AROUND THE HORN

KELLY’S FIRST BOBBLEHEAD ON SEPT. 12: The team will celebrate a starting rotation mainstay with the Merrill Kelly Bobble courtesy of Casino Arizona & Talking Stick Resort on Sat., Sept. 12 for the first 20,000 fans in attendance.

KPOP DEMON HUNTERS ON SEPT. 13: Fans will want to act fast to ensure they get the exclusive D-backs x KPop Demon Hunters Tee as club’s popular Special Event Ticket Pack series embraces the worldwide phenomenon.

SQUISHY DUMPLINGS ON SEPT. 14-15: The viral sensation D-backs x Mystery Squishy Dumpling will feature four options with the red, teal, white and ultra rare City Connect dumplings with each Special Event Ticket Pack including one of the exclusive, must-have dumplings.

HERE’S THE STORY: The D-backs are a season-high 10 games above .500 [last: Sept. 29, 2024 (89-73) end of season]...have won 4 straight games and 5 out of their last 6.

- The D-backs are 7-3 in their last 10 road games... have won or split 6 of their last 7 road series (5 wins, 1 split).
- The D-backs are 9-4 in their last 13 interleague games.
- D-backs starters’ combined 2.85 ERA since Aug. 29 (10 GS) ranks third best in the NL, to the Phillies (1.81) and Nationals (2.64) and fifth best in MLB.
- Zac Gallen** is making his first start since July 7 and **Michael Soroka** is expected to follow with his first appearance since Aug. 22.
- Ketel Marte** has hit in 7 straight games since returning from the 10-day IL on Aug. 31 (7 H, 5 BB), carrying an .846 OPS with 1 double, 1 homer and 2 RBI... has reached base 2+ times in 5 of his last 7 games.
- Gabriel Moreno** has a 6-game road hitting streak and hit safely in 13 of his last 14 road games...in his last 14 road games is batting .321 (18-for-56)/1.031 OPS with 5 doubles, 4 homers, 13 RBI and 8 walks.
 - Moreno** has reached base 2+ times in 5 of his last 6 road games and in 8 of his last 10.

LAST GAME: The D-backs won 5-3 in 11 innings @ Royals on Tuesday, their third extra-inning win in the last 4 days.

- Tim Tawa** (3-for-5, HR, 2 RBI) recorded his fifth 3-hit game of the season...gave the D-backs a 2-0 lead in the ninth inning with his solo homer (10) and had a go-ahead RBI single in the 10th.
- Lourdes Gurriel Jr.** broke a 3-3 tie in the 11th inning with his RBI triple and **Ketel Marte** added a sac fly to give the D-backs a 5-3 lead.
- Geraldo Perdomo** gave the D-backs their initial 1-0 lead in the eighth with his sac fly.
- Corbin Burnes** tossed 3.0 scoreless innings in his season debut (2 H, 2 BB, 2 K).
- Kade Strowd** (1.2 IP), **Kevin Ginkel** (1.1), **Dennis Santana** (1.0) and **Jonathan Loáisiga** (1.0) combined for 5.0 shutout frames with 3 hits, 2 walks and 3 strikeouts.
- Blake Walston** recorded his second career win (1 R-0 ER in 2.0 IP, 0 H, 3 BB, 2 K).

ROSTER MOVES: The D-backs reinstated RHP **Zac Gallen** from the 60-day IL (right elbow inflammation), RHP **Michael Soroka** from the 15-day IL (strained left glute) and optioned RHP **Kade Strowd** and LHP **Blake Walston** to Triple-A Reno.

WILD CARD RACE: The D-backs are in third place in the NL Wild Card race, a 0.5 game ahead of the Padres (Season tied 5-5), 3.0 games behind the Cubs (WC2, trail 2-4) and 3.5 games behind the Phillies (WC1, tied 3-3).

OVER THE LONG HAUL: The D-backs are 12 games above .500 (33-21) since July 9....their 33 wins since then are second most in the Majors, behind the Red Sox (38).

NAIL-BITERS: The D-backs’ 27 1-run wins (27-19, .587) are second in MLB to the Dodgers (30-22, .577)...4 of their last 5 wins have come via a 1-run advantage.

- The D-backs won a franchise record-tying 3 straight 1-run games from Sept. 5-7 for the first time since Aug. 19-22, 2025.

PEN QUARTET: The D-backs are 1 of 4 teams with 4 relievers (**Taylor Clarke**/2.52, **Brandyn Garcia**/2.08, **Jonathan Loáisiga**/2.43, **Juan Morillo**/2.33) with a sub-3.00 ERA [min. 40.0 IP] (also: Braves, Guardians and Padres).

- The D-backs and Guardians are the only clubs with 4 relievers who own a sub-3.00 ERA with minimum 50 appearances.

PEN SPOTLIGHT: **Justin Martinez** has not allowed an earned run in 7 games (2 R-0 ER in 6.2 IP) since returning from the 60-day IL on Aug. 18...is 2-0 with an opponent .091 AVG (2-for-22)/.377 OPS with 5 walks, 8 strikeouts.

TRENDING BATS: **Geraldo Perdomo** has reached base safely in 13 of his last 16 games, batting .294 (15-for-51)/.397 OBP with 6 RBI, 9 walks, 2 sac fly’s and 2 sac bunts...has reached base 2+ times in 10 of those.

- James McCann** has reached base safely in 8 straight starts, batting .321 (9-for-28)/.798 OPS with 1 double, 1 homer, 3 RBI, 1 walk and 1 sac fly.
 - In his last 20 starts, is batting .373 (28-for-75)/1.021 OPS with 3 doubles, 5 homers, 18 RBI, 4 walks and 1 sac fly.
- Tim Tawa** has reached base safely in 16 straight road games...has hit safely in 7 of his last 8 road games at a .345 clip (10-for-29)/.992 OPS with 1 double, 2 homers, 5 RBI and 3 walks.
- Lars Nootbaar** has reached base safely in 10 of his first 13 road games as a D-back since Aug. 14, batting .382 (13-for-34)/1.171 OPS with 3 doubles, 3 homers, 10 RBI, 4 walks and 1 sac fly.

VS. ROYALS: The D-backs have won 4 straight games @ Royals and are 6-2 in their last 8 meetings @ Royals.

- Have won or split 9 of their 10 all-time series @ Royals (won 7, tied 2).

LAST START: Took the loss on July 7 @ Padres (4 ER in 6.0 IP, 6 H, 3 BB, 5 K)...tossed 5.0 scoreless innings after allowing 4 runs in the first.

READY FOR ACTION: Tossed 1.2 scoreless innings (1 H, 2 BB, 2 K) in his lone rehab start with Triple-A Reno on August 30 vs. River Cats...also pitched in bridge camp games to complete his rehab.

THE CHANGEUP: With his changeup (17.6 pct. usage), is holding opponents to a .147 AVG (10-for-68) with 13 strikeouts and a 26.5 whiff pct.

SECOND MOST STRIKEOUTS BY A D-BACK: His 1,078 strikeouts are second all-time among D-backs, ahead of Brandon Webb (1,065) and behind Randy Johnson (2,077).
