TODAY'S TRANSACTIONS: The Reds today activated from the 10-day injured list **OF Dane Myers** (left shoulder contusion); optioned to AAA-Louisville **INF/OF Ivan Johnson**.

TONIGHT'S GAME: Is Game 1 of a 3-game series vs **Cory Little's Rockies** and the first game of Cin's longest road trip of the 2026 season, a 10-day/9-game journey that includes upcoming series at **Sea** (Mon-Wed) and **StL** (Fri-Sun).

- The Reds return home to **Great American Ball Park** on 7/27 to begin an 11-day/10-game homestand vs **Cle** (7/27-7/29), **Pit** (7/30-8/2), and **Ath** (8/4-8/6).

STAR-STUDDER: RHP **Chase Burns** and INF **Sal Stewart** represented the Reds as National League All-Stars at the 2026 MLB All-Star Game in Philadelphia.

- It was the first career All-Star selection for both players...2026 marks the third straight year in which Cin has multiple All-Stars.
- Burns** did not play...**Stewart** entered the game as a defensive replacement at third base and went 0-for-1 with a walk.
- Burns** and **Stewart** are the third set of teammates in Reds history to each earn an All-Star selection at age 23 or younger in the same season (also: **Johnny Bench** & **Wayne Simpson** in 1970, **Frank Robinson** & **Vada Pinson** in 1959).

TOUGH SLEDDING: The Reds have dropped 10 of their last 14 games and 13 of their last 19 games.

- Went 20-11 (.645) to begin the year...entered May a season-high 9 games over .500 and in first place in the NL Central (+1.0)...ended the month 2 games over .500 and in fifth place (-6.0).
- Beginning 5/1, have gone 23-41 (.359).
- Since 6/1, have gone 13-24 (.351).

STRUGGLING AGAINST PEERS: The Reds are 6-22 (.214) vs their NL Central counterparts and 23-39 (.371) against all National League opponents.

- The Reds own the lowest winning pct (.214) of any Major League team within its own division.
- Conversely, Cin owns the majors' sixth-best record vs American League teams (20-13, .606).

POWER SURGE: The Reds rank 11th in the majors with 119 homers...they've scored 48.1% of their 395 runs via the HR (190), the third-highest rate in MLB.

- Are on pace to hit 202 homers this season, which would mark the 10th time in club history reaching 200 HR.
- Have hit a Major League-leading 27 homers to the opposite field this year, 6 more than the next closest team (**Phi**).
- Are 1 of 5 teams in the majors to boast 6 players with 10 or more HR (also: **NY Yankees**, **Sea**, **Pit**, and **LAD**).
- Have 4 pinch-hit HRs this season (T5th in the majors)...were the only team in the majors last year not to produce a HR off the bench.
- Are tied for the Major League lead with 8 sets of back-to-back HRs (also: **Athletics**)...hit *back-to-back-to-back* HRs in the 4th inning on 7/8 vs **Phi** (**Elly De La Cruz**, **Sal Stewart**, **JJ Bleday**)...marked their 15th set of 3 straight home runs in the expansion era (since 1961).

BRING 'EM ON: The Reds own a 29-35 record (.453) this season against opponents entering play with a .500-or-better winning percentage, but are 22-37 (.373) vs teams currently at or above .500.

- Have dropped 32 of their last 46 games vs teams entering play with a .500-or-better winning percentage.
- Are 21-15 (.583) vs teams currently under .500.
- Have the second-toughest remaining schedule in the majors based on opponents' winning percentage (.528; **NY Yankees** .539).

SERIES NOTES: The Reds are 125-117 all-time vs the **Rockies** (51-70 in **Colorado**)...Cin took 2 of 3 at **Great American Ball Park** from 4/28-4/30.

- From 4/25-4/27, 2025 the Redlegs swept the **Rockies** at **Coors Field** for the second consecutive season...have won 6 straight games and 7 of their last 8 in the **Mile High City**.
- Since 6/19/23 Cin has won 16 of 19 overall vs **Col**, including 10 of 13 at **Great American Ball Park**.
- The 7/12/25 game was the first in the Reds/**Rockies** all-time series to feature a walkoff win since Cin's 3-2 victory on 9/2/22...the Reds are 15-6 all-time in walkoff games vs **Col**.
- Cin's 4-2 win at **GABP** on 7/13/25 marked **Terry Francona's** 2,000th career victory as a Major League manager.

GENO 200: In Sun's 8-4 loss vs **Chc**, DH **Eugenio Suárez** belted his 200th career home run as a **Cincinnati Red**...is the 11th player in franchise history to hit at least 200 homers with the team.

- Is 3 HR shy of tying **Eric Davis** for 10th place on the club's all-time list.
- Suárez** is the 16th active player in the majors to hit at least 200 HR with a single team.
- Enters tonight having homered in each of his last 2 games, while also reaching safely in each of his previous 16 games.

ELLY MAKING HISTORY: SS **Elly De La Cruz** (496 career games) is the second player in Major League history to produce at least 75 HR and 150 SB within his first 500 career games, joining Reds Hall of Famer **Eric Davis**, who had 107 HR and 190 SB through his first 500 career games.

- Elly** on Sun vs **Chc** collected his 500th career hit...he enters today's game with 199 career extra-base hits.

LAST TIME OUT: Suffered the 1-0 loss on Thu, 7/10 vs Phi (7.1ip, 4h, 1r/1er, 1bb, 5k, 2hb, 89TP).

- His 7.1 innings marked the longest outing by a Reds pitcher this season.
- First time in his career that he threw as many as 7.1 innings and as few as 89 pitches in a game.
- Threw 12 pitches in the 1st, 20 in the 2nd, 9 in the 3rd, 10 in the 4th, 8 in the 5th, 8 in the 6th, 9 in the 7th, and 13 in the 8th.
- Faced 4 batters in the 8th (hit batter, groundout, RBI-single, BB) before he turned it over to Sam Moll.
- Held the Phillies hitless when he was ahead in the count (0-for-10, 2hb).
- Thew 19 of 28 first-pitch strikes...allowed 7 baserunners.
- Was his fifth quality start of the season.

JULY 3 vs BAL: Did not factor in the decision in the 3-0 loss vs Bal on Fri, 7/3 (5.0ip, 3h, 3r/2er, 5bb, 6k, 1hr, 93TP).

- Matched a career high with 5 walks (5x).
- Threw 30 of his 93 pitches in the 1st inning.
- Held batters to 0-for-10 when he was ahead in the count.
- Allowed 8 of his 21 batters to reach.

JUNE 28 at PIT: Suffered the 9-4 loss at Pit on Sun, 6/28 (4.1ip, 9h, 5r/5er, 0bb, 6k, 2hr, 1hb, 98TP) .

- Produced a season high 17 swings-and-misses (52 swings).
- Matched a season high with 10 base runners (4/8 at Mia).
- Was the fourth time this season that he didn't issue a walk.
- Allowed multiple homers for the first time since 5/30 vs Atl.
- Faced 3 batters in the 5th inning (fly out, home run, single) before turning it over to Julian Garcia.

JUNE 22 vs MIL: Did not factor in the decision in the 10-inning, 2-1 loss on Mon, 6/22 vs Mil (7.0ip, 2h, 0r, 2bb, 7k, 106TP).

- Was his 12th career scoreless start of at least 7.0 innings, his first since 7/27/25 vs TB (7.1ip).
- Matched Chase Burns (5/3 at Pit) for the longest scoreless outing by a Reds pitcher this season.
