PENNANT RACE FEVER: Last night's crowd of 43,417 was this season's | CUATRO: Ketel Marte has hit safely in 6 of his last 7 fifth-largest home crowd and 1 of 10 home crowds of 40,000+.

• All-time, it is the largest crowd for a September/October Wednesday home game and 1 of only 5 crowds of 40,000+ as well as the 10th-largest crowd for a Wednesday home game.

APPROACHING 2.4 MILLION: The D-backs have back-to-back seasons of 2.3+ million in attendance and this season's 2,359,021 is the largest home attendance since 2008, fourth largest since 2003 and ninth all-time.

· Have drawn 2,359,021 through 80 home games, passing 2007's 2,325,413 and 2024's 2,341,876.

NL WILD CARD RACE: The D-backs — who trailed by 10.0 games in the NL Wild Card race on August 1 — are tied for fourth with the Reds, 1.0 game behind the thirdplace Mets.

SNAKE BITES: The D-backs are 8-4 in their last 12 games.

- Geraldo Perdomo has reached base safely in 13 straight games, the third-longest streak of his career (.383, 18-for-47, 1.155 OPS, 4 2B, 1 3B, 2 HR, 7 RBI, 10 BB-5 K, 3 HBP)...stretch began with a career-best 12game hitting streak from since Sept. 9-23
- · Gabriel Moreno has reached base safely in a career-high 13 straight games, hitting .354 (17-for-48)/.978 OPS with 2 doubles, 2 homers, 7 RBI and 10 walks (6 K).
- Corbin Carroll has hit safely in 12 straight home games (.386, 17-for-44, 1.154 OPS, 5 2B, 1 3B, 2 HR, 11 RBI, 8 BB), tied for the second-longest of his career (also: March 29-April 25, 2025) behind his career-best 16-gamer from Aug. 9-Sept. 13, 2024.

LAST GAME: The D-backs lost 5-4 vs. Dodgers in 11 innings.

- The D-backs cut down a 4-1 deficit with a 3-run eighth inning on Corbin Carroll's RBI double, Gabriel Moreno's RBI single and Adrian Del Castillo's pinch-hit sac fly.
- Ryne Nelson had a quality start and a career-high-tying 9 strikeouts (3 ER in 6.0 IP, 7 H, 0 BB, 9 K)...has 6 quality starts in his last 7 starts.
- Corbin Carroll tied a career high with 4 times on base, with a single, a RBI double and 2 walks...also had his career-best ninth outfield assist, throwing out Hyeseong Kim at the plate in the 10th inning.

HOME SWEET HOME: The D-backs' 43-37 (.537) home record is the team's fourth-best home mark, behind 2017 (52-29, .642), 2019 (44-37, .543), 2024 (44-37, .543), and the sixth winning season at home since 2017.

• The 43-37 (.537) home record is the team's sixth-best since 2009 behind 2017 (52-29, .642), 2011 (51-30, .630), 2013 (45-36, .556), 2019 (44-37, .543) and 2024 (44-37, .543).

START ME UP: The D-backs starting rotation is among the best in the Majors since Aug. 27 ranking first with 17 quality starts, tied for third with 12 starter wins, fourth with a 2.82 ERA, fifth with 50 runs allowed, fifth with 147.0 innings and sixth with an opponent .643 OPS.

Perdomo's 6.9 fWAR (FanGraphs.com) is second in the NL to Shohei Ohtani/LAD (7.2) and ahead of Trea Turner/ PHI (6.7) and Corbin Carroll/AZ (6.6).
