NATIONALS NEWS

SERIES BUSINESS

The Washington Nationals square off against the Kansas City Royals in game two of the three-game series on Tuesday night.

- Washington beat the Royals, 7-3, in game one on Monday night...**Dylan Crews** hit a three-run homer in the fifth inning to extend Washington's lead...**Brad Lord** earned his fifth win of the season.
- With a win tonight, the Nationals would secure their fourth consecutive series win and their first series win against the Royals since May 26-28, 2023 at Nationals Park.
- Following this series, the Nationals will enjoy an off day in Tampa before starting a three-game road trip over Father's Day weekend with the Tampa Bay Rays.

WINNING WAYS

Washington enters tonight's game having won seven of their last 10 games and three consecutive series.

- The Nationals have won 10 of their last 11 series since May 12.
- The Nationals have a 27-19 (.586) record since April 25 and have won 10 of 15 series over this stretch.
- The Nationals are 12-9 (.571) at home dating back to May 3...This comes after starting the season with a 3-12 (.200) record at Nationals Park.

VOTE FOR OUR ALL-STARS

All-Star voting is now open and **CJ Abrams** and **James Wood** have placed themselves among the best players in Major League Baseball and the National League...

See charts to the right for position specific rankings.

- Wood has hit safely in his last seven games going 12-for-28 (.429) with two doubles, three homers, six RBI, four walks, three stolen bases and 11 runs scored...He is hitting .355/.466/.627 with six doubles, eight homers, 17 RBI, 22 walks, six stolen bases and 32 runs in his last 29 games...Wood is the only player in Major League Baseball with 20 home runs and 10 stolen bases.
- Abrams is 8-for-29 (.276) with a homer, five RBI, one stolen base and six runs over his last seven games.

DAYLEN'S DAYS

Daylen Life is 16-for-48 (.333) with a double, two triples, one homer, nine RBI, one hit by pitch, five walks, three stolen bases and seven runs scored over his last 13 games since June 1...He has just six strikeouts in 54 plate appearances (11.1%).

- On the season, he ranks among NL outfielders in triples (T3rd, 3), doubles (T3rd, 16) and hits (T6th, 75).

CORNER BATS

Since May 22, Washington's corner infielders **Luis Garcia Jr.** (6 HR, 23 RBI), **Curtis Mead** (6 HR, 15 RBI) and **Jorbit Vivas** (1 HR, 4 RBI) lead Major League Baseball with 13 home runs and are tied for the MLB lead with 41 RBI.

- Luis Garcia Jr.** is slugging .621 with three doubles, a triple, six home runs and 23 RBI since May 24, his 23 RBI are tied for most in Major League Baseball since that date...He is 7-for-25 (.280) with two doubles, two homers and eight RBI in his last seven games.
- Curtis Mead** is slugging .521 with two doubles, six homers and 15 RBI since May 22.

THIS AND THAT

Some notable notes from the hitters:

- Keibert Ruiz** has hit safely in seven of his last eight games going 9-for-27 (.333) with two doubles, a homer, three RBI, two walks and five runs scored.
- Dylan Crews** has driven in at least one run in a career-high five straight games, tied for the second-longest active streak in Major League Baseball...He has hit safely in all five games.
- Nasim Nuñez** has reached base safely in his last eight games, batting .321 (9-for-28) with a double, two walks, three stolen bases, six RBI and five runs scored...He is second in Major League Baseball with 25 stolen bases behind **Bobby Witt Jr.** (26)

FRAME JOB

Bobby Wilson's catchers rank tied for third in Major League Baseball with five Catcher Framing Runs (**Drew Millas** - 3, **Keibert Ruiz** - 2), according to Baseball Savant..."Catcher Framing Runs converts strikes to runs saved on a .125 run/strike basis, and includes park and pitcher adjustments. To qualify, a catcher must receive 6 called pitches per team game."

- The Nationals are one of just two teams (also Blue Jays) with two catchers in the top 13 in the league...Drew Millas is T7th and Keibert Ruiz is T11th.
- For comparison, Washington's catchers ranked 30th in MLB with -18 Catcher Framing Runs in 2025.

SAVES ON SAVES

The Washington Nationals have had nine separate pitchers record at least one save this season, tied for the second-most in Major League Baseball with the Cincinnati Reds and behind the Minnesota Twins (11) and the second-most in Nationals history (2005-pres.) behind the 2017 Nationals (11).

- Gus Varland** (5), **Richard Lovelady** (4), **Clayton Beeter** (4), **PJ Poulin** (2), **Orlando Ribalta** (2), **Andrew Alvarez** (1), **Brad Lord** (1), **Mitchell Parker** (1) and **Paxton Schultz** (1) have all recorded saves this year.

Lefty starter returns to Major League Baseball after spending the last three seasons with the Yomiuri Giants of Nippon Professional Baseball...Was a first-round pick by the Kansas City Royals in 2014 and their Minor League Pitcher of the Year in 2017.

- Made his Major League debut with Kansas City on July 27, 2020, his 25th birthday.
- Became the third pitcher since at least 1901 to earn the win in his MLB debut on his birthday, joining Edwin Jackson (9/9/03 at ARI) and Zach Day (6/15/02 at MON).

LAST START

Griffin tossed 6.0 innings and allowed just one run on six hits in a no-decision at San Francisco on June 10.

LEFT ON LEFT CRIME

Griffin has held opposing left-handed batters to a .172 batting average (15-for-87) with 25 strikeouts and just six walks...His four-seam fastball (.063), sweep (.167) and sinker (.200) have been particularly tough on left-handed hitters this year.

- In three starts from April 26 to May 8, lefties went 1-for-20 (.050) with six strikeouts and three walks against him.

TECHNICALLY, HE'S A ROOKIE

Although he spent three seasons in Japan, Griffin still qualifies as a rookie...Because of that, he ranks among qualified National League rookie pitchers in wins (1st, 7), starts (T1st, 14), WHIP (2nd, 1.09), innings pitched (1st, 78.0), strikeouts (2nd, 74) and opponents' average (3rd, .219).

GRIFFIN'S GLOVE

Griffin has three defensive runs saved and two runs saved above average according to FanGraphs.com, tied for most among National League pitchers.

BACK IN THE STATES, BACK IN THE WIN COLUMN

Griffin earned his first Major League win as a starter in his first career start on March 30 at Philadelphia...He threw 5.0 innings allowing just two earned runs on five hits with five strikeouts and no walks.

- It was his first Major League appearance since Sept. 22, 2022 at Tampa Bay and first Major League start after spending the last three seasons with the Yomiuri Giants of Nippon Professional Baseball

WINNING WAYS

Griffin won three of his first five starts without taking a loss, becoming just the third pitcher in Nationals history (2005-pres.) to win at least three of his first five starts with Washington without suffering a loss...He joins **Luis Atilano** (3-0 in 2010) and **Micah Bowie** (3-0 in 2007).

NPB Central League All-Star in 2025...Went 6-1 with a 1.52 ERA, 87 strikeouts, 22 walks and just one home run allowed in 89.0 innings across 17 starts.

- Recorded a 0.61 ERA (4 ER/59.0 IP) in nine starts from May 17 to July 12, 2025.
- Tossed 8.2 scoreless innings on June 15, 2024 at Nippon (5 H, 9 SO, 2 BB).
- Struck out 12 batters twice in 2024, both against Hiroshima: June 29 and Aug. 7.

Advanced through Kansas City's Minor League system as a first-round pick...Was the organization's Minor League Pitcher of the Year in 2017.
