yesterday's day/night double-header...following today's game, the Cardinals will visit Milwaukee for a three-game series at American Family Field that begins on Memorial Day tomorrow afternoon...the Cardinals completed a 3-3 homestand (2-1 vs. KC, 1-2 vs. PIT) last Thursday with a 6-2 loss and have gone 2-3 over their last five games...St. Louis is 13-13 at home and 16-9 in road games this season - the third most road wins in the NL behind Atlanta (19) and the LA Dodgers (17).

FLIGHT PATTERN: St. Louis enters today in 2nd place in the NL Central, 2.0 games behind first place Milwaukee and 1/2-game in front of 3rd place Chicago ...St. Louis is 15-9 since April 27 (4th-best in NL) and had 29+ wins through the first 50 games of a season for the first time since the 2015 Redbirds started 33-17 and won NL the Central Division with a 100-62 mark.

MAUTZ TO DEBUT IN TODAY'S START: Manager Oliver Marmol announced last night that rookie LHP **Brycen Mautz**, the Cardinals 2nd round draft selection in 2024 out of the University of San Diego, would start today's series finale and make his MLB debut...Mautz, 24, was 0-2 with a 2.90 ERA in 9 starts for Memphis (AAA) this season...the 6-3, 225-lb lefty (#52) was the Cardinals Minor League Pitcher of the Year in 2025.

QUEEN CITY TWO-WAY: **Jordan Walker** homered in both games of yesterday's double-header, joining **Scott Rolen** (2002), **Stan Musial** (1949), **Enos Slaughter** (1946), **Joe Medwick** (1934) and **Chick Hafey** (1928) among Cardinals to do so in Cincinnati. **RBI GUY:** Walker's 7 RBI in yesterday's double-header were the most since **Paul Goldschmidt** had 8 on 6/14/22 in a twinbill vs. Pittsburgh

THIRD TIME'S A CHARM: The Cardinal have outscored their opposition 29-8 in the 3rd inning and they've hit 10 HR's in the 3rd inning, their most of any inning...the Cardinals (10), Dodgers (14) and Phillies (11) are the lone NL teams to have hit 10+ HR's in the 3rd inning this season.

RUNNING REDBIRDS: The Redbirds baserunning has kept the pressure on this season with the Cardinals advancing from 1st to 3rd/home 42 times, tied for most in the majors with the Detroit Tigers...the team has had the NL's fewest outs on the basepaths (6) trailing only Texas (3) in MLB...Cardinals baserunners have the majors highest pct. (52 pct) of bases taken.

A DEBUT SEEN BY FEW: With hits in both games of yesterday's double-header, **Bryan Torres** joined **Speed Walker** (9/15/23) and **Heinie Mueller** (9/25/20) as the lone Cardinals to have hits in both games of a twinbill on their MLB debut date (*Orf*)...Torres also became just the 3rd Cardinal since 1900 with multiple hits & HR in his MLB debut along with **Bobby Smith** (4/16/57 at CIN) and **Joe Cunningham** (6/30/54 at CIN).

ON THIS DATE IN CARDINALS HISTORY (May 24, 1926): The Cardinals defeat the Cincinnati Reds 11-6 at Sportsman's Park in St. Louis as they come back from a 6-0 deficit thanks in large part to a 7-run 8th inning...CF **Taylor Douthit** led the way with 3 hits and 2 RBI and 3B **Les Bell** hit a 2-run HR in the 7th...**Jesse Haines** picked up the win in relief, his 1st of the season...the win evened the Cardinals record at 19-19 and was played in front of an announced crowd of 5,500...**Note:** The Cardinals are celebrating the 100th Anniversary of their 1st World Championship from 1926 this season.

CINCINNATI CONNECTIONS

Former Reds Executive, the late **Walt Jocketty**, served as the Cardinals GM for 13 seasons (1995-2007)...during tenure, St. Louis compiled seven NL Central Division championships (1996, 2000-02, '04-06), two NL Championships ('04, '06) & one World Series Championship ('06).

Terry Francona played in 86 games in 1990 with the Louisville Redbirds (AAA), including five at pitcher...his father, **Tito Francona**, played parts of two seasons (1965-66) with St. Louis...became a Cardinal via trade by Cleveland in exchange for a player to be named (Dec. 15, 1964)...originally signed by the St. Louis Browns before the 1952 season (MLB debut for Baltimore in 1956).

Reds pitching coach **Derek Johnson** played baseball & coached at Eastern Illinois Univ. (1991-94)...coached at Southern Illinois Univ. (1995-97).

Hall of Famer **Scott Rolen** played his final four seasons with the Reds (2009-12)...won the 2010 Gold Glove and was a two-time All-Star (2010-11)

Justin Bruihl pitched for the Reds Triple-A Louisville affiliate in 2024.

Riley O'Brien made his MLB debut with Cincinnati (Sept. 28, 2021 at Guaranteed Rate Field).

César Prieto made his MLB debut at Cincinnati on Aug. 29, 2025 & collected 1st MLB hit on Aug. 31 off **Emilio Pagán**.

Reds Asst. Pitching Coach **Matt Tracy** was born in St. Louis...graduated from Christian Brothers College HS.

Julio Rangel served as Bullpen Coach for the Reds in 2019.

Cardinals.TV broadcaster **Mark Sweeney** played outfield for both the Cardinals (1995-97) and Reds (1999).

Cardinals Hall of Famer **Vince Coleman** played in 33 games for Cincinnati in 1996.

Reds Senior Advisor **Cam Bonifay** played two minor league seasons with the Cardinals...worked for St. Louis as a professional scout and special assistant.

Reds Special Asst. to the GM **John Morris** played five seasons (1986-90) with the Cardinals.

Reds President of Baseball Ops **Nick Krall** previously interned for the New Jersey Cardinals of the NY Penn League (SS).

Reds broadcaster **Jeff Brantley** pitched in 48 games for St. Louis in 1998.

Cardinals Hall of Famer **Jim Edmonds** played 13 games for the Reds in his final season (2010).

Cardinals Hall of Famer **Julián Javier** played in 44 games for the Reds during his final 1972 season.

Reds Senior Advisor **Eric Davis** played two seasons (1999-2000) for St. Louis.

Cardinals Principal Owner and Chief Executive Office **William DeWitt Jr.** was a prior owner of the Reds and shareholder of the Cincinnati Bengals...his father, **William O. DeWitt**, was a sole owner of the Reds from 1961-67.

Reds CEO **Robert Castellini**, Chairman **W. Joseph Williams Jr.** and Vice Chairman **Thomas Williams** were Cardinals investors from 1995-2006...interests were sold as a condition of their acquisition of a controlling ownership stake of the Reds.
