Last 10 games: 8-2 Last 15 games: 12-3 Last 20 games: 14-6 TIGERS DEFEAT RAYS TO WIN SIXTH STRAIGHT SERIES: The Tigers extended their series winning streak to six with a 7-1 win over the Rays on Wednesday. Parker Meadows had three hits, including a leadoff homer, while Spencer Torkelson went 2x4 with a double, a homer and three RBI. Dillon Dingler and Riley Greene each had two hits and drove in a run. On the mound, Sean Guenther picked up his third win of the season, striking out three over 2.0 perfect innings. Brenan Hanifee, Tyler Holton, Will Vest and Jackson Jobe each had scoreless outings to close out the win.

OUT OF THE PARKER: Parker Meadows led off last night's game with a home run, his second leadoff homer of the season and his ninth roundtripper overall. The blast marked Detroit's ninth leadoff homer of the season, establishing a new franchise record. Since being reinstated from the injured list on August 3, Meadows is slashing .291/.335/.506 with nine doubles, five triples, six home runs and 23 RBI. Among American League hitters in that span, he ranks tied for eighth in fWAR (1.7) and tied for 10th with 20 extra-base hits.

BIG SEAN: Sean Guenther continued his impressive season last night, pitching 2.0 perfect innings with three strikeouts to earn his third win of the season. Guenther has allowed just one earned run over 15 appearances since August 22, posting a 0.48 ERA (18.2IP/1ER), 0.54 WHIP and 11 strikeouts. Among American League relievers (min. 15.0 innings) in that span, he ranks first in WHIP and opponent on-base percentage (.159), second in opponent batting average (.131) and opponent OPS (.339), third in ERA and fourth in opponent slugging percentage (.180).

WELCOME TO THE SHOW: Jackson Jobe made his Major League debut in last night's game, working a scoreless ninth inning. Jobe became the fifth pitcher to debut for the Tigers this season, joining Brant Hurter, Ty Madden, Keider Montero and Bryan Sammons.

SECOND HALF SURGE: With last night's win, the Tigers improved to 29-11 (.725) since August 11, which is the best record in the Majors over that span and the team's best record in a 40-game span since going 29-11 from August 15-September 26, 2011. Since August 11, the Tigers lead the Majors with a 2.59 ERA (365.0IP/105ER) and a +66 run differential.

TIGERS AND RAYS: The Tigers and Rays conclude their season series this afternoon. Detroit has won four of the first five meetings from Tampa Bay this season. With last night's win, the Tigers clinched their first season series win over the Rays since 2021.

AT COMERICA PARK: The Tigers are 2-0 on their current six-game homestand, which includes three games vs. Tampa Bay (2-0) and three games vs. Chicago (AL) (September 27-29). Detroit is 40-36 at Comerica Park this season, including a 14-5 record in its last 19 games in Detroit.

ON DECK: The Tigers begin their final series of the regular season tomorrow as they open a three-game series against the White Sox. Detroit has won nine-of-10 games from Chicago (AL) this season, including taking two-of-three in the only series this season at Comerica Park.

- Gave up one earned run-or-fewer in six consecutive starts from April 26-May 25, posting a 0.77 ERA (35.0IP/3ER) with 17 hits allowed, 11 walks and 29 strikeouts.
- Allowed a home run to Michael Massey leading off the second inning on May 20 at Kansas City, snapping his streak of innings without allowing a homer to start the season at 48.1...in the Wild Card Era (since 1995), that was the third-longest streak by a Tigers starting pitcher to begin the season and sixth longest by any Tiger.
